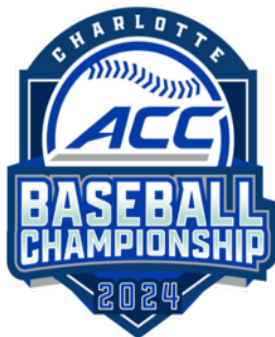

## ACC CHAMPIONSHIP STORYLINES & NEWS

- Miami continues its **80th season** in program history and **inaugural campaign** under the direction of head coach **J.D. Arteaga**.
- The **11th-seeded Hurricanes** open up their postseason against the **seventh-seeded Louisville Cardinals** at 11 a.m. Tuesday.
- Miami is **26-27** all-time in the **ACC Baseball Championship**. The Hurricanes' **lone ACC Championship** came in **2008**.
- In **22 meetings**, Miami and Louisville are **tied, 11-11**. The Hurricanes won the last head-to-head affair, 17-5, on April 21, 2024.
- Miami left-hander **Rafe Schlesinger** (4-5, 5.92 ERA) draws the start opposite Louisville lefty **Evan Webster** (5-2, 3.54 ERA).
- Two Hurricanes earned All-ACC accolades: SP **Gage Ziehl** (First Team) and 3B **Daniel Cuvet** (2nd & All-Freshman Team).
- In conference play, Ziehl **leads all ACC hurlers in innings** (68.1) and **complete games** (2), while ranking **fifth in ERA** (3.56).
- Cuvet **paces all Division I freshmen in RBI** (65), while ranking **second in home runs** (21) and **total bases** (154).
- Miami has totaled **18 comeback victories**, tallying 10 wins when trailing after the sixth inning, including **five walk-offs**.
- In **2023**, the Hurricanes tallied a **42-21 record**, earning a top-10 seed in the postseason for the second straight year.
- Miami has qualified for the **College World Series 25 times** - the second-most of any program nationwide, trailing only Texas (38). The Hurricanes' **four national championships** (1982, 1985, 1999, 2001) are tied for fifth-most all-time.

**THE HURRICANES' SKIPPER**

UM Sports Hall of Fame Class of '07  
No. 33 retired in '03

Winningest pitcher in program history (43)



J.D. Arteaga became the 10th head baseball coach in University of Miami history, elevating to the helm of the program prior to the 2024 season.

Arteaga previously served as associate head coach in charge of pitching. Overall, 2024 will mark Arteaga's 22nd year as a member of the Hurricanes baseball staff.

For the fourth straight year, the Hurricanes' longtime pitching guru groomed an All-American hurler in 2023. Right-hander Andrew Walters cemented himself as one of the most dominant closers in college baseball, after earning a spot as a finalist for the prestigious NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award the season prior. The unanimous All-America honoree headlined a Miami staff which featured four draft picks in the 2022 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.

Southpaw Carson Palmquist led the class as a third-round choice by the Colorado Rockies, while righty Alex McFarlane followed shortly as a fourth-round selection by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Arteaga developed another All-American in 2021, as Palmquist was a consensus All-America pick and earned first-team honors by the NCBWA and Perfect Game. The lefty headlined Miami's four All-ACC selections with a first-team nod while also earning a place on the ACC All-Freshman Team.

Palmquist and right-hander Alejandro Rosario each were named Freshman All-Americans, while right-hander Jake Smith was selected in the sixth round of the MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels and right-hander Daniel Federman signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Orioles.

The 2020 Hurricanes featured a pair of All-Americans, as standout right-handed pitchers Brian Van Belle and Chris McMahon were both selected to Collegiate Baseball's All-America Second Team.

After the season, sophomore right-hander Slade Cecconi was taken by the Arizona Diamondbacks with the 33rd overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft, becoming the 29th Hurricane to be selected in the first round of an MLB Draft.

McMahon, a junior right-hander, went in the second round of the MLB Draft to the Colorado Rockies. Van Belle and fellow right-hander Tyler Keysor signed free agent contracts following the shortened five-round MLB Draft, joining the Red Sox and Reds organizations, respectively, and giving Miami four pitchers joining the professional ranks.

The 2019 season featured the emergence of redshirt junior Brian Van Belle as a standout starter for the Canes. The right-hander earned All-ACC Second Team honors and was named to the All-Starkville Regional team to cap a season in which Van Belle led the Hurricanes in wins (10), innings pitched (95.1) and had the lowest ERA among starting pitchers (3.30). Right-hander Slade Cecconi earned Freshman All-America honors, while Evan McKendry (9th round, Rays) and Gregory Veliz (15th round, Angels) headlined four pitchers selected in the MLB draft.

In 2018, Arteaga guided right-hander Evan McKendry to a breakout season on the mound, where he led the Hurricanes staff in wins (seven) and strikeouts (114), as well as compiled a 3.52 ERA - second-best among weekend starters - while earning Third-Team All-ACC honors. Fellow right-hander Daniel Federman earned Freshman All-America honors, while four Miami pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft.

Jeb Bargfeldt, Miami's ace in 2017, was named to the All-ACC Second Team in his first season working under Arteaga. The left-hander finished the season 7-3 with a 2.28 ERA over 87 innings.

Arteaga, a standout southpaw during his own four years in the Miami rotation, helped guide the Hurricanes to their second straight College World Series berth and 25th in program history in 2016. Under his direction as pitching coach in 2016, closer Bryan Garcia set the all-time saves record at Miami and became the first Hurricane to win NCBWA Stopper of the Year honors as the nation's top relief pitcher.

Garcia (sixth round, Detroit) and left-hander Danny Garcia (14th round, Seattle) were both selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. At least one Hurricane pitcher has been selected in the MLB Draft each year since 2004.

Arteaga recently coached left-hander Chris Diaz to ACC Co-Pitcher of the Year honors in 2014. Under his guidance, all four of Miami's starting pitchers in 2014 - Diaz, Bryan Radziewski, Javi Salas and Andy Suarez - were all drafted in the top 10 rounds of the 2014 MLB Draft.

Suarez, who elected to return to school and served as the staff ace on a 2015 team that qualified for the College World Series, was drafted in the second round (No. 67) overall by San Francisco in the 2015 MLB Draft.

Arteaga helped lead Radziewski to Rawlings All-America honors in 2013 - the first for a UM player since 2010. Two of the team's weekend starters, Radziewski and Diaz, ranked among the top three in ERA for all Atlantic Coast Conference pitchers in 2013.

Arteaga has tutored three recent first-round draft picks in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft - Carlos Gutierrez in 2008, Chris Perez in 2006 and Cesar Carrillo in 2005. Gutierrez was the 27th overall pick in the 2008 draft by the Minnesota Twins after earning second team All-ACC honors. Perez, who came to Miami as a starting prospect, was aided by Arteaga in his transition to becoming one of the country's top closers. Carrillo started his career 24-0 as a Hurricane.

In addition to his work in converting Perez from a starter to a closer, he helped Kyle Bellamy in his transition from a traditional over-the-top throwing motion to a sidewinding delivery. The move had great rewards, as Bellamy recorded 16 saves and finished the 2009 season with a 0.97 ERA en route to numerous first team All-America honors.

Arteaga's 2008 staff boasted National Freshman Pitcher of the Year and Roger Clemens Award finalist Chris



Hernandez, who finished 11-0 with a 2.72 ERA while opponents hit just .223 against him. All three starters in 2008, Hernandez, sophomore lefty Eric Erickson and senior right-hander Enrique Garcia combined to go 27-4 while the entire pitching staff combined for the fewest walks (187) in school history and eighth-most strikeouts (554).

His 2006 staff, composed almost entirely of first-time starters, recorded five shutouts, the most by a UM staff since the 1998 season. Miami also recorded the team's first postseason shutout on the road since 1976 with a 7-0 win against Ole Miss in the 2006 Oxford Super Regional.

Four pitchers from Arteaga's 2005 pitching staff signed pro contracts following the season, including the school's first pitcher drafted in the first round since the 1991 season, Carrillo. Arteaga also played a major role in Carrillo's career development and run at the NCAA record books. Carrillo, who was the 18th overall pick in the 2005 draft, ended with a career record of 25-3, was an All-American and a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and the Roger Clemens Award as college baseball's best pitcher in 2005.

The 2004 Miami pitching staff produced the best team ERA in (3.73) since the 2000 season (3.72).

Head coach Jim Morris named Arteaga the Hurricanes' next pitching coach on March 4, 2003, nine games deep into the season. Arteaga's style and approach to pitching was vital in J.D. Cockcroft's development into the ace on Miami's 2003 club. Cockcroft, a crafty left-hander, went 11-3 with a 2.72 ERA in a team-high 119 innings, including three complete games and one shutout.

Arteaga played for the Hurricanes from 1994-1997, helping UM reach the College World Series four straight seasons. He left Miami as the program's all-time wins leader with 43 and the all-time starts leader with 72. Arteaga ranks second for innings pitched in a career with 458.1.

He is also fifth on the all-time strikeouts chart with 343 career punchouts. Arteaga threw three complete games at UM and struck out career-high 11 batters on two different occasions (FSU, 4/16/95 and George Washington, 2/16/96). He posted an 11-3 record as a sophomore in 1995 and a 9-1 mark as a freshman.

Miami retired Arteaga's No. 33 on Feb. 5, 2003, prior to the season opener with Florida International. A 26th round draft choice by the New York Mets, Arteaga spent six seasons in the Mets' and Houston Astros' organizations. He had signed on with the Texas Rangers' organization in the spring of 2003, prior to accepting his post with the Hurricanes. He spent his last professional season with the Astros' Triple-A franchise New Orleans Zephyrs, compiling a 9-10 record with a 4.29 ERA in 15 starts and 42 appearances.

The left-hander came to the Hurricanes out of Westminster Christian in Miami. He won a career-best 12 games as a junior in 1996 (12-1) and came back to go 11-4 as a senior in 1997.

After six seasons in professional baseball, Arteaga earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from the University of Miami.

He is married to the former Ysha Schettini and the couple has a daughter, Ariana. The Arteagas' son, Ari, passed away in 2018 at the age of 16. The Ari Arteaga Foundation was founded shortly afterward to honor and memorialize Ari. Its mission is to spread Ari's spirit by helping children and families overcome obstacles they may face due to unforeseen hardships. The goal is to shine Ari's light on their path of need.

## ACC CHAMPIONSHIP NEWS & NOTES

### MIAMI OPENS ACC CHAMPIONSHIP

- The **11th-seeded Miami Hurricanes** begin postseason play against the **seventh-seeded Louisville Cardinals** at 11 a.m. Tuesday.
- Miami and Louisville are joined by the **second-seeded Clemson Tigers in Pool B**.
- The Hurricanes are **26-27** all-time in the **ACC Baseball Championship**. Miami has **won one ACC Championship in 2008**.
- Last year, the Hurricanes reached the title game for the first time in 11 years.
- Since the conference adopted a 12-team pool play format in 2017, the **lowest seed** in a pod has advanced to the **semifinals six times**, including 11th-seeded Pitt in Charlotte two seasons ago.
- Miami junior left-handed pitcher **Rafe Schlesinger** (4-5, 5.92 ERA) toes the rubber opposite Louisville senior lefty **Evan Webster** (5-2, 3.54 ERA) in the tournament opener.

### TWO HURRICANES EARN ALL-ACC ACCOLADES

- Right-hander **Gage Ziehl** was named to the **All-ACC First Team**, while third baseman **Daniel Cuvet** garnered **All-ACC Second Team** and **All-ACC Freshman Team** honors, the league office announced Monday afternoon.
- Ziehl earned conference recognition for the **second straight year** after being tabbed a second team selection in 2023.
- Cuvet was **one of just three freshmen** to garner **first or second team** distinction, joining Georgia Tech's **Drew Burress** and North Carolina's **Jason DeCaro**.

### CARDIAC CANES

- Through its first 54 games, Miami has **notched 18 come-from-behind victories**, including **five walk-off wins** against NJIT on Feb. 16, then-No. 15 North Carolina on March 16, FIU on March 19, then-No. 3 Clemson on March 28 and BYU on May 2.
- The Hurricanes have tallied **10 victories trailing after six innings**.
- On March 9, Miami overcame a **nine-run deficit** vs. then-No. 13 Virginia, scoring 13 unanswered runs. The come-from-behind win marked the Hurricanes' **largest comeback victory** since erasing a nine-run deficit against Tampa on **May 13, 1992**.
- The Hurricanes scored six runs in the seventh inning before plating another seven tallies in the eighth.

**DANNY DINGERS**

- Freshman **Daniel Cuvet** has established himself as one of the most prolific power hitters in the country.
- As of May 20, Cuvet leads all **Division I freshmen in RBI** (65), while ranking **second in home runs** (21) and **total bases** (154). The infielder is also **third in slugging** (.706).
- Heading into the postseason, Cuvet **paces the club in 12 offensive categories**, including average (.344), homers, RBI and OPS (1.133).
- Cuvet has a chance to become the **first freshman** to lead Miami in batting, home runs and RBI.
- Only **one Hurricane freshman** has hit more homers than Cuvet, with **Pat Burrell (23)** setting the single-season mark in **1996**.
- The Fort Lauderdale, Fla., native is currently **tied for the seventh-most home runs by a Hurricane** in a campaign.
- D1Baseball tabbed Cuvet as the **ninth-best third baseman** in the country.

**GAGEING THE ACES IN THE ACC**

- Junior **Gage Ziehl** has built a reputation as one of the top arms in the country.
- In conference play, Ziehl **leads all ACC hurlers in innings** (68.1) and **complete games** (2), while ranking **fifth in ERA** (3.56).
- Across 14 appearances, the right-hander has turned in 10 quality starts, becoming the **first Hurricane** to pitch at least **6.2 innings in five straight outings** since **Jeb Bargfeldt in 2018**.
- Ziehl has tossed **at least six innings in nine of his last 10 starting nods**, highlighted by two complete games.
- On March 15, Ziehl tossed the **first complete game** by a Miami starter since Bargfeldt accomplished the feat against Boston College on **May 17, 2018**.
- Two weeks later against then-No. 3 Clemson, the captain punched out a **career-high 15 batters** in his second complete game in three starts, becoming the **first Miami pitcher** to total **15 strikeouts** in an outing since **Bryan Radziewski** fanned 16 hitters against Virginia Tech on **March 23, 2013**.
- Following one of the greatest performances in recent Hurricanes baseball history, the Macedon, N.Y., native was named **ACC Pitcher of the Week** on **April 1**.
- Ziehl followed it up with eight quality innings at then-No. 9 Duke on April 5, before limiting then-No. 10 Florida State to two earned runs over seven innings on April 11.
- As of May 20, the 6-foot, 223-pound ace is six innings shy of the century mark. Following his seven-frame outing against Pitt, Ziehl became the **first Hurricane** to pitch at least **92 innings in back-to-back seasons** since **Chris Diaz** accomplished the feat in **2013 and 2014**.

### WE GO WITH DGO

- Junior **Dorian Gonzalez Jr.** has been a key cog in the middle of Miami's order.
- Gonzalez Jr. **paces the Hurricanes in doubles** (16), while sitting **second in hits** (67), **RBI** (47) and **total bases** (107). The Miami native is also **third in average** (.310).
- A year ago, Gonzalez Jr. served primarily as a defensive replacement, appearing in 53 contests after being a regular during his freshman campaign.
- In 2022, he hit .263 with two home runs and 21 RBI, missing one month due to a lower-body injury.

### LONG TIME COMING

- Senior **Jacoby Long** has come of age in his last year of collegiate eligibility.
- In conference action, Long **leads the Hurricanes in batting** (.364), the **five-highest mark among all ACC players**.
- Overall, the center fielder is hitting .302 with four home runs and 24 RBI, swiping a team-high nine stolen bases in 50 games.
- The Palm Beach Gardens, Fla., native has totaled **63 percent** of his **career RBI**, **59 percent** of his **career hits** and **half** of his **career homers** in just this season.
- Long has made 38 starts in 2024 after earning just **20 combined nods** across his **first three years**.

### THE INJURY BUG

- Injuries have plagued Miami this season, as **seven Hurricanes** have **missed significant time**, including All-ACC candidates **Blake Cyr** and **Jason Torres**.
- A 2023 Consensus Freshman All-American, **Cyr** was limited to **25 games** after breaking his **thumb** at Duke on April 5.
- Prior to his injury, Cyr tallied a .284/.397/.537 slashline with seven home runs and 21 RBI.
- **Torres** started Miami's first **39 contests** before having **season-ending elbow surgery**.
- The 6-foot-1, 228-pound slugger finished his sophomore campaign with a .331 average, eight home runs and 32 RBI.
- Junior left-handed pitcher/utility **Renzo Gonzalez** and freshman outfielder **Luca Reyes** have been **sidelined the entire year**.
- Right-handed relievers **Drew Dwyer**, **Julian Hernandez** and **Jordan Vargas** have also been **unavailable throughout the season**, combining to throw just 15 2/3 innings.
- Recently, the Hurricanes suffered another blow, as setup man **Brian Walters** **underwent season-ending arm surgery**. Walters' 3.29 ERA is the top mark in Miami's bullpen.

### O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• The University of Miami players and coaches combined to select right-handed pitcher **Gage Ziehl** and **Dorian Gonzalez Jr.** as 2024 team **captains**.

### CANES BASEBALL ENTERS 80TH SEASON

- The **2024 campaign** is the **80th** in **Miami Hurricanes baseball history**.
- The Hurricanes enter the season with a new leader, as **J.D. Arteaga** embarks on his **first season** at the helm of the Canes, after spending 21 years as a coach and a four-year Hall-of-Fame playing career in Coral Gables.
- Arteaga, who is the **10th head coach** in program history, follows the footsteps of legendary skippers **Ron Fraser** and **Jim Morris**.
- The Hurricanes have accomplished a lot in advance of their 80th season: national championships in **1982, 1985, 1999** and **2001, 25 trips** to the **College World Series** and an **NCAA record 44 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances**.
- Miami has also produced **56 All-Americans**, while **66** different Canes have gone on to play in the **MLB**.

### NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES

- Miami has **18 newcomers** on the 2024 roster, with 12 freshmen, three transfers and three JUCO transfers joining the 17 returning letterwinners from a year ago.
- Head coach **J.D. Arteaga** also overhauled his coaching staff, bringing in **Laz Gutierrez, Darren Fenster** and **Rob Cooper**.
- Gutierrez returns to his alma mater after spending the past four years as the head coach at Nova Southeastern. Before coming home to South Florida in 2019, Gutierrez worked **13 years** with the **Boston Red Sox** organization, helping the Red Sox win **three World Series Championships** (2017, 2013, 2018).
- Fenster comes to The U after **12 years** with the **Red Sox**. During his time with the organization, Fenster groomed the next crop of major-league stars, helping the franchise win **two World Series** rings in 2013 and 2018.
- A Double Cane, Cooper rejoins the program after working the **past 19 seasons** as the **head coach** at Penn State and Wright State. Cooper's resume is also filled with international experience, as he has been selected to **four coaching stints** with **USA Baseball** in 2000, 2007, 2009 and 2013.
