## **QUICK HITS**

### SHRINERS CHILDREN'S CHARLESTON CLASSIC

Miami is set to compete in the Charleston Classic for the fourth time since the inception of the tournament in 2008. Miami is one of five teams who will have played in the tournament four times (Charleston, Clemson, Davidson, Temple). Miami has won the Charleston Classic twice before (2009-10 and 2014-15) and are the only two-time winners in the history of the Classic.

### **CRUISING ON OFFENSE**

Miami's offense has been on fire through the first three games, averaging 98.0 points per game. It is the highest three-game scoring average for the Hurricanes to start the season since 1964-65 when Miami scored 106.7 points per game through the first three contests. Miami currently ranks fifth in the nation (first in the ACC) in scoring offense.

### THE 1,000-POINT CLUB

Senior Brandon Johnson eclipsed the 1,000-point mark in his career on Sunday, connecting on a 3-point basket to perfectly hit 1,000 points. Johnson is the fourth active Hurricane to reach 1,000 points, joining Nijel Pack (1,664), Jalen Blackmon (1,325) and Matthew Cleveland (1,177).

### **DEPTH AND VERSATILITY**

The Miami roster is extremely deep this year as the bench is accounting for 37.0 points per game. Freshman Divine Ugochukwu leads the Miami bench in scoring at 11.3 points per game, followed closely by freshman Jalil Bethea at 9.7 points per contest.

- The Hurricanes sit third in the nation 3 in field goal percentage at a .576 shooting clip.
- Miami had six players score 10-plus 6 points in a game for the first time since Dec. 17, 2022 vs. St. Francis (PA).
- Guard Nijel Pack tied his career high 9 with nine assists against Coppin State on Sunday.

## THE MATCHUP

- Miami heads to Charleston, S.C., for the 2024 Shriners Children's Charleston Classic beginning on Thursday, Nov. 21. The Hurricanes will take on the Drake Bulldogs in the first game of the tournament at 12 p.m. on Thursday. The game will air on ESPN2 with Rich Hollenberg and Perry Clark on the call. Fans can also listen to the game on 560 WQAM.
- This will be just the second all-time meeting between the Hurricanes and the Bulldogs and first in regular-season action as the last time these teams met was in the first round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament.
- The five-seed in the Midwest Region, Miami defeated 12th-seeded Drake, 63-56, in Albany, N.Y. to advance to the next round. The Hurricanes trailed by eight with under five minutes to play, but then-third-year-sophomore Nijel Pack willed Miami to victory, scoring 21 points in the game.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Hurricanes moved to 3-0 on Sunday when they defeated the Coppin State Eagles, 93-63, Sunday afternoon at the Watsco Center. Six different players scored in double-figures in the win.
- Miami was led in scoring by Matthew Cleveland who totaled 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting. The Hurricanes knocked down 14 threes in the game, marking the second straight game Miami has connected on 10-plus shots from beyond the arc.

### **SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS**

- Drake enters Thursday's game with an identical 3-0 record as the Hurricanes, most recently defeating the FGCU Eagles, 63-61, in Des Moines, Iowa. The Bulldogs are under new direction this season as Ben McCollum was named the new head coach in the offseason.
- The Bulldogs are led in scoring by Bennett Stirtz, who is averaging 18.7 points per game, while Cam Manyawu paces the team in rebounding at 6.7 boards per contest. As a team, Drake averages 74.0 points per game and is shooting 49 percent from the field and 39.7 percent from 3-point range.

- Overall, Miami holds a 7-2 record in Charleston Classic games and, on average, has outscored its opponents by 16.1 points per contest in games it has won. Five of the Hurricanes' seven victories have been double-digit wins.
- In 2014, Angel Rodriguez was named the Classic's Most Valuable Player and Tonye Jekiri earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team.

### HIT THE ROAD, CANES

vs. Connecticut

11/24

- Miami is set to play its first neutral site game of the season on Thursday against Drake. The Hurricanes are 30-28 all-time in neutral-site openers and 10-3 under head coach Jim Larrañaga.
- Overall, Miami holds a 108-99 record in neutral site contests and a 102-82 mark since the program rebirth in 1985.
- In 2023-24, the Hurricanes went 2-2 in neutral site games, winning two games and the entire Baha Mar Bahamas Championship in November, falling to Colorado at the NABC Showcase in December and losing to Boston College in the first round of the ACC Tournament in March.

### A BALANCED ATTACK

- Six Hurricanes are currently averaging double-figures in scoring Nijel Pack (14.7), Lynn Kidd (14.0), Jalen Blackmon (14.0), Divine Ugochukwu (11.3), Matthew Cleveland (11.0) and Brandon Johnson (10.3) making Miami one of four Division I teams with six players averaging double-digits.
- The Hurricane are the only Power 4 team to do so as the other teams are Missouri State, Portland State and Washington State. Miami and Missouri State are the only two of those four teams to have a freshman averaging double-figures.

### **DIVINE'S HIS NAME**

- Freshman Divine Ugochukwu has been playing excellent basketball in his first three games as a Hurricane, averaging 11.3 points and 2.0 assists per contest, while shooting a team-leading 81.3 percent from the field.
- Ugochukwu is one of six ACC freshmen averaging 10-plus points per game this season and leads all ACC rookies (min. 15 attempts) in field goal percentage.

### **DISHING DIMES**

- Graduate student Nijel Pack is just four assists away from reaching 350 dimes in his career. Once he hits that mark, Pack will become one of nine active Division I players with 1,500-plus career points and 350-plus career assists.
- Pack currently ranks fifth in the nation (second in the ACC) in assist/ turnover ratio (10.0) and 21st in the country (second in the ACC) in assists per game (6.7).

### TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK

- The Hurricanes have been very effective in taking care of the ball this season sitting fifth in the nation (first in the ACC) in assist to turnover ratio at 2.25.
- Miami's turnover average of only 8.0 per game is good for fourth in the nation (first in the ACC).

- The Hurricanes signed a pair of four-star recruits on Nov. 13, making up the nation's No. 10 recruiting class per Rivals.
- Guard Matthew Able checked in as the No. 34 player in the class per 247Sports Composite rankings. On the 3SSB Circuit in 2024, Able averaged 13.6 points, 5.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.4 steals in 19 games.
- Benjamin Ahmed is the No. 94 player in the nation per 247Sports Composite rankings and second-best player out of Connecticut.
   He helped Putnam Science Academy win the National Prep Championship in 2023.

### **COUNTDOWN TO 750**

- Head coach Jim Larrañaga earned his 743rd win as a Division I collegiate head coach on Sunday against Coppin State, putting him just seven wins away from 750 in his career.
- Once he hits that mark, Coach L will be one of just 25 coaches in Division I men's basketball history to win 750 games. He will join the likes of ACC basketball coaching greats Mike Krzyzewski (1,202), Jim Boeheim (1,015) and Roy Williams (903).

- > Bring head coach Jim Larrañaga to 744 career wins, just six away from 750.
- > Be the fourth straight win for the Hurricanes, something that has not happened since the end of non-conference play in 2023-24.

### **KY TO THE LEAGUE**

- In June, Kyshawn George was selected 24th overall by the Washington Wizards via a proposed trade with the New York Knicks in the 2024 NBA Draft at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- George was the 26th player in Miami program history to hear his name called in the NBA Draft and the first first-round draft pick since Lonnie Walker IV was selected 18th overall in 2018.
- At least one Hurricane has been chosen in five of the last eight NBA Drafts – George, Jordan Miller (2023), Isaiah Wong (2023), Dewan Hernandez (2019), Lonnie Walker IV (2018) and Bruce Brown Jr. (2018) and Davon Reed (2017).

### **KEEPING ELITE COMPANY**

- Nijel Pack currently sits 20th among all active D-I players in career points (1,664), fourth in career 3-pointers (298) and tenth in 3-pointers per game (2.57).
- Lynn Kidd ranks second among all active D-I players in career field goal percentage (.663), while guard Jalen Blackmon ranks third in career free-throw percentage (.904).
- Forward Brandon Johnson is tied for 15th among active D-I players for career double-doubles with 23.

### PACK x ACC POTW

- Graduate student Nijel Pack was named ACC Co-Player of the Week alongside Florida State's Jamir Watkins on Nov. 11. Pack averaged 19.0 points, 5.5 assists and 2.5 rebounds per game in the opening week of the season.
- Pack is the first Hurricane to be named ACC Player of the Week since Feb. 6, 2023 when he earned the same accolade. Pack is a four-time conference player of the week honoree having been named ACC Player of the Week twice and Big 12 Player of the Week twice while at Kansas State.

In his 13 seasons at the University of Miami, head coach Jim Larrañaga has led the Hurricanes to six NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16. He has guided the Hurricanes to their first Elite Eight (2022), first Final Four (2023), first ACC Tournament title (2013) and first two ACC regular season crowns (2013 and 2023).

Larrañaga has been named the Associated Press, Naismith, USBWA and Henry Iba National Coach of the Year, twice was both the ACC and USBWA District Coach of the Year and was the 2013 NABC District Coach of the Year.

The winningest coach in program history, Larrañaga has

posted five 25-win seasons at UM – the only Miami coach to do so even once – and seven in his career. He also has recorded eight 20-win campaigns at Miami and 14 in his career.

In conference action, the Hurricanes have won nine or more league games in eight of 13 seasons, while prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami had never won more than eight ACC games in a season.

Larrañaga has helped the Hurricanes to 30 postseason victories, including 11 in the NCAA Tournament (six appearances), 13 in the ACC Tournament (13) and five in the NIT (two). He ranks top-30 all-time among Division I coaches with 740 victories, including seventh among active coaches.

During his time at Miami, Larrañaga has coached eight NBA Draft picks, two All-Americans and 22 All-ACC honorees.

In 2023, Larrañaga was both inducted into the UM Sports Hall of Fame & Museum and named a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame first-time nominee.

Miami has seen unprecedented fan interest in the program under Larrañaga. In 2017-18, for the third straight season, the Hurricanes sold out their season-ticket allotment at the Watsco Center. The 2015-16 campaign marked the first time in UM history that any team sold out of season tickets. Across 2021-22 and 2022-23, Miami recorded four of the five highest single-game student attendance marks in program history.

### **MIAM**

During the 2023-24 season, the Hurricanes posted a 15-17 overall record and a 6-14 mark in ACC play. Under Larrañaga's tutelage, fourth-year junior Norchad Omier earned his second consecutive All-ACC Second Team honor and was named the 2024 Skip Prosser Award recipient, honoring the league's top men's basketball scholar-athlete.

Freshman Kyshawn George was selected 24th overall in the 2024 NBA Draft by the New York Knicks, becoming the 26th player drafted into the NBA in program history. Miami is one of 12 schools with three or more draft picks in the last two years.

In 2022-23, Larrañaga guided Miami to its best year ever. The Hurricanes finished 29-8 (15-5 ACC), shared the ACC regular season title and earned their first Final Four appearance. Miami set or tied program records for overall, ACC, regular season (24), home (16), top-25 (seven), top-10 (three) and top-five (two) victories. The team ended the year third in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll, good for its best finish ever.

Seeded No. 5 in the Midwest Region, the Hurricanes knocked off top-seeded and No. 2/1-ranked Houston, 89-75, and second-seeded and No. 5/7-ranked Texas, 88-81, in a three-day span in Kansas City, Mo., to clinch their Final Four bid. They also knocked off seven teams with a combined 23 NCAA titles (including one vacated) during the 2022-23 campaign, including an eight-point road victory at North Carolina, a 22-point home win over Duke and a 16-point triumph over Indiana in the NCAA Tournament. The team lost by more than seven points just twice all year.

Larrañaga earned multiple significant achievements during the historic season. First, on Nov. 19, 2022, he led Miami to a 74-64 victory over his alma mater, Providence, in Uncasville, Conn., to become just the 35th coach with DI experience to reach 700 wins, including only the fourth to do so while in the ACC. On Dec., 21, 2022, he was named a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame first-time nominee. Following the season, on May 4, 2023, he was inducted into the UM Sports Hall of Fame & Museum.

Numerous Hurricanes claimed major awards during the season, as well. Isaiah Wong became Miami's second ACC Player of the Year and sixth All-America, garnering NABC third-team distinction. He was also a finalist for the John R. Wooden Award and the Jerry West Award, among many other accomplishments. Jordan Miller received Second Team All-ACC status, while Norchad Omier picked up third-team plaudits. Nijel Pack won NCAA Tournament Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player honors, while Miller and Wong both tallied All-Tournament Team status.

The 2022-23 success followed another tremendous season the year before, as Miami, picked No. 12 in the ACC preseason poll, went 26-11 (14-6 ACC). Seeded No. 10 in the Midwest Region, the Hurricanes rattled off three straight victories to make the Elite Eight for the first time, including throttling second-seeded and No. 8/7 ranked-Auburn, 79-61, in the Round of 32, en route to finishing co-No. 16 in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll.

Larrañaga set the program record with his 221st victory at The U on March 2, 2022, at Boston College, just weeks after a Feb. 9, 2022, triumph over Georgia Tech made him the first coach in NCAA history with 100 league wins at three DI schools and/or in three DI conferences. Kameron McGusty turned in one of the best years in program history, claiming First Team All-ACC, NABC First Team All-District 2, ACC All-Tournament First Team, NCAA Tournament All-Midwest Region and Senior CLASS Award finalist accolades.

In 2017-18, Miami played in its fourth NCAA Tournament in a six-year span, claiming the No. 6 seed in the South Region. The Hurricanes tied for third in the ACC and finished the season with a 22-10 mark, including an 11-7 record in conference play. The Hurricanes were nationally ranked for 15 weeks, reaching as high as No. 6 in the polls.

Freshman Lonnie Walker IV was named Honorable Mention All-ACC, becoming the first freshman all-conference honoree in program history. He also was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team. Miami earned road wins over then-No. 12 Minnesota and then-No. 9 North Carolina, the fourth straight year and the sixth time in Larrañaga's first seven seasons that Miami defeated two or more top-15 teams.

In 2016-17, Miami went 21-12 overall and claimed the No. 8 seed in the Midwest Region. It defeated three ranked teams, including two in the top 10. Davon Reed won the Skip Prosser Award and Larrañaga registered his 600th all-time win with a 72-46 triumph at Pittsburgh on Jan. 14, 2017.

The 2015-16 Hurricanes played their way into the NCAA Tournament's Sweet 16 for the second time in four seasons, and just the third time in school history.

In 2012-13, Larrañaga helped Miami to a No. 2 national ranking by both the AP and USA TODAY and a No. 2 seed in the NCAA

tournament. At the time, he was the 10th coach in the last 10 years to lead two top-10 programs, as Miami was No. 2 on Feb. 18, 2013, and George Mason was No. 8 in the final Top 25 poll in 2006.

Individually, Shane Larkin earned the ACC Player of the Year and Lute Olson National Player of the Year awards, as well as All-American status and finalist nods for the Bob Cousy, John Wooden and James Naismith player of the year honors before declaring early for the 2013 NBA Draft. Larkin was also the ACC Tournament MVP, on the ACC All-Defensive Team and a Defensive All-American. Durand Scott was the ACC Defensive Player of the Year.

### **GEORGE MASON**

Larrañaga came to Miami after serving as the head coach at George Mason for 14 seasons. He guided the program to five NCAA Tournament appearances (1999, 2001, 2006, 2008, 2011), including an unprecedented run to the 2006 Final Four that captured the nation's attention, as the Patriots defeated Michigan State, North Carolina, Wichita State and Connecticut along the way. Following that run, Larrañaga was selected the 2006 Clair Bee National Coach of the Year.

Larrañaga built the George Mason program into a perennial contender in the highly-regarded Colonial Athletic Association, winning more games than any other coach in program and conference history (273) en route to three conference titles (1999, 2001, 2008).

In 2006, Larrañaga became the first coach at a mid-major school to take his team to the Final Four in 27 years and earned the CAA's first NCAA tournament at-large berth in 20 years. Along the way, he led Mason to a school record in wins, its first-ever national ranking, its first-ever appearance in the Top 10 and its first wins over Top 10 teams.

### **BOWLING GREEN**

Larrañaga served as the head coach at Bowling Green for 11 seasons (1986-1997) and at Division II American International for two seasons (1977-79).

At Bowling Green, he made an immediate impact in his first season. In 1986-87, the Falcons were the nation's most improved team under a first-year head coach that took over a program with a losing record, posting a 15-14 record for an eight-game improvement over the previous season. Larrañaga went on to record a 170-144 mark in 11 years at Bowling Green, earning 1997 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading Bowling Green to a 22-10 record, a conference regular season co-championship and a berth in the NIT. The 22 victories were the most by a Bowling Green team in 47 years and the 13 conference wins were the second- highest total in BGSU history.

Larrañaga's 170 victories at Bowling Green ranked second all-time on the Falcons' coaching list and he was only the second coach to record consecutive postseason appearances. Larrañaga led his squad to NIT berths in 1990 (18-11) and in 1991 (17-13), the first time the Falcons enjoyed back-to-back postseason appearances since the early '60s. Bowling Green won better than 60 percent of its games in Larrañaga's last four years (70-44). The Falcons finished fourth or better in the MAC in five of Larrañaga's 11 seasons and he is among the winningest coaches in MAC history.

### **AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL**

Larrañaga earned his first head coaching position in 1977 when he was named to the post at American International, a Division II program in Springfield, Mass. Taking over a team that had suffered through five consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, Larrañaga turned AIC into a winning program in his first year and compiled a 28-25 mark in two seasons.

Larrañaga's first coaching opportunity came at Davidson College from 1971-76, serving as an

vidson College from 19/1-/ro, serving as an assistant coach to Terry Holland. Davidson captured three Southern Conference regularseason championships and an NIT berth in his five years there, and he compiled a 47-12 record doubling as the freshman team coach. In 1976, he left Davidson and spent one season as player-coach for the Geronemo Basketball Club in Belgium.

After his two-year stint at American International, Larrañaga was reunited with Holland at the University of Virginia in April 1979. An assistant coach under Holland at UVA for seven seasons from 1979-86, he helped the Cavaliers reach the NCAA Final Four on two occasions (1981 and 1984), finish in the top five of the AP and UPI polls and average more than 24 victories per season. The Cavaliers were 169-62, won three regular-season Atlantic Coast Conference championships and made four NCAA Tournament appearances in that span. Virginia also made a pair of NIT appearances, winning the NIT Championship in 1980. Larrañaga was on the staff during the careers of three-time National Player of the Year Ralph Sampson and NBA first-round draft choice Olden Polynice.

A 1971 graduate of Providence College with a degree in economics, Larrañaga was a four-year letterman for the Friars. As the team captain in his senior season, he led Providence to a 20-8 record and an NIT appearance. He graduated as the school's fifth all-time leading scorer with 1,258 points and was selected in the sixth round of the draft by the Detroit Pistons of the National Basketball Association. He was the team's top scorer as a sophomore and junior and was named New England's Division I Sophomore of the Year in 1969. He was inducted into the Providence College Hall of Fame in 1991.

Larrañaga and his wife, Liz, have two sons and four grandchildren. Their son, Jay, played for his father at Bowling Green, was the head coach of the NBDL's Erie Bayhawks and is now an assistant coach with the Los Angeles Clippers. Jon was a member of his father's George Mason teams from 1999-2003, earning first team Academic All-America honors for NCAA Division I-AAA schools.


