- Transfer guard, Daylen Berry has impressed Buc Nation early as the two-way shot creator scored 18 points vs UTRGV, recorded a double-double (19 points and 12 rebounds) at LSU, and led the team in scoring vs Furman (16).
- Daylen Berry is also currently T-15th in the nation in total steals (19).

- In a Big South Season Preview interview, Coach Nimley mentioned speeding up the Bucs' offensive tempo as a style change spectators can expect to see this '24-'25 season. The Bucs ranked 311th out of 351 division one programs last year in scoring offense.
- Although they are young, a graduate transfer from Drexel Univeristy, Lamar Oden Jr., was recruited to this year's team and expects to see a heavy amount of minutes to provide some added experience to the Bucs' lineup.

FIRST FULL YEAR FOR COACH NIMLEY

- Charleston Southern officially named Saah Nimley as their fulltime head coach on Monday, March 4th.
- Nimley was elevated to the role of Interim Head Coach on November 29, 2023 after Head Coach Barclay Radebaugh stepped down. Radebaugh is the winningest coach in program history and was in the midst of his 19th season at the helm at CSU.
- Nimley began his coaching career in 2019-2020, joining the CSU staff as an assistant coach after a stellar four-year playing career at CSU where he ranks 3rd in career scoring and 1st in career assists all-time.
- Nimley was named Player of the Year for the Big South at the conclusion of the 2015 season.
