## NOTING THE WOLFPACK

### The Basics of the Matchups

- Friday's meeting with the Canes will be the 22nd all-time. The two programs have split the last 10 meetings with Miami winning two of the last three. When playing four sets, the Pack is 3-6 against the Canes and 1-2 when playing five sets.
- In the last meeting in Coral Gables, then sophomore Ava Brizard led the Pack with 19 kills, while Courtney Bryant added 15.
- Sunday's tilt with the Florida State will be the 54th all-time. The Seminoles lead the series 46-7 and have won seven of the last 10 meetings. Since the rally scoring era began in 2001, the Wolfpack is 0-10 when playing four sets against the Seminoles and 2-2 when playing five.
- In the last meeting in Tallahassee, then sophomore Ava Brizard tallied a career high 25 kills on 53 attempts with three errors to finish the match with a .415 hitting percentage.

### Down to the Wire

- With just eight matches left in the 2024 regular season, the Wolfpack looks to continue to build a resume that would earn it a spot in the NCAA Tournament. Despite having an RPI that should have gotten NC State into the tournament, the Pack was marked "first four out" in 2023 due to not enough quad-one wins.
- The Pack checked in at 39 in this week's RPI rankings, 46 in the KPI, and 40 in the strength of schedule report.
- Out of the eight remaining games in ACC play, the Pack will face a ranked opponent in at least four of them -- Miami received votes in this week's poll.

### Big Red's Makes a Statement

- Senior Amanda Rice tallied 37 kills during opening weekend for the Pack and recorded double-digit kills in all three

- In the final weekend of non-conference play, the Lemont, Ill. native tallied 30 kills, averaged 3.75 kills per set, recorded a .333 hitting percentage -- marks that ranked first in the ACC among any opposite.
- As of Monday, the Rice ranks 19th in the nation, in all of D1, among opposites for kills per set (3.38) and ranks third in the ACC in kills per set by an opposite (Olivia Babcock from Pitt averages 4.39 per set and ranks third in the nation, first in the ACC).

### Skye's the Limit

- Senior libero Skye Stokes has recorded at least one service ace in 88 games throughout her career. She leads all active players in the ACC for most games with a service ace in their career.
- She currently ranks 13th in the nation for active career leaders (D1) in service aces and is the only student-athlete in the ACC that ranks in the top 15 for the stat.
- Stokes totaled at least one service ace in 18 of the squad's 29 matches last season.
- She recorded a career high seven in four set win at Boston College and marked the fourth most in a single match in program history. Her seven aces against the Eagles marked just the second time an athlete in the ACC recorded that many in a match in 2023 (Georgia Tech's Bianca Bertolino recorded that many against Louisville seven days prior).
- Entering the 2024 season, she sat at 145 career service aces (102 at West Virginia plus 43 at NC State) - a mark that ranks eighth in program history for most in a career. She also recorded a mark of 0.39 aces per set in 2023 to take the top spot in the record book for career average - breaking a record that sat for 20 years (Julia Reiss recorded 0.33 aces per set in her lone season with the Pack in 2003).
- Her jump serve made any gym she's in go silent, always shocked opponents due to the spin and speed of the ball. This season, she has transitioned to a float serve.

### A Family Affair

- Fifth year setter Naomi Cabello will lineup against a familiar face in Sunday's match against Louisville -- her younger sister Nayelis, a freshman setter for the Cardinals.
- Sunday marked the first time the two have ever taken the court together.

### What a Jump

- The Wolfpack checked in at 33 in the third RPI ranking of the season -- jumping 27 spots from the Oct. 7 poll.
- The ranking is the second highest in program history to date. Last year, the Pack checked in at 27 in the first RPI ranking of the 2023 season.
- As of Monday, Oct. 21, the Pack remains at 33 in the RPI rankings.

### A Match That Hit Close to Home

- The October 13th match against the Blue Devils marked the annual Pink Match for the Wolfpack.
- The first coach of the volleyball program, Kay Yow, battled breast cancer on-and-off for 22 years. She

earned the inaugural Jimmy V Perseverance Award at the 2007 ESPY Awards after one of the most remarkable seasons in the history of women's college basketball.

- Senior setter Naomi Cabello and freshman outside Reis Baune both have seen the affects of breast cancer first hand -- both their mom's battled the disease. Mayra Cabello and Mandy Baune, both survivors, were both in attendance on Sunday.

### First RPI Check In

- The NCAA released the first RPI rankings of the 2024 season on October 2. The Wolfpack checked in at 50, 23 spots lower than a year ago- RPI of 27 on Oct. 2, 2023 marked the highest RPI ranking in program history.
- As of October 7, the Wolfpack checked in at 60.

### Gnarly Plays and Feelin' Gritty

- The Wolfpack have proven they aren't afraid to make a 'gnarly play', as head coach Luka Slabe likes to say. Whether it is sprinting toward the bleachers, diving toward signage, heading toward a bench, or hitting a ball over the net from the ground -- the Pack will do whatever it takes to keep a rally going.
- Senior Libero Skye Stokes made the number three spot on Sports Center Top 10 after a 'gnarly' play against Liberty on September 11 that had her diving into signage in the south end of Reynolds Coliseum to keep the ball in play -- the Pack won the rally in the end.
- The Pack has also proven it is full of grit. The team has been working on their mindset when it comes to being down in a set -- not counting themselves out, but focusing on the next point.
- Despite being down 11 in set three against Coastal Carolina, the Wolfpack forced set point to be played seven times after a 6-0 scoring run to minimize the scoring deficit to six before the Chanticleers won the set, 25-18.

### Court Chop, The Difference Maker

- Junior outside hitter Courtney Bryant has proven to be the game changer for the Pack in its last few matches. She has recorded 10+ kills in three of the last four matches.
- Despite the Pack dropping the match to Mizzou on September 1, Bryant started the match and immediately scored a handful of points in attempts to help the Wolfpack down the Tigers.
- She finished the South Florida Invitational with 20 kills, 10 digs, five service aces, four blocks, and three assists. Her performance in Tampa earned her Tournament MVP.
- Bryant missed the beginning for the 2023 season due to injury and quickly became a familiar face in the lineup last season. She has already proven to be a name to remember this season.

### Tamed the Bulls, Had a Day

- In the four-set win over South Florida, who received votes in last weeks AVCA coaches poll, the Pack recorded 13 total blocks (1 solo, 24 assists). At the beginning of the third set, the Pack was out-blocking the Bulls 11-0 and finished the match out-blocking

- The Pack also tallied a season high 12 service aces in both matches of the South Florida Invitational - a mark that ties for seventh most in a single match in program history.

#### Slabe Era Extended Through 2029

- After the 2023 season, head coach Luka Slabe received a contract extension through the 2029 season.
- Since taking over the program, Slabe has compiled a 62-42 record, highlighted by the historic 22-7 record during the 2023 season.

#### Opening Weekend of Milestones

- The Pack saw two student-athletes reach career milestones in opening weekend. Senior setter Naomi Cabello reached 1,000 assists and senior middle blocker Jada Allen achieved 500 kills in the loss at then No. 12 Creighton.
- Cabello became just the second setter in the Slabe Era to achieve 1,000 assists -- she joins former setter Kristen McDaniel.
- Allen is the third athlete on the current roster to reach 500-plus kills in the past year. She joins Ava Brizard and Amanda Rice in the 500 kills club under Slabe.

#### 2024 Roster

- The Pack returned 14 from the 2023 roster and added three during the off season -- one transfer and two freshman.
- Key returners for the Pack: Ava Brizard, Naomi Cabello, Martyna Leoniak, Jada Allen
- Junior Sophie Groom joined during the spring semester. The middle blocker was a member of the ASUN All-Freshman Team after averaging 2.06 kills per set, a .309 hitting percentage, 0.77 blocks per set, and 2.54 points per set.
- Reis Baune and Alyssa Forelli joined the Pack over the summer. Baune, an outside hitter, was a 13u National Champion and All-American in high

school. Forelli, a setter, earned first team All-Region and second team All-State honors.

#### Never Forget 2023

- The 2023 squad made the season one for the history books -- literally. The Pack opened the season with a 11-1 record to mark the best start under Slabe and the best start since 2015. During that 11-1 run, the Pack maintained a 10 game win-streak to mark the longest since 2014 AND the longest under Slabe.
- History was made on Oct. 1 when the Wolfpack defeated then No. 5 Louisville, 3-1, in Reynolds Coliseum. The win marked the first win over a top-five opponent, first win over a ranked opponent in Reynolds Coliseum, and just the second win over a top-25 team ... ALL in program history. The win allowed the Pack to receive votes in the Oct. 2, 2023 AVCA coaches poll -- no record of this occurring previously.
- In the first RPI rankings of 2023, NC State checked in at 27, a program best, and was one of just five ACC schools in the top-30. The Pack would go on to finish the season 43rd in the RPI rankings.
- NC State visited Carmichael Arena in Chapel Hill on Oct. 29. After defeating the Tar Heels 3-1, the Pack marked the first win in Chapel Hill since 1997. 15 days later, the Pack would pick up its 20th win of the season at Virginia Tech, recording the first 20-win season since 2017.
- The Wolfpack would go on to finish the season 22-7, the best overall record since 2012 for the Wolfpack and the 12-6 conference record was the best since 2016.

#### Hungrier Than Ever

- Every college athletes goal is to make an appearance in the NCAA Tournament before their career comes to an end.
- The 2023 season ended sooner than anticipated after the Pack did

not earn an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament on Selection Sunday. All returning players have mentioned how hungry the team is for a post season appearance.

#### Big Red's World and We're Just in it

- Senior opposite Amanda Rice had a stellar 2023 campaign. She recorded three 18+ kill matches, including a career high 26 kills in the loss at Duke. The Illinois native became the first person since 2016 to record 26+ kills in a five set match, joining Pack great Julia Brown (31 vs Syracuse in 2012).
- Rice was also one of only two opposites to rank in the top-10 for best attack percentage in a single match in 2023. Big Red recorded 16 kills on 24 attacks with zero errors to finish the match at Virginia in November with a .667 hitting percentage (Ashley Slater from Wake Forest is the only other opposite to rank in the top-10 in the conference for best hitting percentage from finishing the Syracuse meeting with a .706 percentage after going 12-0-17)
- Her performance against UVA in November put her in the top-27 for best single match attack percentage last season in the NCAA (all DI schools).

#### It Means So Much More

- Senior libero Skye Stokes lost her father in May 2023. When she was young, he started a club program for her to be able to participate in. Volleyball has always been important for the two and she has her favorite picture of them tattooed on her outer left calf
- She continues her volleyball career for him and reminds herself daily that it is much "bigger than the game" these days
- She has "DAD" written on the outer sole of her shoe and wears a blue (his favorite color) ribbon in his honor

#### Healy Takes Canada ... Team Canada

- The sophomore from San Rafael, Calif.

earned a spot on the U19 Canadian National team to compete at the NORCECA Continental Championship in Puerto Rico in May 2023 and then the U21 team to compete in Toronto in 2024.

- Healy is able to play for Canada due to holding dual citizenship -- mom is originally from Canada.
- In 2023, Healy helped Canada to a sixth place finish.
- In 2024, Canada finished fourth and Healy ranked 17th overall in the tournament for best scorers as she finished with 39 points.

#### What a Guy

- Head coach Luka Slabe won the National Championship in 2001 when he played for BYU. On Sept. 1, 2023 he and his teammates were inducted into the BYU Hall of Fame, alongside the 1999 and 2004 teams. He was also a member of the National Championship Runner Up squad in 2003.

#### Why Not Us?

- The 2023 season ended sooner than the Pack had hoped after not hearing its name called on Selection Sunday. Despite the heartbreaking end to the season, those returning in 2024 immediately went to work and found themselves saying "Why not us in 2024?".
- The men's basketball run in the 2024 ACC Tournament proved that anything is possible. They also started using the term "Why not us?" and used it throughout the post season run. The proved that even the underdog can shock the world when it's least expected.

#### Gold for USA in 2020

- In his final competition with Team USA at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics as an assistant coach, Luka Slabe helped the team capture the country's first ever gold medal in the sport.

### BIO

Slabe was hired as the 10th head coach in program history for NC State volleyball on Feb. 10, 2020. Slabe joined the Wolfpack after two years with USA Volleyball. While at USA Volleyball Slabe has worked under sport legend Karch Kiraly to help the American side qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, in which the team won the country's first-ever gold medal in the event. Additionally, he helped the team take home a silver medal at the 2019 FIVB World Cup.

In his first season at the helm, the Wolfpack went 8-9 including a 7-9 record in conference play after navigating through a difficult year due to the CoVID-19 pandemic. Two Pack players earned all-conference honors in Melissa Evans (First Team) and Jade Parchment (Second Team).

In year two and three, Slabe and company finished 16-13 overall, 10-8 in conference play. Two members of the team earned all-conference honors each season (2021: Melissa Evans - First Team, Jada Allen - Freshman Team | 2022: Priscilla Hernandez - Second Team, Ava Brizard - Freshman Team).

In 2023, the Pack finished with a 22-7 record overall after beginning the season 11-1 to mark the program's best start to a season since 2015. On September 13, Slabe recorded his 50th win as a head coach and almost two months later record his first 20 win season. On October 1, the Wolfpack defeated then No. 5 Louisville, 3-1, at Reynolds to mark the first win over a top-five team in program history, in addition to the first win over a ranked team in Reynolds Coliseum. The win was also just the second over a ranked team in program history.

Prior to his time with the USA National Team, Slabe was an assistant coach with the men's program at his alma mater, BYU from 2015-18. Slabe helped BYU finish as NCAA runners-up in both 2016 and 2017, while also reaching the Final Four in 2018. Additionally, BYU won a pair of Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Championships (2016 and 2018).

From 2013-15, Slabe served as the head coach of the Slovenian National Team, dramatically increasing the program's world ranking. During his tenure as a Head Coach of Slovenia Men's National Team, various professional teams, while competing in the most prestigious club league in the world – Champions League, his teams won eight national and international championship titles.

Slabe played collegiately at BYU, helping the program to the 2001 NCAA Championship. The team was the 2003 NCAA runner-up as well. He earned a Bachelor's Degree in Athletic Training from BYU in August 2003.

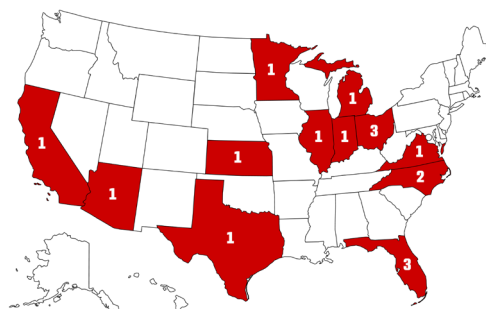
