EAGLES DIGEST

- Coppin heads South to face the Miami Hurricanes on November 17 at 2 pm on ACCNX. The Eagles are 0-3 against Miami, and last met on December 21, 2019.

- In his CSU debut, **Derrius Ward** led all players with 19 points at Wake Forest on Monday night. CSU outscored Wake Forest, 27-22 in the second half and also outrebounded the Demon Deacons.

- In Coppin's home opener vs. Rider, Ward and **Toby Nnadozie** both had a game-high 18 points. Nnadozie's effort was a career high along with his four 3-pointers.

- Against Virginia on Monday night, Ward (12) and **Jonathan Dunn** (11) were both in double figures. Dunn's total was a career-high before he went off for 22 points on 9-of-14 shooting the next game at UMBC.

- The Eagles are under the direction of 2nd year head coach **Larry Stewart**. Stewart is arguably the greatest player in CSU history, winning back-to-back MEAC POTY awards, was an inaugural induction into CSU's Hall of Fame and played five NBA seasons.

- Derrius Ward was named MEAC Defensive Player of

the Week on November 12 after averaging 15.3 ppg & 6.0 rebounds over the 1st 3 games of the season.

- 15 of 20 players & coaches on the CSU roster are from either the Baltimore, Philadelphia or DC region.

- Sophomores **Ryan Archey** and **Camaren Sparrow** are the team's top returning players. Archey led Coppin in scoring during MEAC play last year and was 3rd Team All-MEAC. Sparrow was a walk-on last season but made the MEAC All-Rookie Team.

- Ten players are new to the program, including five 4-year transfers **Julius Ellerbe** (EMU), **Jonathan Dunn** (Austin Peay), **Derrius Ward** (Florida Memorial), **Toby Nnadozie** (UMES) and **Macahi Nelson** (AIC).

- The coaching staff features four of Coppin's all-time greatest players. Assistant **Stephen Stewart**, the younger brother of Larry, was also a back-to-back MEAC POTY (94-95), **Sidney Raikes** was a 2x 1st Team All-MEAC selection & ranks 8th in points. **Terquin Mott** was the 1997 MEAC POTY and led CSU to a NCAA Tournament win over #2 South Carolina. Raikes will be inducted into CSU's Athletic HOF in February.

Coppin State University named Larry Stewart ('06) as the new Head Men's Basketball Coach on May 2, 2023. Stewart returned to his alma mater after spending 14 years as an assistant coach at the three other Historically Black Colleges

and Universities in Maryland. Stewart served as an assistant at Bowie State for six seasons (2009-15) with the last three as associate head coach, Morgan State (2015-19, 2022-23) and Maryland Eastern Shore (2019-21) with one season as associate head coach.

Stewart is widely regarded as one of the greatest players in Coppin State history and is one of two Eagles (Joe Pace) to play in the NBA, where he played five seasons with the Washington Bullets, Vancouver Grizzlies and Seattle SuperSonics. He was a two-time MEAC Player of the Year, earning the honor in back-to-back seasons (1990, 1991), and was a three-time All-Conference selection (1989, 1990, 1991). After going undrafted, Stewart averaged 10.4 points and 5.9 rebounds in his 1991-92 rookie season for head coach, and Hall of Famer, Wes Unseld with the Bullets and became the first undrafted player in league history to make an NBA All-Rookie Team. In his final season in the league, he played alongside perennial All-Starts Gary Payton and Shawn Kemp under the legendary George Karl. Among his other teammates throughout his NBA career include Chris Webber, Juwan Howard, Ralph Sampson, Michael Adams, Manute Bol, Rex Chapman, Terry Cummings, Pervis Ellison, Harvey Grant, Nate McMillan, Gheorge Muresan, Sam Perkins, Detlef Schrempf and Scott Skiles,

Leading Coppin to its first MEAC Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in 1990, Stewart and the Eagles earned a 15-seed before falling to Syracuse in the first round, where he outscored Derrick Coleman, the first overall selection of that year's NBA Draft. In the following season, Stewart averaged 23.9 points and 13.4 rebounds, both of which are school records, and led Coppin to the NIT.

Stewart ranks third all-time in scoring at Coppin and is the only player in program history to score at least 1,000 points (1,824) and grab 1,000 rebounds (1,052), a school record. Stewart is also the all-time leader in field goal percentage (64.6) and ranks second in field goals (676), free throws (471) and blocks (149). As the MEAC celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2021, Stewart was named to the conference's All-Time Team.

His Coppin State jersey (42) was retired at a ceremony in 1993 and hangs in the rafters of PEC Arena, and he has been inducted into both the Coppin State and MEAC Halls of Fame (2005).

From 1997 to 2008, Stewart played overseas in Spain, Turkey, Greece and France before starting his coaching career as an assistant coach at Bowie State in 2009. In his six seasons at BSU, the Bulldogs won 113 games, went to a pair of NCAA Tournaments (2011, 2013), won the 2013 CIAA Tournament and saw Cameron Knox win the 2015

CIAA Player of the Year award.

Following his tenure at Bowie State, Stewart spent four seasons in his first stint at Morgan State, under head coach Todd Bozeman. With Stewart on the sideline, Tiwan Kendley and Phillip Carr combined to receive three First Team All-MEAC awards, with Carr being named the 2017 Defensive Player of the Year, and both went on to play professionally.

He returned to the Bears' bench for the 2022-23 campaign as an assistant after two seasons at Maryland Eastern Shore, which included the canceled 2020-21 docket where he was the Hawks' associate head coach under Jason Crafton.

A Philadelphia native, Coach Stewart is the son of Lois and Larry Stewart, Sr., and has three siblings, Latanya, Stephen and Lynard. Stephen is also a graduate of Coppin State, who was selected as the MEAC Player of the Year in 1994 and 1995, and an inductee into the Coppin State and MEAC Halls of Fame.

Coach Stewart resides in Baltimore County with his wife, Toi, daughters Lexis, Laryn, and son, Tai.

Professional (1991-2008)

- Signed as Undrafted Free Agent with Washington Bullets in 1991, averaged 10.4 points & 5.9 rebounds as rookie and became 1st undrafted player in NBA History to make an All-NBA Rookie Team.

- Last played with Seattle SuperSonics in 1996-97 season, where he made his only playoff appearance.

- Played in 270 games, averaging 7.4 points & 4.0 rebounds with a 50.9 field goal percentage.

- Played overseas in Spain, Turkey, Greece and France.



ASSISTANT COACH SIDNEY RAIKES

Raikes played four seasons for the Eagles (1992-95) and ranks among Coppin's all-time leaders with 1,412 points. He also places second in school-history in steals, fifth in free throws and sixth in assists. Raikes, who earned First Team All-MEAC honors in 1994 and 1995, also holds CSU's single-game school-record by going 19-of-19 at the

free throw line in a win over North Carolina A&T on February 18, 1995.

Prior to returning to Coppin as an assistant coach, Raikes served as an assistant coach for the girls basketball team at Woodrow Wilson High School in Camden, N.J. He helped Woodrow Wilson win four consecutive Olympic National Conference Championships and three straight South Jersey Group 3 titles. During the 2005 season, Raikes and Woodrow Wilson won a state championship.

Returning to his alma mater as an assistant in 2007, Raikes was responsible for recruiting, scouting, player development along with practice and game preparation. In his last season, Raikes helped guide the Eagles to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Championship game while Janelle Lane earned Third Team All-MEAC accolades. Under Raikes' tutelage Genesis Lucas earned a spot on the MEAC All-Rookie Team during the 2014-15 season while Larrisa Carter was named the MEAC Rookie of the Year in 2011. Coppin State, led by MEAC Players of the Year Rashida Suber and Shalamar Oakley, also won the MEAC Championship during Raikes' first season when the Eagles went 22-12 in 2008.

Raikes then spent a season at Towson (2016-17) before spending the last six seasons as an assistant and associate head coach at Maryland Eastern Shore. During his time with the Hawks, three players earned All-MEAC honors with a pair receiving All-Rookie or Defensive Team accolades.



ASSISTANT COACH STEPHEN STEWART

The 1994 and 1995 MEAC Player of the Year, Stewart was the 1993 Rookie of the Year and earned First Team All-Conference honors in each of his last two seasons. As a freshman, Stewart was named the MEAC Tournament Most Valuable Player, leading the Eagles to their second

conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. In 2015, Stewart led CSU to the NIT where it earned its first-ever postseason victory with a first-round victory at Saint Joseph's.

Stewart is a member of the Coppin and MEAC Hall of Fame and currently ranks ninth in school-history in both scoring (1,393) and rebounding (546), and third in free throws despite playing just three seasons (1993-95) due to NCAA regulations.

Beginning his coaching career at Coppin where he spent three seasons, Stewart spent time at Albany, La Salle and Loyola Maryland before assisting University of Delaware for four years. He returned to Coppin for a season in 2016 before serving as an assistant at Delaware State from 2018 to 2021.

A DOOZIE FROM NNADOZIE

In Coppin's loss on Saturday to Rider, junior **Toby Nnadozie** scored a career-high 18 points with four 3-pointers. His previous best was 17 points last season against Delaware State when he played at MEAC rival Maryland Eastern Shore. Coming into Saturday's game, Nnadozie had just six career 3-pointers, all coming in six different games.

FIFTH TIME IS A CHARM

Redshirt senior **Derrius Ward** is on his fifth school in five years as a college player. Starting at La Salle before heading to a Juco as a sophomore, he also played at UTRGV and Florida Memorial (NAIA) last year.

On November 12, he was named the MEAC Defensive Player of the Week after averaging 15.3 points and 6.0 rebounds over the first 3 games of the season. He currently leads the team in points, rebounds, 3-pointers and free throws.

GETTING IT DUNN

Jonathan Dunn had arguably the best game of his career at Virginia, recording a career-high 11 points on 5-of-11 shooting after scoring a combined 10 points in the first three games. He also had two rebounds and a block.

Three days later, he doubled that figure with 22 points on 9-of-13 shooting at UMBC.

PUTTING COPPIN ON THE MAP

One of Region's top programs in the 90s, Coppin was the 3rd #15 seed (1st HBCU and low-major) to defeat a #2 seed in the NCAA Tournament when it beat South Carolina in the 1997 NCAA Tournament. The Eagles were edged by Texas in the 2nd Round. During the 90s, Coppin went to three NCAA Tournaments (90,

93, 97) and a pair of NITs (91 & 95). CSU defeated Saint Joseph's in the 1995 NIT behind assistant coaches Stephen Stewart and Sidney Goodman (Raikes). During the 90s, Coppin had a winning record in each season with six 20+ win seasons, nine MEAC regular season titles (all but 1992) and a 145-21 MEAC record. From 1993 to 1996, Coppin enjoyed the Nation's longest home winning streak of 42 games.

1976 NAIA CHAMPIONS

Coppin's lone National Championship came in 1976 when it won the NAIA Title behind Hall of Famer and former NBA player **Joe Pace**. The Eagles won five games in six days to do so and got 43 points, 12 rebounds and six blocks in the Championship Game victory over Henderson State for their 30th-straight win.

ON & COPPIN - WATCH ON ESPN+

Last season, which was the 25th anniversary of Coppin's 1997 NCAA Tournament upset win over South Carolina, ESPN+ aired 'On & Coppin' which told the story of the Eagles historic season and how Ron 'Fang' Mitchell built a dynasty in West Baltimore. Also featured is Coppin's victory over the Terrapins during the 1989 season.

NEW TO THE STAFF, BUT NOT CSU

Chad Andrews-Fulton, who played two seasons for the Eagles (2017-18 & 2018-19), the first two years under the previous coaching regime, is now a graduate assistant on the staff. A Philadelphia native, he played two seasons at nearby Baltimore City CC before heading to Coppin where he averaged 7.1 ppg & 5.8 rpg with nearly 80 assists, 40 steals and 30 assists in 62 games.

CHARM CITY, PHILLY & DC

A majority of the roster, including the staff, (15 of 20) are made up of individuals from the Baltimore area, Philadelphia and the DMV. The entire coaching staff is from the City of Brotherly Love, as are seniors **Zahree Harrison** and **Derrius Ward**. **Toby Nnadozie** and **Camaren Sparrow** are from Baltimore with twin brothers **Cam'Ron Brown** and **Car'Ron Brown** from nearby Odenton, Md. **Ryan Archey**, **Julius Ellerbe** and **Peter Oduro** are all from the DMV.

The lone outsiders are **Khali Horton** (Erie, Pa.), **Cam Liggins** and **Jonathan Dunn** (Missouri), **Aa'Reyon Munir-Jones** (Chicago), and **Machi Nelson** (Hagerstown, Md.).

WHAT IS BACK & WHAT'S NOT

Coppin returns just five players from last season with four sophomores who saw consistent playing time as freshman, and redshirt senior **Zahree Harrison** who missed most of the season with an injury. Key losses include **Justin Winston** & **Malik Battle** to graduation along with **Greg Spurlock**.

Stewart's at Coppin featured seven freshman. This season, Coppin brought in nine transfers, led by **Julius Ellerbe** (EMU), **Jonathan Dunn** (Austin Peay), **Derrius Ward** (Florida Memorial) and **Toby Nnadozie** (UMES). Four others are junior college products with twins **Cam'Ron Brown** and **Car'Ron Brown** (Allegany), **Cam Liggins** (Ellsworth CC) and **Peter Oduro** (Odessa). Also new are walkons **Macahi Nelson** and walk-on **Darius Leonard**.

TWIN SENSATIONS

Coppin State is one of 10 Division I teams that features twins on its roster with juniors **Cam'Ron Brown** and **Car'Ron Brown**. The duo led Allegany College of Maryland to the NJCAA Tournament last season. Cam'Ron ranked 2nd nationally in steals and 3rd in assists and was named 1st Team All-Region with 12.6 ppg, 4.4 rpg, 6.9 apg & 3.2 steals. He also had a triple-double. Car'Ron put up 9.9 ppg, 3.2 rpg and 1.6 apg with 26 steals. The Eagles will play two of those nine other schools this season in Loyola Maryland (Milos & Veljko Ilic) and MEAC rival Delaware State (Kareem & Kaseem Watson).

TOP SCORING FRESHMEN

Last season, Coppin's freshman class made up nearly half of the Eagles' points. Four of those freshman are returning sophomores in **Ryan Archey**, **Camaren Sparrow**, **Aa'Reyon Munir-Jones** and **Khali Horton**.

Ryan Archey put up a season-high 26 points against Morgan State on January 20. It was the most points scored by a CSU freshman since February 18, 2017 when DeJuan Clayton also put up 26 points.

Archey went on to receive four MEAC Rookie of the Week awards while Sparrow received a pair. Both made the MEAC All-Rookie Team while Archey was also placed on the All-MEAC 3rd Team.

"A BRAND OF BASKETBALL"

Under the previous coaching regime, Coppin was one of the Nation's leaders in 3-point attempts and adjusted tempo (possessions per 40 minutes). In 2021, Coppin led the Nation with 76.8 possessions, averaging two full possessions more than second place Eastern Kentucky. The Eagles ranked 8th (72.2) in the category in 2022 and 19th (71.4) in 2023. Last season, Coppin was 266th in tempo under 1st year HC Larry Stewart.

MBB TO THE HALL OF FAME

Assistant Coach **Sidney Raikes** will be joined by two-sport athlete **Danny Singletary** as MBB players to be inducted into the CSU Hall of Fame on February 22. Goodman was a 2x 1st Team All-MEAC selection, ranks 8th in CSU history in points, 2nd in steals and made a school-record 19-of-19 FTs vs. NC A&T on 2/18/95. While probably more known for baseball, Singletary was a All-MEAC selection in 1998 and went for a 22 points in the 1997 NCAA Tournament win over South Carolina. On the diamond, he reached High A Ball w/ the Diamondbacks.

GOTTA LOVE FREE BASKETBALL

Coppin played back-to-back overtime games early in its conference season last year, starting with a win over Maryland Eastern Shore on January 8 before dropping a heart-breaker to Morgan State on January 20. It was the first time since the 2010-11 season that the Eagles went to overtime in back-to-back games. (1/31 2OT loss to Norfolk State & 2/5 win at Bethune-Cookman).

COMPETITIVE IN THE MEAC

Despite the overall records, Coppin proved to be very competitive with great defense in conference games last season. The Eagles dropped the MEAC opener by just 2 points to a much improved Delaware State program before the back-to-back overtime games. Coppin nearly pulled an upset of regular season champion Norfolk State on Homecoming and at Howard two nights later.

NON D1 OPPONENTS

When Cheyney visits Coppin State on January 16 for a special 11am Education Day game, it'll be the first time since the 2016-17 season (Chestnut Hill & Goldey-Beacom) that the Eagles played a non-Division I opponent.
