OPENING SERVE

• The Duke volleyball team gears up for its final two games of the season, welcoming Wake Forest to Cameron Indoor Stadium Wednesday before hitting the road to face Miami Friday in the regular season finale. Both matches are set for 3 p.m. and will be broadcast on ACC Network Extra.

• Wednesday's matchup will serve as the Blue Devils' Give Thanks game. Fans are encouraged to bring canned food items to donate to a local food bank to help serve the Durham community. Fans that bring five canned goods will receive one raffle ticket to be entered in a raffle to receive a Duke volleyball prize pack.

LAST TIME OUT

• The Blue Devils are coming off a pair of home losses to No. 7 Stanford (0-3) and Cal (1-3) in Cameron Indoor Stadium over the weekend.

• Outside hitter **Taylor Williams** led the offense with 25 total kills across the two matches, while setter **Grace Penn** tallied 56 assists to pace the Blue Devils. Freshman libero **Mailinh Godschall** logged 35 digs for the weekend.

A CLOSER LOOK AT THE SERIES

WAKE FOREST

• Duke leads the all-time series with Wake Forest, 62-19, including a 32-4 record at home. The two programs met earlier in the year with Duke earning a 3-1 road victory (25-23, 31-33, 25-19, 25-22) on Oct. 11. The hard-fought match featured a whopping 41 ties and 23 lead changes, including 21 ties in the second set.

MIAMI

• The Blue Devils and Hurricanes are set to face off for the 33rd time in program history, with the Blue Devils narrowly leading the all-time series 17-16. The two teams met earlier this season with Miami claiming the five-set victory, 18-25, 25-21, 25-20, 23-25, 15-11, in Durham on October 25.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

WAKE FOREST

• Wake Forest dropped a pair of home matches last week, falling to No. 1 Pitt (0-3) and No. 10 SMU (0-3) in Varsity Arena. The Demon Deacons moved to a 13-16 overall record and a 5-13 mark in ACC play. Wake Forest's offense features five players that have recorded 150-plus kills on the year in Paige Crawford (307), Sahara Maruska (232), Laila Ricks (179), Olivia Murphy (169) and Dior Charles (150). Heading into the final two regular season matches, Charles and Tina Grkovic rank in the top 10 of the conference standings in blocks per set, averaging 1.26 (5th) and 1.22 (7th), respectively. Emma Farrell also ranks in the top 10 in digs, totaling 3.98 per set for seventh best in the ACC.

MIAMI

• Miami currently sits 20-9 overall and 11-7 in conference play. The Hurricanes are coming off a shutout over Clemson (3-0) and a reverse sweep over Georgia Tech (3-2) over the weekend. Flormarie Heredia Colon and Ariana Rodriguez were tabbed ACC Offensive Player of the Week and ACC Setter of the Week, respectively, for their performances last weekend. Heredia Colon continues to lead the ACC in total kills (454) and total points (522.5), while ranking second in points per set (4.88) and in kills per set (4.24). Rodriguez currently ranks third in the ACC for total assists (935) and sixth in assists per set (8.66).

TWENTY-SIX YEARS

- Head coach Jolene Nagel has been at the helm of the Blue Devils since 1999 and is in her 26th season this fall.
- Under Nagel's guidance, she has led the Blue Devils to 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11.
- Nagel earned her 700th career victory November 5, 2023 as the Blue Devils downed Virginia Tech in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became the ninth active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 700 career victories.
- As a program, Duke owns 1,026 career wins - 508 are under the direction of Nagel.

2023 MILESTONE ... CHECK!

- With the 3-1 win over Loyola Maryland on August 31, 2023, Duke became the 43rd program in NCAA Division I history to reach 1,000 wins in program history.

FIVE HUNDRED DUBS AT DUKE

- With the 3-2 victory over Colgate on Aug. 30, 2024, head coach Jolene Nagel tallied her 500th win at the helm of the Blue Devils.

VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS

- The ACC features a slew of ranked opponents this season as one of the toughest conferences in the nation.
- Duke is 0-8 this season against ranked foes so far -- No. 13 Kansas (L, 1-3), No. 3 Penn State (L, 0-3), No. 19 Florida State (0-3), No. 16 Georgia Tech (2-3), No. 10 SMU (0-3), No. 1 Pittsburgh (0-3), No. 3 Louisville (0-3) and No. 7 Stanford (0-3).
- Last years' team was 1-5 against ranked foes. Their lone win was against No. 18 Creighton (3-2), the first win over a ranked opponent since Sept. 20, 2019 against No. 14 Oregon. Duke's last ranked win over an ACC foe was the 3-1 victory against Pitt in 2018.

SERVICE ERRORS

- Duke committed a season-high 17 service errors in the setback to Michigan State.
- Duke has committed 10-or-more errors in 11 matches this fall. The Blue Devils are 5-6 in those matches, including the 3-1 win over Clemson in which they

had 5. Duke had double-digit service errors 12 times a year ago.

GOSS EARNS SECOND ACC WEEKLY NOD

- Breonna Goss was named ACC Freshman of the Week for the second time this season following her performance against Boston College and Syracuse.
- Goss helped lead the Blue Devils to a 2-0 start in ACC competition as they defeated Boston College (3-2) and Syracuse (3-1).
- The Fishers, Indiana native tallied 20 kills and just two errors on 42 swings to hit an impressive .429 percent. She started both matches and also grabbed five blocks. Against the Orange, she hit .500 percent with nine kills and no errors.
- She is hitting .289 percent in her debut season with the Blue Devils.

CAN YOU DIG IT

- Duke freshmen libero Mailinh Godschall leads the Blue Devils' defensive effort with 447 digs (4.26/set) this season. Her 37 in the loss to Georgia Tech rank 18th nationally in five-set matches this season.
- Godschall ranks fourth in the ACC in digs per set and 91st nationally. She is ninth among all true freshmen and leads all rookie defensive specialists in the ACC.
- Through 29 games, she owns 447 digs, 78 assists and 31 aces to lead the team. Her 447 digs leads the conference, while her 4.26 per set ranks third.
- She has tallied 20-or-more digs in seven matches, including a career-high 37 against Georgia Tech. She followed up that performance with 23 against Clemson. Godschall has tallied 10 or more digs in all but five matches.
- Duke has had great success with freshmen starting liberos as the last one was 2021 ACC Defensive Player of the Year Mackenzie Cole.

FRESHMEN STARTING ASSIGNMENTS

- Duke's freshmen have stepped up in a huge way this season and are crucial to Duke's success on the court.
- Breonna Goss has started in all 29 contests as one of Duke's most impressive middle blockers, while Mailinh Godschall has earned 28 starts -- she was unavailable for the St. John's match.
- Taylor Williams has seen action in 27 matches and has made 18 starts, while Avery Hamlin has played in 19 matches with one starting assignment.

RICHARDSON'S OFF-SEASON SURGERY

- Senior Rachel Richardson is having one of her best seasons, and just six months ago had double hip surgery due to tears in both hip labrums.
- On April 1, 2024, Richardson became the most recent patient of Dr. Richard Mather III -- one of the nation's premier hip specialists.
- In the struggles she experienced after surgery and during rehab, she turned to God and put her trust in Him. She officially completed her return to competition Sept. 5 against LSU.

HOME COURT DUBS

- Duke is set for 18 home contests this fall at Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- A season ago, the Blue Devils went 12-2 at home.
- The Blue Devils are 283-106 at home since Jolene Nagel took over the program in 1999.

BLOCK PARTY

- Duke registered a whopping 30 block assists for 17.0 total blocks in the setback to St. John's (9/14).
- It marked the most of a Duke team since Oct. 6, 2019 when it tallied 18.
- So far this season, Rylie Kadel leads the way with 62.0, followed by Breonna Goss (58.0), Kerry Keefe (43.0), Ngozi Iloh (38.0) and Rachel Richardson (32.0).

KADEL SITS OUT

- Rylie Kadel missed five straight matches against Virginia, Virginia Tech, Miami, No. 19 Florida State and No. 16 Georgia Tech. She returned to the lineup for one set against Clemson, registering two kill on three attacks.
- The Blue Devils were 1-4 in her absence.

SIX WITH DOUBLE-DIGIT DIGS

- Duke featured six players with double-digit digs in the 3-1 victory at Wake Forest (10/11).
- Grace Penn (17), Mailinh Godschall (15), Kerry Keefe (14), Nikki Underwood (11), Taylor Williams (11) and Rachel Richardson (10) led Duke's defensive effort.
- Five Blue Devils have tallied over 100 digs this season -- Godschall (412), Penn (205), Keefe (187) and Underwood (174) and Richardson (122).

SPIKE OUT CANCER

- The Duke volleyball team continues its partnership with the Duke Cancer Institute's Teen and Young Adult Oncology Program this season with the Spike Out Cancer initiative.
- The Blue Devils will dedicate their game against Stanford on Nov. 22 to help raise awareness about and support for teen and young adult cancer. With your support, every spike made by the Blue Devils will raise funds for the Duke Cancer Institute's TYAO Program.

PAALMAN'S MILESTONE

- Graduate student middle blocker Tiffany Paalman reached 300 blocks for her career against Virginia Tech.
- She collected 295 total blocks as an undergrad at Green Bay.
- She has earned significant playing time as one of Duke's starting middles with the absence of Rylie Kadel.

FAMILIAR FACE

- Former 2024 Duke graduate Maddie Bryant remained in Durham as a member of the Blue Devil coaching staff. She will serve as an assistant coach and the director of operations for the 2024 season.
- Bryant spent the past two seasons as a Duke volleyball student-athlete where she was the starting libero in the fall of 2022 and 2023. She suffered a season-ending injury in 2022, just six matches into the season.
- As a captain in 2023, she played in every set (107) and led the team with 387 total digs for 3.62 digs per set. She also added 103 assists and 27 service aces as a key member to Duke's offense and defense. The Anderson, South Carolina, native tallied 20-or-more digs four times and saw double-digit digs in all but seven games as a graduate student.
- Prior to her arrival in Durham, she spent three seasons at Tennessee.

0-3 LOSSES

- Duke was swept in four of its last six matches, falling to No. 10 SMU, No. 1 Pittsburgh, No. 3 Louisville and No. 7 Stanford, marking the 11th time this fall the Blue Devils have been swept -- joining matches against No. 3 Penn State, Michigan, North Carolina twice, NC State, Virginia and No. 19 Florida State.
- A season ago, the Blue Devils were swept four times -- three times by top-10 opponents.

FIVE SET MATCHES

- Duke played in its sixth five-set match this fall in the setback to Georgia Tech (11/1).
- The Blue Devils are 3-3 in marathon matches this season.

GRACE PENN’S MILESTONE

- Graduate student Grace Penn reached 2,500-career assists in the victory over Syracuse. She dished a career-high 52 dimes, which ranks 42nd among Division I players this season.
- To date, she owns 2,859, 710 came as Duke's quarterback this season.
- She has dished 40-or-more times eight this season, including in the most recent matches against Georgia Tech (11/1) and Clemson (11/3).

PENN CAREER MATCHES

- Graduate student Grace Penn has played in 142 career matches, which is tied for the seventh most among active Division I players.
- Pitt’s Valeria Vazquez Gomez (142), Florida State’s Taylor Head (139) and Boston College’s Sophia Lambros (139) round out the ACC players in the top 10.

KEEPING UP WITH KERRY

- Junior outside hitter Kerry Keefe has carried much of Duke's workload on offense this season following the graduation of first team All-ACC selection Gracie Johnson. She has 19 double-digit kills performances this season, averaging 3.60 kills per set - a slight increase from her 3.36 average a year ago.
- Keefe was sensational for Duke in 2023, earning a spot on the All-ACC second team. As a sophomore, she tied for first on the team with 356 total kills and led all outside hitters with a .308 hitting percentage. She tallied 10-or-more kills in all but three matches and accumulated five double-double performances as a six-rotation player.
- This season, she leads the team with 367 kills and has also added 187 digs and 43.0 total blocks.
- For her career, she owns a .266 hitting percentage, 883 kills, 453 digs and 141 total blocks as one of Duke's go-to threats on both sides of the ball.

ACE, ACE & ANOTHER ACE

- Duke has put an emphasis on its serve the last few years and finished fourth in the ACC last season with 1.64 per set (175 total).
- Duke returned Kerry Keefe (29), Christina Barrow (24), Rachel Richardson (19) and Rylie Kadel (10) to the service line this fall.
- Freshman Mailinh Godschall leads the team with 27, followed by Kerry Keefe (23), Taylor Williams and Grace Penn (17), Rachel Richardson (13), Rylie Kadel (13), and Grace Penn (13).

RYLIE KAAAADEL

- Senior middle blocker Rylie Kadel has been solid for Duke this season.
- She holds a .363 hitting percentage alongside 137 kills. She notched a career-high 16 against Colgate as she posted a .625 clip with just one error to go along with five blocks.
- Against the 13th-ranked Jayhawks, she added 11 kills, two aces and two blocks for a .529 hitting percentage. Kadel tied her career high of 10 total blocks in the setback to St. John's and owns 39.0 total blocks this fall.
- She has tallied four-plus blocks in seven games this season and leads the team with 62.0 total blocks.

- She missed five matches before playing one set in the win over Clemson, and missed Duke's next two matches at SMU and Pittsburgh

FIRST DOCTORAL CANDIDATE

- Graduate student Tiffany Paalman joins the Duke volleyball team as its first doctoral candidate in program history.
- Paalman, a transfer from Green Bay, is working towards her Ph.D in Marine Science.

KADEL LOOKS TO LEAD MIDDLES

- Rylie Kadel returns as one of Duke's main offensive threats from the middle position.
- Over the course of her career, she has seen action in 77 contests for 242 sets and has knocked down 447 kills with 211 coming during her sophomore year.
- She owns a .286 hitting percentage and is Duke's leading returning blocker with 224 total blocks. She features 26 games with four-or-more total blocks.
- During her sophomore campaign, she tallied 18 solo blocks and 104 block assists to rack up 309.0 points.

PENN STATE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

- Senior outside hitter Rachel Richardson was named to the Penn State All-Tournament Team following her performance in University Park.
- She led the team with a career-high 17 kills and 13 digs against Princeton (9/13) and also added six blocks against St. John's (9/14).

COMPETITIVE CONFERENCE GETS TOUGHER

- The Atlantic Coast Conference continues to be one of the toughest volleyball conferences in the nation, and this year is certainly no exception with the conference expansion.
- The ACC features four in the top 10 of the latest poll -- No. 1 Pitt, No. 3 Louisville, No. 7 Stanford and No. 10 SMU. No. 15 Georgia Tech and No. 23 Florida State round out appearances in the top 25. North Carolina and Miami are both receiving votes.

- SiriusXM aired an Atlantic Coast Conference fall sports preview show. Hosted by Katie George, the show featured interviews with every head coach from each of the ACC's volleyball programs.

KEEPING UP WITH THE KEEFES

- Junior Kerry Keefe has volleyball in her blood as her mother, Kristin, played at Stanford and was a member of the 1996 Olympic team.
- Her twin sisters, Caitlin and Michaela, played volleyball and graduated from Stanford in 2020, while her brother, James, was on Stanford's men's basketball

- team and graduated in 2024.
- Her father, Adam, played for the Cardinal and was in the NBA (1992-2003) as the 10th overall pick in the 1992 NBA draft.

STANFORD CONNECTIONS

- 2024 marks the first season with Stanford as an ACC foe, and with already several connections between the two schools, the Cardinal feels like home.
- In addition to Kerry Keefe's deep-rooted Stanford family history, redshirt sophomore Millie Muir's father, Bernard, is the current Athletic Director at Stanford.

ACC UNITY TOUR

- This July, Lauren Ingram and Millie Muir represented Duke at the 2024 ACC Unity Tour in historic Charleston, S.C.
- The tour was part of the ACC's commitment to supporting student-athletes through meaningful educational opportunities, including the area of social justice, and is a component of the league's social-justice platform, ACC UNITE.
- This marks the third ACC Unity Tour, which began in 2022 when ACC student-athletes and administrators visited Selma and Montgomery, Alabama, for an immersive journey to one of the centers of the civil rights movement. In 2023, the event was held in Washington, D.C., with the attendees visiting key sites of the civil rights movement and engaging in the celebration of the 50th anniversary of Title IX.
- Duke volleyball has had a representative in all three years.

BATTLE FOR BULL CITY, B&GC FUNDRAISER

- For the second consecutive year, the Duke volleyball team is partnering with NC Central volleyball for the "Battle for Bull City", a fundraiser to benefit the Boys & Girls Clubs of Durham and Orange Counties.
- Duke competed on NC Central's campus last season and marked the first time a Duke team competed on its campus since the 1970s.

THE HISTORY MAKERS AMBASSADOR

- Christina Barrow is serving as a Digital Archive Student Ambassador for The HistoryMakers, an archive of over 3,500 oral histories with prominent African Americans.
- Student ambassadors work to make their campuses more aware of The HistoryMakers and its remarkable archive, which includes lengthy, detailed interviews with politicians, movie stars, musicians, style icons, and more.
- The HistoryMakers is a national 501 non-profit research and educational institution committed to preserving and making widely accessible the untold personal stories of both well-known and unsung African Americans. Through the media and a series of user-friendly products, services and events, The HistoryMakers enlightens, entertains and educates the public, helping to refashion a more inclusive record of American history.

2024 ACE PROGRAM

- Kerry Keefe and Sydney Tomlak participated in Duke's ACE Program over the summer.
- Keefe traveled to Panama while Tomlak traveled to Costa Rica.
- ACE provides full-funding for selected Duke student-athletes to engage in immersive summer service experiences with international communities. The program is made possible by David Rubenstein's generous support and Duke Athletics Ticket Sales. The ACE program reflects Duke University's mission of public service and international engagement.
- To date, ACE remains the only international community engagement program designed specifically for D-I student-athletes on this scale.

THE 2023 SEASON

- The Duke volleyball team went 19-10 overall and 10-8 in conference play during the 2023 season.
- Returning outside hitter Kerry Keefe was named second team All-ACC for her efforts as a sophomore.
- Statistically, Keefe tied for first on the team with 356 kills and a .308 hitting percentage. She also added 222 digs, 29 aces and 56.0 total blocks as a six-rotation player.
- Christina Barrow, Keefe, Millie Muir, Rachel Richardson and Nikki Underwood were named to the All-ACC Academic Team for their successes in the classroom.

HELLO, BLUE DEVILS!

- Duke welcomes three graduate transfers to the 2024 squad in Tiffany Paalman (Green Bay), Grace Penn (Boston College) and Ariana White (Harvard).
- Additionally, four freshmen join the Blue Devils this fall.

ELLICOTT CITY, MARYLAND GIRLS

- Freshman Mailinh Godschall and senior Rachel Richardson both come to Durham from Ellicott City, Md.
- Godschall attended Centennial High School while Richardson attended St. John's College High School.

WELCOME BAILEY FROM TEAM IMPACT

- Duke volleyball head coach Jolene Nagel and the program announced the signing of Bailey from Team IMPACT to the 2024 signing class. Bailey signed her national letter of intent in the presence of her family and new teammates.
- Bailey, a native of Roxboro, N.C., plays volleyball and soccer as an eighth grader. She lives with a genetic condition called 22q Deletion Syndrome and is a die-hard Duke fan.
- Prior to signing Bailey has participated in several team activities including team meals, a visit to Bull City Escape Room, attending practice and hosting the whole team for a birthday gathering at her family's home in Roxboro.

CELEBRATING DUKE'S CENTENNIAL

- In 2024, Duke celebrates its Centennial, marking one hundred years since Trinity College became Duke University. Duke will use this historic milestone to deepen the understanding of its history, inspire pride and strengthen bonds and partnerships, and prepare for a second century of continued excellence and impactful leadership.

ACC ADDS CAL, SMU + STANFORD

- The ACC Board of Directors voted to formally admit the University of California, Berkeley (Cal), Southern Methodist University (SMU) and Stanford University to the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- Cal, SMU and Stanford will join the ACC as full members with full voting participation effective July 1, 2024 (SMU) and August 2, 2024 (Stanford and Cal).

SHARE THE MIC PARTNERSHIP CONTINUED

- For the second consecutive year, the Duke volleyball program continued its Share the Mic campaign this past February during Black History Month, a partnership with several HBCU volleyball programs around the country.
- First launched in 2020 by associate head coach Kellie Catanach Johnson, Share the Mic is intended to help increase the visibility of HBCU programs within the sport, provide a platform for their student-athletes to have their voices heard and form a partnership between the schools to impact change for years to come.

ACC TOP SIX FOR SERVICE AWARD

- Six Duke student-athletes were honored by the ACC with the league's Top Six for Service Award. The accolade is presented annually to six members of the Duke Athletics community from each conference institution who demonstrate outstanding dedication to community service and outreach programs.
- Junior Christina Barrow was honored and is a trailblazer of her own. She has given tours to our Iron Duke Donors, has spoken on panels representing the athletic department as well as women in sports and she met with and gave an intensive tour to a local private middle school doing a project on sports and social justice.
- She will be serving as a Digital Archive Student Ambassador for the HistoryMakers, an archive of over 3,500 oral histories with prominent African Americans. Student ambassadors work to make their campuses more aware of HistoryMakers and its remarkable archive, which includes lengthy, detailed interviews with politicians, movie stars, musicians, style icons, and more.

TOMLAK'S GSA SUMMIT

- For the second consecutive year Duke Athletics was represented at the Green Sports Alliance Summit as Duke field hockey graduate Alayna Burns and junior Sydney Tomlak took part in the three-day event in Los Angeles.
- While it was the second time Burns had the opportunity to attend it marked the first year of Duke attending the conference as an official member of the Green Sports Alliance, which is a tremendous step forward in the Blue Devils' commitment to sustainability and combatting climate change.
- The 14th Annual Green Sports Alliance Summit returned as the largest and most influential gathering for the sports and entertainment community to unite around environmental and social sustainability. AEG, as a pioneering member of the Green Sports Alliance, was the Title Sponsor for the event which gathered over 700 stakeholders and feature proven solutions to advance the movement.
- Tomlak, pursuing a degree in environmental science and policy, has been heavily involved in the Duke Athletic Sustainability group during her time in Durham. She joined Burns in helping to lay the groundwork in launching the organization that empowers Duke student-athletes to create a positive environmental impact on campus.

Jolene NAGEL

HEAD COACH // 26TH SEASON AT DUKE

Jolene Nagel became Duke University's fifth head volleyball coach in 1999, joining the Blue Devil staff after successful stints at Cornell and Georgetown. Under her guidance, Duke has earned a reputation as one of the elite programs on the East Coast. Nagel has led the Blue Devils to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, including an ACC-record seven consecutive trips to the postseason event from 2005-11. A perennial contender in the ACC, Duke has recorded 20 or more wins in 14 of Nagel's 20 campaigns and consistently finished among the top three in the conference. Nagel earned her 700th career victory November 5, 2023 as the Blue Devils downed Virginia Tech in straight sets. With the win, Nagel became just the ninth active NCAA Division I head coach to reach 700 career victories. The winningest Duke volleyball coach on record, she also ranks among the league coaching leaders in overall winning percentage, ACC winning percentage, ACC wins and NCAA Tournament appearances.
