BOSTON COLLEGE VS. MIAMI - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 60th meeting between the two schools.
- BC leads the all-time series against the Hurricanes, 30-29.
- BC captured all three meetings during the 2023-24 season.
- On Feb. 17, Boston College won, 85-77 at Conte Forum, snapping a four-game losing streak against Miami, dating back to March 5, 2021.
- On March 6 in Coral Gables, the Eagles came away with a 67-57 win.
- In ACC Tournament play on March 12, BC breezed by the U, 81-65.
- The Eagles are 15-11 all-time in home games against Miami.
- From 1989-2004, both schools were members of the Big East.
- BC compiled a 15-6 mark versus Miami during that span.

- 4-0 when Donald Hand Jr. has a double-double.
- 6-1 when Roger McFarlane hauls in at least six rebounds.
- 7-3 when Elijah Strong hits at least one 3-pointer.

- 6-2 when Donald Hand Jr. tallied at least two 3-pointers
- 5-2 when Dion Brown has at least five boards
- 3-1 when Fred Payne scores in double figures

NOW TRENDING

- On Dec. 7 at Wake Forest, Joshua Beadle earned his first start at BC; four of his six career starts have come in ACC play.
- In 11 non-conference games, Dion Brown is averaging 6.2 points per game, connecting on 5-of-20 from beyond the arc.
- Through two ACC games, Brown is doubling up his scoring - at a 13.5 ppg clip - and has made 4-of-6 from the perimeter.
- Jayden Hastings earned his first career start on Dec. 21 vs. SMU, scoring a career-best nine points in 29 minutes played.
- Donald Hand Jr. has registered five games this season with at least three 3-pointers. He had three all of last year.
- Since coming off the bench the last three games, Chas Kelley III is averaging 6.3 points/game and is shooting nearly 60%.

HAND MAKES HISTORY AS ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- After a career-high 29-point double-double outing on Dec. 28, Donald Hand Jr. was named the ACC Player of the Week.
- Hand poured in 15 of his 29 points in the first half and scored eight of BC's final 10 points down the stretch in the win.
- It marked the first time in the history of the ACC that a father and son have each been named ACC Player of the Week.
- Donald Hand Sr. won the award on Jan. 31, 2000 while starring as a guard at Virginia.
- The ACC began its weekly awards program during the 1972-73 season.
- It is the first ACC Player of the Week honor for a BC player this season and the first since Nov. 23, 2023 (Quinten Post).
- Since joining the ACC in 2005-06, an Eagle has been selected ACC Player of the Week 18 times (10 different players).

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Donald Hand Jr. ranks 78th nationally in defensive rebounding percentage (24.3%).
- Chad Venning's block percentage of 7.5% ranks 78th nationally.
- Boston College's team FT percentage (73.9%) would rank as the eighth-best single-season mark in program history.

ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 1

- Boston College is 2-1 overall and 1-0 in ACC play all-time on the January 1 calendar date.
- In addition to it being New Year's Day, January 1 also marks the celebration of National Bloody Mary Day.
- Several notable events in history occurred on January 1 - 1502 - Portuguese explorers discover Bay of Guanabara, naming it Rio de Janeiro; 1600 - Scotland begins its numbered year on Jan. 1; 1673 - regular mail delivery begins between NY and Boston; 1797 - Albany replaces NYC as capital of New York; 1818 - Mary Shelley's "Frankenstein" is published anonymously; 1831 - William Lloyd Garrison published first issue of the abolitionist newspaper "The Liberator;" 1863 - U.S. President Abraham Lincoln issues the Emancipation Proclamation to free slaves in the confederate states.
- Notable January 1 birthdays: pioneer George Washington Carver; explorer John Smith; seamstress Betsy Ross; Italian statesman Lorenzo de' Medici; Revolutionary War hero Paul Revere; baseball Hall of Famer Hank Greenberg.

EAGLES AMONG THE ACC / NCAA LEADERS

- Donald Hand Jr. ranks 15th in scoring (15.3), eighth in rebounding (7.5) and first in free throw percentage (.890).
- Hand is one of three players - and the only guard - to rank in the top 15 in scoring and rebounding in the conference.
- Maxime Raynaud (Stanford) and Cooper Flagg (Duke) are the others.
- He is one of the top rebounding guards in the country, ranking second in the ACC and 15th nationally among all guards.
- His near 90.0% proficiency mark from the charity stripe ranks 49th nationally.
- Hand ranks tied for fourth in the ACC - and 46th nationally - in double-doubles, with four.
- Chad Venning ranks third in the ACC - and 82nd nationally - in blocked shots, averaging 1.54 swats per outing.
- Venning's 20 total blocks is second-most in the ACC and is 66th-most in the country.
- Venning is six field goals made short of qualifying for the league's field goal percentage leaders; he would be third (.541).
- Jayden Hastings is 13th in the ACC in blocks, swatting 1.1 shots per game so far this season.

DONALD HAND JR. - YEAR-OVER-YEAR IMPROVEMENTS

- In his second full season with Boston College, Donald Hand Jr. has shown a major statistical leap from a season ago.
- Hand is averaging nearly a +8.0 jump in scoring average and +6.0 jump in rebounding per game this season.
- His shooting percentages across the board have all seen improvement, including over a 7.0% jump in 3-point proficiency and a 15.0% from the charity stripe.
- Using the metric PAR (points+assists+rebounds), he has seen a +16.3 jump year-over-year and a +11.6 increase when measured over 40 minutes.
- Hand has already surpassed his 2023-24 totals in points, rebounds, assists, and FTM. He needs two more 3-pointers made to pass his 2023-24 total.
- After suffering a season-ending injury early in game two as a true freshman, Hand's first significant playing time post-injury came during the 2023-24 season.
- On Dec. 30, Hand was named ACC Player of the Week after a 29-point/10-rebound performance in a win over FDU.

BROWN EMERGING

- Dion Brown had his best offensive output of the season against SMU on Dec. 21, scoring a season-best 20 points.
- Brown made 6-of-10 shots from the floor, including 3-of-3 from the perimeter in 33 minutes of play.
- In ACC play, the junior transfer is averaging 14.0 points per game, while tallying 5.0 boards and 3.0 assists.
- Over his last three games, Brown is averaging 12.3 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 2.0 assists.

HIGH-PERCENTAGE VENNING

- Chad Venning tallied a season-high 18 points against FDU on Dec. 28, connecting on 8-of-10 from the floor.
- It was the sixth game this season where the grad transfer has attempted at least 10 shots - BC is 5-1 in those games.
- For his career, Venning has attempted at least 10 FG in 46 career games and is shooting .532% in those games.
- Venning leads Boston College in FG%, connecting on 54.1% of his shot attempts, including 56.7% from inside the arc.
- He is six made field goals short of qualifying for the ACC field goal leaders - his .541 mark would rank fourth in the league.

HASTINGS MAKING MOST OF FIRST START

- Redshirt freshman Jayden Hastings earned his first collegiate start on Dec. 21 against SMU.
- The 6-9 post player registered season-highs in scoring (nine points) and minutes played (29).
- He made 3-of-6 shots from the floor and 3-of-4 from the charity stripe, to go along with five boards and a blocked shot.
- Hastings is averaging nearly 4.0 points, 4.0 boards, and a blocked shot in 14 minutes per game this season.

BRINGING THE BOOM

- Boston College has registered 10 or more 3-pointers on four occasions this year, including a season-high 12 at Wake Forest.
- Through 13 games, the Eagles have made 84 3-pointers at a nearly 34.0% clip.
- A season ago, BC made 100 3-pointers at just over a 36.0% clip through its first 13 games played.
- Donald Hand Jr. leads BC with 24 3-pointers made, while Elijah Strong (13), Chas Kelley III (12), and Fred Payne (11) have each connected on double-digits in the 3FGM column.

THE CAYMAN CLUTCH GENE

- Three different Eagles connected on 3-pointers that either forced OT or sealed the victory for Boston College in the Caymans.
- Donald Hand Jr. made a 3-pointer on the right wing with 14 seconds left against Missouri State, forcing overtime.
- In the extra frame, Elijah Strong connected on a 3-ball from the left wing with four ticks left, sealing the 76-74 win.
- Joshua Beadle's step-back 3-pointer with 2.2 seconds left propelled BC over Boise State and to the tournament title.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN VS. MIAMI...

- Boston College would move to 9-5 overall on the season.
- The Eagles would move to 1-2 in ACC play
- BC would improve to 31-29 all-time against Miami
- It would mark the fourth straight win over Miami - the longest winning streak vs. the Canes since 2007-08
- BC would move to 1-0 in January and 6-3 at home
- Boston College would move to 6-3 in weekday games.
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 58th win at Boston College and his 185th as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn victory #1,282 all-time in 92 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

WITH A LOSS VS. MIAMI...

- Boston College would fall to 8-6 overall
- The Eagles would move to 0-3 in conference play
- BC would fall to 0-1 in January and 5-4 at home
- It would even the all-time series with Miami at 30-30
- BC's three-game win streak vs. the Canes would end
- Boston College would register the 1,104th loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

I'VE GOT SIX ON IT

- Roger McFarlane has grabbed at least six rebounds in all but six of his last 35 games played, dating back to Dec. 16, 2023.
- He has had at least six rebounds in 69 of his 104 career games - better than 66% of his games played.
- McFarlane has grabbed at least six boards in seven of 13 games this season; BC is 6-1 in those games.
- The 6-4 guard ranks second on the team in rebounding, averaging 5.5 boards per outing.

FIVE'S COMIN'...

- Sophomore guard Fred Payne has scored in double digits on four occasions off the bench for the Eagles.
- In the overtime win over Missouri State, Payne poured in a career-high 18 points - including a key 3-pointer in the OT period.
- He had 11 points in 14 minutes of action against ODU in the Cayman Islands Classic opener.
- Against Loyola (Md.), Payne scored 10 points in 11 minutes of action, knocking down 4-of-7 shots including two 3-pointers.
- In BC's ACC opener at Wake Forest, Payne made 3-of-5 shots in 17 minutes, good for 12 points.
- Nearly a year ago, Payne suffered what was a season-ending knee injury on Dec. 5, 2023 against CCSU

CHARITABLE VENTURES

- Donald Hand Jr. ranks nationally in free throws made (65; 30th), attempted (73; 69th), and percentage (.890; 49th).
- His .890 proficiency from the FT line this season would rank second all-time in Boston College history.
- Hand's .846 career FT percentage (99-117) ranks third all-time in the BC record book.
- Hand made 19-of-20 from the line through the first two games of the season, including 11-for-11 vs. The Citadel.
- The last BC player to connect on at least 23 of 25 free throws over a three-game span was Olivier Hanlan in 2014-15.
- Hanlan went 25-for-26 over a three game stretch, including a perfect 14-for-14 from the line at Pitt on Feb. 24, 2015.
- Hand has had six games with a perfect mark from the line, most recently going 9-9 vs. FDU.

DOUBLE IT UP

- Through the first five games of the year, a BC player logged a double-double: Donald Hand Jr. (22p/10r) vs. The Citadel, Roger McFarlane (11p/11r) vs. VCU, Elijah Strong (25p/13r) vs. Temple, Hand (15p/14r) vs. Loyola (Md); Hand vs. ODU (12p/10r).
- It marked the first time since the 2006-07 season where at least one player posted a double-double in five consecutive games.
- So far this season, Hand leads BC with three double-doubles, while Strong has two, and McFarlane one.

McFARLANE RANKS AMONG ACTIVE LEADERS IN DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Roger McFarlane's first double-double of the season came against VCU and was the 17th of his career.
- Among all active players, he ranks tied for 43rd nationally in double-doubles - and is eighth among all guards.

ADVISORY: CONTENT IS OFFENSIVE

- Boston College's 22 offensive rebounds vs. Loyola (Md.) were the most in a single-game since Dec. 6, 2009 vs. Miami
- Additionally, BC logged a season-best offensive rebounding percentage of 50.0% in the win.

CAYMAN, SAW, CONQUERED: EAGLES GO 3-0 AND WIN CAYMAN ISLANDS CLASSIC

- Joshua Beadle's 3FG with 2.2 seconds left propelled Boston College past Boise State, winning the Cayman Islands Classic.
- The 63-61 win over Boise State clinched the first MTE victory since the 2018-19 season for BC, when it captured the inaugural Fort Myers Tipoff. It was the first eight-team MTE win since the Eagles won the 2003 Paradise Jam.
- Each of the three victories for the Eagles had decidedly different paths toward their eventual outcomes.
- In the opener vs. ODU, BC led for nearly 35:00 and posted both its highest point total (82) and largest margin of victory (30).
- Donald Hand Jr. posted his third double-double of the season (12p/10r) as 14 different Eagles saw action.
- The Eagles dished out a season-best 18 assists and committed a season-low eight turnovers in the balanced victory.
- Against Missouri State, the Eagles drilled 3-pointers to force overtime (Donald Hand Jr.) and win the game (Elijah Strong).
- Hand and Fred Payne led BC with 18 points apiece, while Strong added 13 points - with eight coming in the overtime period.
- Boston College logged its most blocked shots in a game in nearly two years, swatting away 10 Missouri State attempts.
- In the title game against Boise, the Eagles erased a nine-point deficit with less than nine minutes remaining.
- The game saw seven ties and five lead changes in the second half before Beadle's gamewinning trifecta sealed the win.
- Chad Venning led BC with 16 points; Beadle's 3-pointer elevated him to a new career-high in points, with 13.
- The stout Eagles' defense held the Broncos without a field goal for the final 9:00 and 24 points below their season average.
- Hand Jr. was named tournament MVP, averaging 12.0 points, 6.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists in the three games.
- Strong was also named to the all-tournament team, averaging 10.7 points and 4.3 rebounds in BC's three victories.

STRONG EFFORT AGAINST TEMPLE

- Elijah Strong registered his first collegiate double-double with career-highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) against Temple.
- Strong made his first five field goal attempts, finishing 11-of-19 on the night. The 11 field goals were also a career-high.
- The sophomore grabbed 13 rebounds, including four on the offensive glass and nine on the defensive end.
- At the time, the scoring and rebounding totals for Strong ranked as season-highs for a Boston College player in 2024-25.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR DONALD ON OPENING NIGHT

- Donald Hand Jr. logged his first career double-double - 22 points and 10 rebounds - in the opener vs. The Citadel.
- Hand connected on 11-for-11 from the free throw line, becoming the first Eagle to make at least 11 FT without a miss since Quinten Post - now with the Golden State Warriors - knocked down 11-of-11 vs. Virginia on Feb. 25, 2024.
- It marked the 22nd time since 1996-97 where a BC player was perfect from the charity stripe with at least 10 attempts.
- Since 1996-97, 97 Boston College players have logged a double-double while scoring at least 20 points.
- It marks the first time a BC player logged his first career double-double while scoring at least 20 since Nov. 30, 2022.

THERE'S SCORING IN THE PORTAL

- A pair of newcomers - Chad Venning and Roger McFarlane - enter BC having scored 1,000 career points.
- Venning comes to BC having scored 1,062 career points (9.9 ppg) in 107 games at Morgan State and St. Bonaventure.
- In three seasons at Southeastern Louisiana (91 games), McFarlane tallied 1,006 points (11.1 ppg).
- Dion Brown tallied 777 points in 54 games (14.4 ppg) in two years at UMBC, including a record 607 points last year.

THERE'S REBOUNDING IN THE PORTAL

- Dion Brown and Roger McFarlane were two of the best rebounding guards in the country in 2023-24.
- Brown, a 6-3 guard, averaged 7.6 rebounds last year at UMBC – which ranked him sixth in the America East.
- Brown and 2024 NBA lottery pick Devin Carter were the only two players 6-3 or under to average at least 19.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in 2023-24.
- In America East play (16 games), Brown led the league in scoring (21.4) and rebounding (9.6).
- McFarlane pulled down 8.6 rebounds per game a season ago for Southeastern Louisiana.
- His 8.6 rpg in 32 games played ranked him second overall in rebounding in the Southland Conference.
- In league games only, McFarlane led the Southland with 9.8 boards per outing in 18 games.
- Over the past two seasons, he ranked second in the Southland for rebounds (528) and rebs/game (8.4).
- Chad Venning has also been a presence on the glass over the past two seasons at St. Bonaventure.
- Venning averaged 5.1 rebounds/game over the last two seasons and was one of the top offensive rebounders in the A-10.

BROOKLYN'S FINEST

- Chad Venning is a graduate transfer from St. Bonaventure, playing his final season of college basketball at BC.
- The 6-9 post presence was a Second Team All-Atlantic 10 pick in 2023-24, after leading the Bonnies in scoring and blocks.
- Venning averaged nearly 14.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 1.7 blocks per game, helping guide the Bonnies to a 20-12 record.
- His 8.5 block percentage mark ranked 38th nationally according to KenPom.com last year.
- Venning logged two double-doubles and reached double-digits in scoring 25 times, including five games with 20-plus points.
- He averaged nearly 13.0 points and 6.0 rebounds as a junior; in 65 total games with SBU, earned 62 starts
- Venning began his college career at Morgan State, seeing action in 42 games over two seasons from 2020-22.

BEADLE PROVIDES VETERAN SPARK

- Another veteran transfer joining the Eagles for the 2024-25 campaign is Joshua Beadle; a graduate transfer from Clemson.
- A versatile, athletic guard, Beadle has the ability to play either guard slot and will have two seasons of eligibility with BC.
- Beadle was a key contributor for Clemson's run to the 2024 Elite Eight - the program's first E8 in 44 years of play (1980).
- A season ago, the 6-3 guard averaged 3.1 points, 1.0 rebounds, and 1.0 assists in 11 minutes per game for the Tigers.
- Beadle led Clemson in 2-point FG percentage (.32-53, .604) and registered a 1:30:1 assist/turnover ratio in 2023-24.
- He earned his degree in parks, recreation, and tourism management from Clemson this past summer.

THE 60 POINT MARK

- Boston College held The Citadel to 60 points in the season opener on Nov. 4 and ODU to a season-low 52.
- BC has captured its last 16 games, including its last seven non-conference matchups, when holding opponents to 60 or fewer.
- Under Earl Grant, the Eagles are 21-2 when keeping their opponents at 60 or less on the scoreboard.

STRONG RETURNS

- Elijah Strong enters his sophomore season poised to make an even bigger impact on the Eagles' lineup in year two.
- He opened 2024-25 with a 11 points, three rebounds, and two assists in 29 minutes of play vs. The Citadel.
- The active and energetic forward from Charlotte saw action in 19 games in his first season at Boston College.
- Strong was a spark off the bench, scoring 10 points in 12 minutes in the second half in BC's 63-59 NIT win at Providence.
- The 6-8, 235 lbs. forward added seven points in 10 minutes of play in the NIT second round loss at UNLV
- Inserted into the starting lineup for a game at Clemson, he responded with 14 points (6-9 FG) in 26 minutes.

McFARLANE ANOTHER GUARD ON THE GLASS

- Roger McFarlane - a graduate transfer from Southeastern Louisiana - is another high-level scoring and rebounding guard.
- Standing at 6-4, 215 lb., McFarlane ranked third nationally in rebounding (8.6 rpg) among all players 6-4 or shorter.
- McFarlane averaged 14.8 points and 8.6 boards, en route to being named to the 2023-24 NABC All-District 22 and All-Southland Conference teams.
- From Fort Lauderdale, Fla., he reached double-digits in the scoring column 27 times, including six games with 20 or more.
- McFarlane posted a team-best 10 double-doubles, including an 18-point, 17-board performance vs. UNO.
- In 91 career games at SLU, he scored in double figures 51 times - 12 with 20+ points - and logged 16 double-doubles.
- As a prep, McFarlane starred at the University School in Fort Lauderdale, teaming up with former BC football great Jay Flowers and 2022 NBA Rookie of the Year Scottie Barnes in the backcourt.

ROSTER COMINGS AND GOINGS

- Boston College welcomes seven newcomers – four transfers and three freshmen – to the 2024-25 roster.
- Transfers: Joshua Beadle (Clemson – two seasons remaining); Dion Brown (UMBC –two seasons remaining); Roger McFarlane (SE La. – one season remaining); Chad Venning (St. Bonaventure – one season remaining).
- Freshmen: Nick Petronio (Needham, Mass./Milton Academy); Kany Tchanda (Kinshasa, Dem. Rep. of Congo/Sunrise Christian Academy); Luka Toews (Tokyo, Japan/The Newman School). Another player – Jayden Hastings – is a redshirt freshman who sat out last season at the Heights.
- BC's attrition rate is nearly 88% of scoring, 82% of rebounding, and 88% of assists from the 2023-24 roster. BC is 20th nationally in fewest minutes returning, 25th in fewest scoring and 26th in fewest rebounding returning.

WHOLE WIDE WORLD

- BC has had at least two international players on its roster in each of the last nine - and 11 of the last 12 seasons.
- Boston College has had at least one foreign-born player on its roster for the last 12 seasons, dating back to 2013-14.
- This season, newcomers Luka Toews and Kany Tchanda are the first two Eagles from Japan and Congo, respectively.

EARL GRANT

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant enters his fourth season as the Clement and Elizabeth Izzu Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Since his arrival at the Heights in 2021, Grant has established a culture of gritty and relentless play on the court, combined with selfless humility, a family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players off the court.

This past season, Grant guided the Eagles to their deepest postseason run in 13 years as BC advanced to the second round of the National Invitation Tournament. Finishing with a 20-16 overall record, Grant's 2023-24 BC squad registered the highest overall

win total for the program since the 2010-11 season and the most true road victories in a season (7) in nearly two decades.

For the second time in three seasons under Grant, Boston College advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2024 ACC Championship, falling in overtime against Virginia. Grant tied Al Skinner for the most wins in ACC Tournament play by a BC coach, with five.

In 2023-24, BC was led by Quinten Post, who finished his three-year career as one of the top players in the ACC and in the nation. He earned 2023-24 ACC All-Conference Second Team honors, while also earning a spot on the conference's All-Defensive and All-Tournament teams. Post led Boston College in scoring, rebounding, and blocked shots, while ranking second in assists. The 7-footer was one of only two players in the ACC in 2023-24 to rank among the top 10 in the league in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots, and field goal percentage in the regular season. He became one of only five Boston College players over the last three decades to average at least 17 points and eight rebounds per game.

Additionally, Post was one of only three players in the last 30 years to record 50 3-pointers made, 100 assists, 50 blocked shots, and 30 steals in a single season. He was selected by the Golden State Warriors in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft, becoming the 34th player in Boston College history to be drafted into the NBA.

During the 2022-23 campaign, Grant's gritty group tallied three wins over nationally ranked opponents, including a 63-48 drubbing of No. 6 Virginia - the first win over a top 10 team in nearly six seasons. Led by ACC Most Improved Player Quinten Post, Boston College won nine games in ACC play - the most since the 2010-11 campaign. Four of the Eagles nine ACC wins came on the road - the highest win total in away league games since 2008-09. As a result, BC and Grant extended their partnership through the 2028-29 season.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CofC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players - Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley - were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CofC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member

of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CofC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson - 58.4 points per game - in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacqui, have three sons: Trey, Eyziah and Elonzo.
