SETTING THE SCENE

Stanford returns home for the first of three straight games at home, welcoming Miami to Maples Pavilion on Wednesday, Jan. 22 at 8 p.m. The action will be broadcast on ESPN2.

THE STARTING FIVE

• The Cardinal is off to a 12-6 start (4-3 ACC), including conference wins over North Carolina, California, Virginia Tech and Virginia, and a quadrant one NET win over Santa Clara and the Tar Heels. The Cardinal is 9-1 at home this season and 2-0 in ACC play.

• Stanford's roster holds an exciting mix of returning players, transfers and freshmen, led by one of the premier centers in the country, Maxime Raynaud. The Pac-12 Most Improved Player last season, Raynaud is 10th nationally in scoring at 20.8 points per game and third in rebounding with 11.6 per night. He leads the ACC in scoring and rebounding, and his 15 double-doubles this season pace the nation. No other player in the country has more than 13 and no other major conference player has more than 10.

• Three players are averaging double figures, paced by Raynaud but also including Jaylen Blakes (14.8) and Oziyah Sellers (14.1). Both players are posting career-best numbers by a comfortable margin.

• Stanford opened ACC action with an 89-81 victory Dec. 7 on the road over California. The triumph was the first for Stanford at Haas since 2021 and its third straight overall in the series. Stanford added to the conference tally with a home sweep of Virginia Tech and Virginia from Jan. 8-11 and a win at North Carolina on Jan. 18 after a last-second jumper from Blakes.

• Kyle Smith joined the Cardinal from Washington State as the reigning Pac-12 Coach of the Year, where he led the Cougars to 25 wins and the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24.

SOUTH BEACH TO THE BAY

The meeting with Miami will be the fifth in program history and the first as ACC rivals. The Cardinal last faced Miami at the 2016 Advocare Invitational in Orlando (L, 67-53), but it defeated the Hurricanes in the 2015 NIT Championship game, led by 25 points from Chasson Randle and the game-winning free throws with 3.4 seconds to play. Kyle Smith is 9-3 vs. Bill Courtney-coached teams, with all 12 matchups in the Ivy League.

THE NATION'S LEADING CENTER

Maxime Raynaud has been the nation's premier center this season, averaging 20.8 points and 11.6 rebounds per game, ranking 10th and third nationally, while also leading the country in double-doubles (15). He was the first Stanford player with seven consecutive double-doubles since Reid Travis accomplished the same feat from Feb. 24-March 19, 2018.

He ranks first in the ACC in scoring and rebounding and seventh in field goal percentage. Stanford has never had a player finish higher than third on the national rebounding leaderboard (Curtis Borchardt, 2001-02), while his scoring average is on pace to be a top-seven average in program history. The closest statistical comparison at Stanford to Raynaud is Adam Keefe, who was 11th nationally in scoring (25.3) and fourth in rebounds (12.2) in 1991-92. Keefe also holds Stanford's single-season double-double record with 20 (1991-92).

Raynaud became the program's 51st member of the 1,000-point club at Stanford, and he currently ranks 26th in program history in scoring with 1,290 points. He is one point away from passing the legendary Hank Luisetti '38 (1,291). He is also ninth on the all-time rebound list (826) and is eight away from eighth (Josh Huestis, 834). He is the seventh player in Stanford history to reach 1,200 career points and 800 rebounds.

He is a mainstay in France's national team system, leading Les Bleus to a gold medal at the 2023 FIBA U-20 European Championship in Greece and a silver medal at the 2019 FIBA U-16 European Championship in Italy. Raynaud was also a practice player for France ahead of the 2024 Olympics in Paris.

EXCELLENT COMPANY

Raynaud is putting up historic numbers not just at Stanford, but in the ACC. He would join a select group of players to win both the league's scoring and rebounding titles, which has only been done 13 previous times in ACC history - nine of those players won ACC Player of the Year, and only twice since the 1950s (1964 and 1978) has the scoring/rebounding leader not been the ACC Player of the Year. The last five to accomplish the feat have all earned the ACC's top award: Marvin Bagley III (Duke, 2018), Tyler Hansbrough (UNC, 2008), Antawn Jamison (UNC, 1998), Tim Duncan (Wake, 1997) and Horace Grant (Clemson, 1987).

Raynaud would be the fifth Stanford player to be a conference scoring champion, and the first to lead in both scoring and rebounding. The Cardinal's previous conference scoring titles came from Landry Fields (2010), Casey Jacobsen (2002), Keith Jones (1984) and Hank Luisetti (3x, 1935-38).

The last major conference player to finish in the top-10 nationally in both points and rebounds was Zach Edey (Purdue, 2022-23, 23-24). Raynaud is on pace to join Edey as the only two major conference players to accomplish the feat in the last 15 years, and just the sixth player total, also joining Terry Taylor (Austin Peay, 2020-21), Mike Daum (South Dakota State, 2018-19) and Lamine Diane (CSUN, 2018-19).

MEET KYLE SMITH

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 270-199 career record in his 15th season as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. He spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-00).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round. The postseason was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. They also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a bid for a second consecutive season in 2023. Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

Smith led San Francisco to a 63-40 record from 2016-19, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Preceding him in the Bay Area, he was at Columbia, where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season.

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Hurricanes at No. 78 in the NET rankings (Jan. 20). The matchup is currently a quadrant four contest, as Miami slots in at No. 234. 14 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, including eight in Q1.

BIG SHOT BLAKES

Jaylen Blakes has led Stanford to a pair of quadrant one wins on the road this season, scoring in the closing seconds to secure wins at Santa Clara (Nov. 23) and at North Carolina (Jan. 18). Stanford rallied from an eight-point deficit in the final four minutes to defeat Santa Clara, 71-69, with Blakes scoring the game-winning basket from 18 feet with two seconds to go, fading away from the elbow and sinking a jump shot. The heroics continued at the Dean Smith Center in Chapel Hill, as Blakes received the ball with just over seven seconds to play before driving coast-to-coast and hitting a fadeaway 12-foot jumper to give Stanford a 72-71 win over the Tar Heels.

Blakes scored 20 points with seven assists against North Carolina while having eight points and a career-best 10 assists against Santa Clara.

THE ACC'S MOST IMPROVED PLAYER

Jaylen Blakes has been one of the most improved players, not just in the ACC, but in the entire country this season, ranking 14th in the ACC in scoring, sixth in assists, and fifth in steals. He is in the top-50 nationally in assists (5.2), free throws (86) and free throw attempts (108). On the season, Blakes is averaging 14.8 points, 5.3 assists and 1.8 steals per game, making him one of just nine players nationally to hit each of those benchmarks, and one of four in a major conference. The only Stanford alumni in the last 30 years to post those numbers is Brevin Knight '97 (three times, 1994-95, 95-96, 96-97). Knight holds the top four single-season steals marks in Stanford history, and Blakes is on pace to challenge for the fourth-place spot.

Among all power conference players, Blakes ranks second in scoring growth from 2023-24 to 2024-25, improving by 13.0 points per game. Only Wisconsin's John Tonje (14.6 ppg improvement) has more, and he is one of six that have improved by more than 10 points per game (min 14 ppg).

LAST TIME OUT

Jaylen Blakes scored the game-winning jumper with less than two seconds to play, and Stanford rolled out of the Dean Smith Center with a 72-71 victory over North Carolina. The ACC's leading scorer and rebounder, Maxime Raynaud, led the way with 25 points, 13 rebounds and four blocks, including a trio of 3-pointers and a 6-for-6 mark at the free throw line. Blakes scored 20 points with a game-high seven assists, while Oziyah Sellers was in double figures with 11 points to go with four assists, and Donavin Young had nine points and three blocks, including a perfect 3-for-3 mark from beyond the arc.

SELLERS MARKET

Oziyah Sellers has been an explosive and efficient scorer this season, averaging a career-high 14.1 points on 49.0 percent shooting, including a 40.8 percent mark beyond the arc. Sellers slots in 19th in the ACC in points - Stanford is the only ACC program with three of the top-20 scorers in the league - and eighth in field goal percentage and eighth in 3-point percentage (min. 1.5 made per game). He ranks first in conference games only at 50 percent from beyond the arc, tied with Duke's Cooper Flagg, and seventh in field goal percentage at 52.1 percent. He is one of nine ACC players, along with Raynaud, to have 10 or more field goals in a single game twice or more this year.

INSIDE THE POSSESSION

Stanford has maximized possessions on both ends of the floor through 18 games, with the Cardinal recording 6.9 steals per game, seventh-best in the ACC, and forcing 11.7 turnovers per game, while having just 10.1 turnovers per night offensively. Stanford is on pace for its lowest turnovers per game mark on record - the previous best mark was 10.8 per game, accomplished by the 2014-15 team.

Additionally, Stanford is 31st in the country in taking care of the ball, with a 14.9 turnover percentage, while allowing steals on just 7.5 percent of possessions (14th-best nationally). The Cardinal is also forcing offenses to score one-on-one, ranking seventh nationally in opponent assists per field goal (39.1%, KenPom). Stanford has also been elite at the free throw line at 77.7 percent (25th nationally) and 89.2 percent in ACC play (leads the conference).

ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK, AGAIN

Maxime Raynaud was named the ACC Player of the Week for the second time this season on Dec. 23. Raynaud is one of two players in the ACC to earn multiple Player of the Week awards this season (Cooper Flagg, Duke), and he was also a USBWA National Player of the Week on Nov. 18. The outstanding season for Raynaud continued over matchups with Merrimack and Oregon, with the 7-footer from Paris averaging 18.0 points and 14.5 rebounds per game over the two matchups with a double-double in both. His national honor on Nov. 18 was Stanford's first national player of the week since Kanaan Carlyle won AP honors in January last season.

LAIPNI LŪDZAM SAIMNIECĪBĀ

Stanford announced its first signee in the class of 2025 on Nov. 18 in Kristers Skrinda from Riga, Latvia. One of the top prospects in Europe, Skrinda is rated as a top-100 (No. 91 overall) four-star prospect from On3. A versatile, 6-10 forward who attended the prestigious Riga State Gymnasium No. 2 in Riga, Skrinda starred for Latvia at the FIBA U18 Eurobasket in Tampere, Finland, where he averaged 17.7 points, 10.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists per game while shooting 43.9 percent from 3-point range and 96 percent from the free throw line.

PRO CARD

The Cardinal currently has four players on NBA rosters this season in Brook Lopez (Milwaukee Bucks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Ziaire Williams (Brooklyn Nets) and Spencer Jones (Denver Nuggets).

KYLE SMITH

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL FIRST SEASON AT STANFORD

Kyle Smith was announced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball on March 25, 2024, and begins his first season at Stanford in 2024-25.

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 258-193 career record across 14 seasons as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. Additionally, he spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-2000).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round, while the postseason event was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. A talented coach known for expertise in analytics and player development, Smith's tutelage has included two NBA Draft selections in CJ Elleby (2020) and Mou-hamed Gueye (2023) and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Myles Rice (2024), while three Cougars earned All-Pac-12 recognition this season. Smith also coached San Francisco's Jamaree Bouyea, who made his NBA debut in 2023, and mentored a series of professional athletes as an assistant coach, including NBA players Matthew Dellavedova and Patty Mills at Saint Mary's.

Smith has also seen success on the recruiting trail, landing two top-60 classes, the highest for Washington State in over a decade. He signed a top-100 prospect to Pullman in the class of 2022, the first for the program since Klay Thompson in 2008.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Smith produced seven All-WCC picks, paced by two-time All-WCC first team selection Frankie Ferrari.

Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season. Smith mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections over his six seasons at Columbia, led by Maodo Lo, a two-time first team honoree and the second-leading scorer in school history.

Smith played an integral role in building the Gaels' program into a perennial championship contender in the West Coast Conference under head coach Randy Bennett. In his nine seasons in Moraga, the Gaels made three NCAA Tournament (2005, '08, '10) appearances and earned one NIT bid (2009). Saint Mary's averaged 23 wins over Smith's last six seasons on the staff, including an 81-20 record over his final three seasons. The 2009-10 team finished with a 28-6 record, advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championship and was ranked 19th nationally in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll.

During his one season at Air Force, Smith served as the Falcons' offensive and recruiting coordinator and took a lead role with player development and scouting. He was instrumental in the recruitment of 2003-04 Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Nick Welch along with all-conference players Antoine Hood and A.J. Kuhle.

Before joining the Falcons, Smith served eight seasons as an assistant coach at San Diego from 1992-2000 under Hank Egan and Brad Holland. During his time at San Diego, Smith helped lead the Toreros to their second-highest win total in school history (20 in 1999-2000) and as associate head coach, orchestrated a defense that allowed the lowest opponent scoring average (62.6) in the West Coast Conference (62.6 in 1999-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record and the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot a school-record 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship.

Smith earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career.

Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo, and Luke.
