
WEEKEND STORYLINES

- The 2025 season marks the 81st season in the program history and second under the direction of head coach J.D. Arteaga.
- · Arteaga, who is the program's all-time wins leader, played at Miami from 1994-97 before serving as an assistant for 21 years.
- Miami holds a narrow lead in the all-time series against Virginia, 39-33. The two teams first faced off in 1985, when the Hurricanes earned an 11-6 victory at Mark Light Field on their way to a second national championship.
- The Hurricanes are 13-2 in their last five games and have won ten straight conference games a feat that was last completed in 2014
- Miami has not lost an ACC series in over a month (at North Carolina) and with the two-game sweep over then-No.13 NC State, Miami has earned five straight conference series victories.
- Daniel Cuvet, who ranks first in the ACC in RBI (69), has 18 multiple RBI games and four where he's tallied four RBI a piece.
- Following a statement weekend at Mark Light Field, Miami's AJ Ciscar and Daniel Cuvet have been named ACC Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, as announced by the conference office Monday.
- Before sweeping then-No.13 Georgia Tech in late April, Miami has catapulted 39 spots in the Warren Nolan RPI rankings. As
 of May 9th, the Hurricanes sit at 25th.
- · Miami right-hander Griffin Hugus has been a steady force on the mound, ranking seventh in the ACC with 72 strikeouts

THE HURRICANES' SKIPPER

UM Sports Hall of Fame Class of '07 No. 33 retired in '03 Winningest pitcher in program history (43)



J.D. Arteaga became the 10th head baseball coach in University of Miami history, elevating to the helm of the program prior to the 2024 season.

Arteaga previously served as associate head coach in charge of pitching. Overall, 2025 will mark Arteaga's 23rd year as a member of the Hurricanes baseball staff.

For four straight years, the Hurricanes' longtime pitching guru groomed an All-American hurler. Right-hander Andrew Walters cemented himself as one of the most dominant closers in college baseball, after earning a spot as a finalist for the prestigious NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award the season prior. The unanimous All-America honoree headlined a Miami staff which featured four draft picks in the 2022 Major League Baseball First-Year Plaver Draft.

Southpaw Carson Palmquist led the class as a third-round choice by the Colorado Rockies, while righty Alex McFarlane followed shortly as a fourth-round selection by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Arteaga developed another All-American in 2021, as Palmquist was a consensus All-America pick and earned first-team honors by the NCBWA and Perfect Game. The lefty headlined Miami's four All-ACC selections with a first-team nod while also earning a place on the ACC All-Freshman Team.

Palmquist and right-hander Alejandro Rosario each were named Freshman All-Americans, while righthander Jake Smith was selected in the sixth round of the MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels and right-hander Daniel Federman signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Orioles.

The 2020 Hurricanes featured a pair of All-Americans, as standout right-handed pitchers Brian Van Belle and Chris McMahon were both selected to Collegiate Baseball's All-America Second Team.

After the season, sophomore right-hander Slade Cecconi was taken by the Arizona Diamondbacks with the 33rd overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft, becoming the 29th Hurricane to be selected in the first round of an MLB Draft.

McMahon, a junior right-hander, went in the second round of the MLB Draft to the Colorado Rockies. Van Belle and fellow right-hander Tyler Keysor signed free agent contracts following the shortened five-round MLB Draft, joining the Red Sox and Reds organizations, respectively, and giving Miami four pitchers joining the

The 2019 season featured the emergence of redshirt junior Brian Van Belle as a standout starter for the Canes. The right-hander earned All-ACC Second Team honors and was named to the All-Starkville Regional team to cap a season in which Van Belle led the Hurricanes in wins (10), innings pitched (95.1) and had the lowest ERA among starting pitchers (3.30). Right-hander Slade Cecconi earned Freshman All-America honors, while Evan McKendry (9th round, Rays) and Gregory Veliz (15th round, Angels) headlined four pitchers selected in the MLB draft.

In 2018, Arteaga guided right-hander Evan McKendry to a breakout season on the mound, where he led the Hurricanes staff in wins (seven) and strikeouts (114), as well as compiled a 3.52 ERA – second-best among weekend starters – while earning Third-Team All-ACC honors. Fellow right-hander Daniel Federman earned Freshman All-America honors, while four Miami pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft.

Jeb Bargfeldt, Miami's ace in 2017, was named to the All-ACC Second Team in his first season working under Arteaga. The left-hander finished the season 7-3 with a 2.28 ERA over 87 innings.

Arteaga, a standout southpaw during his own four years in the Miami rotation, helped guide the Hurricanes to their second straight College World Series berth and 25th in program history in 2016. Under his direction as pitching coach in 2016, closer Bryan Garcia set the all-time saves record at Miami and became the first Hurricane to win NCBWA Stopper of the Year honors as the nation's top relief pitcher.

Garcia (sixth round, Detroit) and left-hander Danny Garcia (14th round, Seattle) were both selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. At least one Hurricane pitcher has been selected in the MLB Draft each year since 2004.

Arteaga recently coached left-hander Chris Diaz to ACC Co-Pitcher of the Year honors in 2014. Under his guidance, all four of Miami's starting pitchers in 2014 – Diaz, Bryan Radziewski, Javi Salas and Andy Suarez – were all drafted in the top 10 rounds of the 2014 MLB Draft.

Suarez, who elected to return to school and served as the staff ace on a 2015 team that qualified for the College World Series, was drafted in the second round (No. 67) overall by San Francisco in the 2015 MLB Draft.

Arteaga helped lead Radziewski to Rawlings All-America honors in 2013 – the first for a UM player since 2010. Two of the team's weekend starters, Radziewski and Diaz, ranked among the top three in ERA for all Atlantic Coast Conference pitchers in 2013.

Arteaga has tutored three recent first-round draft picks in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft – Carlos Gutierrez in 2008, Chris Perez in 2006 and Cesar Carrillo in 2005. Gutierrez was the 27th overall pick in the 2008 draft by the Minnesota Twins after earning second team All-ACC honors. Perez, who came to Miami as a starting prospect, was aided by Arteaga in his transition to becoming one of the country's top closers. Carrillo started his career 24-0 as a Hurricane.

In addition to his work in converting Perez from a starter to a closer, he helped Kyle Bellamy in his transition from a traditional over-the-top throwing motion to a sidewinding delivery. The move had great rewards, as Bellamy recorded 16 saves and finished the 2009 season with a 0.97 ERA en route to numerous first team All-America honors.

Arteaga's 2008 staff boasted National Freshman Pitcher of the Year and Roger Clemens Award finalist Chri







Hernandez, who finished 11-0 with a 2.72 ERA while opponents hit just .223 against him. All three starters in 2008, Hernandez, sophomore lefty Eric Erickson and senior righthander Enrique Garcia combined to go 27-4 while the entire pitching staff combined for the fewest walks (187) in school history and eighth-most strikeouts (554).

His 2006 staff, composed almost entirely of first-time starters, recorded five shutouts, the most by a UM staff since the 1998 season. Miami also recorded the team's first postseason shutout on the road since 1976 with a 7-0 win against Ole Miss in the 2006 Oxford Super Regional.

Four pitchers from Arteaga's 2005 pitching staff signed pro contracts following the season, including the school's first pitcher drafted in the first round since the 1991 season, Carrillo. Arteaga also played a major role in Carrillo's career development and run at the NCAA record books. Carrillo, who was the 18th overall pick in the 2005 draft, ended with a career record of 25-3, was an All-American and a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and the Roger Clemens Award as college baseball's best pitcher in 2005.

The 2004 Miami pitching staff produced the best team ERA in (3.73) since the 2000 season (3.72).

Head coach Jim Morris named Arteaga the Hurricanes' next pitching coach on March 4, 2003, nine games deep into the season. Arteaga's style and approach to pitching was vital in J.D. Cockroft's development into the ace on Miami's 2003 club. Cockroft, a crafty left-hander, went 11–3 with a 2.72 ERA in a team-high 119 innings, including three complete games and one shutout.

Arteaga played for the Hurricanes from 1994-1997, helping UM reach the College World Series four straight seasons. He left Miami as the program's all-time wins leader with 43 and the all-time starts leader with 72. Arteaga ranks second for innings pitched in a career with 458.1.

He is also fifth on the all-time strikeouts chart with 343 career punchouts

Arteaga threw three complete games at UM and struck out career-high 11 batters on two different occasions (FSU, 4/16/95 and George Washington, 2/16/96). He posted an 11-3 record as a sophomore in 1995 and a 9-1 mark as a freshman.

Miami retired Arteaga's No. 33 on Feb. 5, 2003, prior to the season opener with Florida International. A 26th round draft choice by the New York Mets, Arteaga spent six seasons in the Mets' and Houston Astros' organizations. He had signed on with the Texas Rangers' organization in the spring of 2003, prior to accepting his post with the Hurricanes. He spent his last professional season with the Astros' Triple-A franchise New Orleans Zephyrs, compiling a 9-10 record with a 4.29 ERA in 15 starts and 42 appearances.

The left-hander came to the Hurricanes out of Westminster Christian in Miami. He won a career-best 12 games as a junior in 1996 (12-1) and came back to go 11-4 as a senior in 1997.

After six seasons in professional baseball, Arteaga earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from the University of Miami.

He is married to the former Ysha Schettini and the couple has a daughter, Ariana. The Arteagas' son, Ari, passed away in 2018 at the age of 16. The Ari Arteaga Foundation was founded shortly afterward to honor and memorialize Ari. Its mission is to spread Ari's spirit by helping children and families overcome obstacles they may face due to unforeseen hardships. The goal is to shine Ari's light on their path of need.

CUVET LIFTS HURRICANES TO VICTORY OVER FIU

- The University of Miami baseball team (30-18, 14-9 ACC) took down the FIU Panthers by a final score of 10-6 Wednesday night at Mark Light Field.
- Daniel Cuvet led the Hurricanes with an electric performance at the plate as the sophomore went 4-for-5 with five RBI and a crucial three-run home run in the eighth inning to give Miami its sixth-straight win.
- Brian Walters shut the door for the Hurricanes, tossing 11/3 scoreless innings to earn his eighth save of the season. The veteran right-hander allowed three hits but kept FIU off the scoreboard, striking out one and stranding a pair of baserunners to preserve Miami's victory.

THE WHOLE NATION IS ON HURRICANE WATCH

- The Miami Hurricanes baseball team's turn around in the past month has been nothing short of spectacular.
- Miami, who is 9-1 in their last ten games, have won ten straight conference games — a feat that has not been accomplished since the 2014 season.
- After outscoring then-No.13 NC State 16-7 in two games last weekend, Miami also claimed their fifth-straight conference series. That's right, Miami has not lost an ACC series in over a month (at North Carolina).
- Before sweeping then-No.13 Georgia Tech in late April, Miami has catapulted 39 spots in the Warren Nolan RPI rankings. As of May 9, the Hurricanes sit at 25th.

ANOTHER CANES SWEEP - THIS TIME IN ACC AWARDS

- Following a statement weekend at Mark Light Field, Miami's
 AJ Ciscar and Daniel Cuvet have been named ACC Pitcher
 and Player of the Week, respectively, as announced by the
 conference office Monday.
- Ciscar delivered a dominant outing in the Hurricanes' 10-3 victory over No. 13 NC State on Saturday. The freshman right-hander worked 6 2/3 innings, surrendering just one unearned run on five hits while striking out six and walking one.
- Since moving into the starting rotation in late March, Ciscar has posted a 4-1 record with a 3.42 ERA over 47 1/3 innings. He becomes the second Hurricane this season to earn ACC Pitcher of the Week honors, joining right-hander Griffin Hugus, who received the award after fanning 11 in his Feb. 17 start against Niagara.
- Cuvet continued to be a pitcher's nightmare, going 5-for-6 (.833) with two doubles, two home runs and eight RBI against the Wolfpack.
- The Fort Lauderdale, Florida, native leads Miami with 12 home runs and ranks first in the conference in RBI with 64.

KEEP CRUSHIN' IT, CUVET!

- · Sophomore infielder Daniel Cuvet made history last season by breaking a 28-year-old freshman home run record, surpassing Pat Burrell's mark of 23 set in 1996. Now, the Fort Lauderdale, Florida, native is chasing more milestones.
- Cuvet enters the weekend just two home runs shy of tying Miami greats Randy Guerra and Manny Crespo for 10th on the program's all-time career home run list with 39 career homers.
- The sophomore, who is batting 18-37 (.486) with five doubles, six homers and an eye-poping 25 RBI in his last ten games, leads the ACC in RBI (69) and is ranked fifth nationally. Cuvet tallied 75 RBI his freshman year. which ranks ninth in the program's all time record book.
- In the past four games, Daniel has registered at least three RBI in each contest.

GET HOT, STAY HOT

· There's no doubt the Hurricanes have been one of the hottest teams in the country over the past two weeks. In their last 10 games, three Miami hitters - Daniel Cuvet (.486), Max Galvin (.421) and Jake Ogden (.409) - are each batting over .400 and have combined for 52 of the team's 102 hits during that stretch.

THE CANES ON THE BUMP

- · In their last ten contests, the Miami arms have held their opponents to a stellar .241 batting average while tallying 74 strikeouts. Freshman right-hander AJ Ciscar contributed 22 to that total in the 19 innings he pitched.
- Reliever Brian Walters, who ranks third in the ACC in saves (8), has been electric when brought into the game. In his last five saves, the right-hander has only given up one run while tallying five strikeouts in the 7.2 innings that he's thrown.
- Heading into the weekend, Friday night starter Griffin Hugus ranks second in the conference in innings pitched (66), seventh in strikeouts (72) and sixth in batters struck out looking (22).

SELFLESS PLAY, RELENTLESS EFFORT

- Daniel Cuvet, who is leads the ACC in RBI (69), has 18 multiple RBI games and four where he's tallied four RBI a piece. Bobby Marsh is behind Cuvet (39 RBI) as the designated hitter has nine multiple RBI games and five where he's tallied four a piece.
- Jake Ogden leads the Hurricanes in four major offensive categories. The UNC Greensboro transfer ranks first in at-bats (191), runs (48), hits (67), and steals (11-11). Ogden also leads the squad in multiple-hit games

THE RETURN OF DANNY DINGERS

- After a historic freshman season, Daniel Cuvet returns to Coral Gables for his sophomore campaign.
- Ranked number one on D1Baseball's list of the nation's best third basemen, the Miami slugger led the 2024 Hurricanes squad in home runs (24), RBIs (75) and batting average (.351)
- · Cuvet also shattered a 28-year-old freshman home run record. Previously held by Pat Burrell, Cuvet tallied his 24th home run against Duke in the ACC Tournament semifinal round — also tying him for the second-most home runs in a season in team history with Alex Toral (2019) and **Yonder Alonso** (2008)
- · Not only did Cuvet, who's known around the dugout as "Cuvie", crack Miami records, but he also led all Division I freshman nationally in RBIs (75) - one shy of tying Miami great and big leaguer Ryan Braun's freshman singleseason record.

- Outfielder Max Galvin, who spent his first two years at Miami-Dade College, posted a .400/.469/.591 slash line for the Sharks in 2023.
- Galvin's summer in the Northwoods League showed no signs of rust after redshirting the 2024 season at Oklahoma State. Miami's new outfielder tallied 14 multihit games, ending with a .344 batting average which ranked eighth out of the entire summer league.
- On the bump, Cincinnati transfer Griffin Hugus and freshman Lazaro Collera, who hails from Westminster Christian in Miami, will be looking to turn some heads with their skillset.
- Hugus has showed impressive poise during the Hurricanes' fall and spring sessions. The right hander, in his freshman year for Cincinnati, was name to the AAC All-Freshman Team as a two-way player.
- Collera, a Miami native, was ranked the second-best right handed pitcher in the state of Florida and 14th nationally by Perfect Game. He also checks in at #51 in Perfect Game's list of the nation's top 100 freshmen.
- Standing at 6-6 230, his fastball velocity topped out at an impressive 98 mph at the 2023 PG High School Showcase.

NEW ONE-AND-DONE ACC TOURNAMENT

On February 2, the Atlantic Coast Conference announced a new design to the baseball conference tournament with the additions of California, SMU, and Stanford.

All 16 teams will compete in a single-elimination tournament, where seedings will be based on regular season standings.

The top four seeds will receive double-byes into the quarterfinal, seeds five through eight will earn a bye into the second round (No. 5 vs. No. 12/13 winner, No. 6 vs. No. 11/14 winner, No. 7 vs. No. 10/15 winner, No. 8 vs. No. 9/16 winner) and seeds nine through 16 will compete in the four first-round games (No. 9 vs. No. 16, No. 10 vs. No. 15, No. 11 vs. No. 14, No. 12 vs. No. 13)

The tournament will run from Tuesday, May 20 to Sunday, May 25.
