
#### PRE-TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

- The 2025 season marks the 81st season in the program history and second under the direction of head coach J.D. Arteaga.
- · Arteaga, who is the program's all-time wins leader, played at Miami from 1994-97 before serving as an assistant for 21 years.
- Miami leads the all-time series 7-1, including a perfect 6-0 mark in Coral Gables. The teams are tied 1-1 at neutral sites, with no prior meetings in Berkelev.
- The first matchup came on June 4, 1980, with Cal winning 4-3 in Omaha. Their last meeting was also in Omaha on May 29, 1992, a 13-inning thriller won by Miami, 4-3. The Hurricanes have won the last seven matchups.
- Miami fell to Notre Dame, 12-2, in the series finale Saturday afternoon at Mark Light Field to end the 2025 regular season. Miami sophomore third baseman Daniel Cuvet was named one of 25 semifinalists for the 2025 Golden Spikes Award.
- Cuvet's 15th home run of the season against Virginia marked the 39th of his career, tying him for 10th all-time in program history with Manny Crespo and Pat Burrell.
- In the series finale vs. Notre Dame, Cuvet recorded his 76th RBI of the season, tying Hurricanes legends Pat Burrell and Ryan Braun for sixth-most in a single season.
- Daniel Cuvet (First Team), Griffin Hugus (Second Team), and AJ Ciscar (All-Freshman Team) earned All-ACC recognition on Monday as announced by the ACC office.

# **HEAD COACH**

#### THE HURRICANES' SKIPPER

UM Sports Hall of Fame Class of '07 No. 33 retired in '03 Winningest pitcher in program history (43)



J.D. Arteaga became the 10th head baseball coach in University of Miami history, elevating to the helm of the program prior to the 2024 season.

Arteaga previously served as associate head coach in charge of pitching. Overall, 2025 will mark Arteaga's 23rd year as a member of the Hurricanes baseball staff.

For four straight years, the Hurricanes' longtime pitching guru groomed an All-American hurler. Right-hander Andrew Walters cemented himself as one of the most dominant closers in college baseball, after earning a spot as a finalist for the prestigious NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award the season prior. The unanimous All-America honoree headlined a Miami staff which featured four draft picks in the 2022 Major League Baseball First-Year Plaver Draft.

Southpaw Carson Palmquist led the class as a third-round choice by the Colorado Rockies, while righty Alex McFarlane followed shortly as a fourth-round selection by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Arteaga developed another All-American in 2021, as Palmquist was a consensus All-America pick and earned first-team honors by the NCBWA and Perfect Game. The lefty headlined Miami's four All-ACC selections with a first-team nod while also earning a place on the ACC All-Freshman Team.

Palmquist and right-hander Alejandro Rosario each were named Freshman All-Americans, while righthander Jake Smith was selected in the sixth round of the MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels and right-hander Daniel Federman signed a free agent contract with the Baltimore Orioles.

The 2020 Hurricanes featured a pair of All-Americans, as standout right-handed pitchers Brian Van Belle and Chris McMahon were both selected to Collegiate Baseball's All-America Second Team.

After the season, sophomore right-hander Slade Cecconi was taken by the Arizona Diamondbacks with the 33rd overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft, becoming the 29th Hurricane to be selected in the first round of an MLB Draft.

McMahon, a junior right-hander, went in the second round of the MLB Draft to the Colorado Rockies. Van Belle and fellow right-hander Tyler Keysor signed free agent contracts following the shortened five-round MLB Draft, joining the Red Sox and Reds organizations, respectively, and giving Miami four pitchers joining the

The 2019 season featured the emergence of redshirt junior Brian Van Belle as a standout starter for the Canes. The right-hander earned All-ACC Second Team honors and was named to the All-Starkville Regional team to cap a season in which Van Belle led the Hurricanes in wins (10), innings pitched (95.1) and had the lowest ERA among starting pitchers (3.30). Right-hander Slade Cecconi earned Freshman All-America honors, while Evan McKendry (9th round, Rays) and Gregory Veliz (15th round, Angels) headlined four pitchers selected in the MLB draft.

In 2018, Arteaga guided right-hander Evan McKendry to a breakout season on the mound, where he led the Hurricanes staff in wins (seven) and strikeouts (114), as well as compiled a 3.52 ERA – second-best among weekend starters – while earning Third-Team All-ACC honors. Fellow right-hander Daniel Federman earned Freshman All-America honors, while four Miami pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft.

Jeb Bargfeldt, Miami's ace in 2017, was named to the All-ACC Second Team in his first season working under Arteaga. The left-hander finished the season 7-3 with a 2.28 ERA over 87 innings.

Arteaga, a standout southpaw during his own four years in the Miami rotation, helped guide the Hurricanes to their second straight College World Series berth and 25th in program history in 2016. Under his direction as pitching coach in 2016, closer Bryan Garcia set the all-time saves record at Miami and became the first Hurricane to win NCBWA Stopper of the Year honors as the nation's top relief pitcher.

Garcia (sixth round, Detroit) and left-hander Danny Garcia (14th round, Seattle) were both selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. At least one Hurricane pitcher has been selected in the MLB Draft each year since 2004.

Arteaga recently coached left-hander Chris Diaz to ACC Co-Pitcher of the Year honors in 2014. Under his guidance, all four of Miami's starting pitchers in 2014 – Diaz, Bryan Radziewski, Javi Salas and Andy Suarez – were all drafted in the top 10 rounds of the 2014 MLB Draft.

Suarez, who elected to return to school and served as the staff ace on a 2015 team that qualified for the College World Series, was drafted in the second round (No. 67) overall by San Francisco in the 2015 MLB Draft.

Arteaga helped lead Radziewski to Rawlings All-America honors in 2013 – the first for a UM player since 2010. Two of the team's weekend starters, Radziewski and Diaz, ranked among the top three in ERA for all Atlantic Coast Conference pitchers in 2013.

Arteaga has tutored three recent first-round draft picks in the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft – Carlos Gutierrez in 2008, Chris Perez in 2006 and Cesar Carrillo in 2005. Gutierrez was the 27th overall pick in the 2008 draft by the Minnesota Twins after earning second team All-ACC honors. Perez, who came to Miami as a starting prospect, was aided by Arteaga in his transition to becoming one of the country's top closers. Carrillo started his career 24-0 as a Hurricane.

In addition to his work in converting Perez from a starter to a closer, he helped Kyle Bellamy in his transition from a traditional over-the-top throwing motion to a sidewinding delivery. The move had great rewards, as Bellamy recorded 16 saves and finished the 2009 season with a 0.97 ERA en route to numerous first team All-America honors.

Arteaga's 2008 staff boasted National Freshman Pitcher of the Year and Roger Clemens Award finalist Chri







Hernandez, who finished 11-0 with a 2.72 ERA while opponents hit just .223 against him. All three starters in 2008, Hernandez, sophomore lefty Eric Erickson and senior righthander Enrique Garcia combined to go 27-4 while the entire pitching staff combined for the fewest walks (187) in school history and eighth-most strikeouts (554).

His 2006 staff, composed almost entirely of first-time starters, recorded five shutouts, the most by a UM staff since the 1998 season. Miami also recorded the team's first postseason shutout on the road since 1976 with a 7-0 win against Ole Miss in the 2006 Oxford Super Regional.

Four pitchers from Arteaga's 2005 pitching staff signed pro contracts following the season, including the school's first pitcher drafted in the first round since the 1991 season, Carrillo. Arteaga also played a major role in Carrillo's career development and run at the NCAA record books. Carrillo, who was the 18th overall pick in the 2005 draft, ended with a career record of 25-3, was an All-American and a finalist for the Dick Howser Trophy and the Roger Clemens Award as college baseball's best pitcher in 2005.

The 2004 Miami pitching staff produced the best team ERA in (3.73) since the 2000 season (3.72).

Head coach Jim Morris named Arteaga the Hurricanes' next pitching coach on March 4, 2003, nine games deep into the season. Arteaga's style and approach to pitching was vital in J.D. Cockroft's development into the ace on Miami's 2003 club. Cockroft, a crafty left-hander, went 11–3 with a 2.72 ERA in a team-high 119 innings, including three complete games and one shutout.

Arteaga played for the Hurricanes from 1994-1997, helping UM reach the College World Series four straight seasons. He left Miami as the program's all-time wins leader with 43 and the all-time starts leader with 72. Arteaga ranks second for innings pitched in a career with 458.1.

He is also fifth on the all-time strikeouts chart with 343 career punchouts

Arteaga threw three complete games at UM and struck out career-high 11 batters on two different occasions (FSU, 4/16/95 and George Washington, 2/16/96). He posted an 11-3 record as a sophomore in 1995 and a 9-1 mark as a freshman.

Miami retired Arteaga's No. 33 on Feb. 5, 2003, prior to the season opener with Florida International. A 26th round draft choice by the New York Mets, Arteaga spent six seasons in the Mets' and Houston Astros' organizations. He had signed on with the Texas Rangers' organization in the spring of 2003, prior to accepting his post with the Hurricanes. He spent his last professional season with the Astros' Triple-A franchise New Orleans Zephyrs, compiling a 9-10 record with a 4.29 ERA in 15 starts and 42 appearances.

The left-hander came to the Hurricanes out of Westminster Christian in Miami. He won a career-best 12 games as a junior in 1996 (12-1) and came back to go 11-4 as a senior in 1997.

After six seasons in professional baseball, Arteaga earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from the University of Miami.

He is married to the former Ysha Schettini and the couple has a daughter, Ariana. The Arteagas' son, Ari, passed away in 2018 at the age of 16. The Ari Arteaga Foundation was founded shortly afterward to honor and memorialize Ari. Its mission is to spread Ari's spirit by helping children and families overcome obstacles they may face due to unforeseen hardships. The goal is to shine Ari's light on their path of need.

#### MIAMI DROPS RUBBER MATCH TO NOTRE DAME

- The University of Miami baseball team dropped the series finale to the Notre Dame Fighting Irish by a final score of 12-2 Saturday afternoon at Mark Light Field.
- Miami starter Tate DeRias (2-2) took the loss after allowing three runs on three hits and two walks while striking out four in five innings of work
- Notre Dame starter Jackson Dennies lasted 4 2/3 innings, giving up two runs on five hits. Ricky Reeth (3-1) earned the win in relief, tossing 2 1/3 scoreless innings while striking out two.

#### CUVET TABBED GOLDEN SPIKES SEMIFINALIST

- University of Miami sophomore third baseman Daniel Cuvet has been named one of 25 semifinalists for the 2025 Golden Spikes Award, which honors the nation's top amateur baseball player.
- Cuvet has delivered a stellar 2025 season for the Hurricanes. He led Miami with a .374 batting average, 17 home runs, and 76 runs batted in, while posting a .447 on-base and .707 slugging percentage.
- Throughout the 2025 season, Cuvet delivered numerous pivotal performances for the Hurricanes. On May 2, he blasted two home runs and drove in five runs to lead Miami to a 6-4 victory over then-No. 13 NC State
- That effort was part of a two-game sweep of the ranked Wolfpack in which Cuvet went 5-for-6 (.833) with two homers, two doubles and eight RBIs, earning him ACC Player of the Week honors.
- Pat Burrell won the Golden Spikes Award in 1998, the only Miami player to win the honor to date. Miami and MLB great Ryan Braun was a finalist in 2005, Zack Collins was a semifinalist in 2016, and in 2023, slugger Yohandy Morales was named a semifinalist.
- The Golden Spikes Award, first presented in 1978, is widely regarded as the highest honor in amateur baseball. It is awarded annually to the nation's top amateur baseball player based on athletic ability, sportsmanship, character, and overall sports contribution.
- The 47th Golden Spikes Award will be presented in late June during the College World Series finals in Omaha, live on ESPN.
- During the series against Virginia, Cuvet blasted his 15th homer of the season. A line drive to right field that marked the 39th of his career, tied him for 10th all-time in program history with Randy Guerra (1976-79) and Manny Crespo (1998-00).
- The sophomore slugger also completed another milestone, where in the series finale against Notre Dame, Cuvet notched his 76 RBI of the season. With that run batted in, Cuvet tied Hurricanes legend and former MLB All-Star Ryan Braun and Hurricanes legend for sixth-most in a

#### CUVET, HUGUS AND CISCAR EARN ALL-ACC HONORS

- · A trio of Miami Hurricanes were honored by the Atlantic Coast Conference on Monday as Daniel Cuvet was named to the All-ACC First Team, Griffin Hugus secured a spot on the All-ACC Second Team, and AJ Ciscar was selected to the ACC All-Freshman Team.
- · Cuvet, one of the most dominant bats in the nation, continued to build upon a record-setting freshman campaign with an explosive sophomore season. The Miami native ranked among the conference leaders in home runs (16), RBI (76), and slugging percentage (.707), leading the Hurricanes' lineup throughout the
- · Hugus, a right-handed transfer from Cincinnati, emerged as one of Miami's best arms during his first season as a Hurricane. The junior logged 14 starts with a 3.92 ERA and five wins, striking out 84 batters in 78 innings pitched.
- Hugus, a native of Wellington, Fla., ranked fourth in the ACC this regular season with 84 strikeouts and held the fourth spot in number of innings pitched.
- · Ciscar, a freshman right-hander from Miami, immediately impacted the mound, showcasing composure and talent beyond his years. In 19 appearances, eight of them being starts, Ciscar posted a 5-1 record with a 3.77 ERA across 57.1 innings, striking out 56 batters and halting the opposition to a .205 batting average.

A LOOK BACK ON THE 2025 REGULAR SEASON... **Signature Wins vs. Top Teams:** Miami boasts multiple victories against elite competition. The Hurricanes won series over two Top-15 opponents - sweeping No. 13 Georgia Tech and sweeping a two-game series over No. 13 NC State. They also notched marquee single-game upsets, including a 13-7 road win at No. 8 Florida and a 9-6 home victory over No. 5 Florida State.

#### Strong Overall Record & ACC Performance:

The Hurricanes compiled a 31-23 overall record, finishing above .500 in the ultra-competitive ACC (15–14 ACC). Miami held its own in a conference featuring several nationally ranked programs, and was firmly in the upper half of the ACC standings by season's end. Importantly, Miami's 15 ACC wins and over 30 total victories underline a robust resume that is traditionally worthy of an NCAA bid.

# Red-Hot Conference Stretch (Historic Win Streak):

Miami caught fire in conference play during the spring.The Hurricanes rattled off 10 consecutive ACC wins - their longest league winning streak in over a decade (last achieved in 2014). This surge included five straight ACC series triumphs and propelled Miami up the standings.

#### High RPI & Tough Schedule:

Miami's postseason resume is reinforced by strong metrics, especially their strength of schedule. They have faced one of the toughest schedules in the country - rated No. 8 in Warren Nolan's RPI rankings (as of May 18) - meaning Miami is battle-tested against top-tier competition. Few bubble teams can match Miami's combination of quality wins and schedule strength.

# Explosive Offense:

The Hurricanes feature a potent lineup led by sophomore Daniel Cuvet, one of the nation's most feared hitters. Cuvet hit .374 with 16 home runs and 76 RBI on the season, including a torrid stretch batting .526 over a 10-game span (6 HR, 24 RBI). In ACC play alone he hit .398 with 9 homers and 44 RBI, consistently coming up big against top pitching.

Jake Ogden and Max Galvin form a dynamic 1-2 punch at the top of the order, combining for over 40 multi-hit games this year. Ogden (team-best 24 multi-hit games) and Galvin (18 multi-hit games) provide speed and on-base ability that ignites the offense.

#### Impact Pitching and Resilience on the Mound:

Miami's pitching staff features a mix of seasoned arms and emerging talent that has kept the team competitive in every series. Griffin Hugus logged 78 innings and ranked among ACC leaders in strikeouts (84) and innings pitched. Freshman right-hander A.J. Ciscar has been a revelation - posting a 5-1 record with a 3.77 ERA - and holding opponents to a .205 average while

allowing only 3 home runs all season. Ciscar's poise and ability to shut down lineups gave Miami a major boost down the stretch.

At the back end, closer Brian Walters anchored the bullpen with 8 saves, one of the top leaders in the ACC, providing stability in tight games. In total, Miami's arms racked up 400+ strikeouts and a sub-.250 opponent batting average, showing the depth and competitiveness of the pitching staff. This combination of an ace, a stellar freshman starter, and a reliable closer makes Miami a tough out for any team.

#### **NEW ONE-AND-DONE ACC TOURNAMENT**

On February 2, the Atlantic Coast Conference announced a new design to the baseball conference tournament with the additions of California, SMU, and Stanford.

All 16 teams will compete in a single-elimination tournament, where seedings will be based on regular season standings.

The top four seeds will receive double-byes into the quarterfinal, seeds five through eight will earn a bye into the second round (No. 5 vs. No. 12/13 winner, No. 6 vs. No. 11/14 winner, No. 7 vs. No. 10/15 winner, No. 8 vs. No. 9/16 winner) and seeds nine through 16 will compete in the four first-round games (No. 9 vs. No. 16, No. 10 vs. No. 15, No. 11 vs. No. 14, No. 12 vs. No. 13)

The tournament will run from Tuesday, May 20 to Sunday, May 25.
