HOME SWEET HOME

• The Hurricanes host Indiana in their home opener on Friday. Since the program's rebirth in 2001, the Hurricanes are 19-5 all-time in home openers.

• In the last two seasons combined, Miami has posted a 32-5 home record, including four top-25 wins with two being in the top 10.

• Miami will go on to face Indiana in three consecutive seasons, where the teams have split wins. The Hurricanes took down the Hoosiers in 2024 in Austin, Texas, in four sets.

• Upset No. 5 Stanford, No. 15 Georgia Tech and No. 25 Arkansas to notch a spot in the AVCA rankings twice and first time since 2021.

• Heredia Colon became a first-time AVCA All-American and All-ACC First Team honoree following an incredible 2024 season, while Rodriguez tabbed AVCA All-Region honors after her Miami debut in 2024 where she ranked third in the ACC for most assists and seventh all-time in Miami history (1,058)

HEAD COACH JOSE 'KENO' GANDARA

13TH SEASON | UC SANTA BARBARA '90

Jose "Keno" Gandara accepted the position of head volleyball coach at the University of Miami on March 20, 2013, becoming just the second head coach since the program returned in 2001. Over more than a decade at the helm, Gandara has built the Hurricanes into a consistent force in the ACC and on the national stage, guiding the program to eight NCAA Tournament appearances, including four consecutive bids from 2021–24.

RECENT SUCCESS

The 2024 campaign showcased the resilience and growth of Gandara's program. Miami finished 22-11 overall and 12-8 in the ACC, advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Canes made national headlines in September when they stunned defending national champion and No. 1-ranked Texas in Austin, handing the Longhorns their first home loss in nearly a decade. The reverse sweep marked Gandara's 200th career win and remains one of the program's most significant victories. Miami followed with upsets over No. 5 Stanford, No. 15 Georgia Tech, and No. 25 Arkansas. Two players — Flormarie Heredia Colon and Grace Lopez — earned AVCA All-America honors, with both also collecting All-ACC recognition, while Ariana Rodriguez joined them on the AVCA East Coast All-Region team. In all, Miami collected eight weekly ACC honors across the season.

In 2023, Gandara and the Hurricanes secured their third straight NCAA appearance, finishing 18-12 with notable wins over top-25 Georgia Tech. Freshman standout Grace Lopez earned AVCA All-America status, while Savannah Vach and Lopez both earned All-Region honors. Miami placed five players on the All-ACC teams. That summer, Gandara received one of the highest honors of his career when he was inducted into the Puerto Rico Sports Hall of Fame for his impact as both a player and coach.

The 2022 season saw Miami maintain its momentum with a 19-11 record, including 10 sweeps and a strong 12-6 finish in ACC play. Three Hurricanes collected All-Region honors and four were named All-ACC, highlighted by First Team selections for Janice Leao and Savannah Vach.

BREAKTHROUGH IN 2021

One of Gandara's finest coaching performances came in 2021. The Hurricanes posted a 25-5 record, the program's most wins in a season since 2012, and finished second in the ACC with a 15-3 mark. Miami advanced to the NCAA second round, reached No. 14 in the RPI, and ended the year ranked No. 25 in the AVCA Coaches Poll. The Canes recorded 15 sweeps, demonstrating their consistency and dominance. Individually, multiple players earned regional and national recognition, including AVCA All-Region honors for Janice Leao and Savannah Vach. The season set a new benchmark for the program under Gandara's leadership.

EARLY POSTSEASON RUNS

Gandara wasted no time establishing Miami as a postseason presence. In his first three seasons (2013–15), he guided the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including his first tournament win in 2014 over UCF. That same season, Miami finished 22-9, with senior outside hitter Savannah Leaf earning ACC Player of the Year and AVCA Second-Team All-America honors. Freshman setter Haley Templeton was named ACC Freshman of the Year and AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

In 2017, Miami reached the NCAA second round after defeating College of Charleston, finishing 22-6 with its best winning percentage since 2012. Senior Olga Strantzali capped her career by being named both ACC Player of the Year and AVCA East Coast Region Player of the Year, while also earning AVCA All-America honorable mention.

DEVELOPING TALENT

Under his guidance, Miami has produced multiple AVCA All-Americans, All-Region honorees, and All-ACC performers, including two ACC Players of the Year (Leaf in 2014 and Strantzali in 2017). He has also developed Freshman of the Year winners, First Team

All-ACC selections, and academic standouts who excel on and off the court.

BEFORE MIAMI

Before taking over at Miami, Gandara spent eight years as an assistant coach at the University of Washington. There, he helped the Huskies capture the 2005 NCAA Championship and advance to the 2006 Final Four, working closely with head coach Jim McLaughlin. He was instrumental in scouting, defensive systems, and player development during Washington's rise as one of the nation's premier programs. Gandara also served as an assistant coach at UNLV and at his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara.

PLAYING CAREER

A native of San Juan, Puerto Rico, Gandara enjoyed an outstanding playing career at UC Santa Barbara. A two-time All-American as a middle blocker, he led the Gauchos to the 1988 national championship match and earned first-team All-America honors in 1989. Gandara was later inducted into the UCSB Athletics Hall of Fame and also competed internationally, representing both Puerto Rico and the United States in international competition, where he was also inducted into the PR Hall of Fame.

PLAYING CAREER

Off the court, Gandara is respected as a teacher and mentor who emphasizes growth beyond volleyball. He is married to Stephanie Cox, a former UCSB setter and professional player on the AVP Tour. The couple has one son, Lucas, born in 2011.

PREVIEW

The University of Miami volleyball team is set to begin the 13th season under the Jose 'Keno' Gandara era as it opens up the 2025 campaign at home vs. Indiana and Ohio State.

Coach Gandara has added five transfers and six freshman along with the five returning Canes.

Since the program's rebirth in 2001, the Hurricanes are 19-5 all-time in home openers. In the last two seasons combined, Miami has posted a 32-5 home record, including four top-25 wins with two being in the top 10.

The 2024 season was a season to remember as the Hurricanes took down the defending 2023 national champions and No. 1-ranked Texas Longhorns in a reverse sweep in Austin, Texas, giving the Longhorns their first loss at home since 2014 and Gandara's 200th career win. Miami went on to also upset No. 5 Stanford and No. 15 Georgia Tech in five sets to earn a spot in the AVCA rankings for the first time since 2021 (No. 20 on 9/9/24 and No. 25 on 9/23/24).

Senior outside hitter Flormarie Heredia Colon earned her first AVCA All-America honor, along with All-ACC First Team accolade after ranking second in kills (525) and points (599.5) in the ACC. Redshirt sophomore setter Ariana Rodriguez also notched AVCA East Coast All-Region honors in her debut season at Miami, following her 1,058 assist season to sit in seventh all-time in Miami history for career assists. The Dominican Republic duo also received spots on the 2025 Preseason All-ACC Team.

With only five returners, the Hurricanes are full of fresh faces as five transfers and six freshman enter the 305 to maintain the momentum of last season.

Ava Carney, Naylani Feliciano and Dalia Wilson round out the returners. Carney was fifth in kills last season despite missing 14 matches; Feliciano split time with starting libero Yaidaliz Rosado in 2024 but still tallied 114 digs; Wilson led the team in blocks and was third in kills and points.

Transfers Logan Wiley (Georgia Tech), Gaby Arroyo (Dayton), Jazmin Vergara (Tennessee State), Lilou Stegeman (American) and Kate Lijic (Utah State) add to the roster experience. Highlighted by Wiley, who earned a spot on the 2024 ACC All-Freshman team and Arroyo, a key defensive player with the Flyers the last two seasons.

Freshmen libero Olivia Durst, opposite hitter Mariam Mushkudiani, outside hitter Sonja Danilovic, setter Billie Reiter, outside hitter Amina N'Diaye and middle blocker Simone Baskin join the team to make their college debuts.

SCOUTING THE HOOSIERS

Miami and Indiana have met three consecutive seasons, splitting the win column after Indiana won in five sets in 2023 and Miami took the four-set win in 2024.

The Hoosiers are picked to finish 11th in the Big Ten Preseason Poll, with only four upperclassmen leading seven new freshmen.

Indiana is returning their two kill leaders, Candela Alonso-Corcelles and Avry Tatum, as well as their two block leaders, Madi Sell and Ava Vickers. Despite offensive and defensive power coming back for 2025, the Hoosiers will start 2025 with a new starting setter and libero.

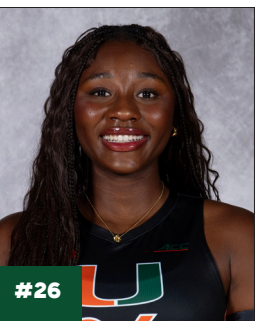
