305 CHALLENGE PREVIEW

- The Mean Green travels to the 305 Challenge with day one in Coral Gables, Fla., on Friday before day two on the FIU campus in Miami
- Friday features UNT's opening contest versus Drake at noon CT before meeting tournament co-hosts RV Miami (FL) on ACC Network at 5 p.m. CT
- **AJ Ricketts** (PxP) and **Alan Obrador** (analyst) will be on the call for the match against the Hurricanes
- On Saturday, North Texas will meet Stetson at 10 a.m. CT on ESPN+ from Ocean Bank Convocation Center in Miami
- **Natalie Kalibat** and **Zach Letson** will call Saturday's action
- The Mean Green trail the all-time series against Drake 0-2 after meetings in 1978 and 1981
- UNT trails Miami (FL) 0-2 including a three-set loss in Denton last season
- Sophomore middle blocker **Addison Achilles** dropped four kills and four blocks against the Hurricanes in last year's match
- Senior setter **Kamryn Scroggins** posted 18 assists and eight digs while **Alexa Washington** spelled Scroggins with 10 assists in the loss
- The Mean Green have not visited Miami since Oct. 21, 2001, as it fell in a dramatic five-set loss (30-27, 23-30, 17-30, 30-23, 14-16)
- Prior to Saturday's match, North Texas have never faced Stetson

PREVIOUSLY ON...

- The Mean Green opened the season with an undefeated 3-0 weekend at the Lion Invitational on the East Texas A&M (Commerce, Texas) campus
- This marked UNT's first 3-0 start to a season since 2018 and the seventh time in program history overall
- North Texas defeated both Little Rock and Providence 3-1 before it capped the weekend with a sweep over East Texas A&M on Saturday
- Sophomore outside hitter **Reagan Bedell** was named the weekly American Conference Honorable Mention after she led with 41 kills (3.73 K/S)
- True freshmen **Dakota Mitchell** (43 digs), **Alessandra Romo** (24 digs) and **Sidney Soria** (57 assists) impressed in their respective collegiate debuts

TRANSITION TEAM

- First-year UNT head coach **Dave Fleming** inherits a team that lost over 700 kills from last year's graduates
- The Mean Green return the second-lowest percentage of kills (18.6%) in the American Conference behind only Memphis (11.4%)
- Seniors **Paige Mooney**, **Kamryn Scroggins** and **Alexa Washington** will provide the greatest source of roster continuity
- Mooney led the team with 2.93 digs per set while Scroggins paced the Mean Green with 616 assists, 255 digs and 10 double-doubles
- Washington serves as the lone four-year senior for the Mean Green
- Sophomore **Ryann Vik** was named to the Preseason All-American Conference Team on Aug. 19
- Last season, Vik led all freshmen in the league with 1.06 blocks per set and ranked 17th among Division I first-year players

NEW YEAR, NEW SQUAD

- Armed with eight returners, including three seniors, first-year head coach **Dave Fleming** added eight newcomers to his roster
- Outside hitters **Tatum Busch** (Tarleton State) and **Jahniya Jackson** (Georgia State) add 161 and 158 career kills, respectively, to the roster
- Opposite hitters **Lilly Croshaw** (Illinois State) and **Reese Watters** (Arkansas State) look to carve out contributing roles after underutilized freshmen campaigns at previous schools
- Along with 4A Texas state champion setter **Sidney Soria** (Randall High School), liberos **Dakota Mitchell** (Kolona, Iowa) and **Alessandra Romo** (McKinney, Texas) joined the roster as incoming freshmen

THE FLEMING FILE

- First-year UNT head coach **Dave Fleming** comes to Denton after 20 seasons at Division II Colorado Mesa
- Fleming won four Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Coach of the Year awards with AVCA Regional Coach of the Year honors in 2014
- Accumulating a 390-184 record while at Mesa, he holds the program record for winning percentage at .679
- Fleming coached 21 All-American selections and 80 all-conference players, including three RMAC Player of the Year award winners, three Setter of the Year honorees and three Freshman of the Year selections
- Prior to his tenure in Grand Junction, he served as an assistant coach at UCLA for four seasons (2001-04)
- The Bruins compiled 86 wins while Fleming was on staff and earned four bids to the NCAA Tournament
- Fleming worked under legendary head coach **Andy Banachowski**, who ended his 43-year hall of fame career with six national championships and 1,106 wins – all at UCLA
- From 1994-96, Fleming worked as an assistant coach with USA Volleyball for the Women's National Team

TEAM 50

- Mean Green Volleyball celebrates its 50th season as a program in 2025
- Started in 1976, North Texas have played over 1,500 matches with nearly 300 letter winners
- UNT has produced two AVCA All-American selections, **Corina Marginas** (2003) and **Carnae Dillard** (2015), nine All-Region selections and 57 All-Conference selections – including 11 conference player of the year award winners
- The inaugural season was played under former head coach **Dolores Copeland** (1976-78) to a 23-19-1 record as a member of the Texas Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (TAIAW)
- After three seasons under Copeland, **Vickie Guy** (1979-84) took the reigns for the next six seasons, including the transition to NCAA Division I in 1982 and led the program into the Southland Conference in 1983
- **Dee Edwards** (1985-86), **Carol Pierce** (1987-88) and **Melissa Evans** (1989-90) each spent two seasons at the helm before **Donna Martin** (1991-99) took control for the ensuing nine seasons
- Under Martin, the Mean Green won its first conference championship in 1995 leading the the program's lone trip the NCAA Tournament
- At the turn of the millenium, **Cassie Headrick** (2000-09) looked to resurrect the program after four years as a member of the Big West Conference
- In 2006, Headrick led the Mean Green to its first regular season conference championship with a Sun Belt Conference West Division title after a 23-win season
- **Ken Murczek** (2010-12) became the eighth head coach in program history in 2010 and led North Texas to its second Sun Belt West Division title in his first season
- He repeated the feat in 2012 before falling to No. 17 WKU in the final of the 2012 Sun Belt Championship
- With the transition to Conference USA, former head coach **Andrew Palileo** (2013-21) entered the fray
- Palileo holds program records for career wins (163), winning seasons (7) and single-season victories (29)
- In 2017, Palileo led the Mean Green to the CUSA Regular Season title after a one-loss league campaign
- **Kristee Porter** (2022-24) led North Texas into the American Conference in 2023 before current head coach **Dave Fleming** was hired ahead of the 2025 season

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES

- Opened in 2006, the **UNT Volleyball Center** provides the Mean Green with an intimidating atmosphere
- The intimate arena seats 450 with a low ceiling, recessed basketball goals and a lively pep band to give UNT a distinct home-court advantage
- Since 2010, the Mean Green have registered a winning record at the UNT Volleyball Center in 15-consecutive seasons and holds a 167-96 mark (.635) entering 2025
- Entering the year, UNT Volleyball Center has drawn 99,478 fans in 19 seasons, including 90 matches in front of a sellout crowd
- Renovations to the Olympic Sports Complex were completed over the summer which included home and visiting locker rooms, expanded lobby areas and coaches' offices

NEXT UP

- Day one of the UNT-UTA Invitational begins on Friday at the UNT Volleyball Center
- The Mean Green open its home schedule against Little Rock on Friday at 7 p.m. CT on ESPN+
- North Texas meets Northwestern State on Saturday at 1 p.m. CT from College Park Center in Arlington, Texas before it closes the tournament versus UT Arlington on Sunday at 5 p.m. CT
- UNT defeated Little Rock 3-1 on Aug. 29, at the Lion Invitational and have won four of the past five meetings
- The Mean Green hold a 13-5 record over Northwestern State, including five-consecutive wins dating back to Sept. 20, 2005
- Sunday's match against UTA marks the 63rd contest between the two programs since UNT since 1976
- North Texas has won seven of its previous 10 matches against the Mavericks

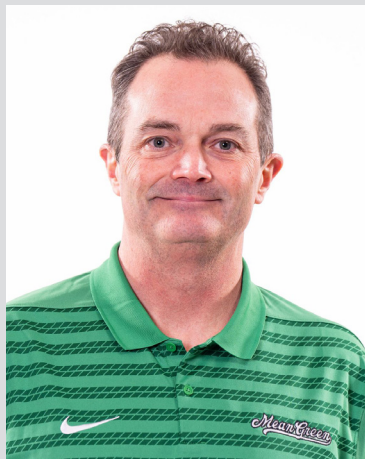

DAVE FLEMING

Head Coach | 1st Season

Dave Fleming was named the 11th head coach of UNT volleyball on Dec. 24, 2024, and enters his first season in 2025. Prior to joining the Mean Green, Fleming spent 20 years as head coach at Colorado Mesa in Grand Junction, Colo.

In 1994, Fleming graduated from the University of Michigan with a master's degree in kinesiology. During his time in Ann Arbor, he worked as a volunteer assistant coach for the women's team and played for the men's club volleyball team.

Fleming posted a record of 390-184 (.679) with the Mavericks and holds the program record for career winning percentage. During the 2024 season, he became the active wins leader among all Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference coaches.

After his stint with USA Volleyball, he became head coach at Valhalla High School in El Cajon, Calif., where he won coach of the year and a conference championship over two seasons. While in California, Fleming also worked as a club coach for San Diego Volleyball Club (1994-2001) and Sports Shack Volleyball Club (2001-04). In 2012, he was a founding member of Mesa Juniors Volleyball Company in Palisade, Colo., and served as President of the Board of Directors.

In total, Fleming tallied 258 conference victories and won four league championships during his time in Grand Junction. The Mavs held a position inside the AVCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll for the final 41 consecutive weeks of his tenure, a streak that dates to Aug. 29, 2022.

Fleming won four RMAC Coach of the Year awards and added AVCA South Central Region Coach of the Year honors in 2014. He coached 21 All-Americans and 80 all-conference players, including three RMAC Player of the Year winners, three Setter of the Year honorees and three Freshman of the Year selections.

Before he took the head job at CMU, Fleming served as an assistant coach at UCLA for four seasons. During his time in Los Angeles, the Bruins compiled a record of 86-43 and earned four bids to the NCAA Tournament with Elite Eight appearances in 2001, 2003 and 2004. Fleming worked under head coach Andy Banachowski, who ended his 43-year career with six national championships and 1,106 wins, all at UCLA. In 1997, Banachowski was the first coach inducted into the International Volleyball Hall of Fame.

From 1994-96, Fleming held an assistant coaching role for USA Volleyball with the Women's National Team. The team helped host the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta after it won the nation's first gold medal in a major competition at the 1995 FIVB World Grand Prix. Fleming worked under head coach Terry Liskevych and alongside assistant coaches Aldis Berzins and Jeanne Beauprey Reeves while with the national team.

He began his coaching career as a student assistant with the women's team at Denison University before he earned a bachelor's degree in geology with a minor in physical education in 1992. Fleming played and coached the men's club volleyball team while also starting for the varsity tennis team.
