Coastal Carolina volleyball is on the road for the third straight weekend as it travels to the Sunshine State for a pair of games at the 305 Invitational in Miami. The Chanticleers will open the tournament on Thursday at 6:30 p.m. when they take on 2024 NCAA participant Miami, then face FIU on Friday at 6 p.m. Coastal Carolina swept the Hurricanes and Panthers in back-to-back matches on the road in 2016. This weekend will be the Chants' first meeting with either opponent since. Both matches can be streamed on the ESPN app or watchespn.com.

#### STREAKS, STORYLINES, SIDEBARS

- ▶ LOOKING FOR SEVEN STRAIGHT: A win over Miami on Thursday would be the Chanticleers' seventh consecutive win and give them their best 10-match start (8-2) since going 10-0 to open the 2020 season. Their six straight wins are their most consecutive non-conference victories since winning nine in a row to open the 2019 season.
- MORE TOURNEY OPPONENTS: Coastal will be facing its sixth 2024 NCAA Tournament opponent of the season Thursday, Miami. The Chants are 3-2 against NCAA Tournament teams so far in 2025, defeating Delaware State, Cleveland State and NC State after suffering back-to-back losses to North Carolina and South Carolina.
- TRIPLE-DOUBLE RECORD: CCU junior Jalyn Stout is two triple-doubles shy of setting the NCAA career record across all divisions. She enters the weekend with an NCAA Division I record 38 career triple-doubles. The record of 39 is held by Jordyn Gates, who played at Division II Grand Valley State.
- MORE SBC POW AWARDS: Stout was named Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week for the second time in three weeks on Tuesday, while Anna Rita was voted the league's Defensive Player of the Week for the first time. Stout posted three triple-doubles, and Rita tallied 25 blocks in three matches at the Wolfpack Invitational.
- ▶ ALL-TOURNAMENT CHANTS: Stout was named MVP of the Wolfpack Invitational, averaging 3.92 kills, 3.83 assists, and 3.50 digs per set, tallying 47 kills, 46 assists, and 42 digs with 10 blocks and a .300 hitting percentage. Rita recorded 25 total blocks and 24 kills in 12 sets and received all-tournament accolades. Emily Fowler was also named to the all-tournament team with 35 kills and 16 blocks in 12 sets

#### **QUICK GLANCE: MIAMI**

- ▶ The Hurricanes enter Thursday's match on a sevenmatch winning streak following their win over Illinois on Saturday. They haven't lost since dropping their season opener to Indiana on Aug. 29.
- ▶ Flormarie Heredia Colon leads the ACC and ranks 10th in NCAA Division I with 4.80 kills per set. She ranks fifth in the conference in total kills (120). Colon leads the ACC in points per set (5.70) and is tied with teammate Ariana Rodriguez for the conference lead in aces per set (0.60).
- Miami is holding its opponents to a .168 hitting percentage, while posting an attack percentage of .252. Dalia Wilson is the team's leading attacker with a .367 hitting percentage.
- Naylani Feliciano is averaging a team-best 4.10 digs per set, which ranks fifth in the ACC. Rodriguez is the Hurricanes' primary setter with 9.13 assists per set.

#### **QUICK GLANCE: FIU**

- ▶ FIU enters the 305 Invitational with a 5-4 record following back-to-back wins over Presbyterian and Georgia over the weekend. The Panthers will face FGCU on Thursday before facing the Chants on Friday.
- ▶ The Panthers lead Conference USA with 15.28 digs per set, which is 56th nationally. Mandi Morioka is FIU's leading receiver, averaging 4.47 digs per set. She ranks second in C-USA.
- Savannah Cook leads the Panthers and C-USA with 9.48 assists per set. Kira Givens paces the FIU attack, averaging 9.71 attacks per set and 3.35 kills per set, both tops on the team.
- ▶ As a unit, the Panthers have 35 more kills than their opponents this season, 426-391.

#### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE**

- Junior Jalyn Stout has posted a double-double in 29 straight matches dating back to last season.
- So far this season, she has double-digit kills in seven matches, double-figure assists in eight matches, and double-digit digs in seven matches.
- ➤ She set the NCAA single-season record for doubledoubles last season with 26, while also producing an NCAA record 20 triple-doubles.
- Stout has recorded 63 career double-doubles, posting 25 as a freshman in addition to 26 last season and nine this year.

#### WALLIS TAKING ADVANTAGE OF TIME

- ▶ Junior Ava Wallis is making the most of her playing time this season after being a reserve last year. She has played in all nine matches this season after seeing the court in just 11 as a sophomore.
- ➤ She leads the team in assists with 185 and ranks third in digs with 85. A year ago, she had just 69 digs. Wallis is just two assists shy of 400 as a Chanticleer. She played her freshman season at Northeastern before transferring to CCU as a sophomore.
- Wallis has distributed 20 or more assists in seven of nine matches, including a career-high 29 against NC State on Sunday. It was the third time she handed out 29 assists after doing it twice last season.
- Wallis has recorded five double-doubles this season, including three in a row. She has posted six career double-doubles.
- Wallis registered a career-high 17 digs at NC State in the championship match of the Wolfpack Invitational. It was her fifth double-digit collection of the season and third time she was credited with 15 or more digs at CCU.

#### STOUT NAMED SBC WEEK ONE POW

- ▶ Jalyn Stout was named SBC Offensive Player of the Week for her performances against Maryland and North Carolina on opening weekend. It was her third career weekly accolade.
- ▶ The Gainesville, Fla., native finished with 33 kills, 38 assists, and 19 digs, while hitting .301. Stout averaged 3.38 kills, 4.22 assists, 2.11 digs, and 4.39 points per set.
- ▶ In the season-opening match against Maryland, Stout recorded her 35th career triple-double with 20 kills, 22 assists, and 10 digs, while hitting .381. She finished one dig shy of a triple-double against North Carolina, accumulating 13 kills, 16 assists, and nine digs.

#### **CHANTS FACE CHALLENGING SCHEDULE**

- ➤ Coastal has three matches remaining against teams that reached the 2024 NCAA Tournament: Miami and Texas State, twice.
- ▶ The Chanticleers play five autonomy conference teams this season. Coastal is 2-2 against in its first four matches, defeating Maryland and NC State, while falling to North Carolina and South Carolina.
- ➤ Coastal will play three conference champions: Cleveland State (Horizon), Delaware State (MEAC) and Texas State (Sun Belt). CCU has defeated CSU and DSU.
- ▶ The schedule includes three September tournaments: the Wildcat Classic (September 5-6), hosted by Davidson; the Wolfpack Invitational (September 12-14), hosted by NC State; and the 305 Invitational (September 18-19) in Miami.
- ▶ The Chanticleers play both Sun Belt Conference preseason division favorites on the road, traveling to Statesboro to take on East Division favorite Georgia Southern and closing out its road schedule at West Division favorite Texas State.

#### **RETURNERS RUNDOWN**

- ➤ Defensive specialist Bailee Earnhardt is the lone senior to have played all four years at Coastal. She has played in 78 matches and 251 sets during her career and is approaching 500 career kills (424).
- Junior libero Anna Smith played in all 30 matches for 104 total sets and made two starts, totaling 95 digs, 22 assists, four service aces and one kill.
- ▶ Junior Jalyn Stout earned First Team All-Sun Belt honors last season. She led the nation with an NCAA record 20 triple-doubles. Stout posted double-digit assists in 29 of 30 matches, double-digit digs in 26 matches, and double-figure kills in 21 matches. Stout ranked third in the Sun Belt in points (457.5) and total kills (402), sixth in kills per set (3.41), and 11th in digs (392). She was the only Chanticleer named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Team
- Junior Ava Wallis began her collegiate career at Northeastern but transferred to Coastal Carolina following her freshman season. As a sophomore she played in 11 matches and accumulated 213 assists, averaging 5.07 assists per set (42 sets played).
- ▶ Junior outside hitter Emma Van Elslande, a native of Luxembourg, saw limited action as a freshman but played in all 30 matches as a sophomore. She led the Chanticleers with 0.32 service aces per set, ranking third with 27 total service aces. Her 143 kills are the third-most among all returning players.
- Senior Leah Olsen has played in three matches and four sets during her previous two seasons with the Chanticleers.
- ▶ Junior outside hitter Emily Fowler is one of the Chants' top returning players. Last season, she finished third on the team in scoring with 306.5 points, an average of 3.10 points per set, which was the second-highest average on the team. She led the team in solo blocks (20) and ranked third in total blocks (61) and posted the second-best kills per set average (2.53) and third-most total kills (250) on the team.

#### **FOUR TRANSFERS JOIN ROSTER**

- Kibi Jae' Huggins (Southeastern Louisiana), Becca Micelle (Clemson), Anzley Rinard (Oral Roberts) and Anna Rita (Austin Peay) transferred to Coastal Carolina for the 2025 season.
- ▶ Huggins and Micelle are graduate transfers each with four years of experience; Rita is a junior who played each of the previous two seasons at Austin Peay; Rinard earned Summit League All-Freshman Team honors last season at Oral Roberts. Rinard and Rita joined the program in January.

#### FOURSOME OF FRESHMEN SIGN

- ▶ Elin Andersson joins the program from the Swedish club circuit, while Kayla Channell, Bella Loeswick, and Julia Rose Rivera made their way to CCU from the high school level.
- Channell and Loeswick each led their high school to a state championship in 2024, while Rivera helped her team capture a state title in 2023.
- Andersson competed for her country's national team at the 2024 U20 European Championship as well as the U17 and U19 North European Volleyball Zonal Association championships in 2022 and 2024.

#### **NEW STAFF ADDITIONS**

- Head coach Steve Loeswick assembled an entire new coaching staff over the winter, hiring Matt Scott as associate head coach/recruiting coordinator and Aaron King as an assistant coach.
- ➤ Scott joined the CCU staff following a three-year stint at Alabama. Prior to going to Tuscaloosa, he spent five years at UConn where he tutored six all-conference selections. He began his coaching career at Samford, where he served for three seasons.
- King joined the staff after two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mississippi State. Prior to his stint in Starkville, he served as an assistant coach at Stetson for six seasons after being a volunteer assistant at Western Kentucky in 2016.

#### **COACHES PICK CHANTS THIRD**

➤ Coastal was picked to finish third in the Sun Belt Conference's East Division by a vote of the league's 14 head coaches. The Chanticleers tied for third in division last season with a record of 7-9 after finishing first or second in the division in their first eight years as a member of the conference.

#### STOUT NAMED PRESEASON SBC POY

- ▶ Junior setter Jalyn Stout was voted the Sun Belt Preseason Player of the Year, after earning First Team All-Sun Belt honors last season.
- ➤ Stout ranked third in the Sun Belt in points (457.5) and total kills (402), sixth in kills per set (3.41), and 11th in digs (392). She was the only Chanticleer named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt Team.

Steve Loeswick enters his third season at the helm of the program after he took over the program early in the 2023 season after former head coach Jozsef Forman announced his resignation.

The Chanticleers went 17-6 after he took over the program and finished with a 22-10 overall record and the Sun Belt Conference regular season and tournament titles with a 14-2 SBC mark. Loeswick was named the 2023 Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year and the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Southeast Region Coach of the Year.

Under Loeswick's guidance, Jasmine Rivest earned the conference's Player of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year honors. Jalyn Stout was named the Sun Belt Freshman of the Year after setting an NCAA record with 14 triple-doubles and joined Rivest on the All-Sun Belt first team, while Sydney Lewis was selected to the all-conference second team.

Along with the Sun Belt title, Loeswick led the Chants to their sixth NCAA Tournament appearance. Coastal's 2023 berth marked the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament since 2017.

During his second season, Stout earned First Team All-Sun Belt honors, breaking her NCAA record for triple-doubles with 20.

Loeswcik joined the CCU athletics program as head beach volleyball coach in 2018 and joined the indoor volleyball coaching staff as an assistant coach in 2020.

Loeswick served as the head volleyball coach at North Florida for six seasons, guiding the Ospreys to a 97-94 overall record. He led UNF to its first ASUN championship appearance in 2012, a season that also included 20 wins for the first time in the program's NCAA Division I history. Loeswick guided several Ospreys to ASUN All-Conference and individual awards, including two Freshman of the Year winners, one Libero of the Year recipient, and one Defensive Player of the Year honoree.

Before taking over the reins at North Florida, Loeswick had a 14-year assistant coaching career that included five seasons at LSU (2007-11), three seasons at Oklahoma (2004-06), and six seasons at Cornell (1998-2003).

While at LSU, Loeswick helped the Tigers accumulate 112 wins, five consecutive SEC Western Division titles, and win the 2009 SEC championship -- the program's first since 1991. LSU was one of 25 programs nationally to put together four straight NCAA Tournament appearances (2007-10), and the program had a trio of 25-win seasons in 2007, 2009, and 2010. Loeswick's tenure also saw the Tigers garner multiple honors, including the 2009 SEC Player of the Year, a pair of SEC Defensive Players of the Year, eight All-SEC selections, a first-team AVCA All-American, seven honorable mention All-Americans, and six AVCA All-Region honorees. Four student-athletes also surpassed 1,000 career kills during his time with the LSU program.

Prior to his arrival at LSU, Loeswick spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma from 2004-06. As a member of 2006 AVCA Central Regional Coach of the Year Santiago Restrepo's staff, Loeswick aided the Sooners' record-turnaround in 2006 highlighted by a 28-6 record and a trip to the NCAA Sweet 16. The 28 victories and .824 winning percentage were school records, while the 15 more league wins marked the best one-year turnaround in Big 12 history.

OU finished the 2006 season ranked No. 12 in the AVCA poll, its highest ranking in program history, and boasted a pair of All-American honors along with the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year and Libero of the Year.

Before Oklahoma, Loeswick served as an assistant coach for six seasons at Cornell. During his tenure, the Big Red racked up a 93-38 record and 16 All-Ivy League selections, including 2000 Player of the Year Robin Moore. Cornell posted a top-three finish in the Ivy League standings during three of Loeswick's final four seasons, including a 21-4 mark and a second-place finish in 2003.

Loeswick played collegiately at the University of Southern California. He was a four-year starting setter for the Trojans and was just the third player in program history to start in a single position for all four seasons. Following his playing career at USC, Loeswick played in Germany's top professional volleyball league.

In 1996 Loeswick earned his bachelor's degree in exercise science from USC. A native of North Tonawanda, N.Y., he married the former Jennifer Arbuckle on June 17, 2006. Jennifer was a standout outside hitter at Virginia Tech from 1992-95.

The Loeswick's have three children - two daughters, Isabella Rose, a freshman on the team at Coastal, and Lillian Ann, and a son, Steven Jacob
