## Student-Athlete Host Form



This form must be completed when serving as a student-athlete host during a PSA's Official Visit. As a representative of Miami Athletics, you must follow University, ACC, and NCAA standards, comply with all recruiting rules, and direct any questions to your Head Coach or Compliance. Please review the NCAA Bylaws below for your understanding:

**13.6.7.4 Entertainment Expenses. [A]** An institution may provide up to \$60 per person to entertain a prospective student-athlete, student host and up to four family members accompanying the prospective student-athlete during an official visit, which excludes the cost of meals and admission to campus athletics events. Additional individuals accompanying the prospective student-athlete on the official visit may pay the actual cost of entertainment arranged by the institution. The entertainment allowance may not be used for the purchase of souvenirs, such as T-shirts or other institutional mementos. The institution or representatives of its athletics interests shall not provide cash to a prospective student-athlete or the prospective student-athlete's family members for entertainment purposes. **[R]** (Adopted: 4/26/23 effective 7/1/23, Revised: 11/16/23)

13.6.7.5 Student Host. [A] A student host must be either a current student-athlete or a student designated in a manner consistent with the institution's policy for providing campus visits or tours to prospective students in general.
