LAST TIME OUT

The Jacksonville Dolphins concluded their 2024-25 season with a postseason appearance in the College Basketball Invitational, the school's first postseason trip in 2017. To get there, JU finished the ASUN regular season in fourth place, earning a home playoff game against ECU.

Jacksonville won its tournament game over the Colonels -- part of a three-game season sweep of ECU -- before falling to North Alabama in the Semifinals. Under head coach Jordan Mincy, the Dolphins have reached the ASUN Semifinals in all but one season.

To reach its final ranking, Jacksonville went on a seven-game winning streak in conference play. The team also won six straight road conference games. In non-con play, JU defeated ACC foe Virginia Tech in November, the school's first ACC win in over 20 years.

INTERESTING?

- Anakin Brown will continue to wear the previously retired #4, last worn by his father JU HoFer Dee Brown.
- The 'Phins have two players who played high school basketball in Jax, six players from within two hours of JU.
- JU has never had a player named Jaylen suit up, yet will have two this season who also share the same initials.

THE MATCHUP

Jacksonville squares off against the 'Canes for the first time since 2020, owning six total wins over Miami in program history. The 'Phins last defeated Miami in 1971, but are coming off an ACC win over Virginia Tech last season.

Jordan Mincy enters his fifth year as head coach of Jacksonville University men's basketball in 2025-26.

2024-25

- Jacksonville earned an invitation to the 2025 College Basketball Invitational, the school's first postseason berth since 2016-17.
- Three players landed on All-ASUN Postseason awards lists: Robert McCray V, All-ASUN First Team, Chris Arias, All-Freshman ASUN Team, Jakari Spence, All-Academic ASUN. McCray was also awarded Preseason ASUN Player of the Year (first since 2010) and 2025 All-ASUN Tournament Team.
- Oversaw Jacksonville's 6-0 start to ASUN road games which was the first such streak at JU since 1986-87.
- Won seven ASUN games in a row which was highest total for the program since 2009-10.
- Defeated ACC foe Virginia Tech in Blacksburg for school's largest Power 4 victory since 2010.

2023-24

- Mincy led the Dolphins to a semi-finals finish in the ASUN Tournament with wins over #9 Kennesaw State and #1 ECU before falling to #2 Stetson on a last-second shot.
- Finished year with 16-17 record, 5-11 in ASUN play.
- Earned non-conference wins over Georgia Southern twice, Robert Morris, Farleigh Dickenson, Campbell, Louisiana-Monroe and Erskine.
- Won annual River City Rumble against rival UNF 62-50.
- Robert McCray selected to Third-Team All-ASUN and later entered name into NBA Draft.

2021-22

- Coach Mincy wasted no time in putting his stamp on the program, with a successful first year at the helm.
- Won the 2022 Joe B. Hall Award as the top first-year head coach in the country
- Led team to 21 wins, the second-most wins for a first-year head coach in program history
- First undefeated home season since 1972-73 (14-0)
- First ASUN Basketball Championship final appearance since 2009
- One of only five first year mid-major coaches in the country to reach to 20-win plateau
- Won 11 ASUN Conference games and finished as the two-seed in the South Division after being picked

CHRIS ARIAS -- JACKSONVILLE'S VERY OWN

Chris Arias is no longer a secret. In fact, he is one of the ASUN's very best young talents. Arias burst onto the scene during his freshman season, playing in every single one of Jacksonville's contests. He was one of just four players to play in every game and the only freshman Dolphin to do so.

The Jacksonville native, who played his high school ball at Providence High School, was a knockdown shooter all season. Arias had his star moment early in his freshman year, collecting a season-high 19 points against South Carolina State just four games in. He notched double-digit scoring efforts nine more times including in four straight games in the heat of ASUN conference season. For his efforts, he was named to the ASUN All-Freshman Team after his first season as a 'Phin.

Ahead of the 2025-2026 season, Arias was recognized again by the league when he was named as a Preseason All-ASUN member. Arias will look to improve upon his rookie season as a key figure on JU's team this year.

SIZE ALL OVER

Jacksonville's team features plenty of size, with nine total players taller than 6'5". Newcomer Charles Caporaso leads the unit standing in at 7'0" flat. Caporaso is the tallest player to suit up under Mincy in his five years at Jacksonville.

But Caporaso isn't the only sizable option JU has. Newcomers Jaylen Jordon (6'8"), Allen Udemadu (6'10") and Jason Thirdkill Jr. (6'7") all will look to utilize their size on the inside. Tito Deng (6'11") is the tallest returning player for the Dolphins, flanked by Donovan Rivers (6'9") who led the team in blocks last season. Enrico Borio (6'8") is also back after suffering an injury midway through last season. Guards Chris Arias (6'6") and Hayden Wood (6'6") will give Jacksonville solid length around the perimeter.

COMMITTED LONG TERM

After the strong debut season of the Jordan Mincy era, Jacksonville University Athletics signed him to a new long-term contract on that would keep him at JU for a decade. His new contract runs through the 2030-31 season.

COACHING STAFF CHANGES

Head coach Jordan Mincy added an ASUN legend to the Jacksonville coaching staff ahead of the 2025-26 campaign in FGCU's own Brett Comer.

Comer, coming off a coaching stint at Stetson during the 2023-24 season, was the head of the spear for FGCU's fabled 2013 run to the Sweet 16. That team was the first ever #15 seed to ever make it that far in the NCAA Tournament. In his playing days, Comer was a two-time All-ASUN First-Team member with the former Dunk City crew.

After his playing career, Comer went on to Dayton as a graduate assistant where he helped coach the likes of NBA First Round pick Obi Toppin. With the Hatters, Comer won the ASUN Tournament and reached the first round of the NCAA Tournament in '24.

Comer uses his years of high-level ASUN offensive experience to now lead the Dolphins' offensive attack.

Mincy also announced the promotion for assistant coach Troy Pierce into the role of associate head coach. Former associate head Michael Fly took a job with FSU men's basketball prior to the season.

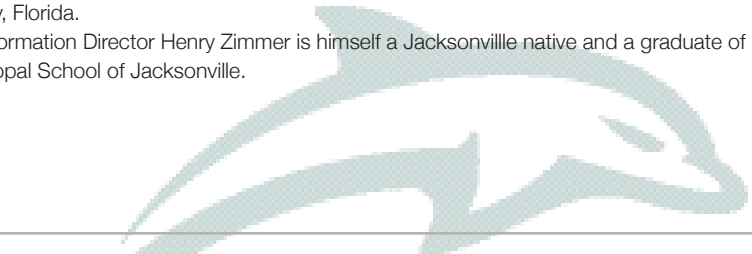
LOCAL FLAIR

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

While featuring plenty of prominent players from around the north Florida area, JU has two student-athletes from the continent of Africa.

Tito Deng returns for his junior season and has been a crowd favorite since he first stepped on the court at Swisher Gymnasium.

Deng hails from South Sudan, specifically from the Twic County located inside the state of Warrap. Jacksonville and South Sudan are only separated by the entire Atlantic Ocean and about seven different countries.

Staying in Africa, Allen Udemadu comes to Jacksonville by way of Lagos, Nigeria. Lagos is one of the fastest growing cities in the world, featuring over 21 million people. It is the largest city in the country and the most populated urban city on the continent.

Jacksonville also features a Brazilian national in Enrico Borio.

Borio, who played prep ball in Miami, is from Curitiba, Brazil. Curitiba is the capital of the state of Parana. Borio's international celebrity has helped him garner over 30,000 followers on Instagram and he details his life as a Division 1 basketball player in the States.

ALMOST COMPLETELY NEW ROSTER

In the modern age of basketball, Jacksonville is no stranger to the transfer portal. This season, Jacksonville took on six transfers from across the nation along with five freshmen. Only Donovan Rivers returns as a regular starter. Rivers is also the only starter returning from last year's starting five that competed in the College Basketball Invitational. Despite it all, JU will be looking to garner big minutes from players who missed significant time last season.

RETURN FROM INJURIES

Two key players return from injuries suffered last year in Enrico Borio and Simon Wheeler. Wheeler tore his ACL just four games into his first season with the Dolphins. Though he only played in four games, he managed to dish 22 assists which finished fifth best on the team. Wheeler is known for his ball-dishing ability as he set the single-season assist record at Ashland before coming to JU.

Borio returns from an elbow injury he suffered after appearing in 13 games. The Brazilian dropped a career-high 11 points at UCF and recorded a career-high four blocks in conference play against Austin Peay.

Redshirt freshman guard Anakin Brown also returns from a hip injury.

HOME SWEET SWISHER

Swisher Gymnasium has become one of the toughest environments to play in, not only in the ASUN, but in mid-major basketball.

Jacksonville lost just three games at only all season in 2024-2025. The team won an ASUN Tournament game on home court, part of two wins over ECU at home during conference and postseason play.

Under Mincy, Jacksonville has raised its attendance levels to over 70% of capacity filled in Swisher for every home game.

In the past two seasons, JU has posted 11-3 marks while playing at the program's home barn. That number was 15-0 in the first season under Mincy.

JACKSONVILLE FACING MCCRAY, FLY AT FSU

A trip to FSU will be a bit of a homecoming for Jacksonville and two men on the FSU men's basketball team.

The Dolphins will face off against two new Noles in Robert McCray V and assistant coach/GM Michael Fly. McCray was last year's ASUN Preseason Player of the Year while Fly served as JU's associate head coach. McCray scored over 1,000 points while donning a JU uniform. Fly served on the staff for two seasons after a head coaching stint at FGCU.

SEASON AT A GLANCE

Jacksonville will play just three home non-conference games during the final weeks of 2025. The 'Phins will play four to five games in the middle of their non-con schedule between home games to start the year.

Notable trips include a swing down to Daytona Beach for the Sunshine Slam tournament. Staying in the state of Florida, Jacksonville plays FAMU twice in one season.

Two ACC foes bookend the non-con slate, with trips to Miami and FSU. The furthest the Dolphins will travel this year will be out to Texas to face Texas A&M of SEC fame.

High Point, Texas A&M and Lipscomb are all coming off trips to the NCAA Tournament last season while George Mason and UNA coming off trips to the NIT.

JORDAN MINCY NAMED 2022 JOE B. HALL AWARD WINNER



Jacksonville University men's basketball coach Jordan Mincy was announced as the winner of the 2022 Joe B. Hall Award on April 1, 2022.

He was selected out of 15 finalists, including Hubert Davis at North Carolina, Tommy Lloyd at Arizona and Mike Woodson at Indiana for the award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I college basketball.

"I cannot thank the committee enough for honoring me with this year's Joe B. Hall Award," Mincy said. "I am extremely blessed and humbled to be selected out of such a great field for such a prestigious award.

"The support I received from our administration and the hard-work from our players and staff

are what makes moments like this possible for our program."

Mincy joins the pantheon of former winners, including Brad Underwood (2014, Stephen F. Austin), Steve Prohm (2012, Murray State) and Ryan Odom (2017, UMBC).

"What an honor it is for Coach Mincy to receive the Joe B. Hall Award as the top first year head coach in Division I. Jordan is so deserving of this recognition," Athletic Director Alex Ricker-Gilbert said. "From the time he stepped foot on campus almost exactly one year ago, he has made an impact on our community, program, and student-athletes. He has created an atmosphere of family and that is being felt by our young men.

"This is the first of many 'Coach of the Year' honors that Jordan Mincy will receive as head men's basketball coach at Jacksonville University."

In his first year on-campus, Mincy led the Dolphins to its most wins since the 1985-86 season, going undefeated at a routinely raucous Swisher Gymnasium and advancing in the ASUN Men's Basketball Championship final while connecting with community and reviving the aura around JU basketball in the city.

The Dolphins won 21 games, secured the first undefeated home season since 1972-73 and advanced to the doorstep of the NCAA Tournament. After being picked in the preseason to finish 10th out of 12 teams in the league, JU finished ASUN play with 11 wins, its most wins since the 2010-11 campaign, and finished as the two-seed in the South Division, including a sweep of North Florida in the River City Rumble.

JU earned its first postseason victory since 2018, beating Central Arkansas in the ASUN Quarterfinal round and advanced to its first conference tournament championship game since 2009 after defeating Jacksonville State on the road in the semifinal round.

Mincy compiled the second-most wins for a first-year head coach in program history and was one of only five mid-major coaches in the country to reach the 20-win mark in his first season.

He coached the team to a conference-best scoring defense, field goal percentage defense, three-point percentage defense and rebounding margin. The scoring defense was fifth in the nation among Division I teams and the rebounding margin was good for 12th in the country.

Kevion Nolan earned First Team All-ASUN honors, the first Dolphin to make the All-Conference First Team since Kori Babineaux in 2016.

The committee that selects the winner is a 15-member panel, consisting of five current Division I head coaches, five retired head coaches and five collegeinsider.com staff members.

Joe B. Hall passed away on Jan. 15, 2022, at the age of 93.

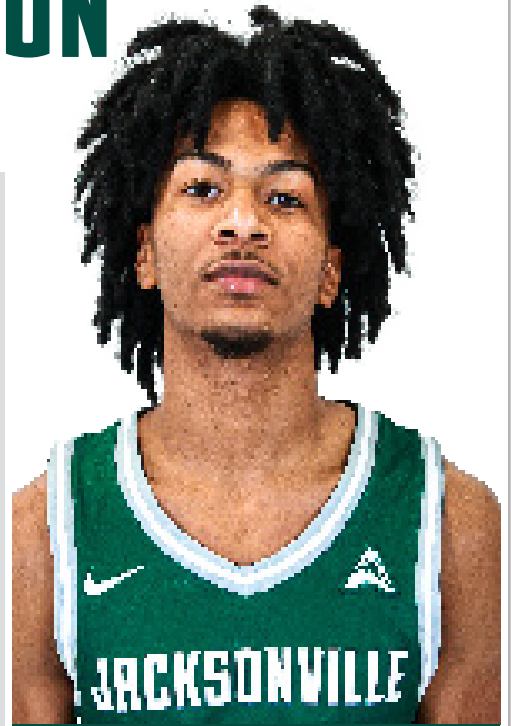

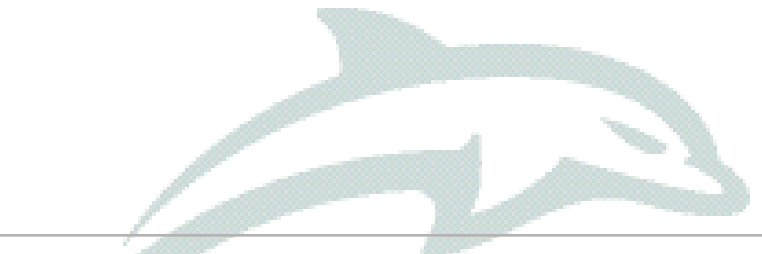

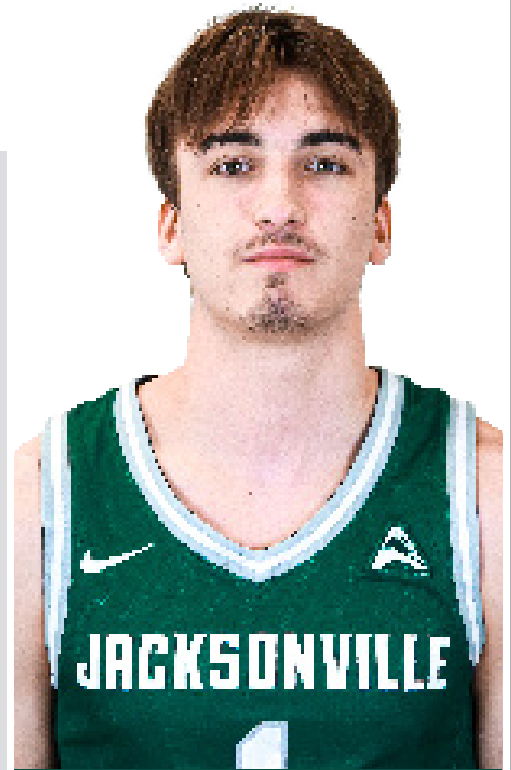
