WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- Oklahoma State's women's basketball team will play a pair of games at the Cayman Islands Classic this week when it faces Charlotte on Friday and Miami (Fla.) on Saturday. Both contests are set for a 10:00 a.m. (CST) tip.
- The Cowgirls have played in four Classics/Challenges under head coach Jacie Hoyt.
- OSU went 2-1 at the 2022 Cancun Women's Challenge, 0-2 at the 2023 Baha Mar Classic in The Bahamas, 1-1 at the 2023 Trailblazer Classic in Utah and 1-1 last year at the Daytona Beach Classic.
- The Cowgirls are first nationally in 3-pointers per game at 12.7 and fourth in scoring offense at 99.0 points per outing.
- OSU is fourth nationally with its 22.6 assists per game.
- Three Cowgirls rank in the top 10 nationally in made 3-pointers with Lena Girardi checking in at No. 3 with 25, Haleigh Timmer is sixth with 23 and Micah Gray is ninth with her 22 made treys.
- Stailee Heard is 17 rebounds away from 500 for her career.
- Micah Gray has 105 3-pointers as a Cowgirl and is five shy of moving into the top 10 on the school's all-time list.
- Macey Huard will miss the 2025-26 season due to injury.
- OSU enters the event with 889 wins in program history.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark OSU's first-ever meeting with Charlotte.
- OSU has squared off with Miami on three occasions and is 1-2 all time in the series.
- The Cowgirls knocked off the Hurricanes in the first round of the 1989 NCAA Tournament in Stillwater.
- Miami was victorious at the 1991 Florida International Classic and again in the first round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament in Bloomington, Ind.

KNOW THE FOE

- Charlotte is in its second season under Tomekia Reed after going 11-21 a year ago.
- The 49ers checked in at No. 10 in the American Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Miami was picked eighth in the ACC Preseason Poll.
- The Hurricanes went 14-15 last year in their first season under the direction of head coach Tricia Cullop.

HANG A HUNDRED

- With its 112-point effort against Prairie View A&M, OSU has reached the century mark eight times under Jacie Hoyt.
- Last year, OSU scored a school-record 113 points against Chicago State before breaking the mark four games later with 125 points against Alabama State.
- The Cowgirls have already set the school's single-season mark for 100-point games with four in the squad's first five games.

LAST TIME OUT

- OSU bounced back from its first loss of the year with a 98-45 win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Monday.
- Stailee Heard became the 26th Cowgirl to reach the 1,000-point mark and logged a career-best six steals.
- Lena Girardi scored 17 points, giving her double-digit outings in six of the first seven games of her collegiate career.
- OSU has won five games by at least 50 points this season, most in Division I. Only two Big 12 teams this century have had more such victories in a single season – Baylor in 2019-20 and 2016-17 (six each).

CHEERS TO HALF A HUNDRED

This season will mark the 50th anniversary of the first season the Cowgirls competed inside Gallagher-Iba Arena.

- OSU's 1975-76 team played four times inside the historic venue.
- On Dec. 4, OSU defeated Northern (Okla.), 67-47, before defeating Oklahoma, 76-36, six days later.
- On Jan. 20, OSU took down Cowley County Community College, 76-27, before defeating Tulsa, 95-42, on Jan. 27.



PRESEASON POLLING

The Cowgirls were picked to finish fourth in the Big 12's preseason coaches' poll. OSU's position is its best since being picked fourth prior to the 2014-15 campaign.

- The best-ever preseason position for the Cowgirls came in 2013-14 when they shared third place with West Virginia.
- OSU garnered 186 points, including two first-place votes to stand fourth. Baylor was third with 200 points, Iowa State was second at 202 and TCU was first with 10 first-place votes and 219 points.
- Additionally, the Cowgirls were picked fourth in a vote of Big 12 and national media members.

UNDER THE WATCHFUL EYE

Stailee Heard appears on the 20-player watch list for the Cheryl Miller Award it was announced by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association.

- The Cheryl Miller Award, one of five Naismith Starting Five awards, recognizes the best small forward in women's college basketball. The award is in its ninth year and named after the three-time Naismith Player of the Year.
- Heard was also among the players named to the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Women's College Player of the Year Watch List.

OSU TO THE W

The Cowgirls produced their first WNBA draft pick in 2010 with Andrea Riley going in the first round to the Los Angeles Sparks. OSU has since added five draft picks.

- Natasha Mack is currently active with the Phoenix where she played in 34 games, averaging 4.7 points and 5.8 rebounds per game while helping the Mercury reach the WNBA Finals. She ranked fourth among league players with her 1.5 blocks per game.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Cowgirls have made it a habit to defend their home floor during the Jackie Hoyt era.

- Overall, OSU is 41-9 in three seasons on the historic white maple floor inside Gallagher-Iba Arena under Hoyt.
- The Cowgirls finished 17-1 on their home floor this year for their best regular-season win total at home in program history.
- The Cowgirls finished the year 8-1 at home in Big 12 games, their best league mark in Gallagher-Iba Arena since 2020-21.
- OSU went 14-3 in its first season under her direction before posting a 10-5 mark in year two.

PRESEASON PUB

Staillee Heard was unanimously selected as a member of the All-Big 12 Women's Basketball Preseason Team.

- Heard is coming off a season in which she earned honorable mention All-America status and was a first-team All-Big 12 selection. Additionally, she was named to the USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Year Midseason Watch List.

- A native of Sapulpa, Okla., she averaged 16.8 points and 8.2 rebounds over 32 contests as a sophomore.

PRESEASON RESPECT

- OSU landed at No. 22 in the Associated Press preseason poll, marking the first time the Cowgirls have carried a preseason ranking since starting 21st in 2014-15.
- Additionally, the outlet projected Haleigh Timmer as the transfer most likely make the biggest impact for the program.
- OSU's transfer class was ranked No. 7 nationally by ESPN.com.

PRO POKES

Several Cowgirls are currently competing professionally across the globe.

- Ténin Magassa is competing in the French LFB for Charleville-Mezieres.
- Anna Gret Asi in competing in the Belgian Top Division for Royal Castors Braine.
- Naomie Alnatas is competing professionally in the Spanish LF Challenge for Celta Zorka.
- Clitan De Sousa is competing in Spain in the LF Challenge for Real Canoe.
- Former OSU All-American Natasha Mack just wrapped up the WNBA season where she helped the Phoenix Mercury reach the WNBA Finals.
- Tegan Cunningham is competing in her native Australia for the Kilsyth Lady Cobras.

FAB FRESHMAN

- Lena Girardi picked up her first weekly honor with her selection as the Big 12 Freshman of the Week on Nov. 10.
- Girardi averaged 15.5 points and 4.3 rebounds over OSU's four games.
- She set the program's freshman single-game record against Langston with her nine made 3-pointers.

PORTAL PRESENCE

During the offseason, the Cowgirls added six players with significant Division I experience.

- That group brings with it 388 career games played and 264 starts as well.
- Additionally, those six players have scored nearly 3,000 (2,937) points combined prior to their arrivals in Stillwater.

- Girardi is the 15th player since 2009 to wear the Cowgirl uniform after earning top 100 status and the fourth brought into the mix by head coach Jacie Hoyt.
- The Purchase, New York native averaged 30.8 points and 12.9 rebounds per contest during her final prep season.
- Girardi's father, Joe, enjoyed a lengthy Major League Baseball career with the Chicago Cubs, Colorado Rockies, New York Yankees and St. Louis Cardinals.
- He also managed the Florida Marlins, Yankees and Philadelphia Phillies.

RED, WHITE AND BLUE

In June, Stailee Heard was among 21 athletes who participated in the 2025 USA Basketball Women's AmericCup Team Trials at the U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Training Center in Colorado Springs.

- Players were selected by the USA Basketball Women's Junior National Team Committee.
- Additionally, Heard competed with teammates Faith Acker, Micah Gray and Jadyn Wooten at the USA Basketball 3X Nationals in May in Mesa, Arizona.

PLAYER PEDIGREE

Macey Huard comes from a family of athletes.

- Huard's father, Brock, was an accomplished quarterback at the University of Washington before moving on to a career in the NFL.
- Her mother, Molly, was a standout for the Washington women's basketball team.
- Her sister, Haley, played basketball at Montana.
- Additionally, she competed at Valor Christian High School in Colorado, which has produced an abundance of athletes, including former Cowboy golf standout Wyndham Clark and current San Francisco 49ers running back Christian McCaffrey.

KUDOS FROM THE USBWA

Stailee Heard appeared on the Ann Meyers Drysdale Watch List and Lena Girardi was named to the Tamika Catchings Award Watch List by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.

- Heard was one of 50 players to appear on the player of the year list, while Girardi was among 20 standouts on the top freshman list.
- The Ann Meyers Drysdale Award is presented annually to the women's national player of the year by the USBWA.
- The USBWA has named a national freshman player of the year since the 1991-92 season. In the 2020-21 season the award was named for Tamika Catchings.

THE COWGIRL STATE

OSU's non-conference slate features a strong in-state flavor with the Cowgirls playing six games overall against teams from the state of Oklahoma.

- After opening with an Oct. 28 exhibition against Oklahoma Christian, the Cowgirls will host a Nov. 6 contest against Langston followed by a Nov. 9 tilt with Oral Roberts in Stillwater.
- The Cowgirls will travel to Oklahoma City on Dec. 13 to take on Bedlam rival Oklahoma before facing Tulsa two days later inside Gallagher-Iba Arena.

TIMMER TIME

The most experienced of OSU's group of newcomers is Haleigh Timmer.

- Timmer competed in 106 games and made 77 starts over three seasons at South Dakota State.
- During her time with the Jackrabbits, she scored 1,155 points and helped SDSU to an 88-19 (.822) record over three seasons.
- Timmer was named an All-Summit League honorable mention pick last year and was a second-team selection as a sophomore.

- She reached the mark in OSU's win over Texas A&M-Corpus Christi to become the 26th Cowgirl to do so.
- Heard became the first OSU player to reach the mark since Natasha Mack did so in 2020-21.

SERVANT LEADER

Achol Akot has been named a Kay Yow Servant Leader. The recipients of the organization's Servant Leader Award are people of great character who put the needs of others before their own, who uplift others, and who do it with grace and humility. They are nominated by their coach, and are people who exemplify Coach Yow's spirit and who reflect her resolve, grace, generosity, and servant's heart. Winners display courage and strength, and their first response is to give to others. Her selection marks the second consecutive year OSU has had a Kay Yow Servant Leader with Rylee Langerman earning the distinction last season.



BEDLAM IS BACK!

After a one-year hiatus, the Cowgirls will renew their Bedlam Series rivalry with Oklahoma. The contest will take place on Dec. 13 in Oklahoma City. The in-state rivals will square off at the Paycom Center, home to the defending NBA champion Oklahoma City Thunder. The contest will mark OSU's first regular-season tilt in the venue since defeating South Florida at the All-College Classic on Dec. 14, 2013.

SOPHOMORE ENCORE

Jadyn Wooten had a standout freshman campaign for the Cowgirls a year ago.

- Wooten played in 30 games and led OSU with 104 assists.
- She was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team, earned league freshman of the week honors on one occasion and was named to the Daytona Beach Classic all-tourney team.

TRIPLE THREAT

- OSU made 13 3-pointers in its win over Prairie View A&M, giving OSU 72 and the most recorded by a Division I team over its first five games since at least 1999-2000.
- Lena Girardi drilled nine treys against Langston to set the school's single-game mark for a freshman and finish one shy of tying the school's overall single-game mark.

BIG 12 ADDITIONS

Among OSU's newcomers are a pair of players with significant experience in the Big 12.

- Amari Whiting spent her first two seasons at BYU. During her time in Provo, she started all 63 games in which she played for the Cougars.
- Whiting averaged 10.4 points and 5.2 boards per contest while dishing out 238 assists over those two years.
- Achol Akot started her career at UCF where she competed for the Knights for two seasons.
- Akot made 36 starts and played in 57 games over those two seasons, averaging 5.9 points and 6.3 rebounds per contest.

GRAY AREA

Micah Gray made an immediate impact during her first season in Stillwater in 2024-25.

- The Oklahoma City native received honorable mention All-Big 12 status after starting all 32 games.
- Gray set the school's single-season standard with her 83 made 3-pointers.
- She also wrote her name into the single-game record book with 10 made 3-pointers against Chicago State. Her total tied for the third-best total in a single game in Big 12 history.

UNANIMOUSLY HEARD

An all-league selection a year ago, Staillee Heard was unanimously tabbed as a preseason All-Big 12 pick this year. She will look to join a list of nine unanimous all-league picks for the Cowgirls since 2013. That list includes Toni Young (2013), Tiffany Bias (2014), Brittney Martin (2015, 2016), Kaylee Jensen (2018), Loryn Goodwin (2018), Vivian Gray (2019, 2020) and Natasha Mack (2021).

- Guided OSU to a 25-win season, the third-highest win total in school history, and its second NCAA berth under her direction last season
- Coached Stailee Heard to honorable mention All-America status in 2024-25
- Won 21 games in her first year in Stillwater to match the program's best total by a first-year head coach.
- Led OSU to the NCAA Tournament, becoming the first coach to lead the Cowgirls to the Big Dance in their first season.
- 2020 Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year after coaching Kansas City to the first regular season conference championship in the history of the program.
- 23 wins in 2021-22 were the second-most for Kansas City since joining NCAA Division I in 1987-88.
- The Roos of 2021-22 appeared in the Women's NIT for just the second time in program history.
- Had the Roos in prime position for their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2019-20 before COVID brought an early end to the season with Kansas City having already won the WAC regular season title and still alive in the conference tournament at the time of the stoppage.
- During her time at Kansas City, Hoyt coached the Roos to a winning percentage of 60.8 percent in conference games. Prior to her arrival, no coach left Kansas City with a career conference winning percentage above 44.2 percent.
- Hoyt led Kansas City to 13 conference wins in 2019-20 and 12 conference wins in 2021-22 for the two highest single-season totals in the history of the program.

Jacie Hoyt's third season at OSU was one of historical significance with numerous team and individual milestones being achieved en route to securing the program's second NCAA berth under her direction.

The Cowgirls racked up 25 wins on the season, the third-best total in program history and earned their second NCAA berth in three seasons under her guidance. For her work, Hoyt was named a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist.

The Cowgirls' 14 Big 12 wins were the most league wins recorded in a single season in program history.

OSU's 85-55 win over No. 12 Kansas State tied the second-largest win over a Top 25 squad in program history.

OSU entered the Associated Press Top 25 on Jan. 13 for the first time since Feb. 19, 2018, and reached No. 17 in the AP Top 25 poll, its highest ranking since reaching No. 17 in 2016. Additionally, the Cowgirls earned their first win over a top-10 opponent since defeating No. 7 UCLA on Dec. 8, 2017 when they knocked off No. 9 TCU on Jan. 22.

Individually, Stailee Heard led the list of honorees, garnering honorable mention All-America status and first-team All-Big 12 honors. Anna Gret Asi was tabbed as a third-team all-league pick and Micah Gray received honorable mention status. Jadyn Wooten was named to the league's all-freshman team. Asi and Macey Huard were named CSC Academic All-Region picks for their work in the classroom.

In 2022-23, its first year under the direction of head coach Jacie Hoyt, Oklahoma State's women's basketball team won 21 games, matching the program's best tally ever under a first-year head coach.

OSU's total marked a 12-win improvement from the previous season and resulted in one of the 10 largest turnarounds in the nation on the year as well.

The Cowgirls navigated the non-conference portion of their schedule with a 10-2 mark before reeling off a 10-8 record in league play. OSU's six-game winning streak during league play was its longest in Big 12 action since 2016.

Among the Cowgirls' conference victories were a pair of wins over ranked opponents with OSU taking down No. 18 Baylor and No. 20 Iowa State. Additionally, the Cowgirls swept three Big 12 series on the year with sweeps of TCU, Texas Tech and Baylor. OSU's season sweep of Baylor was its first over the Bears since 2008.

Overall, the Cowgirls sported five wins over teams either ranked in the Top 25 or receiving votes in the polls.

Hoyt's squad proved formidable at home, amassing a 14-3 mark inside Gallagher-Iba Arena, its highest win total on its home floor since a 14-3 record in 2017-18.

The Cowgirls' season of success culminated with the 17th NCAA tourney berth in school history. With OSU's March Madness appearance, Hoyt became the first coach to lead the Cowgirls to the tournament in their first year at the helm.

Individually, Naomie Alnatas was tabbed as an All-Big 12 selection.

Hoyt was tabbed as the Cowgirls' head coach on March 20, 2022. She came to OSU after serving in the same capacity at Kansas City from 2017-22.

Her roots in Big 12 country run deep. Her mother, Shelly Hoyt, is a Kansas High School coaching legend and Jacie, who played for her mother in high school, went on to play collegiately at Wichita State. In addition to leading the Kansas City program, Hoyt's coaching career includes stops at Fort Hays State, Nevada and Kansas State.

Her work at Kansas City was transformational. In her five seasons at the helm of the Roos, she compiled an 81-65 overall record (55.5 percent) and a 48-31 mark in conference play (60.8 percent). For perspective, the six Kansas City coaches before her combined to go 242-437 overall (35.6 percent) and 144-215 in conference play (40.1 percent). In 2021-22, she coached the Roos to their first postseason appearance in a decade.

Hoyt led the Roos to the 2020 Western Athletic Conference regular season championship – the first in program history – and more than 20 wins in two of her final three seasons.

She was honored as the 2020 WAC Coach of the Year to become the first Kansas City coach to ever receive such an honor and her top player, Ericka Mattingly, was named WAC Player of the Year.

As a student-athlete at Wichita State from 2006-09, Hoyt was a team captain for Albright and started every game at point guard during her final two seasons. She graduated Cum Laude with a bachelor's degree in 2009.

During her high school years, Hoyt enjoyed one of the most prolific scoring careers in Kansas prep history, finishing with 2,016 points in only three seasons at Hoxie (Kan.) HS. Her career average of 26.6 points per game ranks sixth in state history. As a senior, she averaged 28.4 points, 7.4 assists, 6.3 rebounds and 6.1 steals per game. She was a three-time all-state performer in basketball and volleyball and was also a state champion in multiple track events.
