THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt and Miami play for the 50th time Tuesday night when they open ACC play at the Watsco Center in Coral Gables, Fla. The game will be televised on ACC Network with tipoff scheduled for 7:00 p.m.
- The game will be broadcast on ACC Network with Brian Custer (play-by-play) and Scott Williams (analysis) on the call.
- The game will also be broadcast on the Panthers Radio Network (flagship 93.7 The Fan) with Bill Hillgrove (play-by-play) and Curtis Aiken (analysis) providing the commentary.
- Miami has won six straight entering Tuesday's game while Pitt has won two in a row by a

combined 74 points.

- Pitt is 6-6 in ACC openers all-time and defeated Virginia Tech on the road a year ago in the ACC opener, 64-59. The Panthers are 4-1 all-time in ACC openers played on the road
- Miami leads the all-time series between the two programs 27-22, including a 5-1 mark inside the Watsco Center. Pitt and Miami have split two previous meetings to open ACC play, with both contests taking place inside the Watsco Center.
- Pitt enters Tuesday's game having won back-to-back games by 34+ points for the first time since defeating Maryland Eastern Shore 78-43 and New Orleans 99-57 consecutively Dec. 15 and 20, 2018.

SERIES NOTES

- This will be the 50th meeting all-time between Pitt and Miami. Miami leads the all-time series 27-22 and the two programs have an extensive history that intertwines numerous eras.
- Miami leads the ACC era for the two programs (beginning in 2013-14) 11-5, and the Hurricanes won the lone ACC Tournament meeting between the programs (79-73 in 2021).
- Pitt held an 11-8 advantage in the Big East era (1992-2012), including a 2-1 mark in the Big East Tournament.
- A year ago, Pitt defeated Miami in the lone contest between the two programs, 74-65. The Panthers dominated in the paint (34-20) and on second-chance points (17-6).
- A 71-68 Pitt victory on Jan. 28, 2023 was arguably the most memorable recent win in the series. Pitt outscored then-No. 20 Miami 11-0 over the final 2:03 to get the victory.
- There have been four overtime games in the series, with each team winning twice. Most recently, Pitt posted a 59-55 overtime victory at BankUnited Center on Feb. 5, 2014.
- Pitt won five straight in the series from 1993-95 and Miami won seven in row spanning from 2015 through 2020.

NUMBERING THE NIGHTS

- Entering the Miami game, Pitt has played 2,992 men's basketball games in program history. Game number 3,000 is scheduled for Jan. 27 vs. Wake Forest.
- Pitt has an all-time record of 1,728-1,264 for a winning percentage of .578.

LAST TIME OUT

- Freshman forward Roman Siulepa poured in a career-high 28 points and Pitt shot 50 percent

from beyond the arc to power past Penn State, 80-46, Saturday afternoon at The GIANT Center in Hershey.

- The Panthers (7-6) closed out their non-conference schedule with a dominant performance, building a 20-point halftime lead and never looking back. Siulepa went 10-of-16 from the field and knocked down 5-of-6 three-pointers to surpass his previous career high of 20 points. He entered the game with just three made three-pointers on the season.

- Pitt jumped on Penn State early, opening the game with a three-pointer from Barry Dunning, Jr. and never trailing. The Panthers scored their first 15 points exclusively from beyond the arc, as four different players – Dunning, Siulepa, Damarco Minor, and Omari Witherspoon – connected from deep to build a 15-6 advantage.

- The hot shooting continued throughout the opening half as Pitt went 6-of-11 from three-point range and shot 53.3 percent (16-of-30) from the field to take a commanding 40-20 lead into the break. Meanwhile, the Panthers' defense held Penn State to just 26 percent shooting (7-of-27) and 2-of-13 from three-point range in the first 20 minutes.

- Penn State (8-4) trimmed the deficit to 13 points early in the second half with an 8-0 run, but Brandin Cummings stopped the rally with a stepback jumper and then converted a pair of free throws. The Midland, Pa. native finished with eight points and six rebounds.

- From there, Minor took over the playmaking duties. The senior guard hit a three-pointer and found Siulepa for a slam to push the lead back to 51-32. Minor finished with 11 points and a game-high seven assists while connecting on 3-of-5 from long range.

- Siulepa heated up midway through the second half, knocking down back-to-back three-pointers to extend Pitt's advantage to 59-37. His fifth triple of the afternoon gave the Panthers a 62-37 cushion with under eight minutes to play.

- Witherspoon added 15 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including 3-of-5 from three-point range, while Cameron Corhen contributed nine points and a team-high eight rebounds.

- For the game, Pitt shot 50.0 percent (30-of-60) from the field and made 12-of-24 three-pointers (50.0 percent). The Panthers dominated the glass, outrebounding Penn State 42-30, including a 10-7 edge on the offensive boards. Pitt also held a 12-6 advantage in points off turnovers.

LIGHTS OUT

- Pitt had one of its most impressive offensive outings in program history in a 103-63 win over Binghamton just prior to the Penn State game.
- By shooting 62.1 percent (36-of-58) from the field and 59.3 percent (16-of-27) from three, Pitt had an effective field goal percentage of 75.9 percent. That ranks as the fifth-highest eFG% dating back to the 2004-05 season.

SCORIN' WITH CORHEN

- After averaging 11.0 points and 5.2 rebounds per game in 2024-25, Cameron Corhen has taken the next step in his game in 2025-26. He has increased those averages to 13.3 points and 8.6 rebounds per game, while shooting a team-best 53.3 percent from the field. He's blocked 10 shots and even knocked down six three-pointers, while also having the third-most assists on the team.
- Corhen is one of five players in the ACC (and

one of 42 nationally) to be averaging at least 13 points and eight rebounds per game. He is one of 30 players in the country with those statistical averages while shooting at least 50 percent from the field.

- Corhen has four double-doubles on the season, tied for sixth among all ACC players. Three of those double doubles have come against high major opponents, averaging 13.8 points and 9.0 rebounds against those six non-conference opponents.

- His 33:32 minutes per game ranks fifth in the ACC and 12th in the country among non-guards.

- In the season opener against Youngstown State, Corhen finishing with 23 points and 12 rebounds, while shooting 8-of-11 from the field. He followed that up with 14 points and 10 rebounds, while blocking two shots and adding two assists and two steals against West Virginia.

- Corhen's third double-double came in a 17-point, 11-rebound performance against UCF. On Friday, he posted his fourth double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Ohio State.

- In 2024-25, Corhen had a true shooting percentage of .635, ranking fourth in the ACC among those with at least 200 field goal attempts. True shooting percentage measures a player's scoring efficiency by accounting for two-point field goals, three-point field goals, and free throws.

ALL GAS, NO BREAKS

- While Cameron Corhen ranks fifth in the ACC in minutes played in 2025-26, he's not the only Panther logging big minutes.
- Corhen, Omari Witherspoon, Barry Dunning, Jr. and Brandin Cummings each played all 20 minutes of the second half against Hofstra. Dunning played all 40 minutes of the game.
- Dunning had played at least 36 minutes in five consecutive games until Pitt's 40-point win over Binghamton in which he only played 24 minutes. He played MORE than 40 minutes in a game five times a year ago at South Alabama, peaking with 42:02 when he scored 46 points at Texas State.
- Since moving into the starting lineup for the last six games, Dunning is averaging over 34 minutes per contest.
- Not even mentioned yet, Damarco Minor ranks ninth in the ACC in minutes played at 31:38. He has exceeded the 30-minute mark in 10-of-13 games this year.

ROMAN'S EMPIRE

- Freshman Roman Siulepa plays with a bruising style that complements his rugby background. He has a pair of 20-point games this year, tied for the most on the team in 2025-26.
- Siulepa made 9-of-12 shots and had a then-career-high with 20 points and eight rebounds against Quinnipiac. He also posted an assist, a blocked shot and four steals.
- That, however, was just a precursor to his 28-point performance against Penn State in Pitt's final non-conference game of the year. Siulepa

was 10-of-16 shooting, including 5-of-6 from deep. He entered the game just 3-of-20 from three-point range on the season.

- Following the Quinnipiac game, Siulepa seemed to hit a freshman wall, scoring just eight points over the next four games. But he broke out with 12 against Binghamton followed by the 28-point effort against Penn State.

- His performance against Penn State places him among the top 10 freshman single game performances at Pitt in a number of statistical categories including: points (28 - t8th), field goals made (10 - t7th), three-pointers made (5 - t5th), and three-point percentage (.833 - t3rd).

- The top basketball prospect out of Australia and someone who has appeared on the radars of NBA teams since the age of 16, Siulepa was also one of the best youth rugby players in the country. Commentators praised him as one of the best high-school rugby players ever through the GPS system.

- Siulepa's basketball resume has led to claims that he is the best prospect out of Australia since Ben Simmons. He has drawn comparisons to past notable NBA prospects such as Zion Williamson.

THE BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

- Pitt has been outrebounded in a game just three times this season and has won the rebounding battle in all seven team victories this year. In fact, Pitt is +9.4 on the boards in its seven wins and -0.3 in the six losses.

- Six different players are averaging at least 3.5 rebounds per game and three players have at least 22 offensive rebounds on the season. Only seven teams have more players (each has four players) with at least 22 offensive rebounds this year.

- As a team, Pitt has 36 more offensive rebounds (2.8 per game) than their opponents on the season. The Panthers have at least 10 offensive rebounds in seven of the past nine games and are averaging 12.7 per contest during that stretch.

- Cameron Corhen is seventh in the ACC at 8.6 rebounds per contest and he has five double-figure rebounding games. Corhen has at least six rebounds in every game this year and is one of seven players in the country to have 6+ rebounds in a game 13 times this year.

- Papa Amadou Kante had 10 against Youngstown State and then a career-high 11 against Bucknell and is averaging 5.4 per contest.

- Barry Dunning, Jr. is up to 4.9 per game for the full season. Starting point guard Damarco Minor is fourth on the team at 4.0 per contest. Nojus Indrusaitis, fresh off a career-high eight rebounds, and Roman Siulepa are both at 3.5 rebounds per contest.

BRANDIN'S BREAKOUT

- Expected to be a key contributor for the Panthers in 2025-26, Brandin Cummings has been hampered by injury during much of non-conference play. But he put that behind him and looked like one of the top scorers in the country against Hofstra.

- Cummings came off the bench to score a career-high 34 points, including 30 in the second half, as he tried to rally Pitt back from a 17-point deficit. He went 8-for-12 from the field over the final 20 minutes, burying five three-pointers, and made all nine of his free-throw attempts.

- The 34 points were the most in Pitt history by a player coming off the bench and were the second-most by a Pitt player in Petersen Events

- Cummings' 30 second-half points were the second-most in a half in program history as well.
- As a freshman in 2024-25, Cummings showed his scoring potential in mostly limited minutes, averaging 6.3 points per game. He had a season-best 30 points in a win over Eastern Kentucky on Dec. 11, 2024.
- When healthy, Cummings has been the most lethal scoring threat on the roster. He averaged 18.5 points on 9-of-18 shooting (7-of-12 from three) over the first two games of the season. He then missed the team's game against Eastern Michigan and then two more (UCF and Quinnipiac) later in non-conference play. He played a scoreless 19 minutes in his return against Texas A&M before exploding in the second half of the Hofstra game.

MAJOR MINOR

- Fifth-year point guard Damarco "Polo" Minor has taken the long road to get to Pitt, but is leading the Panthers in 2025-26.
- Minor began his collegiate career in junior college at South Suburban College for the 2021-22 season and then spent two years at SIU Edwardsville, culminating in First Team All-OVC honors. He transferred to Oregon State for the 2024-25 season.
- With 1,308 career points and 361 career assists to his name prior to the start of the season, Minor brings experience to the Panthers. He played in his 100th career game at the NCAA Division I level when he got the starting nod against Youngstown State in the season opener.
- In the win over Eastern Michigan, Minor had 12 points, seven rebounds, six assists and four steals, while playing almost 38 minutes. He became just the third player in the NCAA this year to post a 12/7/6/4 game.
- Similarly, he is averaging 10.5 points and 4.0 rebounds, while leading the team in assists (3.5 per game) and steals (1.5 per game). Minor is also shooting 90.0 percent (27-of-30) at the free-throw line and leads the team from three-point range at 41.7 percent (25-of-60).
- Minor is one of just five players in the ACC averaging at least 10 points, four rebounds, three assists and 1.5 steals per game.
- He is the only player in the country averaging those statistical totals while shooting at least 90 percent from the free-throw line. He is one of ten in the country to be averaging those statistical totals while shooting 40 percent from three-point range.
- Minor is one of only four players in the ACC to be shooting 40 percent from three-point range and 90 percent from the free-throw line (minimum 200 minutes played).

PANDEMOMIUM AT PITTS

- Damarco Minor's buzzer beating three-pointer against Ohio State set off "Pandemonium at Pitt" last Friday in the 67-66 victory.
- It was the 40th game-winning shot in the final seconds in Pitt program history and the first since Zack Austin buried an overtime game-winning three pointer in a 91-90 win over the same Ohio State program on Nov. 29, 2024. Minor's shot came 364 days after Austin's.
- While there were still 0.4 seconds remaining after Austin's shot a year ago, Minor's three-

ball was the first walk-off winner that took Pitt from defeat to victory since Ashton Gibbs sunk a similarly long three-pointer to beat Providence 73-71 on March 4, 2010.

- The Gibbs' winner was eerily similar as Pitt had 3.5 seconds to go the length of the court. Much like Minor, Gibbs caught the inbounds pass and dribbled his way up the court before pulling up and walking it off.




