ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries must be submitted through Direct Athletics. Throwing event entries will be limited to three competitors per school per event. If you have additional entries, please email Coach Bloom and Coach Young to confirm the additional competitor(s). **All entries must be received no later than the Tuesday of Meet Week, at 12:00pm EST. ONLY INVITED TEAMS WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.**

UNATTACHED ENTRIES

ONLY unattached/pro athletes affiliated with visiting schools will be allowed into the competitions. Currently, we are not accepting unattached athletes who do not fall under the previously mentioned criteria. For any inquiries or additional questions, please contact Coach Bloom at alex.bloom@miami.edu.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees must be paid PRIOR to the competition date. Entries will be scratched from competition if entry fees are not paid for by the time/date entries close on Direct Athletics. The payment can be made via the link provided below, which will redirect you to the University of Miami Athletics ticketing system. A separate "ticket" must be purchased for each team's gender. If a team is traveling split-squad, please reach out to Coach Bloom to arrange for individual student-athlete entry fees.

LOCATION

FACILITY

Beynon Track Surface: 8 – 42" Lanes: 4 LJ, TJ Runways, 2 PV, HJ Areas: Maximum spike length $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

PACKET PICK-UP

Packets will be available beginning one hour prior to the first event of the meet. Packets can be picked up at the Knight Complex Building. Packets will include heat sheets, as well as athlete and coaches' wristbands.

EVENT CHECK-IN

- Running event participants must check-in with the meet clerk of the course, no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the scheduled event.
- Field event participants must report to the event site no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the scheduled event or they will be scratched.

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN

All Implements must be checked-in and impounded at the designated times at the Implement Weigh-In Area, located outside the Track Patio at the North corner of the track. Uncertified implements will be impounded and released following the event.

The implement weigh-in schedule will be provided closer to the meets

MEET CONDUCT

All track events will be run as finals against time, except for the 100m Hurdles and the 110m Hurdles. All field events, except high jump and pole vault, will be contested in flights with three trials and nine advancing to the finals. In the finals, each competitor will receive three additional attempts. HJ/PV will be run in continual flights. NCAA rules will be in effect.

FACILITY MAP/DROP-OFF & PARKING

TEAM/WARM-UP AREAS

The designated team camp area will be located inside the Knight Sports Complex (volleyball gym). Assigned areas will be sectioned off and labeled for each team. The primary warm-up area will be on the Greentree Practice Field, but please note that on Saturdays, this field will not be available for warm-ups until 11:30am. Warm-ups prior to this time will take place on the track. In the event of inclement weather, warm-up space may be available in the Indoor Practice Facility (IPF), pending availability.

PARKING/DROP-OFF

Please refer to the map below for team drop-off and parking locations. Team drop-off will be located along San Amaro Drive (blue rectangle). Team van parking will be available in Lot 604 between Cobb Stadium and San Amaro Drive (green rectangle), with a limited number of spaces reserved per team. If van parking is needed, please indicate this on the **Visiting Team Questionnaire** on page 13. The bus parking location is TBD.

DIRECTIONS/MAP

FROM MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT


Take Exit marked Coral Gables/Le Jeune Road. Exit onto Le Jeune and head south. Turn right onto Ponce de Leon Blvd (just before the Metrorail). Go 1.7 miles and turn right onto San Amaro Drive (Hurricane Drive). Cobb Stadium is located about a quarter of a mile down on San Amaro Drive.

FROM THE NORTH

Take US-1 (South Dixie Hwy) south and take a right on S Alhambra Circle (under the metro rail). At the light, take a left onto Ponce de Leon Blvd. At the following light, turn right onto San Amaro Drive (Hurricane Drive). Cobb Stadium is located about a quarter of a mile down on San Amaro Drive.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take US-1 (South Dixie Hwy) north and take a left on S Alhambra Circle (under the metro rail). At the light, take a left onto Ponce de Leon Blvd. At the following light, turn right onto San Amaro Drive (Hurricane Drive). Cobb Stadium is located about a quarter of a mile down on San Amaro Drive.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

IN THE EVENT OF HEAVY RAIN:

1. If heavy rain prevents competition on the field, the head meet official, or UM Director of Track and Field will call for a delay in the meet. NOTE: A delay to the start of the meet will be made by the UM Director of Track and Field.
2. Should heavy rains continue with little sign of letup, it is up to the discretion of the head meet official and/or Director of Track and Field to wait to resume, reschedule, or cancel the meet.
3. A decision will be made by the head meet official, coaches, and game manager.

IN THE EVENT OF LIGHTNING:

1. Lightning will be monitored from the track using the Weather Sentry Lightning Detection and Monitoring System, contracted by the NCAA.
2. When there is lightning activity detected by Weather Sentry within a 15-mile radius of the track, the event manager will notify coaches, sport administrators, and officials.
3. When there is lightning detected by Weather Sentry within an 8-mile radius of the track, the meet will be stopped immediately. All athletes, coaches, officials, and staff will exit the field and take shelter inside.
 1. Teams will be escorted to the Knight Gym or their team bus
 2. Officials and staff will be escorted to the Knight Gym
 3. Fans will be directed to leave their seats and find shelter in their cars
4. When lightning is no longer within an 8-mile radius of the track and it has been 30 minutes since the last detection, the event manager will give out an "all clear." The meet will resume based on what was decided by the head coaches, sport administrator, event manager, and head official.
