ABOUT LAST GAME...

- Tre Donaldson scored a career-high 32 points to lead Miami men's basketball to a 67-66 victory over Virginia Tech on Tuesday inside the Watsco Center.
- Donaldson was 13-of-24 from field including the game-winning free throw with 12 seconds remaining.
- He scored 24 of Miami's 36 points in the second half including the last 15.
- Dante Allen added 10 points and five rebounds while Ernest Udeh Jr. added a game-high nine rebounds.
- Miami won the battle in the paint, 42-34, and out rebounded the Hokies, 33-31.

OFFENSE CLICKING

- Miami has been efficient with their offense, leading the league in field goal percentage (50.5) and free throw attempts per game (23.1) and is third in fastbreak points (12.1) and rebound margin (8.5).
- Tre Donaldson facilitates the offense with a team-high 153 assists and ranks fourth in the ACC and is 27th nationally in the category.
- Shelton Henderson ranks third in the conference in field goal percentage at 59.1%, which ranks in the top 35 nationally and is first in the country among all freshmen.

SETTING THE SCENE

- Saturday's contest is the 31st meeting all-time between the two teams with Virginia holding a 17-13 advantage.
- Virginia has won eight of the last nine meetings dating back to 2018.
- Miami is looking for its first win in Charlottesville since Feb. 20, 2017, when the Hurricanes defeated the Cavaliers, 54-48, in overtime.

JAI LUCAS ERA

- In his first season as a head coach, Jai Lucas has engineered one of the nation's biggest turnarounds. Miami, which won seven games last season (3 ACC wins), is 21-5 overall and 10-3 in ACC play under Lucas.
- The 14-win differential ranks as the largest turnaround in Division I this season.
- With his 20th win, Lucas became the fastest first-time head coach in the ACC to reach 20 victories since Bill Guthridge in 1997-98. Lucas reached the mark in 25 games, the second-fewest in ACC history.

- A lifelong student of the game, Lucas credits his father, John Lucas II, as one who gave him his basketball foundation.
- Following his playing career, he refined his coaching skills by working for legendary coaches such as Rick Barnes (intensity), Shaka Smart (how to be a head coach), John Calipari (brutal honesty) and Jon Scheyer (how to build a program as a first-time head coach).
- Lucas has quickly entered the Coach of the Year conversation, leading Miami to its best ACC start since 2015-16, when the Hurricanes opened league play 10-3.

RENEAU-ING HIS GAME

- Malik Reneau has been one of Miami's most consistent offensive weapons, reaching the 20-point mark 15 times this season, including five of the last seven games.
- A Karl Malone Award Midseason Watch List selection, presented annually to the nation's top power forward, Reneau has produced five performances of at least 20 points and 10 rebounds.
- Reneau scored a game-high 26 points on 12-of-19 shooting with six rebounds as the Hurricanes rallied to win at NC State.
- In the win over No. 11 North Carolina, Reneau recorded his seventh double-double of the season as he added 16 points and 10 rebounds.
- He posted back-to-back 20-point games and recorded his sixth double-double of the season in the road win at Syracuse, finishing with 20 points and 11 rebounds.
- In Miami's ACC opener against Pitt, Reneau poured in a game-high 28 points on 8-of-13 shooting and went a perfect 10-for-10 at the free-throw line, becoming the first Hurricane to shoot 100% from the stripe with a minimum of 10 attempts since Jordan Miller in 2023.
- Reneau stuffed the stat sheet in the win at Notre Dame, totaling 17 points, 10 rebounds, and a season-high five steals.
- The Miami native opened the season with 20 points against Jacksonville while shooting 10-of-12 at the line, then followed with a 22-point outing versus Bethune-Cookman.
- He has logged multiple 22-point performances, including double-doubles against Stetson (22 pts, 10 reb) and No. 10 Florida (22 pts, 11 reb), and added 24 points on a perfect 10-of-10 shooting night with 10 rebounds against Delaware State.
- Reneau added 23 points on 8-of-14 shooting and knocked down all three of his attempts from beyond the arc in the win over Georgetown, scoring 19 of his 23 points in the first half.
- In the victory over ULM, he finished with 22 points on 10-of-15 shooting and pulled down 10 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the year.
- Reneau transferred to Miami after spending three seasons at Indiana, earning All-Big Ten honorable mention recognition in both 2024 and 2025.



DIME DONALDSON

▪ Tre Donaldson returned to his home state for his final collegiate season, transferring to Miami from Michigan, and has made an immediate impact for the Hurricanes, ranking second on the team in scoring at 16.4 points per game and reaching double figures in 25 contests.

▪ A Tallahassee native, Donaldson arrived at Miami with a focus on elevating his playmaking and now leads the team with 153 assists. His 2.73 assist-to-turnover ratio ranks third in the ACC.

▪ Donaldson is coming off a career-performance where he scored a career-high 32 points against Virginia Tech, scoring Miami's last 15 points and 24 of the Hurricanes' 36 points in the second half.

▪ Donaldson has posted five double-doubles featuring points and assists, most recently turning in a career performance against Georgia Tech with 27 points and 10 assists.

▪ His other point-assist double-doubles include 10 points and 12 assists versus FIU, 18 points with a career-high 12 assists against ULM, 12 points and 11 assists against Southern Miss, and his first career points-assists double-double in the win over Stetson (15 points, 10 assists).

▪ A year ago, Donaldson helped the Wolverines to the Big Ten Tournament title and was one of four players to start all 37 games. Last season, he averaged 11.3 points, 4.1 assists and 3.5 rebounds per game and had 26 games in which he scored 10-or-more points.

▪ Donaldson comes from an athletic family as his mother, Stacie Symonds, was a standout softball player and Florida State and was recently inducted into the USSSA Hall of Fame.

▪ His father, Rhodney Donaldson, is a member of the Troy University Athletics Hall of Fame and was drafted by the Florida Marlins in the 1997 MLB Draft.

COMING OUT OF HIS 'SHEL'

▪ In a season that has showcased immense freshmen talent, Shelton Henderson stands with the best in the country as the forward is averaging 14.3 points and 4.9 rebounds per game this season while shooting 59.1% from the floor.

▪ His field goal percentage is third in the ACC and 31st

nationally. Among all freshmen, Henderson ranks first in the country.

▪ Henderson has emerged as a top scoring threat in ACC play as he is the team's third-leading scorer at 14.9 points to go along with 5.7 rebounds.

▪ Henderson came to Miami with lofty expectations as he was rated as the fourth-highest recruit in program history by 247Sports Composite.

▪ Henderson tied the school's freshman record for points in a game with a career-high 30 in the win over FIU, shooting an ultra-efficient 10-of-12 from the field and 10-of-11 from the free-throw line.

▪ He followed that performance with 20 points on 7-of-9 shooting in the win over UNF, adding five rebounds.

▪ The freshman has scored in double figures 16 times this season, including a conference-high 22 points at No. 22 Clemson.

▪ Henderson also turned in his most complete performance of the season at Ole Miss, posting season highs in points (18) and assists (5) while tying his season high with nine rebounds.

▪ A Houston native that attended the same high school as Coach Jai Lucas, Bellaire, Henderson was named the Houston Chronicle All-Great Houston Player of the Year.

▪ Henderson was a five-star recruit and was ranked as the No. 14 overall recruit by 247Sports. He earned a composite ranking of 0.9920.

▪ Henderson is the nephew of Pro Football Hall of Famer Eric Dickerson and his grandfather, Elmer Seals, and cousin, Ricky Seals-Jones, also played in the NFL.

PAINT PATROL

▪ Ernest Udeh Jr. has anchored Miami's interior presence and was recently named to the Naismith Basketball Defensive Player of the Year Watch List.

- Udeh has been dominant on the boards, ranking second in the ACC at 9.5 rebounds per game, a figure that ranks 23rd nationally.
- Udeh had his best game of the season in the win over No. 11 North Carolina as he fifth double-double of the season with 15 points and 10 rebounds on 7-of-8 shooting.
- The senior made an immediate impact in his Miami debut, opening the season with a 14-point, 14-rebound double-double against Jacksonville.
- He followed that effort with his second double-double of the season against ULM, finishing with 14 points and a season-high 15 rebounds.
- In conference play, Udeh is averaging 9.2 rebounds and 6.8 points per game, highlighted by double-doubles against Wake Forest (10 pts, 13 reb) and Georgia Tech (13 pts, 15 reb) and North Carolina (15 pts, 10 reb).
- According to KenPom, Udeh owns the nation's top jump-ball rating and has compiled a 69-17 career record in tip-offs, including a 19-4 mark this season.
- Udeh has shown marked improvement at the free-throw line, shooting 69.2 percent (18-of-26) in ACC play after converting just 34.4 percent (11-of-32) during non-conference action.

AMONG THE BEST IN THE GAME

- Miami men's basketball associate head coaches Erik Pastrana and Charlton 'C.Y.' Young were named to the 100 Most Impactful High Major Assistant Coaches by Silver Waves Media.

- Pastrana, who was instrumental in Oklahoma State signing the No. 4 recruiting class in 2020, served as the head coach at Daytona State College and compiled a 19-12 record. Four of his players were named to the Mid-Florida All-Conference Team.
- A staple in city's basketball community Young played high school at Carol City before playing collegiately at Georgia Southern where he ranks 14th all-time in program history in career points and still holds the school's 3-point field goal percentage record, shooting 40.9 percent in his four-year career. Young spent four seasons as the Eagles head coach and helped Georgia Southern to a second-place finish in his third season.

CULTURE OF DEVELOPMENT

- Lucas's first coaching staff also features a wealth of experience in assistant coaches Andrew Moran and Russell Springmann.
- Moran, who was named the 2025 Naismith National High School boys basketball coach of the year, comes to The U after serving as the head coach at Miami's Christopher Columbus High School for the past six years where he led the Explorers to four state championships and a 145-34 record.
- Springmann brings over 20 years of coaching experience to the Miami program having progressively moved up the ranks from being a graduate assistant at Florida in 1996 to the head coach at Oral Roberts the past two seasons.

HEAD COACH JAI LUCAS

Jai Lucas was named the 14th head coach of the University of Miami men's basketball program on March 6, 2024.

Lucas took over the reins of the Miami men's basketball program after spending the past three seasons at Duke, where he served as an assistant coach for one campaign before being elevated to associate head coach in 2023.

One of the nation's most respected assistant coaches and recruiters, Lucas has spent 12 overall seasons on the staffs at Duke, Kentucky and Texas, helping those programs to seven NCAA Tournament appearances.

While at Duke, Lucas played a pivotal role in helping the Blue Devils secure the nation's top recruiting class in both 2024 and 2025. As associate head coach, he served as the program's defensive coordinator. The Blue Devils finished the 2024-25 season ranked seventh in the nation in scoring defense (62.8 points per game) and fourth nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.4). KenPom rated Duke as the fifth-best defense in the country with an adjusted defense efficiency rating of 90.8.

In 2023-24, Duke's defense held opponents to 66.3 points per game, which ranked 28th nationally and second in the ACC, while the team posted records of 27-9 overall and 15-5 in conference to advance to the NCAA Elite Eight. In Lucas' first season in Durham, the Blue Devils yielded just 63.6 points per game, a .406 field goal percentage and .305 three-point percentage – each top 30 nationally and each top two in the ACC, en route to capturing the ACC Tournament championship.

Before arriving in Durham, Lucas was on staff at Kentucky for two seasons, joining the Wildcats as recruiting coordinator in August 2020 before a promotion to assistant coach/recruiting coordinator for the 2020-21 season. In two seasons in Lexington, he helped UK sign five players who played in either the McDonald's All-American or Jordan Brand Classic games and was instrumental in landing three student-athletes ranked in ESPN 100's class of 2021 rankings and two in the 2002 class.

Lucas began his coaching career at his alma mater Texas, where he spent seven seasons on staff. The Houston native began as a special assistant with the program from 2013-15 before serving as director of basketball operations in the 2015-16 season. He was promoted to assistant coach in June 2016 and, in his first year, helped the Longhorns win 20 games and earn a spot in the NCAA Tournament.

In his first two recruiting cycles as an assistant coach, Lucas helped the Longhorns ink two Top-10 signing classes. The 2017 class was rated No. 5 nationally by Rivals while the 2018 class was tapped No. 8 in the country by ESPN and 247Sports. His debut season as an assistant also helped spark a three-year streak in which a Texas freshman was selected in the first round of the NBA Draft -- Jarrett Allen (No. 22 to Brooklyn in 2017), Mohamed Bamba (No. 6 to Orlando in 2018) and Jaxson Hayes (No. 8 to Atlanta in 2019). was named before going No. 8 overall in 2019. The selection of Hayes -- the Big 12 Freshman of the Year -- meant Texas joined Duke and Kentucky as the only programs with a lottery pick in consecutive drafts.

Lucas played two seasons at Texas, helping the Longhorns earn back-to-back NCAA Tournament bids. He played at Florida as a freshman in 2007-08 and was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team. Lucas later spent three seasons in the professional ranks, including one in Latvia with BK Valmiera of the Baltic Basketball League (2011-12) and two in the NBA Development League with the Idaho Stampede (2012-13) and Canton Charge (2013).

Lucas was a McDonald's All-American, a Jordan Brand Classic selection and a Parade All-America Second Team honoree as a senior at Bellaire (TX) High School in the Houston area. He started for three seasons and was a three-time District Player of the Year while leading Bellaire to three consecutive district titles.

Lucas graduated from Texas in 2011 with a degree in corporate communication. He and his wife Kori have two sons, Jaxin and Kalib, and he has a son, Xavier. His father, John II, is a former head coach of the San Antonio Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Cleveland Cavaliers who most recently served as an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets. The elder Lucas played 14 seasons in the NBA after earning All-America honors in both basketball and tennis at Maryland.


