This is just the second-ever meeting between the two programs with Cal winning the sole previous matchup, 82-63, last season on March 2, 2025 at Haas Pavilion.

Entering the week, Cal is 1 of 33 schools in the country to have played at least nine Quad 1 games this season. The Bears have been competitive in each of those contests with the average margin of defeat at 8.5 points with three losses at four points or less.

Going back to the 2024-25 season, Cal is 27-4 overall at home. Going back to the 2023-24 season, Cal has won 19 straight nonconference regular season games.

The Bears are coming off their best season under Smith in which they:

- Earned an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2018-19.
- Won 25 games for the first time since 2012-13.
- Maintained an Associated Press Top 25 ranking for eight straight weeks (going as high as No. 18).
- Set a program record for home wins in a season (16), going 16-1 at Haas Pavilion.
- Set a program record for 3-pointers in a season (297).
- Defeated multiple ranked teams.
- Advanced to the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament.

Cal has registered five wins against teams from the 2025 NCAA Tournament with wins over Florida State, Georgia Tech, Notre Dame, Grand Canyon and Harvard.

On Feb. 10, Gisella Maul received USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week honors after back-to-back double-doubles in wins at Georgia Tech and Pitt.

On Nov. 17, Morris was named the ACC's Rookie of the Week after helping power Cal to a 3-0 week. For the week, she averaged 9.7 points and 4.3 rebounds per game while leading the team with 13 assists and seven 3-pointers.

HEAD COACH CHARMIN SMITH



Charmin Smith is an award-winning coach, former professional player, and active board member who has dedicated her career to progressing equity and opportunity. The true definition of a trailblazer, Smith is the first-ever Black Head Coach for the Cal women's basketball program and is on a mission to leverage her platform to lead societal change through sports.

Fresh off her best season as head coach at Cal, Smith signed a new five-year contract in the spring of 2025 that will retain her through the 2029-30 season.

In her sixth year as head coach in 2024-25 Smith guided the Golden Bears to their first NCAA Tournament appearance (earning an at-large bid as an eight seed) since 2018-19, their first 25-win season which mark the most since the 2012-13 season and Cal's first AP Top 25 ranking since the 2018-19 season coming in as high as No. 18. That season also saw the Bears break the program record for home wins (16) and 3-pointers in a season (297), earn multiple victories over nationally-ranked opponents (No.19 Alabama and No. 21 NC State) resulting in the team being named the NCAA's Team of the Week and complete their first sweep of Stanford since the 1985-86 season. For the second straight year, Smith also signed a Top 25 (ESPN) recruiting class that features Cal's first McDonald's All-American since Kristine Anigwe (2015) in No. 20 ranked Puff Morris and No.70 ranked Taylor Barnes.

In her fifth year as head coach in 2023-24, the Bears won their most overall (19) and conference (seven) games since the 2018-19 season. Smith also guided Cal into the postseason as the Bears earned an at-large bid and a No. 2 seed in the inaugural NCAA Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament. Under Smith's guidance that season, the team also had its first weekend home and road sweeps of Pac-12 schools (both against Washington and Washington State) since 2018-19, swept Oregon for the first time since 2012-13 and set a program record for 3-pointers (282) in a season. The season sweeps of Oregon, Washington and Washington State marked the first time Cal has swept three different Pac-12 schools since 2017-18. The Bears also advanced to the quarterfinals of that season's Pac-12 Tournament for the first time since 2019-20. Smith was named ESPN's Coach of the Week on Jan. 8 of that season.

Smith's unwavering dedication to empowering players to surpass their potential, her commitment to enhancing the representation of Black individuals in the sport, and her resolute drive to inspire action toward racial justice solidify her position as an influential leader in basketball and beyond.

Regarded as a 2025, 2024 and 2020 Top 100 Most Influential Figures in Women's College Basketball (Silver Waves Media), Smith's legacy at Cal Berkeley—beginning with her transition from Associate Head Coach to Head Coach, highlights her strategic acumen and commitment to player development. Her storied tenure includes a 2013 Final Four appearance and an impressive 10 postseason appearances.

Currently serving on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) board, Smith is renowned for her role as a Board Member and co-chair of the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee. Her dedication extends far beyond the basketball court, as evidenced by her impactful contributions to the Cal Athletics Equity Inclusion and Diversity Task Force and her pivotal role in the Chancellor's Counsel for Students of Color and Multicultural Engagement.

Smith experienced a number of successes in her first year as head coach, leading the Golden Bears to three upsets over higher-ranked opponents. The first came in the form of a 4-point victory over No. 20 Arkansas on November 24 and then a win over No. 13 Arizona on the road in the regular season finale. The Bears completed their second upset in the same week as just four days later, they defeated 5-seeded and No. 22-ranked Arizona State in the opening round of the 2020 Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament in Las Vegas. The win over the Sun Devils made the Golden Bears just the second 12-seed to win a game in the Pac-12 Tournament.

Smith has helped coach the Bears to the top three individual seasons in program history. In her first two years in Berkeley, Cal set then-school records for wins in a season, finishing both years with 27-7 marks before Cal pushed itself into elite status with the record-breaking 32-4 Final Four campaign in 2012-13. The Bears also recorded their best Pac-12 record (17-1) and won their first conference regular-season crown that season. Smith has helped lead the Bears to the postseason in 11 of her 13 seasons and was also part of the staff that led the Bears to the 2010 WNIT championship.

Smith's previous roles at Stanford and Boston College allowed her to build upon impact, leading her teams to multiple NCAA appearances and historic victories. Her experience as a point guard for the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx and Seattle Storm later influenced her time as an Assistant Coach for the New York Liberty.

As a standout player on the Stanford women's basketball team, Smith was a crucial component of the team's three NCAA Final Four Appearances and three Pac-10 Conference Championships between 1995 to 1997. Following her collegiate playing career, Smith joined the professional ranks in the ABL from 1997-98 as a member of the Portland Power and played three years in the WNBA, along with one year in the Swedish Basketball League.

Coupled with her impressive career in basketball, Smith also pursued the challenging discipline of Muay Thai martial arts. As a testament to her relentless spirit, Smith applies the lessons from her passion off the court to her coaching approach on the court.

Her leadership extends to a realm where the core values are honor and discipline, where she embodies the ethos that actions must follow words. And her steadfast commitment and achievements have set her apart to lead the future of sports.

About Miami

Miami is currently 14-12 overall and 6-9 in ACC play and is coming off two straight wins. Led by second-year head coach Tricia Cullopp, the Hurricanes feature three players who average double-figure scoring highlighted by RaShaya Kyle who is averaging a double-double at 16.0 points and 10.1 rebounds per game.

Last time out vs the Hurricanes

It was a special win on a special day as the California women's basketball team honored its graduating class and set a program record earning its 16th home win of the season surpassing the previous record set in 2012-13. The Golden Bears defeated Miami, 82-63, with two of the seniors being honored, Michelle Onyiah and Marta Suarez, posting double doubles. Onyiah had a career-high 26 points, hitting her first 10 shots, to go along with 10 rebounds while Suarez had 16 points and 10 rebounds. It marked Onyiah's 10th and Suarez's fourth double doubles of the season and Onyiah's second-straight 20-point, 10-rebound game.

Ioanna Krimili knocked in three 3-pointers and moved into 10th place on the ACC's all-time single-season top 10 list (94) passing NC State's Aislinn Konig. Lulu Twidale tied her career high with six assists for the second-straight game. Cal shot 50.0% from the floor and 42.9% from deep and had a 39-26 rebounding advantage over the Hurricanes.

Cal went to work inside early, scoring its first eight points in the paint to open the game on an 11-2 run. After a Suarez triple put the Bears up 14-2, the Hurricanes responded with a 6-0 run to get back in the game. Cal however, connected on its last three field goals of the quarter to take a 21-15 lead.

Kayla Williams' second triple of the game put Cal up 26-17 with just over eight minutes to go in the quarter. Onyiah followed up with back-to-back layups to increase the Bears' lead to 11. Suarez gave Cal a 14-point lead after hitting a triple followed by a layup later in the quarter.

In the third quarter, Onyiah was a perfect 10-for-10 from the field when she scored her 20th point of the game with 8:09 to go. Krimili was fouled when she hit her second 3-pointer and converted the four-point play to put Cal up 53-36 with 6:53 to go. Lulu Twidale nailed her second 3-pointer to extend the Bears' lead to 22 with 2:16 to go in the quarter. The Bears never let the lead slip below 19 points from there on out and went up by as many as 26 points when Krimili hit her third 3-pointer with 8:09 left in the game.

**In the 75-62 win at Florida State on Thursday:**

- Lulu Twidale posted her third 30-point game of the season and added a career-high nine rebounds and six assists.
- Twidale scored 25 second-half points and assisted or scored on every field goal in the fourth quarter.
- Mjracle Sheppard filled the stat sheet as well finishing with seven points, six rebounds and six assists.
- Sakima Walker just missed out on a double-double with eight points and 11 rebounds.

**RECENT TRENDS**

- Twidale is just 1 of 2 players in the ACC to rank in the top 10 for scoring (16.0), assists (4.5) and 3-pointers (3.1) per game during conference play.
- Over her last four games, Twidale is averaging 20.8 points, 4.8 assists and 3.8 3-pointers per game.
- During ACC play, Maul is averaging 12.3 points and 7.5 rebounds (leads team) while shooting 47.3% from the field and 42.9% from deep.
- In ACC play, Walker leads the conference in FG% (58.6) and Twidale is tied for the lead in 3PM (47).
- Since Jan. 1, Twidale ranks 3rd in the country in 3-pointers (46).
- Since Jan. 1, Walker is shooting 58.9% from the field, which ranks 15th in the country (min. 100 FGA).
- Since Jan. 1, Maul is the only player in the ACC and 1 of just 21 in the country shooting at least 48% from the field and over 40% from deep (min. 50 3PA). She is also ranks fourth in the ACC (leads all guards) and is 1 of just 28 guards across the country with at least four double-doubles in 2026.
- Since Jan. 1, Maul is 1 of only 4 players in the country to shoot 48% from the field and over 40% from deep (min. 50 3PA) while pulling down at least 100 rebounds.
- Walker has shot over 60% from the field in six of her last eight games while averaging 13.6 points per game during that span.
- During ACC play, Sheppard and Twidale are tied for 7th in the ACC in assists and are 1 of only 2 duos in the league to rank in the top 10.

**FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY**

- Twidale led the ACC in 3PM (28) and was fifth in assists (43). She and Virginia's Kymora Johnson were the only two players in the ACC to rank in the top five for January.
- Twidale ranked 7th in 3PM and 37th in assists for January.
- Sheppard ranked 7th in the ACC in assists (41). She and Twidale were 1 of only 2 duos in the ACC to rank in the top 10.

**INSIDE TWIDALE'S PERFORMANCE AT FLORIDA STATE**

- Marked her third 30-point game on the road - leads the ACC and ranks 2nd nationally.
- Twidale ranks second in the ACC and 15th nationally with her three 30-point games this season.
- She is 1 of only 8 players to post a 30-9-6 game this season and 1 of 4 to do it with five 3-pointers.

**INSIDE MAUL'S WEEK AT GEORGIA TECH AND PITT**

For the week:

- Averaged 18.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 3-pointers
- Posted back-to-back double-doubles and shot 56.5% from the field and 50.0% from deep for the week.
- **Was the only player in the ACC and 1 of 2 on the country to shoot over 50% from the field and deep (min. 10 attempts) while grabbing at least 20 rebounds.**
- Nine of her 24 rebounds for the week came on the offensive end.
- Only guard in the ACC and 1 of 3 players overall to record two double-doubles for the week.

At Georgia Tech:

- She took over the game in the fourth quarter finishing with 10 clutch points in the quarter.
- On four separate occasions in the fourth quarter, Georgia Tech cut the Bears' lead to one possession and each time Maul answered with a 2 or 3-pointer to prevent the Yellow Jackets from taking the lead including a baseline jumper with 35 seconds left to put Cal up by five.

**INSIDE TWIDALE'S PERFORMANCE AT PITT**

- Twidale became just the second player in the country this year with multiple games with at least 30 points and seven assists joining Hannah Hidalgo (Notre Dame) and Mikayla Blakes (Vanderbilt).
- She is now the only player in the country to have not only one but two games with at least 30 points, seven assists and seven triples.
- She became just the fifth player in Cal history to have two 30-point games in a season and just the fourth ACC player this season.

**INSIDE TWIDALE'S WEEK AT SYRACUSE AND BOSTON COLLEGE**

For the week:

- Led the ACC in points (52), assists (21) and 3-pointers (12).
- **Led the country in assists.**
- **Was 2nd in the country in 3-pointers.**
- **Was 7th in the country in points.**
- **Only player in the country to rank in Top 10 across all three categories.**
- Averaged a double-double at 26.0 points and 10.5 assists and 6.0 3-pointers.
- Was 1 of only 4 players in the country to have 12 assists in a game.
- Was 1 of only 2 players in the country to average 10+ points and 10+ assists.

At Boston College:

- Became the only other player in the NCAA not named Caitlin Clark (4 times) to post 36 points, eight 3-pointers and nine assists in a game (since at least 2002-03 according to Stathead)
- The eight 3-pointers were second most in a game in program history (Asha Thomas 9 vs Manhattan on Nov. 24, 2017), the second most by an ACC player this season and tied for the seventh most in ACC history.
- The 36 points were the most by a Cal player since 2018 (Kristine Anigwe 37 vs Houston on Nov. 6).
- Lulu became just the fifth player in program history to score at least 36 points in a game.

At Syracuse:

- Posted first career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 12 assists along with four triples for second consecutive game.
- Became just the fifth ACC player to have 12 assists in a game this season.
- Became just the seventh player in Cal history with 12 assists in a game.
- Nailed two crucial 3-pointers in the final 21 seconds of the first overtime (including one with .3 seconds left) to force double-overtime.

- Has scored in double figures seven times which ranks 6th on the team.
- Her 25 points at Syracuse is tied for 2nd highest single-game total on the team.
- Has led the team in rebounding in two games.
- Has been one of the most efficient players in the country off the bench. For players averaging 13.0 minutes per game or less, she leads the country in scoring and is 22nd in rebounding (3.3). (Min. 20 games played)
- After just two seasons at Cal, Twidale is already third on the program's all-time career list for 3-pointers (209). She is just 25 career triples away from tying for first all-time at Cal.

- Mjracle Sheppard has had at least two steals in six of the last eight and in 15 of 27 games overall this year which includes a five-steal game against Charlotte.
- **1,000-point club** - Twidale became the 29th player in Cal history to reach 1,000 career points after scoring 32 points at Pitt on Feb. 8.
- Cal is 1 of 2 teams in the NCAA (Virginia) to have three players who have recorded 10 or more assists in a game: Twidale (12), Morris (12), Sheppard (10).
- Barnes became just the fifth rookie in the ACC to have recorded a double-double (15 points, 11 rebounds at NC State) and the first Cal freshman to do so since 2021 (Michelle Onyiah and Dalayah Daniels).
- Barnes' 202 points are ranked 5th in the ACC among all rookies and she ranks 4th in rebounds (120), 5th in 3-pointers (23) and 10th in assists (35). **She also ranks in the top 10 in steals and blocks making her the only freshman in the conference to rank in the top 10 across all six categories. (Prior to Injury)**
- The Bears have held 12 of 16 power 4 opponents to under their season scoring average and all four ranked opponents to an average of 9.0 points below their average.
- Morris is one of just 31 players overall and three freshmen (Aubrey Galvan, Vanderbilt; Caliyah DeVillasee, Cincinnati) in the country to have had 12 assists in a game this season.
- Barnes and Morris are off to a great start to their career at Cal. They have both posted 17 points in a game this season making them one of four freshman duos (Milan Brown, Caitlyn Jones/Wake Forest; Jocelyne Grier, Amirah Anderson/Boston College; Gal Raviv/Meredith Tippner) in the ACC to have reached that total in a game.
- Barnes and Morris are also two of just 23 freshmen in the nation and three in the ACC to have at least 17 points, five rebounds and five assists in a game.
- **Morris is one of only three rookies in the NCAA and one of just seven players in the ACC (list includes Hannah Hidalgo and Zoe Brooks) to have at least 17 points, eight rebounds and six assists in a game this season.** When you add in the five 3-pointers, she is the only player in the ACC and only freshman in Cal program history to have that stat line in a game.
- Prior to injury, Morris' 52 assists this season were second in the ACC and her 21 3-pointers ranked second among freshmen. **Nationally she was one of only five freshmen in the country to rank in the top 21 in both categories among all rookies.**
- **Barnes and Morris are the only freshmen duo in the ACC to rank in the top 10 among all rookies in the conference in points, 3-pointers, rebounds and assists (prior to Morris and Barnes Injury).**
- Twidale is one of 38 players in the country and four in the ACC with at least seven games with four or more made 3-pointers this season.
- Sakima Walker had blocked at least two shots in 14 of 28 games this year including a stretch of eight straight and ranks third in the ACC with 40 blocks. **Since the Harvard game on Nov. 16 she has totaled 40 blocks which is 33rd in the country.**
- Walker has also shot over 50% from the field in all but three games this season and her 56.7% clip ranks second in the ACC.
- The 63.8 points per game given up are the fewest under Charmin Smith and 11th fewest in program history dating back to the 1981-82 season. The last time Cal's scoring defense averaged 64.0 points or fewer was the 2014-15 season (62.6).
- Cal has now had at least 20 assists in six games this season, beating last year's season total of four such games.
- Cal's streak of 19 straight regular season nonconference win at Haas Pavilion is second best in program history after winning 32 straight between the 2002-03 to 2008-09 seasons.
- Twidale returns as the ACC's top 3-point shooter after she finished the 2024-25 season ranked first in the conference in 3-point percentage (38.2) and second in triples made (94) - behind former teammate Ioanna Krimili who made 97.

- Twidale's 94 triples rank second on Cal's all-time single season list and was the second highest total among all sophomores in the country last year and 13th overall.
- Last season Twidale sixth in the NCAA for games with 3+ 3-pointers (20) and posted five 20-point games.
- Twidale took a significant step from her 2023-24 freshman season to last year:
  - PTS: 6.3 --> 13.2
  - 3PTM: 41 --> 94
  - Rebounds: 1.4 --> 3.3
  - 20+ point games: 3 --> 5
  - Games w/ 3+ 3-pointers: 6 --> 20
- Cal welcomed its second-consecutive Top 25 (ESPN) recruiting class that features two ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 players in McDonald's All-American Aliyahna "Puff" Morris (No. 24) and Taylor Barnes (No. 70) along with Grace McCallop and Isis Johnson-Musah.
- Morris is Cal's first McDonald's All-American since Kristine Anigwe (2015).
- Last season the Bears finished among the NCAA's best in several categories:
  - Total 3-pointers made - 14th (297)
  - 3-point makes per game - 16th (8.9)
  - Field goal percentage - 31st (45.8)
  - 3-point percentage - 35th (35.2)
  - Scoring - 53rd (73.7)
