SYRACUSE NEWS AND NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

Syracuse women's basketball dominated Georgia Tech 94-70 on Thursday, January 29, at the JMA Wireless Dome, improving to 17-4 overall and 7-3 in ACC play.

Laila Phelia led the offensive charge with 23 points on efficient 9-of-13 shooting, including three three-pointers. Dominique Darius delivered a stellar all-around performance with 20 points and eight made free throws, while Uche Izoje added 17 points and grabbed a game-high 15 rebounds for her dominant presence in the paint.

Sophie Burrows contributed eight points with perfect shooting, and the Orange bench provided valuable production throughout the contest.

Syracuse shot an impressive 52.9% from the field and 66.7% from beyond the arc, while holding Georgia Tech to just 43.6% shooting.

The Orange controlled the game from start to finish, never trailing and leading by as many as 29 points in the fourth quarter before a crowd of 2,350.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP

Miami leads the all-time series 22-15 and holds a 12-6 advantage over the Orange in Coral Gables. Despite the Hurricanes holding a significant advantage in the series, the Orange have won five of the last six meetings including all three since Head Coach Felisha Legette-Jack took over the program.

Syracuse looks for its fourth-straight win over UM on Sunday at 2 p.m. in the Watsco Center.

GO-TO TEAM

Coach Jack prides herself on not having a "go-to" player but having a "go-to" team. The Orange have had nine games this season where four-or-more players have tallied double figures in scoring. Most recently, the Orange completed this feat against Stanford with Dominique Darius (26), Uche Izoje (12), Sophie Burrows (11) and Shy Hawkins (10) all scoring in double figures.

DOM-INATING DARIUS

Syracuse graduate student Dominique Darius was named the USBWA National Player of the Week on Jan. 21, becoming the first Orange to earn this recognition since Dyaisha Fair in January 2024. Darius averaged 22.5 ppg over a 2-0 week for the Orange that including hitting the game-winning shot in triple overtime against Cal and scoring a career-high 26 points against Stanford the following game.

EVERYBODY EATS

Syracuse had four players score 18+ points for the first time since Feb. 19, 2017 in SU's 3OT thriller vs. Cal (1/15). Uche Izoje led the way with 22 points while captains Sophie Burrows, Dominique Darius and Laila Phelia added 21, 19 and 18, respectively.

Brittney Sykes (19), Alexis Peterson (19), Gabrielle Cooper (18) and Briana Day (18) were the last Orange quartet to complete the feat.

CLEANING THE GLASS

The Orange averaging an ACC best 17.6 offensive rebounds per game, fifth-best in the country. Syracuse is 16th in Division I in rebounds per game (43.0) and is fourth in the ACC.

The Orange have had six games 55+ rebounds this season, most recently grabbing a season-high 57 boards against Cal (1/15).

DEFEND THE DOME

Syracuse is off to another hot start at the JMA Wireless Dome this season. The Orange are 13-2 at home and finished non-conference play unbeaten at the JMA Wireless Dome (9-0). Syracuse is 50-16 at home during Legette-Jack's tenure with the Orange.

BRACKETOLOGY

Syracuse broke into ESPN Bracketologist Charlie Creme's 2026 NCAA Tournament Bracketology on Dec. 16 as one of the last four teams in the current 68-team field.

In Creme's latest bracketology (Jan. 30), he has the Orange as an 8-seed facing 9-seed Oregon in Austin, Texas.

Creme has nine ACC teams in the field of 68 currently -- third-most among Power conferences. The Big Ten has 12 teams while the SEC has 11 and the Big 12 has eight.

The ACC has four "bubble teams" -- Virginia Tech and Clemson are currently two of the last four in while Virginia and Miami are on the outside looking in.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR THE ROOKIE

Uche Izoje became the first Syracuse freshman to collect USBWA National Freshman of the Week in program history on Jan. 6. The 6-foot-3 rookie collected back-to-back double doubles in a 2-0 week for the Orange in which she averaged 19.5 points and 14.5 rebounds while adding 3.0 blocks per game. She shot 73% from the field over the course of the week en route to earning the national award.

ORANGE PICKED 13TH IN THE ACC

Syracuse was picked to finish 13th in the ACC Preseason Poll. Duke was picked as the ACC Preseason favorite while SU was projected 13th ahead of SMU, Georgia Tech, Pittsburgh, Boston College and Wake Forest.

Syracuse currently sits 7-3 entering Sunday's matchup with Miami (4-6) and is fourth in the ACC standings.

ONE OF ONE

Uche Izoje became the first freshman to record a 20/10/5 game in points, rebounds and blocks since UConn's Sara Strong in the 2025 NCAA Tournament First Round with her 22 points, 13 rebounds and 5 blocks in the Orange's triple overtime win against Cal.

Izoje is the only freshman in the country putting up the numbers she has. With a team-best 10 double doubles, she is the only freshman in the country averaging 14.6 points, 9.3 rebounds and 2.9 blocks per game. She is fifth in the country in blocks per game and total blocks with (60)

The six-time ACC Rookie of the Week is top-5 in the ACC in field goal percentage (4th) and rebounds per game (4th) while leading the league in blocks per game.

THE FELISHA LEGETTE-JACK RADIO SHOW

The Felisha Legette-Jack Radio Show, presented by Wegmans, made its season debut on Jan. 19, at the Wegmans Burger Bar in DeWitt at 7 p.m.

Hosted by Tim Leonard, the voice of Syracuse Women's Basketball, the weekly program will feature head coach Felisha Legette-Jack reviewing recent games and previewing upcoming matchups throughout the season. The show will broadcast live in the Syracuse area on the flagship station of Syracuse Women's Basketball, ESPN 97.7/100.1 FM, and is also available on the Varsity Network app.

Fans are encouraged to attend the show in person at the Wegmans Burger Bar, where they will have the opportunity to win prizes including tickets to upcoming home games and meet Coach Legette-Jack and her staff.

The six-episode season of The Felisha Legette-Jack Radio Show begins Monday, Jan. 19 and runs through February 23.

ORANGE IN THE NET RANKINGS

Syracuse currently is ranked #41 in the NET rankings. The Orange have ranked as high as No. 39 in the NET this season and currently have the 9th-best NET among ACC programs.

TRIPLE OVERTIME THRILLER

Syracuse's triple overtime thriller against Cal was the first triple overtime game for Syracuse since 2013 and first triple overtime win since 1998 against Villanova. It was also the first triple overtime ACC game since Jan. 10, 2016 (Pitt vs. NCSU).

OH SCHMITT! SHE'S GOING TO NEWHOUSE

Syracuse sophomore Olivia Schmitt was accepted into the S.I. Newhouse School of Public Communications prior to the start of the spring semester. Schmitt posted a 3.93 semester last fall and earned acceptance into SU's prestigious communications school.

Schmitt has a strong following on social media and enjoys being a novice creator documenting her life as a student-athlete at Syracuse. She's had several of her posts go viral this season, showcasing her and her teammates bond off the court.

CELEBRATING A LIVING LEGEND

Syracuse University Athletics will honor pioneering marathoner and Syracuse graduate Kathrine Switzer '68, G'72 at halftime of the women's basketball game on Sunday, Feb. 8, vs. Louisville. As part of National Girls & Women in Sports Day, Switzer's historic 261 bib will be permanently hung in the JMA Wireless Dome rafters.

In 1967, Switzer became the first woman to officially compete in the Boston Marathon, courageously persisting despite attempts by race officials to physically remove her. Though women's cross country and track programs didn't exist at Syracuse during her time as a student, she trained alongside the men's team, demonstrating the pioneering spirit that defined her historic run.

FOCUSED ON ACADEMICS

Syracuse had a 3.362 grade point average for the Fall 2025 semester. The Orange had seven athletes earn a 3.5 or higher while two earned perfect 4.0s.

FOUR-HUNDRED

Syracuse's season opener made a special milestone for Orange head coach Felisha Legette-Jack. She became one of four active ACC head coaches with 400 career wins joining NC State's Wes Moore, Miami's Tricia Cullop, and Louisville's Jeff Walz.

AUSSIE AUSSIE AUSSIE!

Syracuse continues its Australian connection with junior Sophie Burrows and sophomore Maddy Potts on the roster. Legette-Jack has had at least one Aussie on the roster for each of her four seasons as head coach at Syracuse.

ACC ROOKIE OF THE YEAR CANDIDATE

Uche Izoje has emerged as a top candidate for ACC Rookie of the Year -- having collected six ACC Rookie of the Week honors just 13 weeks into the season, most recently on Monday, Jan. 26.

Izoje collected her program record fifth ACC Rookie of the Week award on Jan. 19 after helping the Orange sweep Cal and Stanford with a pair of double doubles.

Uche Izoje won back-to-back ACC Rookie of the Week awards on Dec. 1 & Dec. 8, and claimed her third ACC Rookie of the Week honor on Dec. 21, for averaging 17.5 points and 12.5 rebounds while adding 1.5 assists and 3.0 blocks. She shot 69.6% from the field going 16-for-23 over the course of the 2-0 week for SU.

On Dec. 1 she was named the ACC Rookie of the Week, becoming the first ACC Rookie of the Week for the Orange since the 2020-21 season. She had 20 points, 9 rebounds and 7 blocks in SU's lone win of the week over Howard becoming the first ACC Rookie to put up that stat line in a game since Syracuse's Kamilla Cardoso did so in 2020 against Lincoln.

She averaged 10.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 6.5 blocks per game over a 2-0 week for the Orange including a 8-block performance against SMU in the ACC opener to claim her second ROTW award on Dec. 8.

TOP TRANSFER JOINS THE ORANGE

Laila Phelia was one of the biggest transfer portal snags for Felisha Legette-Jack and her staff this offseason. Phelia, a 2x All-Big Ten honoree at Michigan from 2022-24, was recognized as one of the top transfers into the ACC by On3 earlier this month. Phelia helped Michigan to three NCAA Tournaments including the programs first NCAA Elite Eight in 2022. She transferred to Texas prior to the 2024-25 season but only played in eight games of Texas's Final Four season due to an injuring (eye) cutting her season short. Phelia underwent a second eye procedure to correct complications from a previously detached retina in the winter and received a medical redshirt. She was named to the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Shooting Guard of the Year Preseason Watch List ahead of the 2025-26 season.

FOOTBALL DADS

Sophomore Keira Scott and graduate student Dominique Darius are the daughters of former Syracuse Football players George Scott and Donovan Darius. Darius was an all-american for the Orange from and was drafted 25th overall in the 1998 NFL Draft. Darius went on to play 10 seasons in the NFL for the Jacksonville Jaguars. Scott redshirted in 1998 and played in 1999 for the Orange appearing in all 11 games.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN!

Syracuse players selected three captains for the 2025-26 season, Sophie Burrows, Dominique Darius and Laila Phelia - Burrows is the only second-year captain.

DME PIPELINE

Syracuse sophomores Olivia Schmitt and Keira Scott played their senior year of high school together at DME Academy in Jacksonville, Florida. Together the future Orange duo led DME to a 20-7 record.

GAMECHANGERS

WCNY, Central New York's public communications organization, in partnership with Syracuse University Athletics, is proud to announce the premiere of its new television series, "Gamechangers," airing Saturdays, at 8 p.m. on WCNY-TV.

The first season of "Gamechangers" features the Syracuse Women's Basketball team. Hosted by Sean Dorcellus and featuring Head Coach Felisha Legette-Jack, "Gamechangers" is a bi-weekly, 30-minute series that goes beyond the court to explore how championship-caliber programs are built through values, leadership, teamwork, and community.

Each episode pulls back the curtain on the Syracuse women's basketball team with segments from both the player's and Coach Jack's perspective while focusing on the connection the team has to the Syracuse community.

"Gamechangers" move to its new night in the new year when it airs on Saturday nights at 8 p.m. on WCNY-TV. Episodes are also available to stream on-demand at wcny.org/gamechangers and on PBS Passport.

MOURNING THE LOSS OF A LEGEND

Tiana Mangakahia, a beloved Syracuse basketball standout known for her infectious personality and inspiring many through her courageous cancer battle, passed away on Sept. 11, 2025, at the age of 30. She was surrounded by family and friends in her hometown of Brisbane, Australia.

The Orange plan to honor Mangakahia's legacy during the 2025-26 season. Further information will be announced in the coming weeks.

Mangakahia was a star guard for the Orange from 2017-21, earning All-America and All-ACC honors. In November 2019 she underwent surgery while battling stage 2 grade 3 invasive ductal carcinoma (breast cancer), causing her to miss the 2019-20 season. She courageously returned to the court a year later in Nov. 2020, inspiring many. She graduated in 2019 with a degree in communications and rhetorical studies from Syracuse's College of Visual and Performing Arts before extending her studies into the Sport Venue and Event Management graduate program at Syracuse's David B. Falk College of Sport.

A two-time WBCA Division I Coaches All-America Honorable Mention selection, Mangakahia etched her name in the Syracuse record books during her three seasons with the Orange. She graduated as the program leader in career assists (736), assists per game (8.7) and free throw percentage (.873). She earned All-ACC honors in all three seasons, twice garnering first team recognition.

After completing her collegiate career, Mangakahia went undrafted and ultimately signed a training camp contract with the Phoenix Mercury of the WNBA. She went on to play professionally in Russia, France and her native Australia.

In 2019, she was named to the Australian Senior National Team (Opals) preliminary roster for the 2020 Olympics but was forced to bow out after her initial cancer diagnosis. In 2021, she made her Opals debut at the FIBA Women's Asia Cup where she helped Australia bring home a bronze medal.

Mangakahia retired from basketball in 2023 when her cancer unfortunately returned. After living with the disease for nearly two years, she returned to basketball in 2025 when she signed with her hometown club the Southern District Spartans in Australia's NBL1 finishing the season with 12.1 points and 3.6 assists per game.

HEAD COACH FELISHA LEGETTE-JACK



Felisha Legette-Jack, a 1989 graduate of Syracuse University and Orange All-American, is home. The Syracuse native and 20-year collegiate head coach took the reins of the Orange basketball program on March 26, 2022.

In three seasons leading the Orange, Legette-Jack has resurrected a Syracuse program from the bottom of the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) to one of the top teams in the nation's best conference. Legette-Jack guided Syracuse to back-to-back 20-win seasons in her first two years and made a postseason tournament both seasons.

In 2022-23, she took Syracuse to the Super 16 of the Women's NIT (WNIT) and finished with a 20-13 record while Dyaisha Fair earned WBCA All-America honorable mention honors.

The Orange reached new heights in her second season on The Hill, matching program bests in regular season wins (23), conference wins (13), and ACC road wins (6). Syracuse was picked to finish ninth in the ACC but posted a 13-5 record and earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament, tying the biggest jump from preseason expectations to final standings in ACC history.

Legette-Jack was named ACC Coach of the Year in 2024, becoming the first Syracuse head coach to earn the honor in men's or women's basketball. She led SU to its first NCAA Tournament win since 2021 as the Orange finished 24-8 after an eight-point loss to UConn in the NCAA Tournament second round. Syracuse is 36-13 at home during Legette-Jack's tenure at Syracuse and is 56-40 through her first three seasons on The Hill. Fair was selected in the second round of the WNBA Draft by the Las Vegas Aces in 2024, becoming the sixth WNBA Draft pick in program history.

Legette-Jack is synonymous with Syracuse women's basketball success. She led Nottingham High School to a pair of state titles before attending Syracuse, where she was a standout on Coach Barbara Jacobs' teams from 1984-89.

As a student-athlete at Syracuse, Legette-Jack earned Big East Freshman of the Year honors in 1985 after helping lead the Orange to their first Big East Championship in school history. As a sophomore, Legette-Jack averaged a double-double (15.8 ppg and 10.1 rpg) en route to honorable mention All-America honors and All-Big East recognition.

The next year she earned honorable mention All-America and All-Big East Second Team recognition. After missing the 1987-88 season due to a knee injury, she returned to earn All-Big East honors for the fourth time in 1988-89. She finished her career as the program's all-time leader in points, rebounds, field goals made and attempted, and free throws made and attempted. More than 30 years later, she still ranks in the top 10 on Syracuse's career scoring and rebounding lists. She is one of three players in program history to score more than 1,500 points (1,526) and grab more than 900 rebounds (927).

Legette-Jack is enshrined in multiple halls of fame, including the Greater Syracuse Hall of Fame, the Syracuse Urban Sports Hall of Fame, and the Syracuse University Orange Plus Hall of Fame. She was named to the Big East Silver Anniversary team in 2004 and became the first female in Syracuse University history to have her jersey retired when her No. 33 jersey was raised to the rafters of the Carrier Dome on Nov. 14, 2021.

Born Sept. 4, 1966, in Syracuse, Legette-Jack and her husband David have one son, David Maceo, who is currently playing professional basketball in Newcastle, England.

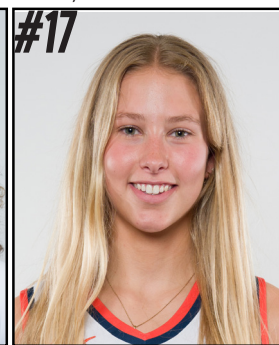
