Mizzou and Miami have met only once previously with the Tigers winning, 93-80, in the 2002 NCAA Tournament.

The Tigers are making back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since five-straight from 2009 to 2013.

Mark Mitchell is one of seven players nationally with 575 points, 160 rebounds and 110 assists.

Missouri is making its 31st trip to the NCAA Tournament with a 23-30 all-time record.

Mark Mitchell has scored 32 points in each of the last two games – the first Tiger to do so back-to-back since 1987-88.

The Tigers are 20-2 this season when scoring at least 73 points (19-1 in regulation) but 0-10 with 72 or fewer points.

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- Missouri is a No. 10 seed for the NCAA Tournament after posting a 20-12 overall record in 2025-26.
- The Tigers finished seventh in a SEC that sent 10 teams to the dance, going 10-8 in league play.
- Mizzou is coming off a 78-72 loss to Kentucky in the second round of the SEC Tournament.
- All-SEC honoree **Mark Mitchell** led MU during his senior campaign, posting team-best totals with 18.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.6 assists.
- Three Tigers score in double figures with **Jayden Stone** (13.2) and **Trent Pierce** (10.6) following Mitchell's lead.
- The Tigers own a scoring offense of 79.7 points with a scoring defense of 75.3.

ABOUT THE HURRICANES

- Miami owns a 25-8 overall record this season after finishing third in the ACC with a 13-5 mark.
- The Hurricanes are led by Malik Reneau, who tallied 18.8 points per game.
- Tre Donaldson is second with 16.5 points to go with a team-best 5.8 assists, while Ernest Udeh Jr. has a Miami-leading 9.3 rebounds.
- The Hurricanes are tallying 81.9 points per game, while allowing 71.2.

SERIES HISTORY

- The schools have met once prior, squaring off in the first round of the 2002 NCAA Tournament.
- The 12th-seeded Tigers defeated fifth-seeded Miami, 93-80, in Albuquerque. Clarence Gilbert led six Tigers in double figures with 20 points.
- Mizzou would ultimately advance to its fourth Elite Eight in school history (in San Jose) after the first-round win.

TIGERS VERSUS ACC

- Missouri owns a 15-21 all-time record against schools from the ACC with 19 of the 36 meetings coming on a neutral court.
- MU is 1-3 versus the league in NCAA Tournament play, defeating Clemson in 2010, while falling to North Carolina (2000), Duke (2001) and Florida State (2018).
- The Tigers are 2-1 against ACC schools under Coach Gates – all in the ACC/SEC Challenge, defeating Pittsburgh in 2023 and California in 2024, while falling at Notre Dame this season.

HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE?

- The Tigers are staying close to home and making the short trip to St. Louis for the opening rounds.
- Enterprise Center is located just 126 miles away from Mizzou Arena.
- It is the second time the Tigers will play an NCAA Tournament game in St. Louis, falling to Houston in the 1982 Sweet 16.

MIAMI CONNECTIONS

- There are a number of familiar faces between the two programs.
- Miami sophomore Marcus Allen spent his rookie campaign at Mizzou in 2024-25.
- Charlton Young is also in his first year as associate coach at Miami after spending three years at Mizzou as the team's associate head coach.
- Mizzou's **Anthony Robinson II** and Miami's Tre Donaldson were also teammates at Florida State University High School, helping the school to the 2022 state championship.

NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- Mizzou is competing in its 31st NCAA Tournament.
- The Tigers are 23-30 all-time in their first 53 NCAA Tournament contests
- Mizzou has earned an invitation to the NCAA Tournament in back-to-back seasons for the first time since a run of five-straight from 2009 to 2013.
- Overall, it marks the third NCAA Tournament bid in four years for the Tigers under head coach **Dennis Gates**.
- MU has advanced as far as the Elite Eight on five occasions (1944, 1976, 1994, 2002 and 2009).

TOURNAMENT NUMBERS TO KNOW

- The Tigers earned the No. 10 seed for the third time in their history.
- Mizzou fell in the first round as a 10 seed in 1993, while going 1-1 in 2010.
- Overall, MU owns an 11-14 record in the round of 64 and is also 7-16 all-time as the lower seed with its last upset win in 2010.

BATTLE TESTED IN THE SEC

- Mizzou is one of 10 SEC schools to earn an NCAA Tournament bid this season.
- It marks just the third time in tournament history a league earned 10-plus bids (14 by SEC last season and 10 by Big East in 2011).
- Overall, Mizzou is 7-8 versus NCAA Tournament teams this season, while Miami is 4-6.
- The schools also shared one common opponent this season with Mizzou defeating Florida, 76-74, and the Gators topping Miami, 82-68.

NCAA TOURNAMENT EXPERIENCE

- Seven of the 14 Tigers have played in the NCAA Tournament in the past for a total of 13 games.
- Of the Tigers usual eight-man rotation, only **Trent Burns**, **Shawn Phillips Jr.** and **Jayden Stone** are making their tournament debuts.
- **Mark Mitchell** has had the most success in the dance, making the Elite Eight at Duke in 2024.
- Miami has three players with NCAA Tournament experience for a total of 12 games.

MITCHELL EARNS ALL-SEC HONORS

- Leading the way for Mizzou this season is All-SEC honoree **Mark Mitchell**.
- The senior earned second-team honors by the league's coaches after receiving third-team accolades as a junior.
- Mitchell is the second Tiger in the program's 14 years in the SEC to be a two-time honoree, joining **Kobe Brown** in 2022 and 2023.
- The senior was also recognized on the NABC All-Central Region Second Team on Tuesday.

ALL-AROUND LEADER IN MITCHELL

- Behind **Mark Mitchell's** All-SEC season is his ability to be an all-around leader.
- Mitchell leads Mizzou in points (18.3), rebounds (5.3) and assists (3.6) this season.
- He is aiming to become just the second player in school history to lead the Tigers in all three categories, joining Albert White in 1998-99.

MR. VERSATILE, MARK MITCHELL

- **Mark Mitchell** and his all-around game has been on display throughout the season.
- Mitchell is just one of seven players in the nation to have totaled 575 points, 160 rebounds and 110 assists during the 2025-26 campaign.
- Mitchell is also aiming to be the first Tiger to tally 17 points, five boards and three assists since Anthony Peeler when he earned Big Eight Player of the Year in 1991-92.

MITCHELL PLAYING HIS BEST BALL

- Even better news for Mizzou is that **Mark Mitchell** is playing his best basketball right now.
- In his last six games, Mitchell is averaging 24.5 points, shooting 62.7 percent from the field.
- The senior has tallied a career-best 32 points in each of his last two games against Arkansas in the regular-season finale and Kentucky in the SEC Tournament.
- In fact, it is only the fifth time in school history a Tiger has scored 32-plus in back-to-back games and first time since Derrick Chievous in 1987-88.
- Overall, Mitchell is tallying 18.3 points in 2025-26 – the most by a Tiger in 12 years (Jabari Brown scored 19.9 in 2013-14).

SECONDARY SCORERS

- With **Mark Mitchell** at the top of his game, he needs just a little help to lead Mizzou to victory.
- The Tigers went 10-3 against SEC foes when two or more players scored 14-plus points but 0-6 when the second-leading scorer was held to 13 or fewer points.
- Mitchell actually averaged more points in losses versus SEC schools – 20.5 compared to 17.8 in its 10 wins.

MAGIC NUMBER IS 73

- The goal for the Tigers is simply to score 73 points.
- Mizzou is 20-2 when tallying at least 73 points (19-1 in games that ended in regulation) but are 0-10 when failing to reach the mark.
- Overall, the Tigers are averaging 79.7 points during the 2025-26 season – scoring 86.1 points in their 20 wins and 69.0 in their 12 defeats.
- Mizzou is also shooting 9.4 percent higher from the field and 8.5 percent higher from 3-point range in wins.

SURGING T.O. BARRETT

- There might not be a more improved player in the SEC this season than **T.O. Barrett**.
- Barrett has scored at least 10 points in 12 of the last 16 games – tallying 12.9 points during that span. He scored in double figures just once in his first 35 career contests.

- In 32 games overall as a sophomore, Barrett is averaging 8.9 points, 3.1 assists and 2.7 rebounds.

DIFFERENCE MAKERS

- It's been a welcomed return with **Trent Pierce** and **Jayden Stone** back in the rotation.
- Since returning to the lineup on Jan. 3, the duo has averaged a combined 23.8 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.9 steals in 19 games.
- A starter last season, Pierce missed the first 13 games with a lower-body injury, while Stone missed the last seven games of non-conference action with a hand injury.

STONE COLD

- After a successful start to his Mizzou career, the Tigers certainly missed **Jayden Stone** during his time out with a hand injury.
- Before his injury, Stone was the first Tiger to score 10-plus points in his first six career games at Mizzou since Jordan Clarkson in 2013.
- Overall, Stone is second on MU with 13.2 points, third with 5.0 rebounds and fourth with 1.9 assists per game.

PIERCING IMPACT

- Junior **Trent Pierce** has also made an impact since returning from injury.
- A lethal shooter, Pierce is averaging 10.6 points per game in 19 contests since his return, shooting 49.3 percent from the field and 39.8 percent from 3-point range.
- The junior has been even better since moving into the starting lineup with Pierce tallying 12.1 points per game and shooting 52.0 percent overall and 40.4 percent from 3-point range in 11 starts.

SHOOTING IMPROVEMENT

- **Trent Pierce** has continued to improve his shot from deep during his career to become one of the team's most dangerous threats.
- Pierce has seen his 3-point shooting jump from 17.2 percent as freshman to now 39.8 percent as a junior.

- Pierce is attempting to become the 11th player in school history to shoot 50 percent from the field and 40 percent from 3-point range (minimum 30 made triples).
- He would also join Kobe Brown (2022-23) and Sean East II (2023-24) as the only three Tigers to hit the numbers in the last 14 seasons.

SEC COMMUNITY SERVICE TEAM

- **Trent Pierce** was honored for his work off the court on March 5 as he was named to the SEC Community Service Team.
- A team captain, Pierce leads all Tigers in volunteer hours during his time at Mizzou.

THE CREWS MISSILE

- Graduate student **Jacob Crews** has been one of the top shooters nationally this season.
- Crews leads the Tigers with 56 made 3-pointers and a clip of 45.2 percent from beyond the arc.
- Of players that have made at least 50 triples this season, Crews ranks 16th in the nation with his 3-point clip of 45.1 percent.
- Crews is sixth on MU with 8.6 points per game.

THREE-POINT THREATS

- Overall, Mizzou features a dangerous trio of 3-point shooters in **Jacob Crews**, **Trent Pierce** and **Jayden Stone**.
- All are 3-point threats as Crews leads the way at 45.2 percent, Pierce is second at 39.8 percent and Stone is third at 38.2 percent.
- It's first time in its history that MU has three players with 1.75 triples per game and shooting higher than 37.5 percent from beyond the arc.

FINDING THEIR SHOOTING TOUCH

- Two Tigers who have been stronger as of late from beyond the arc are **Mark Mitchell** and **Anthony Robinson II**.
- Since missing his first nine attempts of the year, Mitchell is shooting 44.4 percent (16-of-36).
- Robinson is also making 44.0 percent during the last eight games (11-of-25). In the previous 17 contests, he was connecting on just 14.5 percent (8-of-55).

TOP RANKS FOR MITCHELL

- With his strong play this season, **Mark Mitchell** ranks among the nation's best in multiple stats.
- The senior currently ranks sixth in the SEC and 76th nationally with his 18.3 points per game.
- In fact, his 18.3 points per game are the most by a Tiger since Jabari Brown tallied 19.9 in 2013-14.
- Efficiency is the key as he ranks second in the SEC and 60th nationally with a field-goal clip of 55.1.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- **Mark Mitchell** also excels at getting to the free-throw line.
- Mitchell currently ranks 12th nationally (and first in the SEC) in free-throw attempts (256) and 38th in makes (170).
- In fact, his 256 free-throw attempts rank as the fifth-most in school history.

- Overall, Mitchell is averaging 8.00 attempts per game from the charity stripe.

MITCHELL PROVES HIS VALUE

- Overall, **Mark Mitchell** is proving to be one of the more valuable players in the SEC this season.
- Against SEC teams, Mitchell accounted for 38.0 percent of the team's points – scoring or assisting on 29.2 points per game.

BIG MAN LENDS A HELPING HAND

- Most impressive about **Mark Mitchell** and his versatility this season comes from his assists.
- Mitchell leads Mizzou with 3.6 assists per game – nearly double his previous high (1.9 last year).
- In fact, Mitchell ranks eighth nationally in assists by a player 6-9 or taller with his 114 helpers.
- Additionally, of his 76 assists against SEC schools, 42 have resulted in a 3-pointer (55.3 percent).

SEC WINS MARK

- Mizzou has made double-digit SEC victories a habit as of late.
- MU won 10-plus conference games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since joining the league and for the fifth time overall in 14 years.
- It also marks the third time in four years under Coach Gates, having done so twice in 10 years prior to his arrival.
- In fact, Gates is just the second Mizzou coach to have three seasons of 10-plus conference wins – joining Norm Stewart, who did it 11 times.

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES

- Fans are in for a treat this year during MU games.
- Nine of MU's 19 games versus SEC foes have been decided by five or fewer points, 13 of which were within four in the final two minutes.
- Mizzou has also excelled in those close contests with a 7-2 record in SEC games decided by five or fewer points.

SCORING OPTIONS

- Utilizing primarily an eight-player rotation, the Tigers can rely on any of the eight to contribute to a victory.
- Mizzou currently features six players averaging at least eight points per game.
- It marks just the ninth time in school history the Tigers have had six players scoring eight points per game and first time since 2021-22.
- Additionally, all six of the team's top scorers have tallied at least 20 points in a game this season .

TOP SHOOTING TEAM

- Mizzou ranks as one of the best shooting teams in the country.

- Mizzou is making 49.0 percent of its field goals this season with a 3-point clip of 35.0 percent.
- MU ranks 22nd nationally with its 49.0 percent overall clip, 36th in effective field goal percentage (55.3) and 38th in 2-point percentage (56.9).

CONSISTENT SHOOTING

- The key to the Tigers ranking among the nation's best shooters is their consistency.
- Mizzou has eclipsed 50 percent in nearly half of its games this season (14-of-32).
- The Tigers are one of 44 schools in the country with 14 games of at least 50 percent shooting.

50 PERCENT EQUALS WINS

- As Mizzou continues to make 50 percent of its field goals, it continues to pile up the wins.
- The 50 percent mark is almost a guaranteed win for the Tigers as MU is now 43-2 under Coach Gates when hitting the mark, including 25-1 since the start of the 2024-25 season.

EFFICIENCY FROM PHILLIPS

- **Shawn Phillips Jr.** is enjoying one of the most accurate seasons by a Tiger in school history.
- Phillips has made 69.1 percent of his field goals – the second-best mark in the MU record book.

BURNING LOVE

- Another player that has taken advantage of increased minutes as of late is **Trent Burns**.
- The redshirt freshman has totaled 107 minutes in the last seven games – he played 30 minutes in the first 12 SEC games of the season.
- In the last seven contests, Burns has totaled 25 points, 25 rebounds, five steals and three blocks.
- Burns scored a season-best eight points on Feb. 28 at Mississippi State, while collecting a personal-best seven boards in two ranked wins versus No. 19 Vanderbilt and No. 22 Tennessee.

ROBINSON ANCHORS DEFENSE

- **Anthony Robinson II** entered the season as a frontrunner for the league's Defensive Player and has continued to be a menace on defense.
- Robinson currently ranks ninth in the SEC and 142nd nationally with 1.59 steals per game.

THE LONE RETURNER

- The reason why junior **Anthony Robinson II** is a top candidate for SEC Defensive Player of the Year is his history from past seasons.
- Robinson was named to the SEC's five-man All-Defensive Team as a sophomore. In fact, he is the only player returning from last year's team (other four were graduating seniors).

GETTING TO THE LINE

- One area where the Tigers would like to take advantage of is the free-throw line.
- Last season, Mizzou ranked second nationally with 19.7 makes per game from the free-throw line and third with 27.0 attempts.
- This year, however, the Tigers are seventh in the SEC in attempts per game (24.2) and 11th in makes from the charity stripe (16.6), while placing 15th with a clip of 68.6 percent.

AND-ONE

- Not only does **Mark Mitchell** lead the team in free throw makes and attempts this season but he also is elite at finishing through contact.
- Mitchell has a team-best 33 and-ones in 2025-26 – averaging just more than one per game.

THE MISSING PIECE

- One player that MU would like to take advantage of drawing contact is **Anthony Robinson II**.
- Last season, Robinson was second on the team with 140 free-throw attempts (4.2 per game).
- This year, however, Robinson has had his attempts minimized despite playing more minutes.

- Robinson's fouls drawn per 40 minutes has gone from 5.2 to 3.8, while his free-throw rate went from 79.5 to 48.9.

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- The Tigers take on the 2025-26 campaign with a number of familiar faces.
- Mizzou is the only team in the SEC with three returning starters from last season with **Mark Mitchell**, **Trent Pierce** and **Anthony Robinson II** all back for MU.
- Overall, it marks the first time that MU returns three starters since the 2020-21 campaign.

FLYING HIGH

- There is one thing you can't teach on the court and that is height, which Mizzou owns a lot of.
- The Tigers average height in 2025-26 is 79.79 inches (nearly 6-foot-8).
- Mizzou's height is nearly an inch taller than the second-previous tallest team in school history (79.00 in 2017-18) and more than a half inch taller than any other team in the SEC.

- **Trent Burns** (7-5) is also tied for the tallest player in MU history and second tallest player nationally.

1,000 POINT SCORERS

- **Jacob Crews** (Nov. 25) and **Jayden Stone** (Jan. 20) both joined the 1,000-point club this season.
- The duo joined **Mark Mitchell** and **Jevon Porter** in the club as the Tigers now boast four players with 1,000-plus points in their careers.

- Additionally, Mitchell surpassed 1,000 points as a Tiger on March 7. He is the 49th player in school history to reach 1,000 points and the eighth to do it in just two seasons (1,045 of his 1,745 points have come as a Tiger).

STRONG FROM THE START

- The Tigers pulled off a number of firsts to open league play.
- Mizzou won its first two conference games for the first time in its 14 years in the SEC.
- Perhaps most impressive about its 2-0 start, MU defeated the top two teams in the SEC preseason poll – topping Florida and winning for the first time ever in 10 tries at Kentucky.

BIG VICTORY

- The Tigers made an early statement on Nov. 12, posting an 83-60 victory over Minnesota.
- The 23-point win marks the largest for MU in 147 games versus the Big Ten Conference – surpassing its previous high of 22 (Illinois in 2022).

MITCHELL EARNS PRESEASON NODS

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** is one of the top returners in the SEC and in the nation this season.
- Mitchell is one of 50 players named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Preseason Watch List – which is presented to the men's national player of the year by the USBWA.
- The senior was also named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team.
- Mitchell leads MU with 18.3 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.6 assists.

TOP RETURNING SCORER

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** led the Tigers in scoring as a junior and is back for more in 2025-26.
- Mitchell tallied 13.9 points per game – shooting 50.5 percent from the field and leading the team in free-throws made (142) and attempts (212).
- In fact, Mitchell's 13.9 points are the most by a returning Tiger since Marcus Denmon in 2011-12 (he averaged 16.9 in 2010-11).

BREAKOUT CANDIDATE

- **Anthony Robinson II** has been identified as one to watch this season.
- Robinson was named one of 10 breakout players for the 2025-26 campaign by Andy Katz and one of 20 by Jon Rothstein.
- Robinson tallied 9.0 points per game during his sophomore season, leading Mizzou with 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

OH CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Three Tigers are serving as team captains during the 2025-26 campaign.
- **Mark Mitchell**, **Trent Pierce** and **Anthony Robinson II** are all set to serve in leadership roles this season.

CREWS IMPROVEMENT

- **Jacob Crews'** strong shooting early this season shouldn't be much of a surprise as he finished his first season in the Black & Gold strong as well.
- In his last 14 games of 2024-25, Crews shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range after sinking 29.2 percent in his first 19 games at Mizzou.
- Crews has gone even further this season as he is now averaging 8.6 points with a 3-point mark of 45.2 percent.

LEARNING FROM THE POINT GOD

- **Anthony Robinson II** spent some of his summer learning from Chris Paul as he was one of 12 players nationally to earn an invite to his camp.
- Robinson participated in the Chris Paul Elite Guard Camp from July 29 to August 1 this summer.

TAKING THE SHOW ON THE ROAD

- The Tigers went on the road to open the 2025-26 season, putting on a show at Howard.
- Mizzou's win marks the first time it won a road season opener since 2003, while the 21-point win is its largest since in a road opener since a 52-29 win at Saint Louis in 1941.
- The Tigers were the only power conference school to open with a win in a true road game.
- Overall, Mizzou is 4-7 in road games this season, including a 3-5 mark in SEC play.

TIGERS SIGNS TOP CLASS

- The Tigers made a splash in November by signing one of the nation's top-ranked recruiting class.
- MU signed **Jason Crowe Jr.** (No. 5 in ESPN100), **Toni Bryant** (No. 14) and **Aidan Chronister** (No. 83).
- Crowe and Bryant were both named McDonald's All-Americans – the first time Mizzou had two honorees in the same season (one of three schools in 2026).
- Overall, Mizzou originally had the No. 1 class on signing day and now ranks No. 2 nationally, behind Duke and its top-ranked class.

MU SLATED SEVENTH IN SEC POLL

- Missouri was picked to finish seventh in the SEC this season, as voted on by the league's media.
- It marks the Tigers' highest preseason selection since being voted fifth in 2017-18.
- Defending national champion Florida was first in the preseason rankings, followed by Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama and Arkansas in the top five.

EIGHT CORE VALUES

- One goal of Coach Gates in building a program is to instill eight core values in the student-athletes that they carry into the classroom, on the court and into the community.
- The eight core values are: friendship, love, accountability, trust, discipline, unselfishness, enthusiasm and toughness.

SHOW ME STATE

- The Tigers have a Missouri look to the team in 2025-26.
- After not featuring a player from the state in the previous three seasons, four Tigers are playing in their home state this season.
- **Jevon Porter** and **Aaron Rowe** are both from Columbia with **Luke Northweather** also from mid-Missouri in nearby Jefferson City. **Nicholas Randall** is the final native Missourian, from St. Louis.
- It marks the most players from the Show Me State to feature for Mizzou since six were on the 2017-18 roster.

TIGERS IN THE NBA

- Five former Tigers are continuing their playing career in the NBA this season with another five on staffs.
- **Tamar Bates** (Nuggets), **Kobe Brown** (Pacers), **Jordan Clarkson** (Knicks), **Michael Porter Jr.** (Nets) and **Dru Smith** (Heat) are all on rosters this season.
- Additionally, **Sean East II** was named to the NBA Rising Stars game and is currently a member of the Salt Lake City Stars in the NBA G-League.
- In the front office, former MU players include **Josh Kroenke** (Nuggets President), **Quin Snyder** (Hawks coach), **DeMarre Carroll** (Suns assistant), **Larry Drew** (Clippers assistant) and **Jarrett Sutton** (Pelicans scout).



DENNIS GATES

Whitten Family Men's Basketball Head Coach



In just three seasons as Whitten Family Men's Basketball Head Coach, Dennis Gates has made an immediate impact and reestablished University of Missouri on the national stage. Now in his fourth year on the Mizzou sideline, he aims to build off his early progress as the Tigers chase championships with him leading the program.

MISSOURI

- **Named SEC Coach of the Year by USA Today in 2022-23.**
- Named to the Naismith Coach of the Year Watch List twice in his three seasons, finishing as a top-10 semifinalist in 2025.
- Led Mizzou two NCAA Tournament bids (2023 and 2025) in his three seasons, including the program's first postseason victory in 13 years and first-ever appearance in the SEC Semifinals in 2023.
- His 25 victories 2022-23 are the fifth-most by any first-year SEC coach in conference history – trailing only Tubby Smith, John Calipari, Eddie Sutton and Trent Johnson.
- Led the Tigers to 14 wins over ranked teams, including three top-five wins in 2024-25 – a first for Mizzou since 1988-89.
- Two Tigers have played in the NBA after playing for Gates – Kobe Brown (LA Clippers) and D'Moi Hodge (LA Lakers). Overall, seven Tigers have joined NBA or G-League franchises in Gates' three seasons at Mizzou.
- Coached two All-SEC honorees, one SEC Sixth Man of the Year, one SEC All-Defensive Team honoree and two SEC Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

- **2019-20 and 2020-21 Horizon League Coach of the Year.**
- Rebuilt the Vikings program – winning 50 games, including a 39-19 mark his final two seasons.
- Won two Horizon League regular-season titles (2020, 2021) and the 2021 Horizon League Tournament crown.
- Led the Vikings to the 2021 NCAA Tournament – the school's first trip in 12 years – and 2022 Postseason NIT.
