### THE MATCHUP

• Seven Nebraska wrestlers will compete at the NCAA Championships this Thursday through Saturday at Quicken Loans Arena in Cleveland, Ohio.

• The first of six sessions begins on Thursday at 11 a.m. (CT) with the pigtailed and opening round, which is set to be televised on ESPNU. Thursday's action continues at 6 p.m. (CT) with session II, consisting of both second round matches as well as consolation bouts on ESPN.

• Friday's sessions start at 10 a.m. (CT) and 7 p.m. (CT). Session III includes quarterfinals and consolation matches on ESPNU, while Session IV has the semifinals and consolation bouts on ESPN.

• Session V, which includes the medal round matches, is set for Saturday at 10 a.m. (CT) on ESPNU. The championship finals begin on Saturday at 7 p.m. (CT) on ESPN2.

• Every single match on every single mat will be streamed live on Watch ESPN, which can be accessed on a computer at WatchESPN.com or on a tablet or smartphone with the Watch ESPN app. Live scoring and brackets for the entirety of the tournament will be available on TrackWrestling.

• The seven Huskers that qualified for the national meet include Jason Renteria (133), Chad Red Jr. (141), Colton McCrystal (149), Tyler Berger (157), Isaiah White (165), Taylor Venz (184) and Eric Schultz (197). Renteria, Red, McCrystal, Berger, White and Venz qualified based on their finish at the Big Ten Championships two weeks ago, while Schultz earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Championships.

• Four Huskers earned seeds for the NCAA Championships. Taylor Venz (184) is the highest seeded Husker at seventh at 184 pounds. Tyler Berger is eighth at 157 pounds, while Isaiah White is 11th at 165 and Colton McCrystal is 13th at 149.

• **Last Time Out:** Nebraska finished fifth as a team with 72.5 points at the Big Ten Championships on March 3-4.

The list of Huskers who are competing at the NCAA Championships includes two wrestlers who have returning NCAA experience. Tyler Berger (157) is making his third appearance, after earning All-America status by finishing fifth last season. He also reached the round of 12 in 2016. Colton McCrystal (149) is making his second NCAA appearance after reaching the round of 12 last season.

Nebraska has had an All-American in each of the last 29 seasons, dating back to the 1989 NCAA Championships.

In that time, NU wrestlers have earned 84 All-America awards. Four Huskers earned All-America honors last season, including Tyler Berger (5th at 157).

- Two Huskers have returning NCAA Championship experience: Tyler Berger (157) will be making his third NCAA appearance, while Colton McCrystal (149) will be making his second
- Tyler Berger is Nebraska's lone returning All-American, as he finished fifth at 157 pounds at last season's NCAA Championships
- Just one of Nebraska's NCAA qualifiers is a senior (Colton McCrystal); Four of Nebraska's seven NCAA qualifiers are either true or redshirt freshmen

- Five starters have surpassed the 20-win plateau, with Isaiah White (165) and Taylor Venz (184) tied for the team lead with 23 wins

- Four Husker wrestlers are seeded at the NCAA Championships this weekend. Taylor Venz is the highest-seeded Husker, as he is seventh at 184 pounds. He will face Chaz Polson of Wyoming in the first round in a rematch of Venz's dual-meet victory in November. Tyler Berger (157) is seeded eighth and will take on Joe Velliquette of Penn in the first round.

- Isaiah White earned the 11th seed at 165 pounds and will face Demetrius Romero of Utah Valley in the first round. Colton McCrystal is seeded 13th at 149 and will take on Jarrett Degen of Iowa State in the first round.

- Other first-round matchups involving Huskers include Jason Renteria vs. No. 13 Bryan Lantry of Buffalo at 133, Chad Red Jr. vs. No. 7 Brock Zacherl of Clarion at 141 and Eric Schultz vs. No. 14 Cash Wilcke of Iowa at 197.

### FIVE HUSKERS RANKED BY INTERMAT

- Five Nebraska wrestlers are ranked in the March 6 InterMat rankings. Taylor Venz was the highest ranked Husker, coming in at eighth at 184 pounds. Colton McCrystal (10th at 149) was also ranked in the top-10 while Isaiah White is 11th at 165. Tyler Berger is 13th at 157 and Chad Red Jr. is 16th at 141.

### SEVEN HUSKERS RANKED IN FOURTH COACHES' PANEL, FIVE IN SECOND RPI RANKINGS

## BACK POINTS

- Five were rated in the second RPI rankings, also released last Thursday, as Venz was rated eighth, while Berger was ninth. White was 11th, while Red was ranked 15th and McCrystal came in at 16th.
- Wrestlers in each weight class were measured by winning percentage, rating percentage index (RPI) and coaches' rankings to determine conference allocations in their qualifying tournaments for the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships.

### SEVEN PLACE AT BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Seven Huskers earned spots on the podium at the Big Ten Championships, held March 3-4 in East Lansing, Mich. Colton McCrystal (149), Tyler Berger (157) and Taylor Venz (184) were NU's highest finishers, as each placed fourth at their respective weight classes. Jason Renteria (133), Nebraska's lone semifinalist, defeated Scott DelVecchio of Rutgers in the fifth-place match.

- Three Huskers finished seventh at the Big Ten Championships, as Chad Red Jr. (141), Isaiah White (165) and Eric Schultz (197) each won seventh-place matches.

- Six Huskers, Renteria, Red, McCrystal, Berger, White and Venz, earned automatic qualification to the NCAA Championships based on their finish at the Big Ten Championships, while Schultz was announced as an at-large qualifier last week.

- Nebraska placed fifth as a team at the Big Ten Championships with 72.5 team points.

### NEBRASKA SECURES WIN NUMBER 700

- Nebraska's win over Wisconsin on Feb. 9 was its 700th win in dual meets all-time in program history. The Huskers now have a 701-555-29 (.557) record all-time in duals since 1910-11, following a win over Stanford on Feb. 16.

### WHITE SHOWS CONSISTENCY IN FIRST SEASON AS A HUSKER

- Sophomore Isaiah White (165) is proving his place as one of the top wrestlers at his weight in the country in his first season in a Nebraska singlet. White went 11-2 in duals, a win total that led Nebraska starters, and is 23-6 overall, which is tied for the most wins among starters.

- White also led NU starters in dual points (46) and dual takedowns (44) and was taken down just twice in dual competition. He outscored his 13 dual opponents by a combined score of 120-46, not including pins in his matches against Maryland and Indiana.

- White has 11 wins by bonus points on the season, including two pins, four technical falls and five major decisions. He finished second at the Daktronics Open in November and defeated four ranked opponents to finish third at the Cliff Keen Invitational in December. His only losses are to top-12 opponents.

- White won the NCAA Division II title at 165 pounds last season for Notre Dame College (Ohio) before transferring to Nebraska last summer. He went 28-2 overall as a freshman.

### VENZ STRONG DURING REDSHIRT FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

- Taylor Venz (184) has a team leading seven pins this season along with three technical falls and five major decisions on the year, including a pair of major decisions in the Big Ten Championships. His 23 total wins on the season are tied for the most among Husker starters, as he is set to make his first NCAA appearance with a 23-7 overall record.

- At the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational, Venz burst on the scene with four pins on the first day of competition, including a pair in under 15 seconds and two more over top-eight opponents. Venz finished third at the tournament, as the previously unranked wrestler jumped to sixth in the next week's InterMat rankings.

- Half of Venz's 10 wins in dual matches have come by bonus points, as he has a pin, a technical fall and three major decisions.

### EXPERIENCED PAIR LEADS THE WAY

- Tyler Berger (157) and Colton McCrystal (149) are Nebraska's two returning NCAA qualifiers from last season, and led the Huskers to a 10-2 team record with a combined record of 16-3 with nine bonus-point wins in NU's 12 duals in the 2018 calendar year.

- Berger, an All-American at 157 pounds a season ago, is 22-8 this season after finishing fourth at the Big Ten Championships. He won the Daktronics Open and finished fourth at the Cliff Keen Invitational. He has nine wins against ranked wrestlers this season.

- McCrystal, who qualified for the NCAA Championships at 141 pounds last season, moved up to 149 this year and is 21-5 after taking fourth at the Big Ten Championships. He went 10-2 in duals this season, with bonus points in five of his last seven matches. His only two dual losses were to wrestlers that were ranked fourth at the time, Troy Heilmann of North Carolina and Ryan Deakin of Northwestern.

## BACK POINTS

### REDSHIRT FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

• Three redshirt freshmen, Chad Red Jr. (141), Taylor Venz (184) and Eric Schultz (197) have become strong forces in Nebraska's starting lineup this season, as each qualified for this week's NCAA Championships.

• Red is 21-9 on the season after taking seventh at the Big Ten Championships. His five pins in all competitions are tied for third among Nebraska starters. He started every dual at 141 pounds for Nebraska this season.

• Venz leads starters in pins (7) and has defeated six top-11 opponents.

• Schultz is 18-9 on the year with five of his losses coming to top-10 opponents. He did not place at the Cliff Keen Invitational, but gained valuable experience as he took top-ranked Kollin Moore of Ohio State right to the end in a 3-2 loss. He won his first match over a ranked opponent with an 8-6 decision over No. 11 Kevin Beazley of Michigan on Feb. 2.

### RENTERIA A FORCE IN HUSKER LINEUP

• True freshman Jason Renteria didn't wrestle in a match in a Husker singlet until NU's Jan. 7 contest against Maryland, but has racked up three bonus-point wins on the way to an 8-4 record since. The Huskers hadn't won a match at 133 pounds through the first five duals of the year, but Renteria scored 22 dual points in seven appearances this season, and was the only Husker to wrestle at 133 to record a dual victory.

• Renteria scored a pin in 1:48 over Danny Bertoni of Maryland in his first varsity match on Jan. 7, before he took down his first ranked opponent in a 15-5 major decision over No. 19 Colin Valdiviez of Northwestern on Jan. 19. He scored another win over a ranked opponent in a 14-11 decision over returning NCAA qualifier and 17th-ranked Scott DelVecchio of Rutgers on Jan. 21. He pinned Logan Griffin of Michigan State in 1:29 on Feb. 4.

• Renteria was Nebraska's lone semifinalist at the Big Ten Championships, as he finished fifth at the conference meet.

### NEW CONTRIBUTORS RECORD FIRST DUAL WINS

• With six starters, including three All-Americans, lost to graduation from a season ago, Nebraska's starting lineup is dramatically different than it was a season ago.

• Twelve Huskers saw their first dual action of their careers in a Nebraska singlet this season, as Kris Williams (125), Mitchell Maginnis (125), Zak Hensley (133), Brian Peska (133), Jason Renteria (133), Chad Red Jr. (141), Johnny Blankenship (165), Isaiah White (165), Beau Breske (174), Taylor Venz (184), Eric Schultz (197) and Patrick Grayson (HWT) have each been inserted into Nebraska's dual lineup for the first time this season.

• Ten Huskers picked up their first dual wins of their careers this season, as Williams, White and Schultz each won by decision against Wyoming, while Venz and David Jensen (HWT) both won by technical falls in the Wyoming dual. Breske won his first dual match against North Carolina, while Maginnis and Renteria both earned their first dual wins against Maryland. Grayson was the latest Husker to pick up his first varsity win, as he earned a win in the Rutgers dual.

• In addition, NU faced nine teams on the slate currently ranked in the USA Today/NWCA Coaches Poll: Michigan (4th), NC State (6th), Wyoming (14th), Illinois (16th), Northwestern (17th), Rutgers (18th), Purdue (21st), Wisconsin (22nd) and North Carolina (24th).

• Colton McCrystal (149), Tyler Berger (157) and Taylor Venz (184) each took fourth place to lead a list of seven total placers while Nebraska wrapped up a fifth-place team finish with 72.5 team points at the Big Ten Championships at the Breslin Center.

• Freshman Jason Renteria took fifth at 133, while Chad Red Jr. (141), Isaiah White (165) and Eric Schultz (197) each placed seventh at their respective weight classes.

• Nebraska has finished in the top-five at the Big Ten Championships in three consecutive seasons, as well as four out of the last five.

• The fourth-seeded McCrystal advanced to the third-place match at 149 pounds after third-seeded Ryan Deakin of Northwestern took a medical forfeit. McCrystal fell in the third-place match to Ohio State's fifth-seeded Ke-Shawn Hayes for the second time in the tournament, this time by a 7-5 margin. McCrystal finished on the podium for the second time after placing third last season.

• Berger, seeded fifth at 157 pounds, was also the recipient of a medical forfeit in the consolation semifinals, as second-seeded Jason Nolf of Penn State dropped out of the tournament before Saturday's semifinals. In the third-place match, Berger dropped a 6-2 decision to sixth-seeded Andrew Crone of Wisconsin. Berger's fourth-place finish marks the third time he's finished on the podium at the Big Ten Championships, as he placed seventh in 2016 and third in 2017.

• At 184 pounds, the sixth-seeded Venz avenged an earlier loss in a dual meet this season to fourth-seeded Emery Parker, as he defeated Parker by a 9-4 decision. In the third-place match, Venz was defeated by third-seeded Domenic Abounader of Michigan by a 7-3 decision.

• In the fifth-place match at 133 pounds, fourth-seeded Jason Renteria won a 3-2 decision over fifth-seeded Scott DelVecchio of Rutgers, Renteria's second win over the Scarlet Knight grappler in the tournament and his third win against him this season.

• Chad Red Jr. sealed seventh place at 141 pounds in his first Big Ten Championships appearance with a 6-3 decision over Maryland's Ryan Diehl, Red's second victory over Diehl this season.

• Isaiah White, seeded eighth at 165 pounds, also claimed seventh in his first Big Ten appearance, as he evened the season series with sixth-seeded Nick Wanzek (Minnesota) up at a bout a piece with a 5-1 decision on Sunday.

• Eric Schultz, the eighth seed at 197 pounds, was another Husker to avenge an earlier loss, as he defeated seventh-seeded Zack Chakonis of Northwestern by a 3-1 decision in the first sudden-victory period in the seventh-place match.
