Restrooms: Restrooms are located in the North, East and West Stadium concourses, and South end zone. Facilities for the disabled are located under the North Stadium and in the Southeast corner.

Lost and Found: Lost and found is located in the East and West Stadium Concourses. Fans who find lost articles are asked to hand such articles to police officers or stadium security for delivery to lost and found. Both areas are open before and after the game. Lost and found articles will remain at the stadium until the end of the season. They may be claimed by calling (402) 472-1960. All found items may be disposed of at the end of the season if not claimed.

Please Retain Ticket Stubs: If you leave your seat at any time, keep your ticket stub as it designates section, row and seat number.

Telephones: Public phones are located at the concourse level of the East and West Stadiums, and under the South Stadium. The university operator number is (402) 472-7211.

Please Report any Discourtesy: Discourtesty can be reported to stadium personnel (event staff, gatemen, vendors, etc.) or the Athletic Events Office, One Memorial Stadium, (402) 472-1960.

Cameras and Portable Radios: Limited use of cameras is permitted. Game action may not be filmed. Consideration of other spectators is expected.


The Use of Intoxicating Liquors: Use of alcohol is prohibited in the stadium. Event staff and police officers have been instructed to refuse admission to ticket holders who are intoxicated.

Smoking: Smoking is NOT permitted in Memorial Stadium. Passout checks or stamps are available from gate attendants for those who wish to exit to smoke and re-enter the stadium. BOTH the ticket stub and passout check are required for re-admission.

Improperly Parked Vehicles: Or those found parked in a restricted area (driveways, No Parking Zones, grassy areas, etc.) will be towed away at the expense of the owner. Towed cars may be claimed by contacting the UNL Police Office, 300 North 17th Street.

First Aid Information: First Aid Stations are located in the Northwest concourse and in the Southeast corner of the stadium. They are managed by a Cardiac Care Team and Red Cross volunteers. Persons suffering sudden illness or injury should report to the closest usher, Red Cross volunteer, or police officer to guide or escort you. Companions of (or persons nearby) fans losing consciousness, or otherwise not ambulatory, should summon the nearest usher, Red Cross volunteer or police officer. They will procure medical help at once.

Husker Nation Pavilion: The Husker Nation Pavilion is located on the Ed Weir Track and Nebraska Soccer Field just outside of the northeast corner of Memorial Stadium. It opens three hours before kickoff of every home game and is free fun for the whole family. Fans can enter from either the south or west side of Ed Weir Track. Typical game-day activities at the Pavilion include a live band, kids zone, food vendors, athletic team autograph sessions and much more. Husker fans can also listen to the Husker Sports Network pregame radio broadcast, as Greg Sharpe, Adrian Fiala, Matt Davison and Lane Grindle broadcast live from the Pavilion before each game.

Prohibited Items

The University of Nebraska reserves the right to examine the contents of any container brought into the stadium. To protect the safety of our fans, players, officials and staff, the following items are prohibited:

- »Alcoholic beverages or controlled substances
- »Backpacks, large bags and coolers
- »Noise makers
- »Glass bottles and cans
- »Video cameras
- »Banners/flags on poles
- »Open umbrellas
- »Knives
- »Limited use of cameras and portable radios is permitted. Game action may not be filmed. Consideration of other spectators is expected.
- »With the passage of a concealed weapons law in the state of Nebraska, fans are reminded that concealed weapons are not allowed on the UNL campus and are prohibited at all collegiate sporting events.

Permissible Items

Fans can access the express entry lanes when entering the stadium with a jacket and tickets. Small purses and camera bags are also allowed in the stadium, but must be screened in the security check points.
