THE MATCHUP

• Nebraska moves into the postseason portion of this season's schedule, as the Huskers will test their place against some of the nation's best this Saturday and Sunday at the Big Ten Championships, held at the Breslin Center on the campus of Michigan State in East Lansing, Mich.

• Session I commences on Saturday at 9 a.m. CT (10 a.m. ET). Session II also slated for Saturday, will get started at 5 p.m. CT (6 p.m. ET). Both sessions Saturday will have a live stream available on BTN Plus and FloWrestling (subscription required for both).

• Sunday's action starts at 11 a.m. CT (noon ET) with Session III, which will be streamed on BTN Plus and FloWrestling. The championship finals in Session IV will begin at 2 p.m. CT (3 p.m. ET) and will be broadcast live on Big Ten Network.

• Live scoring and brackets for the entirety of the tournament will be available on TrackWrestling.

• Eight Huskers earned pre-seeds for the Big Ten Championships. Colton McCrystal (149), Chad Red Jr. (141) and Jason Renteria (133) each earned the fourth seed at their weight classes, while Tyler Berger was seeded fifth at 157. Taylor Venz is sixth at 184, while Isaiah White (8th at 165) and Eric Schultz (8th at 197) also earned top-eight seeds.

• Nebraska finished the dual season with a 10-4 record, including a 7-2 record in the Big Ten to finish tied for third in the conference dual meet standings. Nebraska ended the season by winning eight of nine duals, including each of the last three.

• **Last Time Out:** Nebraska closed out the regular season with a 23-14 win over Stanford on Feb. 16.

• **Up Next:** Qualifiers to the 2018 NCAA Championships will compete at the national tournament, held March 15-17 in Cleveland, Ohio.

Nebraska's lineup at this year's Big Ten Championships returns two placemen from last year's conference tournament. Both Colton McCrystal and Tyler Berger took third last season. Two other returning Huskers competed at last season's tournament, Dustin Williams and Collin Purinton, but neither is expected to compete this weekend.

With Nebraska's win over Stanford to close the dual season, the Huskers recorded double-digit wins in a season for the eighth consecutive season, and the 16th time in 18 seasons under Head Coach Mark Manning. The Huskers went 10-4 in dual competition this season.

With advance notice, telephone interviews can be arranged for other hours, depending on class and practice schedules. For interviews following competition, Nebraska wrestlers and coaches are generally available on the gym floor following a five-minute cooling-off period after the competition has concluded.

Colton McCrystal and Isaiah White were also ranked in the top-10 at their respective weights, as McCrystal is ninth at 149 and White is 10th at 165.
- Tyler Berger is 11th at 157 and Chad Red Jr. is 12th at 141. Jason Renteria, who was 19th at 133 in the Feb. 13 poll, dropped out of the rankings after a loss at Stanford.

SIX HUSKERS RANKED IN THIRD COACHES' PANEL, FIVE IN SECOND RPI RANKINGS

- Six Nebraska wrestlers were ranked in the third NCAA Division I Coaches' Panel Rankings, released Feb. 22. Tyler Berger and Taylor Venz were the highest ranked Huskers, coming in at eighth at 157 and 184 pounds, respectively. Colton McCrystal was ranked ninth at 149 pounds, while Chad Red Jr. (141) and Isaiah White (165) were both ranked 12th. Eric Schultz rounded out the list of Huskers in the rankings, as he came in at 30th at 197.
- Five were rated in the second RPI rankings, also released last Thursday, as both White and Venz were rated seventh, while Berger was eighth. Both Red and McCrystal came in at 10th in their respective weight classes.
- Wrestlers in each weight class will be measured by winning percentage, rating percentage index (RPI) and coaches' rankings to earn spots in their qualifying tournaments for the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships.

EIGHT HUSKERS RECEIVE BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS PRE-SEEDS

- Eight Nebraska wrestlers were pre-seeded by the conference's coaches at their weight classes ahead of the Big Ten Championships. Colton McCrystal (4th at 149), Chad Red Jr. (4th at 141) and Jason Renteria (4th at 133) each earned the highest pre-seeds for Nebraska, while Tyler Berger was seeded fifth at 157 to give the Huskers four with top-five seeds.
- Taylor Venz (6th at 184), Isaiah White (8th at 165), Eric Schultz (8th at 197) and Mitchell Maginnis (11th at 125) also received pre-seeds for the conference tournament.

HUSKERS BRING TALENT, BUT LACK OF EXPERIENCE, TO BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Nebraska graduated six starters from last year's team, and features eight first-time starters this season. Colton McCrystal (149) and Tyler Berger (157) are the only returning Huskers in this year's lineup with Big Ten Championships experience, which marks the lowest number of participants in last year's tournament expected to compete this season.
- Every other team in the Big Ten is expected to have at least four wrestlers who competed at the Big Ten Championships last season in their lineup in East Lansing. Four teams - Indiana, Minnesota, Ohio State and Wisconsin - could include as many as seven wrestlers who competed last year in their lineups.
- Both McCrystal (141 in 2017) and Berger (157) placed third at last season's Big Ten Championships.

NEBRASKA SECURES WIN NUMBER 700

• Nebraska's win over Wisconsin on Feb. 9 was its 700th win in dual meets all-time in program history. The Huskers now have a 701-555-29 (.557) record all-time in duals since 1910-11, following a win over Stanford on Feb. 16.

WHITE SHOWS CONSISTENCY IN FIRST SEASON AS A HUSKER

• Sophomore Isaiah White (165) is proving his place as one of the top wrestlers at his weight in the country in his first season in a Nebraska singlet. White went 11-2 in duals, a win total that led Nebraska starters, and is 20-4 overall, which is tied for the most wins among starters.

• White also led NU starters in dual points (46) and dual takedowns (44) and was taken down just twice in dual competition. He outscored his 13 dual opponents by a combined score of 120-46, not including pins in his matches against Maryland and Indiana.

• White has 10 wins by bonus points on the season, including three pins, three technical falls and four major decisions. He finished second at the Daktronics Open in November and defeated four ranked opponents to finish third at the Cliff Keen Invitational in December. His only losses are to top-12 opponents.

• White won the NCAA Division II title at 165 pounds last season for Notre Dame College (Ohio) before transferring to Nebraska last summer. He went 28-2 overall as a freshman.

VENZ STRONG DURING REDSHIRT FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

• Taylor Venz (184) has a team leading seven pins this season along with three technical falls and three major decisions on the year, including a 11-1 major decision over Shwan Shadaia of Michigan State on Feb. 4. He won a pair of decisions against Wisconsin and Stanford to close the dual season.

• At the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational, Venz burst on the scene with four pins on the first day of competition, including a pair in under 15 seconds and two more over top-eight opponents. Venz finished third at the tournament, as the previously unranked wrestler jumped to sixth in the next week's InterMat rankings.

• Half of Venz's 10 wins in dual matches have come by bonus points, as he has a pin, a technical fall and three major decisions.

EXPERIENCED PAIR LEADS THE WAY

• Tyler Berger (157) and Colton McCrystal (149) are Nebraska's two returning NCAA qualifiers from last season, and led the Huskers to a 10-2 team record with a combined record of 16-3 with nine bonus-point wins in NU's 12 duals in the 2018 calendar year.

• Berger, an All-American at 157 pounds a season ago, is 18-6 this season with seven of his wins against ranked wrestlers. He won the Daktronics Open and finished fourth at the Cliff Keen Invitational. He defeated 2017 All-American Paul Fox of Stanford by a 3-2 decision on Feb. 16.

• McCrystal, who qualified for the NCAA Championships at 141 pounds last season, moved up to 149 this year and is 17-3 on the year with three wins over ranked opponents. He went 10-2 in duals this season, with bonus points in five of his last seven matches. His only two dual losses were to wrestlers that were ranked fourth at the time, Troy Heilmann of North Carolina and Ryan Deakin of Northwestern. McCrystal pinned Jake Barry of Stanford in 41 seconds on Feb. 16.

REDSHIRT FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

• Four redshirt freshmen, Chad Red Jr. (141), Beau Breske (174), Taylor Venz (184) and Eric Schultz (197) have become strong forces in Nebraska's starting lineup this season.

• Red is 18-7 on the season and has won his last three matches. Three of his seven losses have come to current No. 1 Bryce Meredith of Wyoming and No. 5 Kevin Jack of NC State, all by decision.

• Venz leads starters in pins (7) and has defeated four top-11 opponents.

• Schultz is 15-7 on the year with four of his losses coming to top-10 opponents. He did not place at the Cliff Keen Invitational, but gained valuable experience as he took top-ranked Kollin Moore of Ohio State right to the end in a 3-2 loss. He won his first match over a ranked opponent with an 8-6 decision over No. 11 Kevin Beazley of Michigan on Feb. 2.

• Beau Breske has also been featured in the lineup since early December, and is 9-10 on the year with a win over a ranked opponent at the Cliff Keen Invitational. He notched his first dual win over Adis Radoncic of North Carolina, and followed it up with a pair of wins against Illinois and Maryland.

• Renteria scored a pin in 1:48 over Danny Bertoni of Maryland in his first varsity match on Jan. 7, before he took down his first ranked opponent in a 15-5 major decision over No. 19 Colin Valdiviez of Northwestern on Jan. 19. He scored another win over a ranked opponent in a 14-11 decision over returning NCAA qualifier and 17th-ranked Scott DelVecchio of Rutgers on Jan. 21. He pinned Logan Griffin of Michigan State in 1:29 on Feb. 4.

NEW CONTRIBUTORS RECORD FIRST DUAL WINS

• With six starters, including three All-Americans, lost to graduation from a season ago, Nebraska's starting lineup is dramatically different than it was a season ago.

• Twelve Huskers saw their first dual action of their careers in a Nebraska singlet this season, as Kris Williams (125), Mitchell Maginnis (125), Zak Hensley (133), Brian Peska (133), Jason Renteria (133), Chad Red Jr. (141), Johnny Blankenship (165), Isaiah White (165), Beau Breske (174), Taylor Venz (184), Eric Schultz (197) and Patrick Grayson (HWT) have each been inserted into Nebraska's dual lineup for the first time this season.

• Ten Huskers picked up their first dual wins of their careers this season, as Williams, White and Schultz each won by decision against Wyoming, while Venz and David Jensen (HWT) both won by technical falls in the Wyoming dual. Breske won his first dual match against North Carolina, while Maginnis and Renteria both earned their first dual wins against Maryland. #14 NEBRASKA 23, STANFORD 14

Feb. 16, Stanford, Calif.

• Colton McCrystal (149) and Isaiah White (165) won bonus points for Nebraska in two of the first three matches, and the 14th-ranked Cornhuskers held off a late Stanford rally to win a 23-14 decision Feb. 16 at Maples Pavilion.

• Nebraska closes the dual season with a record of 10-4, as the Huskers, winners of eight of nine duals, reach double-digit wins in duals for the eighth-consecutive season and the 16th time in 18 seasons under Head Coach Mark Manning. Stanford falls to 7-5 on the year.

• Ninth-ranked McCrystal got the Huskers started with a pin in less than a minute, as he put Jake Barry on his back in 41 seconds for his quickest pin of the season. McCrystal improves to 17-3 overall and 10-2 in duals, as he earned his 30th-career win in dual meets.

• Tyler Berger continued the Husker momentum, as he rebounded from an early deficit for a 3-2 decision over All-American Paul Fox, aided by a second-period rideout. The 11th-ranked Berger has won eight of his last 10 duals and is 18-6 on the year and 9-4 in duals.

• White found bonus points for the Big Red at 165 pounds, as he racked up seven takedowns and a pair of nearfalls to cruise to a 21-5 technical fall over Jared Hill in just 3:17. White, ranked 10th by InterMat, has now accumulated 44 takedowns in dual meets, and has been taken down just twice as he improves to 11-2 in duals and 20-4 overall.

• Seventh-ranked Taylor Venz also joined the 20-win club on Friday, as he was tough on top in the third period to seal a 7-3 decision over Austin Flores. Venz scored a pair of takedowns and a reversal in the bout, and is now 20-5 on the year and 10-4 in duals.

• With Nebraska leading 17-5 at halftime, Eric Schultz picked up right where the Huskers left off, as the redshirt freshman won a 9-4 decision over Cole DePasquale to improve to 15-7 on the season and 10-4 in duals.

• Heading into the final bout of the night, NU clung to a 20-14 lead, but Chad Red Jr. stamped out Stanford's glimmer of hope with a 7-2 decision over Isaiah Locsin to clinch the dual for Nebraska.

• Stanford's two ranked wrestlers picked up wins Saturday, as ninth-ranked Keaton Subject won an 18-3 technical fall over Eric Engler at 174 pounds, and eighth-ranked Nathan Butler defeated David Jensen by a 7-3 decision.

• After Butler's win, the Cardinal won bouts at 125 and 133 for a 9-0 scoring run before Red clinched the dual. At 125 pounds, Stanford's Gabriel Townsell won a 10-4 decision over Mitchell Maginnis, while Mason Pengilly scored a takedown and a four-point nearfall in the first sudden-victory period for a 7-1 win over No. 19 Jason Renteria.
