### THE MATCHUP

- No. 14 Nebraska travels to Stanford to close out the dual season this Friday, as the Cornhuskers look to reach the 10-win mark in duals for the eighth consecutive season and the 16th time in 18 seasons under Head Coach Mark Manning.
- Friday night's dual at Stanford is set to begin at 9 p.m. (CT)/7 p.m. (PT). It will be televised on Pac-12 Bay Area, with a live stream available at Pac-12.com with a cable subscription to Pac-12 Network.
- Nebraska enters Friday with a record of 9-4 on the season after taking down No. 20 Wisconsin by a score of 24-10 last Friday, as the Huskers closed the Big Ten schedule with a 7-2 record.
- Six Huskers are ranked in this week's InterMat rankings, led by seventh-ranked Taylor Venz at 184 pounds. Colton McCrystal and Isaiah White join him in the top-10 at their respective weight classes, as McCrystal is ninth at 149, while White is 10th at 165. Tyler Berger is 11th at 157, while Chad Red Jr. is 13th at 141 and Jason Renteria is 19th at 133.
- Stanford is 7-4 on the season and 3-1 in the Pac-12 after defeating Oregon State by a score of 21-15 last Saturday. Stanford is led by 10th-year head coach Jason Borrelli, and two Cardinal wrestlers are ranked in this week's InterMat poll.
- **Last Time Out:** Nebraska defeated No. 20 Wisconsin by a score of 24-10. David Jensen won by pin, while six Huskers won decisions as NU won seven of the 10 matches.
- **Up Next:** Nebraska will have a week off from competition before the 2018 Big Ten Championships, held March 3-4 in East Lansing, Mich.

Nebraska sophomore Isaiah White became the first Husker to reach the 10-win mark in duals with a 6-3 decision over No. 6 Evan Wick of Wisconsin last Friday. White also leads Nebraska with 41 dual points scored, as well as 37 takedowns in dual competition. He has been taken down just twice in duals this season.

Senior Colton McCrystal is looking to join the 10-win club in duals this season, but he is also looking to win his 30th career dual, as he sits at 29-14 in duals in his career and 9-2 this season. McCrystal is second among active Huskers with his 29 career dual wins.

### SIX HUSKERS RANKED BY INTERMAT

- Six Nebraska wrestlers were ranked in this week's InterMat rankings, released Tuesday. Taylor Venz was the highest ranked Husker, coming in at seventh at 184 pounds. Colton McCrystal and Isaiah White were also ranked in the top-10 at their respective weights, as McCrystal is ninth at 149 and White is 10th at 165.

- Tyler Berger is 11th at 157 and Chad Red Jr. is 13th at 141, while Jason Renteria is 19th at 133 pounds.

### SIX HUSKERS RANKED IN SECOND COACHES' PANEL, RPI RANKINGS

- Six Nebraska wrestlers were ranked in the second NCAA Division I Coaches' Panel Rankings, released last Thursday. Taylor Venz was the highest ranked Husker, coming in at seventh at 184 pounds. Tyler Berger joined him in the top 10, as he was rated eighth at 157. Colton McCrystal was ranked 11th at 149 pounds, while Chad Red Jr. (141) and Isaiah White (165) were ranked 12th. Eric Schultz rounded out the list of Huskers in the rankings, as he came in at 24th at 197.

- The same six were rated in the initial RPI rankings, also released Thursday, as Berger was ranked fifth, while White and Venz were ranked sixth. McCrystal was ranked ninth, while Red was 12th and Schultz was rated 26th.

- Wrestlers in each weight class will be measured by winning percentage, rating percentage index (RPI) and coaches' rankings to earn spots in their qualifying tournaments for the 2018 NCAA Division I Wrestling Championships. The coaches' rankings are compiled by a vote of coaches representing each qualifying tournament. For ranking purposes, coaches may only consider a wrestler that has been designated as a starter at a respective weight class. To be eligible for the rankings, wrestlers must have participated in at least five matches against Division I opponents in the weight class and have wrestled within the last 30 days.

### NEBRASKA SECURES WIN NUMBER 700

- Nebraska's win over Wisconsin last Friday was its 700th win in dual meets all-time in program history. The Huskers now have a 700-555-29 (.556) record all-time in duals since 1910-11.

### WHITE SHOWS CONSISTENCY IN FIRST SEASON AS A HUSKER

- Sophomore Isaiah White (165) is proving his place as one of the top wrestlers at his weight in the country in his first season in a Nebraska singlet. White is 10-2 in duals, a win total that leads Nebraska starters.

- White also leads NU starters in dual points (41) and dual takedowns (37) and has been taken down just twice in dual competition. He has outscored his 12 dual opponents by a combined score of 99-41, not including pins in his matches against Maryland and Indiana.

- White has nine wins by bonus points on the season, including two pins, three technical falls and four major decisions. He finished second at the Daktronics Open in November and defeated four ranked opponents to finish third at the Cliff Keen Invitational in December. His only losses are to top-12 opponents.

- White won the NCAA Division II title at 165 pounds last season for Notre Dame College (Ohio) before transferring to Nebraska last summer. He went 28-2 overall as a freshman.

### VENZ STRONG DURING REDSHIRT FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

- Taylor Venz (184) has a team leading seven pins this season along with three technical falls and three major decisions on the year, including a 11-1 major decision over Shwan Shadaia of Michigan State on Feb. 4. He defeated No. 9 Ricky Robertson of Wisconsin by a 12-7 decision last Friday.

- At the Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational, Venz burst on the scene with four pins on the first day of competition, including a pair in under 15 seconds and two more over top-eight opponents. Venz finished third at the tournament, as the previously unranked wrestler jumped to sixth in the next week's InterMat rankings.

- Five of Venz's eight wins in dual matches have come by bonus points, as he has a pin, a technical fall and three major decisions.

## LAST TIME OUT

### #15 NEBRASKA 24, #20 WISCONSIN 10 Feb. 9, Madison, Wis.

- David Jensen (HWT) earned his second dual pin of the year, while six Huskers won decisions, as 15th-ranked Nebraska won seven of 10 matches on the way to a 24-10 win over 20th-ranked Wisconsin on Friday night at the UW Field House.

- The win Friday night marked the 700th win in program history, as NU's all-time record is now 700-555-29 since first fielding a program in 1910-11.

- Nebraska closes the Big Ten dual slate with a 7-2 record, as the Cornhuskers have now won seven of eight duals to run their record to 9-4 overall. Wisconsin drops to 6-3 and 3-3 in the league with the loss.

- Isaiah White got the Huskers started with a win in one of the marquee matchups of the night, as he scored takedowns in the first and third periods and hung on for a 6-3 win over No. 6 Evan Wick. With the win, White improves to 19-4 on the year, and 10-2 in duals as he becomes the first Husker to hit the 10-win mark in duals this season.

- Another ranked matchup went the way of the Huskers at 184 pounds, as No. 7 Taylor Venz won a battle of top-10 wrestlers over No. 9 Ricky Robertson. Robertson was in control for most of the match, and led 6-3 heading into the third period, but Venz scored a late takedown and a pair of nearfalls to win a 12-7 decision for his second win over the Badger grappler this season.

- Heavyweight David Jensen gave the Huskers control of the match heading into halftime, as he turned an attempt by Ben Stone into a Husker pin, as Jensen earned a fall in 1:33. The pin was Jensen's second in a dual this season, and the fastest of his three falls overall on the year.

- NU picked up right where it left off as the lineup turned over to the lower weights out of intermission, as Mitchell Maginnis (125), Jason Renteria (133), Chad Red Jr. (141) and Colton McCrystal (149) won decisions for the Huskers to put the dual out of reach.

- Maginnis, a senior from Grand Island, Neb., won a 5-2 decision over Johnny Jimenez with a second-period reversal and a third-period takedown to earn his second Big Ten dual win of the season.

- Renteria was dominant throughout the 133-pound match, won an 11-4 decision over Jens Lantz with five takedowns and a riding-time point, as he improves to 5-1 on the season.

- Red won his third match in a row and his fifth in the last six, as he defeated Eli Stickley by a 6-3 decision.

- No. 10 McCrystal improved to 16-3 and 9-2 in duals with a 7-4 decision over Cole Martin.

- Wisconsin won decisions at 174 and 197, as well as a major decision at 157.

## BACK POINTS

### EXPERIENCED PAIR LEADS THE WAY

• Tyler Berger (157) and Colton McCrystal (149) are Nebraska's two returning NCAA qualifiers from last season, and led the Huskers to a 9-2 record in the Big Ten with a combined record of 14-3 with eight bonus-point wins in NU's 11 Big Ten duals.

• Berger, an All-American at 157 pounds a season ago, is 17-6 this season with seven of his wins against ranked wrestlers. He won the Daktronics Open and finished fourth at the Cliff Keen Invitational.

• McCrystal, who qualified for the NCAA Championships at 141 pounds last season, moved up to 149 this year and is 16-3 on the year with three wins over ranked opponents. He is 9-2 in duals this season, with bonus points in four of his last six matches. His only two dual losses are to wrestlers that were ranked fourth at the time, Troy Heilmann of North Carolina and Ryan Deakin of Northwestern. McCrystal defeated Cole Martin of Wisconsin by a 7-4 decision last Friday.

### REDSHIRT FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

• Four redshirt freshmen, Chad Red Jr. (141), Beau Breske (174), Taylor Venz (184) and Eric Schultz (197) have become strong forces in Nebraska's starting lineup this season.

• Red is 17-7 on the season and has won his last three matches. Three of his seven losses have come to current No. 1 Bryce Meredith of Wyoming and No. 2 Kevin Jack of NC State, all by decision.

• Venz leads starters in pins (7) and has defeated four top-11 opponents.

• Schultz is 14-7 on the year with four of his losses coming to top-10 opponents. He did not place at the Cliff Keen Invitational, but gained valuable experience as he took top-ranked Kollin Moore of Ohio State right to the end in a 3-2 loss. He won his first match over a ranked opponent with an 8-6 decision over No. 11 Kevin Beazley of Michigan on Feb. 2.

• Beau Breske has also been featured in the lineup since early December, and is 9-10 on the year with a win over a ranked opponent at the Cliff Keen Invitational. He notched his first dual win over Adis Radoncic of North Carolina, and followed it up with a pair of wins against Illinois and Maryland.

### RENTERIA A FORCE IN HUSKER LINEUP

• True freshman Jason Renteria didn't wrestle in a match in a Husker singlet until NU's Jan. 7 contest against Maryland, but has racked up three bonus-point wins on the way to a 5-1 record since. The Huskers hadn't won a match at 133 pounds through the first five duals of the year, but Renteria has scored 22 dual points in six appearances since.

• Renteria scored a pin in 1:48 over Danny Bertoni of Maryland in his first varsity match on Jan. 7, before he took down his first ranked opponent in a 15-5 major decision over No. 19 Colin Valdiviez of Northwestern on Jan. 19. He scored another win over a ranked opponent in a 14-11 decision over returning NCAA qualifier and 17th-ranked Scott DelVecchio of Rutgers on Jan. 21. He pinned Logan Griffin of Michigan State in 1:29 on Feb. 4.

### NEW CONTRIBUTORS RECORD FIRST DUAL WINS

• With six starters, including three All-Americans, lost to graduation from a season ago, Nebraska's starting lineup is dramatically different than it was a season ago.

• Twelve Huskers have seen their first dual action of their careers in a Nebraska singlet this season, as Kris Williams (125), Mitchell Maginnis (125), Zak Hensley (133), Brian Peska (133), Jason Renteria (133), Chad Red Jr. (141), Johnny Blankenship (165), Isaiah White (165), Beau Breske (174), Taylor Venz (184), Eric Schultz (197) and Patrick Grayson (HWT) have each been inserted into Nebraska's dual lineup for the first time this season.

• Ten Huskers picked up their first dual wins of their careers so far this season, as Williams, White and Schultz each won by decision against Wyoming, while Venz and David Jensen (HWT) both won by technical falls in the Wyoming dual. Breske won his first dual match against North Carolina, while Maginnis and Renteria both earned their first dual wins against Maryland. Grayson is the latest Husker to pick up his first varsity win, as he earned a win in the Rutgers dual.

### HUSKERS WORKING THROUGH TOUGH SCHEDULE
