Camp Goals

The primary purpose of the Doc Sadler Basketball Camps is to learn more about the game of basketball, have fun and make new friends. Camp staff will work to develop and improve each camper's basketball skills while promoting sportsmanship.

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Little Dribblers Camp *(boys and girls, ages 5-8)*

This camp has an emphasis on the fundamentals of the game and is geared toward younger children.

Dates: Monday, June 13 - Thursday, June 16

Time: 10 a.m. to Noon

Cost: \$75 per person

Half-Day Camp *(boys and girls, ages 8-18)*

This camp has an emphasis on developing the basic fundamentals of basketball - shooting, dribbling, passing and defense. The camp includes instruction, drills, contests and daily 5-on-5 team games. Players are grouped according to age, height and ability level.

Dates: Monday, June 13 - Thursday, June 16

Time: 1:30 to 5 p.m.

Cost: \$150 per person

Overnight Camp *(ages 8-18)*

This camp will offer instruction by Coach Sadler and his coaching staff to improve each camper's basketball techniques. All basic basketball principles will be emphasized to improve each camper. Camp will also include daily 5-on-5 team games. Campers can choose to stay in the dorm or be a commuter.

Dates: Sunday, June 26 - Wednesday, June 29

Time: All day

Cost: \$295 per person for dorm campers; \$225 per person for commuter campers

Day Camp *(boys and girls, ages 8-18)*

This camp has an emphasis on developing the basic fundamentals of basketball - shooting, dribbling, passing and defense. The camp includes instruction, drills, contests and daily 5-on-5 team games. Players are grouped according to age, height and ability level.

Dates: Monday, July 25 - Thursday, July 28

Time: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Cost: \$225 per person (lunch provided)

Ballhandling & Shooting Clinic *(boys and girls, ages 8-18)*

This clinic focuses on the offensive fundamentals of the game. Shooting, dribbling and passing techniques will be taught to each camper.

Date: Friday, July 29

Time: 9 a.m. to Noon

Cost: \$50 per person

Post Player Specialty Clinic *(boys and girls, ages 8-18)*

This camp will focus on improving post play, including offensive techniques.

Date: Friday, July 29

Time: 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Cost: \$50 per person
