A NEBRASKA SPRING TRADITION



Nebraska's annual Red-White Spring Game has become a major attraction and shows the dedication of Husker Nation. The Huskers had 77,670 fans at the 2009 Spring Game. In the past five years, more than 375,000 fans have flocked to Memorial Stadium to watch NU's final practice of the spring.

Nebraska's attendance of 77,670 at the 2009 spring game was 33,000 more than any other Big 12 school and 16,000 more fans than the other five Big 12 North schools combined.
