## About Oklahoma State

Oklahoma State is 12-5 this season, including a 1-2 mark in Big 12 play after falling to Missouri at home on Wednesday. The Cowboys are currently ranked 31st in the ratings percentage index according to CollegeRPI.com, including the seventh-toughest strength of schedule. James Anderson leads all scorers with his 17.9 points per game average and is shooting 50.8 percent from the floor. Obi Muonelo is chipping in 15.9 points per game and grabbing a team-leading 9.8 boards per contest. Terrel Harris is averaging 14.7 points and shooting 45.6 percent from long range. Byron Eaton is averaging 13.7 points and 5.8 assists per game. Freshman Keiton Page is averaging 10.2 points per game off the bench. As a team, Oklahoma State leads the Big 12 with 86 points per game as well as 10.6 treys per game and a 42 percent shooting average from beyond the arc.

## About Nebraska

Nebraska is 12-5 overall this season and 2-2 in Big 12 Conference action following a 72-61 loss at Oklahoma on Wednesday night. NU is No. 70 in the CollegeRPI.com ratings. The Huskers are led by a pair of senior guards Steve Harley is averaging 12.2 points per game while Ade Dagunduro is chipping in 10.6 points per contest. Those two have started every game for NU. As a

team, the Huskers' defense leads the Big 12, allowing just 56.8 points per contest. The Nebraska offense, however, ranks among the bottom of the league at 66.6 percent. NU is second in the league in steals (9.1 spg) and averages the fewest turnovers in the Big 12 at just 11.6 per game.

## Quick Notes

Byron Eaton needs one assist to become the first player in school history to record 100 assists in each of his four seasons ... OSU's team rankings nationally: second in three-point field-goal percentage, third three-pointers made per game and fourth in scoring offense ... through 17 games, the Cowboys have scored 90 or more points on seven occasions, tying for the second most in school history (2006-07); OSU reached 90 or more points eight times in 1988-89 and 1989-90 ... Chris Croft, the director of operations at Nebraska, was an administrative assistant at Oklahoma State from 1996-98.

## Up Next

The Cowboys host the Oklahoma Sooners (18-1, 4-0) in Bedlam action on Monday, Jan. 26 at 8 p.m. in an ESPN televised game. OSU will travel to College Station, Texas, next weekend to take on the Texas A&M Aggies (15-4, 1-3) on Saturday, Jan. 31, at 1 p.m. in a game televised by ESPN.

# Oklahoma State Cowboy Basketball

## Last Time vs. Nebraska

Oklahoma State made 33 trips to the free-throw line and made 24 as the Cowboys defeated Nebraska 77-63 last season in Stillwater. Byron Eaton scored 20 points while Marcus Dove added 17 and Obi Muonelo added 12. The victory negated a double-double by Husker Aleks Maric who had 17 points and 12 boards. Both teams shot at least 50 percent from the floor, but NU struggled from long range, connecting on just 3 of 12 from beyond the arc. The Huskers also outrebounded the Cowboys 31-24, but committed 19 turnovers. It was the last of five-straight wins for Oklahoma State.

## Series with Nebraska

Nebraska leads the all-time series with Oklahoma State 62-51 including a 35-13 mark in Lincoln. The Cowboys hold a slim 7-6 lead in the series since the Big 12 formed, including a win in the 2007 Big 12 Tournament. OSU has dropped the last two in the Devaney Center, having won four of the last eight games played in Lincoln. Oklahoma State has won the last two meetings, holding the Huskers to an average of just 51 points per game.

# Oklahoma State Cowboy Basketball

## Long-Range Sharpshooters

This season, Oklahoma State is averaging more than 25 attempts from beyond the three-point arc every game, nearly four more per game than the school record of 21.5 set last season. However, this year's Cowboys are connecting at a much higher rate at 42 percent, the third-highest in school history. The Pokes are making 10.59 treys per contest, three more per game than the school record of 7.59 per contest in 1993-94. The group of Terrel Harris, James Anderson, Obi Muonelo and Keiton Page are shooting 44 percent (157-of-357) from behind the three-point line this season. Only four times since the three-point line was added prior to the 1986-87 season has OSU shot 40 percent or better for an entire season.

## Three-Point Chart

Terrel Harris became the 16th player in school history to connect on 100 career three-point shots with two against North Texas. Obi Muonelo became No. 17 with eight at Corpus Christi. James Anderson became the 18th player in school history with 100 or more three-pointers made with two against Arkansas State. With two treys at Baylor, Byron Eaton became the 19th player to reach the century mark. Muonelo currently sits in 10th place on the career treys made list with 129 and needs just two to move into eighth place. Harris is in 12th place with 122. Anderson is in 14th place with 111, and Eaton is 18th with 101. It marks the first time in school history that four different players on the same squad each have 100 or more career three-pointers made. Interestingly, 10 of the 15 other players who have reached the century mark didn't play four years at OSU. Baylor is the only other team in the Big 12 that has four current players with 100 or more career three-pointers.

## Balanced Scoring

Oklahoma State has four different players ranked in the top 20 of the Big 12 Conference in scoring. James Anderson is fourth, Obi Muonelo ninth, Terrel Harris 14th and Byron Eaton is 17th. Muonelo and Anderson also both rank in the top 20 in rebounding. OSU also has four players who rank in the top 10 in the league in three-point percentage. # Oklahoma State Cowboy Basketball

## Improved Ball Handling

Oklahoma State's ball handling has definitely improved this season. Last year, OSU had 482 turnovers, an average of 14.6 per game. So far this season, the Cowboys have 223 through 17 games, an average of 13.1 per game. Entering Big 12 play last season, OSU had a 0.56 assist-to-turnover ratio. This year, that ratio had improved dramatically to 1.17. This is further shown by the improvement with the guards. Here is a look at the four returning guards with significant playing time and their ratios from last year and though 17 games this year:

## Rebounding Guards

With a lack of size along the frontline for the Cowboys, Oklahoma State must rely on its guards for rebounding purposes. So far, they've lived up to that need. Through 17 games, OSU's top three rebounders are all guards. Obi Muonelo — who has moved to more of a guard/forward position but is guard height at 6-5 — leads the Cowboys with 9.8 rebounds per game, including nine double-figure rebounding contests. James Anderson (6-6) is second on the team with 94 rebounds, including a career-high nine against Rhode Island, and Terrel Harris (6-5) is third on the squad with 83 rebounds and a career-high nine against Northwestern State. Not since the 2000-01 season has a guard averaged at least 6.5 rebounds over the course of a season. That year, Maurice Baker (6-1) recorded 202 rebounds over 30 games, an average of 6.7 boards per contest. Should a guard lead the team in rebounding, it would mark the first time in school history since rebounds were kept during the 1951-52 season.

## More on Muonelo's Boards

Obi Muonelo's rebounding average of 9.8 boards per contest is the highest by a Cowboy in 14 seasons. The last time an OSU player averaged more than nine rebounds throughout the course of a season was in 1994-95 when Bryant Reeves grabbed 9.5 boards per contest. Muonelo currently ranks second only to Oklahoma's Blake Griffin in the Big 12 rebounding category.

## Eaton Steals Leader

Senior point guard Byron Eaton is the all-time school leader for career steals with 233. He surpassed the previous record of 170, held by Ivan McFarlin, in his junior year. With two steals against Arkansas State, Eaton tied Oklahoma's Hollis Price for fifth place on the Big 12 Conference's career steals list. He has since moved into sole possession of fifth. Another 15 steals will move him past Kansas' Russell Robinson and into fourth place. Here is a look at Eaton's rank among the league's career steals leaders:

## Eaton One of Top Assist Men

With four assists against Texas A&M, senior point guard Byron Eaton moved past Matt Clark and into second place on the school career assists list. He now has 445 career assists ranking only behind former Cowboy Doug Gottlieb's school-record 793. Eaton needs more than 30 assists to rank in the Big 12's top 10. ## Sophomore Sensation

Sophomore James Anderson scored the second-most points (438) by a Cowboy freshman in school history a year ago, trailing only Richard Dumas' 521 points in 1987-88. Anderson already ranks among the top sophomores in school history. Only Bryant Reeves and Byron Houston had a higher scoring average their sophomore years than what Anderson is currently achieving.

## Against the Others

Sophomore James Anderson is very comparable to some of the top players that have come through the Cowboy program. He is the fourth-fastest to 500 points in school history, reaching that mark in his 37th game. Richard Dumas made it in his 29th game, while Matt Clark reached 500 points in his 34th game and Byron Houston in his 36th contest. Anderson was also the fourth-fastest to 700 points. Through his first 50 games, Anderson trails just Richard Dumas and Matt Clark for the most points by a Cowboy sophomore. ## Other Sophs Stepping Up

With the departure of center Ibrahima Thomas, sophomores Malcolm Kirkland have been asked to step up their roles this season. Marshall Moses had the biggest game of his career against Texas A&M when he recorded career highs in points (15) and rebounds (13) en route to his first-career double-double. His 13 boards were just two shy of his season total up to that point and are the most by a Cowboy sophomore since Ivan McFarlin grabbed 14 against Missouri in the Big 12 Tournament on March 14, 2003. Moses had 23 points prior to his performance against the Aggies. He also had 11 rebounds against Missouri.

A transfer from Arkansas-Fort Smith who only spent one season at junior college, Kirkland scored 10 points in each of his first two starts. At Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, he scored 10 points, all in the second half, on 4-of-4 shooting from the floor and 2-of-2 from the free-throw line. Against Mercer, he scored 10 points — again, all in the second period — on 3-of-6 shooting from the field and 4-of-4 from the charity stripe. In those two halves, Kirkland was 7-of-9 from the floor and 6-of-6 from the free-throw line. He was 1-of-12 previously from the floor.

## Freshman Fitting In

Freshman guard Keiton Page has been the Cowboys' most consistent player coming off the bench this season. The rookie from Pawnee, Okla., is averaging more than 23 minutes per game and making the most of his court time. Keiton is averaging 10.2 points per game along with 1.6 assists and 1.5 rebounds per contest. He is shooting 50 percent from the floor, including 44.3 percent from long range and 62.9 percent from inside the arc. Keiton ranks fifth in the Big 12 in three-point percentage and 12th in treys made per game. He's also connected on 25-of-31 shots from the charity stripe, good for an 80.6 shooting percentage.

During a 3-1/2 minute span in the first half against Mercer, Page scored 11-straight points for the Cowboys. With OSU struggling to score and only up 16-12 at the 12-minute mark, Page took the ball away from Mercer's Mark Hall and got a fast-break layup. With 8:47 to go in the first period, Page had scored 11-straight points and OSU was leading the Bears, 27-12. During the span, he made two layups, two three-pointers and a free throw on a four-point play.

At Baylor, Keiton hit the biggest shot of his young collegiate career. With Byron Eaton fouled out and 10 seconds left in the game, Page took the ball and hit a three-pointer with 4.5 seconds remaining in regulation to put the Cowboys up by one.

# Oklahoma State Cowboy Basketball

## National Rankings

The NCAA released its updated national rankings on Tuesday, and Oklahoma State appears among the best in the country in several categories. The Cowboys are second nationally in three-point field goal percentage behind California's 47.3 percent. The Pokes rank third in three-point field goals made per game and fourth in scoring offense. On the other end, OSU ranks among the teams most prone to fouling, ranking 310th in personal fouls per game.

Individually, James Anderson ranks 12th nationally in three-point field-goal percentage while Obi Muonelo ranks 20th in the same category. Byron Eaton ranks in the top 20 in both assists per game (17th) and steals per contest (19th). Anderson ranks 60th nationally free-throw percentage, 68th in points per game, 70th in three-pointers made per game and 79th in field-goal percentage. Muonelo ranks 20th in three-point percentage, 23rd in rebounds per game and 27th in treys per contest.

## Head Coach Travis Ford

Travis Ford is in his first season as the head man for the Oklahoma State Cowboys. He is the 17th head coach at OSU and will be in charge as the Cowboys begin their second century of basketball. Ford has spent a total of 11 seasons as a head coach at either the Division I or II level and has mastered the art of generating successful programs. He began his career at Campbellsville and after a 16-17 mark in his initial season, he resurrected the team to a 28-3 record the following season. It took a few more years after he took over at Eastern Kentucky, but by his fifth season, the Colonels won 22 games and made an NCAA Tournament appearance. Then, at UMass, he went 13-15 his initial season before back-to-back 20-win seasons the past two years. Ford has compiled a 202-151 overall record as a head coach, including a 135-120 mark at the Division I level.

## Cowboys in the NBA

Desmond Mason, a first-round pick of the Seattle Supersonics in 2000, is currently a member of the Oklahoma City Thunder. Entering 2008-09, he has played in 599 games in eight NBA seasons. Tony Allen, a first-round draft pick in 2004, is in his fifth year with the Boston Celtics. The world champion has played in 236 career games, including 72 starts going into this season. Joey Graham, a first-round pick of the Toronto Raptors in 2005, is in his fourth season with the Raptors. He has 197 career games played with 48 starts entering 2008-09. Stephen Graham is in his fourth season in the NBA and is currently with the Indiana Pacers.

## Graduation Success Rate

Oklahoma State's men's basketball team had a GSR of 92, by far the highest rate in the Big 12 Conference. The national average for men's basketball was 62 percent. Four Big 12 schools finished higher than the national average. In the last eight years, 25 former Cowboys have earned their college degree from OSU. 20 of those players have graduated in the last five years, including three former Pokes who returned to OSU and completed their degrees after playing basketball professionally for several years.

## Academic Progress Rate

Oklahoma State had the second-highest Academic Progress Rate in the Big 12 Conference for the 2006-07 academic year, released during the summer by the NCAA. This report is based on APR information submitted by member institutions for the 2004-05, 2005-06 and 2006-07 academic years. The Cowboys' APR of 957 is much higher than the Division I basketball average of 932 and the average of 918 for public institutions. Here is a look at the Big 12 school:

# Oklahoma State Cowboy Basketball

## All-Decade Teams

As Oklahoma State celebrates the 100th season of Cowboy Basketball, we have put together a list of the top players from each decade. The first two were released in the first game program, looking at the eras from 1907-19 and 1920-29. Here is a look at those teams:

### 1950-59

The 1950s were probably one of the most volatile decades in the history of Aggie Basketball. The era started with a 29-6 record in 1950-51 and a second-place finish in the final Associated Press poll, Oklahoma A&M's first-ever final ranking. The Pokes had three more top-10 finishes over the next five seasons until 1954-55, when Oklahoma A&M had its first losing season under Henry Iba at 12-13. Four years later in 1958-59, Oklahoma State joined what became the Big Eight Conference, leaving the Missouri Valley after 32 years. It was also the end of the Oklahoma A&M Aggies and the start of the Oklahoma State Cowboys.

Included in this decade was the career of OSU's second great big man, Bob Mattick, who was an All-American in 1953 and 1954. Arlen Clark joined Mattick as a two-time All-American in 1958 and '59. Don Johnson, Gale McArthur and Mel Wright joined the All-America ranks during this decade as well.

Some other players from this era made their name later in life in the basketball world and deserved some honorable mention. Eddie Sutton, the long-time coach at Arkansas, Kentucky and eventually Oklahoma State, played for the Cowboys from 1956-59. Don Haskins, who went on to lead Texas Western to the NCAA Championship in 1966, played at OSU as well.

### 1960-69

The 1960s saw a change in the landscape of collegiate basketball. No longer did teams simply take the best players on campus and turn them into a quality squad. It was all about recruiting, and Mr. Iba wanted nothing to do with it. The downfall of Oklahoma State basketball began at the end of the 1950s and stuck around until the late 1970s.

There were bright spots during the decade, to be sure. The 1964-65 squad finished 20-7 and won its first Big Eight title. The Cowboys went 12-2 in league play and finished undefeated at home at 10-0. Oklahoma State made it to the regional finals of the NCAA Tournament and finished ranked No. 13 nationally in the final coaches poll.

Mr. Iba had several good players on his teams in the 1960s, just not at the same time or with any consistency. Larry Hawk and James King were both named second-team All-Big Eight in 1963 while Ivan Wiley, Gene Johnson and Jim Cooper all received honorable mention. Hawk was a first-team selection in 1964 while King received second-team mention in 1964 and first-team accolades in 1965.

## 2009 Cowboy Basketball Signees

### Reger Dowell • 6-0, 170, Guard

Dowell is the starting point guard for the Duncanville Panthers, a Class 5A school just north of the Dallas-Fort Worth metroplex. He ranks as the No. 135 player in the country according to Rivals.com and the No. 138 player according to Hoopmasters. Reger (pronounced 'redge-ERR') was also recruited by Baylor, Texas A&M, Nebraska and Marquette. He is an integral part of why Duncanville is the preseason No. 1 team in the country according to ESPNRISE and PrepNation.

### Roger Franklin • 6-5, 215, Forward

Franklin is a wing player for Duncanville who can play either guard or forward. He has the ability to bang inside or play around the perimeter. He led the Panthers to the Class 5A state title in 2007. Franklin is rated as the No. 9 small forward and 43rd-best player overall nationally by Scout.com and the No. 42 player in the country according to Hoopmasters. Roger was also recruited by Arizona, Michigan State, Oklahoma and UCLA. He is a major part of why Duncanville is the preseason No. 1 team in the country according to ESPNRISE and PrepNation.

### Fred Gulley • 6-2, 175, Guard

Gulley is a starting guard for the Fayetteville High School Bulldogs. He was named the Arkansas Gatorade Player of the Year as a junior last season. He averaged 17 points, 7 rebounds and 6 assists in leading his team to the conference title. Gulley is ranked as the No. 16 point guard in the country according to Scout.com. He was also recruited by Arkansas, Missouri, Stanford, California and Georgia Tech.

### Karron Johnson • 6-7, 225, Forward

Considered one of the top big men in the country, Johnson is rated as one of the top-20 power forwards in the country by all three major recruiting services. Rivals.com ranks him as the No. 45 overall player in the country and the 14th-best PF. He is a four-star forward according to Scout.com as well, and grades out as 93 on a scale of 1 to 100 by ESPN. Karron was also recruited by Memphis, Georgetown, Miami (Fla.), Cincinnati, West Virginia, NC State, Virginia and Seton Hall.

### Ray Penn • 5-9, 170, Guard

Penn is a point guard out of Travis High School in Richmond, Texas, just outside of Houston. He broke onto the recruiting scene last summer when he was the leading scorer at the RBK Summer Championships with 35.8 points per game. He is ranked as the No. 9 point guard in the country by Rivals.com and the 29th-best player overall nationally by Hoopmasters. He chose Oklahoma State after also being recruited by Missouri, Mississippi State and TCU.

### Torin Walker • 6-11, 230, Center

Walker is a long, lanky big man who is a very effective shot blocker, rebounder and high- or low-post position player. He has very good shooting range and accuracy for his size and exceptionally long arms. He averaged 17 points, 14 rebounds and five blocked shots per game as a junior, and was named all-region. He is rated as the No. 14 center nationally by ESPN. Torin was also recruited by Georgia, Auburn, Florida State, Florida, Miami (Fla.), Tennessee, Xavier and Virginia Tech.
