WILDCATS HEAD TO HUSKER INVITATIONAL

The Kansas State Wildcats travel to Lincoln to compete in the 34th annual Sevigne Husker Invitational this weekend. The two-day event will be held at the Bob Devaney Center and begin with the men's heptathlon.

While mutli-event specialists Moritz Cleve, Adam Fretwell and Stephanie Hejde will not compete after strong showings in the heptathlon and pentathlon last weekend at the Wildcat Invitational, the Wildcats have a number of athletes heading to the meet for K-State.

With the Big 12 Championship coming up in three weeks, the Husker Invitational will provide a chance for the Wildcats to compete against strong competition and continue to improve heading into the conference championship.

Results for the Sevigne Husker Invitational will be available at k-statesports.com at the conclusion of each day's action, and live stats will be on Nebraska's site at www.huskers.com.

CLEVE CUTS COMPETITION IN HEPTATHLON

In his first mutli-event of the season at the Wildcat Invitational, Moritz Cleve shined posting a provisional qualifying mark at 5,606 points. On his way to winning the heptathlon he leapt passed his previous best in the long jump by more than a foot. His leap of 23-08.00 earned him 748 points. He won the heptathlon by 100 points.

Cleve was not the only K-State athlete to put on a show at the Wildcat Invitational while Loren Groves posted K-State's first automatic qualifying mark of the season. Groves' throw of 69-08.00 bested the field by more than 11 feet.

Scott Sellers also made a strong showing for the Wildcats with another provisional qualifying mark at 7-00.25 to finish second in the high jump.

Along with the wins by Cleve and Groves, the Wildcats tallied six more first-place finishes at the Wildcat Invitational.

BIG 12 WINS CONFERENCE CHALLENGE

Three schools from the Big 12 Conference and Mountain West teamed up to take on each other's respective conferences in the annual Conference Challenge with the Big 12 coming away victorious 249-118. K-State contributed 41 of the Big 12's points in the win with five first-place finishes and one provisional qualifying time.

Liliani Mendez won the women's mile in 4:46.79 to post to first provisional mark of the season. TiAra Walpool claimed the women's triple jump and Lakeisha Pointer-Allen won the 400M for the Wildcats. On the men's side, Mike Myer won the 200M in a personal best 21.47. Jason Collett won the 800M.

Three Wildcats also participated in Nebraska-Wesleyan Invitational following the Conference Challenge, and Emilee Morris won the 800M in a time of 2:22.76.

GROVES SETS ANOTHER RECORD

Senior thrower Loren Groves posted her second provisional mark of the season in the weight throw on the way to winning the KSU Invitational. Her first-place throw of 68-06.50 set a meet record passing her own mark of 67-10.50 from 2007.

OPENING THEIR EYES

After a successful season in 2008 and with a number of the key parts returning this year, the K-State men's team began the season ranked among the top teams in the country at No. 18. This week the Wildcats drop one spot to No. 19.

Oklahoma State falls from the rankings this week after holding the No. 24 spot, and Texas Tech dropped one spot to No. 8. Texas A&M held its place(5) and Texas climbed to spots (9). Baylor (20) and Nebraska (16) join K-State in the middle of the pack this week, and Missouri (23) completes the Big 12's rankings.

The Wildcats were among seven teams ranked in the Big 12 Conference in the preseason. Texas A&M (6) and Texas (7) both cracked the Top 10 for the conference. Texas Tech (12), Baylor (14) and Nebraska (15) rounded out the top 15 spots in the poll, and Missouri closed out the Big 12 teams at No. 23.

The women's team was not in the preseason rankings, but the Big 12 was still strongly represented. Texas A&M opened the year as the No. 1 team on the USTFCCCA poll. Texas Tech ranked ninth with Texas coming in at No. 12. Nebraska completed the Big 12's teams in the preseason ranking at No. 24.

The Aggies remained atop the rankings this week while Texas remained firm in 6th. Texas Tech dropped slightly to No. 13 as Nebraska fell one spot to No. 20. Baylor fell in the rankings but held in at No. 25.

The USTFCCCA uses a points system taking into account performances in the NCAA Championship from returning players among other considerations.

STARTING STRONG

In the opening weekend of the season in December, a number of Wildcats started the track and field campaign off on the right foot.

Scott Sellers won the Carol Robinson Winter Pentathlon and in the process posted an NCAA provisional qualifying mark in the high jump at 7-02.25. In the next day's KSU All-Comers, fellow high jumper Michael Healey posted a provisional mark at 7-00.25.

The tandem was not alone in posting provisional marks. Senior women's thrower, Loren

Groves began her final season with a strong mark. Her throw of 67-09 was enough for a provisional mark.

RETURNERS PROVIDE STRENGTH FOR K-STATE

The Wildcats return a number of athletes on the men's and women's side who contributed strongly to their teams' success last year. The men return three who qualified for the NCAA Indoor Championships in their respective events -- two of which earned All-America honors.

Senior high jumper Scott Sellers placed second in the NCAA Championships narrowly missing his second national title after claiming the Big 12 title. This year he is also expected to increase his contribution to the Wildcats participating in multi-events as well.

Sophomore combined events specialist Rok Derzanic earned All-America honors after finishing eighth at the NCAA's in the pentathlon. Derzanic also proved to be one of the top in the conference in his event finishing third at the Big 12 Championships. Another sophomore -- Moritz Cleve -- came on strong for the Wildcats in his first year. He finished second in the Big 12 in the heptathlon and came in 12th at the NCAA's. Senior Adam Fretwell adds to the depth in the combined events for the Wildcats as he finished eighth in the Big 12 last year.

On the women's side, senior thrower Loren Groves looks to add to her illustrious career with another Big 12 title. Groves has won two consecutive weight throw conference titles and earned All-America honors last year with a sixth place finish at the NCAA's.

She is not alone as a strong competitor for the women. Junior Beverly Ramos brings experience in the distance events and looks to build off her most successful cross country season of her career this fall. Ramos won three races this fall and finished fourth at the Big 12 Championship. Ramos was joined by senior Liliani Mendez on the All-Big 12 Cross Country Team after Mendez finished 15th to round out the honorees. Mendez also will bring experience to the distance events for the women's team. The women's team will also have depth in the distance events to create opportunities to score points for the Wildcats.

The women will look to be strong in the jumps this year with TiAra Walpool looking to build off her freshman campaign while she also competes in sprints. Nina Kokot will participate in her first indoor season after redshirting last year and making a strong showing in outdoor in the jumps.

Combined events should be another strength for the women's team along with the men. Stephanie Hejde finished 10th at the Big 12 Championship last year in the pentathlon as a sophomore. Annika Schoenebeck came in just ahead of Hejde in eighth place for the Wildcats last year.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The Wildcats boast a lot of experience returning for 2009, but the upperclassmen have some younger teammates with their eyes set on contributing to the team's success this year.

Six of the Wildcats' All-Big 12 performers last year were underclassmen. And with another year of preparation under their belts, those athletes are ready for an even better year.

The addition of a number of freshmen will make the depth of the K-State squad even better. The coaching staff is hoping for big things out of those underclassmen this year to push the Wildcats.
