### HUSKERS RETURN TO FALL ACTION AT BADGER INVITATIONAL

The Nebraska men's golf team resumes fall season competition by traveling to Wisconsin for the Badger Invitational (Oct. 1-3).

Following a practice round on Saturday, the Huskers will take aim at the par 72, 7,106-yard layout of the University Ridge Golf Course outside of Madison, beginning with tee times for the 18-team field at 9:30 a.m. (CT) on Sunday, Oct. 1.

The Huskers will be back in action for the second round on Monday with tee times again at 9:30 a.m. (CT), before concluding the 54-hole tournament with the final round on Tuesday with a shotgun start at 9 a.m. (CT).

The Big Red will be part of a field that features six 2023 NCAA Regional qualifiers, including Illinois State, Long Beach State, Marquette, Middle Tennessee, Northern Illinois and the hosts from Wisconsin, along with contenders Ball State, Campbell, Central Arkansas, Eastern Michigan, Florida Gulf Coast, Loyola-Chicago, Maryland, Nebraska, South Alabama, South Dakota State, VCU and Western Carolina.

In addition to the team competition at the Badger Invitational, Husker sophomore Davis Johnson will compete in the TPC Individual held at the nearby TPC Wisconsin (Oct. 1-2).

Nebraska will look to improve on its performance at the 2022 Badger Invitational, when the Huskers finished fourth with a two-round total of 571 (-5). Will Marshall led the Huskers last year, tying for 16th with a 142 (-2).

### MURRAY EARNS TOP 10 FINISH DURING BIG RED DEBUT

Junior transfer Hamish Murray produced a top-10 individual finish while making his NCAA Division I and Nebraska debut at the Bearcat Invitational in Cincinnati, Ohio (Sept. 18-19).

The Australian tied for ninth overall with a 211 (-2) to lead the Nebraska lineup at the Coldstream Country Club.

Fellow junior Harry Crockett put together Nebraska's best final round with his one-over par 72. Crockett finished with a 54-hole total of 216 (+3) to tie for 30th as the Big Red's No. 2 finisher.

Seniors Reed Malleck and Gentry Scheve both posted rounds of 75 over the final 18 holes to finish at 218 (+5) and 224 (+11), respectively. Will Marshall tied for 67th at 223 (+10).

As a team, Nebraska finished ninth in a strong 14-team field that featured five of the top-30 teams in the nation, according to the Golfweek Preseason Top 30.

### HUSKER TRIO AMONG BIG TEN GOLFERS TO WATCH

Gentry Scheve, Will Marshall and Harry Crockett represented Nebraska among the 2023-24 Big Ten Preseason Men's Golfers to Watch.

Nebraska's most experienced returning golfer, Will Marshall (Elburn, Ill.) is back for his fifth season as a Husker. Marshall led Nebraska with five top-25 finishes and a 73.68 stroke average last season.

Junior Harry Crockett set a school record with a 71.82 stroke average over 11 fall rounds in 2022-23. Crockett, a two-time NJCAA All-American at Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College, did not compete for the Huskers during the spring.

Scheve finished 2022-23 as Nebraska's hottest golfer and continued to build momentum in the summer of 2023 by qualifying for the U.S. Amateur Championship. He added Nebraska's best performance at the season-opening Visit Knoxville Collegiate (Sept. 8-10).
