INTRODUCTION

The 2022-23 Nebraska Athletics Academic Achievement book highlights the academic and leadership achievements of Husker student-athletes. The information in this book is useful to review prior to meeting with prospective students, alumni and current student-athletes regarding the success of their peers. The Hewit Academic Center staff congratulates the individual student-athletes and their coaches for their significant achievements during the 2022-23 academic year.

The "Highlighting the Huskers" pages showcase the stellar achievements that are further detailed throughout the book. The Husker academic program has consistently been a leader in College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans. This past year, the Huskers increased their NCAA Division I-leading total to 351. Nebraska's total is 15 more than No. 2 Stanford. Nebraska continues to lead the nation with 18 NCAA Today's Top 10 Award winners. This award is considered the highest level of honor in NCAA recognition.

Nebraska had 110 student-athletes graduate between December of 2022 and August of 2023. Since 1892, 6,864 Nebraska student-athletes have both lettered and graduated from the University.

The Academic Achievement in Athletics book also highlights other historic accomplishments by Nebraska student-athletes, including the 105 Huskers who have earned NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships since 1970, the 178 Huskers who have earned prestigious 1A FAR Academic Excellence Awards since 2011, and the 14 Huskers who have claimed NCAA Elite 90 awards since 2010.

The 33rd annual A Night at the Lied academic awards ceremony celebrated the achievements of Nebraska's student-athletes in April 2023. The celebration highlighted Nebraska's academic and life skills excellence. At the event, 320 student-athletes were honored for earning a 3.0 or higher gradepoint average. Herman Team GPA awards were presented to the men's tennis and women's cross country teams. Trent Hixson (football) and leva Turke (women's track and field) were chosen as the 2022-23 Nebraska Student-Athletes of the Year for their commitment to excellence in academics, athletics and service. Hixson and Turke also captured Nebraska's Big Ten Medals of Honor.

The Hewit Academic staff is honored to work with Nebraska's incredible student-athletes. The staff believes student-athletes should be recognized for their hard work and dedication to academics, athletics and outreach. The 2023-24 academic year will bring new successes by student-athletes in the classroom, in competition and in the community.

Nebraska produced a school-record-tying 95 percent Graduation Success Rate in 2022-23, which is the second-highest rate among 110 FBS public institutions. 

- Nebraska's cumulative 3.320 fall semester GPA in 2022 was the third-best in history for Husker student-athletes in a fall semester.
- Across all sports, Nebraska tied a program-best 95 percent Graduation Success Rate.
- An impressive group of 110 Husker student-athletes earned their degrees in December 2022, May 2023 or August 2023.
- A total of 296 Nebraska student-athletes earned Academic All-Big Ten recognition in 2022-23.
- A total of 842 student-athletes were honored on the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll in the Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 semesters for earning a 3.000 or better term GPA.
- Husker student-athletes combined for 147 perfect 4.000 GPA semesters in the fall and spring of 2022-23.
- A total of 99 Nebraska student-athletes were named Big Ten Distinguished Scholars for earning a 3.700 or higher GPA during the 2022-23 academic year.
- A group of 11 Huskers earned the Division 1A FAR Academic Excellence Award in 2023, presented to student-athletes who graduate with a 3.800 or higher cumulative GPA.
- Nebraska leads the nation with 18 NCAA Today's Top 10 Award recipients. The Top 10 Award is considered among the most prestigious honors presented to senior scholar-athletes.
- Nebraska leads NCAA Division I with 351 CSC Academic All-Americans, 15 more than second-place Stanford.

- Till Steinforth (men's track and field) captured CSC First-Team Academic All-America honors. Steinforth was a first-team All-American in the decathlon along with being the Big Ten champion in both the decathlon and long jump. NCAA women's outdoor shot put champion Axelina Johansson added second-team CSC Academic All-America honors, while Husker volleyball player Lexi Rodriguez pitched in a third-team CSC Academic All-America award in 2022-23.
- A total of 61 Huskers across all sports earned CSC Academic All-District honors in 2022-23.
- Trent Hixson (football) and leva Turke (women's track and field) were named Nebraska's Student-Athletes of the Year for 2022. They were also Nebraska's Big Ten Medal of Honor recipients.
- Madison Lueger (women's track and field) captured an NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship worth \$10,000 for her academic accomplishments. Lueger and Daniel Monahan (wrestling) also claimed Big Ten Postgraduate Scholarships that were each worth \$7,500 toward their continuing educations.
- Nebraska recognized 320 scholar-athletes, who matriculated at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln for at least one year, for earning a 3.000 or higher GPA.
- Jamieson Battistella, Madison Lueger and Taya Skelton (women's track and field), Dakota Chan (soccer), Annika Evans (volleyball), Chloe and Ellie Kuckelman (women's tennis), Rachel Powers (swimming and diving) and Karlee Seevers (softball) were recognized as Nebraska Outstanding Scholars for maintaining a 3.900 or higher undergraduate cumulative GPA while competing in their final season or graduating.
- The men's tennis team (3.572 GPA) and the women's cross country team (3.731 GPA) claimed the Herman Team GPA Awards for the 2022 calendar year.

HUSKERS PRODUCE RECORD ACADEMIC PERFORMANCES

University of Nebraska student-athletes produced another outstanding year in the classroom, the community and in competition to continue NU's tradition of success in 2022-23. The Huskers increased their NCAA Division I-leading total of all-time College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans to 351 with the addition of track and field athletes Till Steinforth and Axelina Johansson and volleyball player Lexi Rodriguez to Nebraska's total across all sports.

Nebraska is one of only five NCAA Division I schools with 200 CSC Academic All-Americans, joining Stanford (336), Notre Dame (276), Alabama (228) and Penn State (225).

The Huskers also extended their nation-leading streak to 53 consecutive years with at least one Academic All-American.

During the spring semester of 2023, all of Nebraska's studentathletes combined for a 3.370 cumulative grade-point average - the best cumulative GPA in school history.

A total of 842 awards were issued for the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Fall (417) and Spring (425) Honor Rolls, recognizing Husker studentathletes who produced a 3.000 GPA or better during a semester. Among that group, Huskers produced 147 perfect 4.000 GPA semesters.

A total of 99 Nebraska student-athletes were honored as Big Ten Distinguished Scholars for posting 3.700 grade-point averages or better in 2022-23. The Huskers also produced 296 Academic All-Big Ten selections for the year across all sports.

Nebraska's CSC Academic All-America success continues to set the standard for the more than 2,100 NCAA, NAIA and NJCAA institutions across North America. The Husker football team leads all individual sport programs in the nation with 108 all-time CSC Academic All-America awards, while the Nebraska volleyball (40, No. 1) program leads the nation across all women's sports.

Till Steinforth (Saxony-Anhalt, Germany) was named a CSC First-Team Academic All-American with a 4.00 GPA as an architectural studies major. A first-team All-American in the decathlon in 2023, Steinforth was also the Big Ten champion in both the decathlon and the long jump. While

Steinforth proudly represented the men's track and field team, Axelina Johansson (Hok, Sweden) added second-team CSC Academic All-America honors for the women's track and field program. Johansson won the NCAA outdoor shot put title after taking second in the indoor event in 2023. She posted a 3.79 GPA as a graphic design major. Nebraska's 56 combined CSC Academic All-America honors since 2002 for the men's and women's track and field programs lead the nation. The Husker men's and women's track and field programs have combined for 70 CSC Academic All-America All-America awards since 1985.

Lexi Rodriguez (Sterling, III.), a two-time AVCA All-American for the Husker volleyball team, added third-team CSC Academic All-America accolades as an advertising and public relations major.

Offensive lineman Trent Hixson (Omaha, Neb.) claimed Nebraska Male Student-Athlete of the Year honors and was NU's Big Ten Medal of Honor recipient for 2022-23. leva Turke was Nebraska's Female Student-Athlete of the Year and Big Ten Medal of Honor recipient. Turke (Tukums, Latvia) was a three-time Big Ten Distinguished Scholar during her career as a jumper for the women's track and field program.

HUSKERS CELEBRATE GRADUATIONS OF 110 STUDENT-ATHLETES

Across all sports, a total of 110 Husker student-athletes earned their degrees from the University of Nebraska from December 2022 through August of 2023. Nebraska's 25 student-athlete graduates in December of 2022, joined a class of 74 graduates in May of 2023, while 11 Huskers earned their degrees in August of 2023.

320 HUSKERS EARN ACADEMIC MEDALLIONS

Nebraska celebrated its academic, athletic and life skills accomplishments across all sports during the 33rd annual "A Night at the Lied" in April. The award ceremony honored the elite performers in competition, in the classroom and in the community, which included the presentations of 320 honor medallions to high-performing Husker studentathletes. The event also recognized several outstanding performances.

In addition to Trent Hixson and leva Turke earning Nebraska's top individual honors as Student-Athletes of the Year, the women's cross country team (3.731 GPA) and the men's tennis team (3.572 GPA) claimed the 29th annual Herman Awards. The awards are presented to the Husker squads with the top team grade-point averages. The women's cross country team won its 11th all-time Herman Award, while the men's tennis team captured its 10th award in program history.

HUSKERS EARN 296 ACADEMIC ALL-BIG TEN AWARDS IN 2022-23

Across all sports, Nebraska student-athletes captured 296 Academic All-Big Ten selections in 2022-23, while 99 Huskers claimed Big Ten Conference Distinguished Scholar awards. Those student-athletes produced 3.700 or better grade-point averages during the fall and spring semesters of 2022-23.

Husker student-athletes also earned 842 spots on the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll during the fall or spring semesters of 2022-23. To earn a spot on the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll, a studentathlete must earn a 3.000 grade-point average during the semester.

During the fall or spring semesters, 147 Husker student-athletes produced perfect 4.000 semester GPAs.

NEBRASKA'S GSR CLIMBS TO RECORD LEVEL

Nebraska's Graduation Success Rate (GSR) matched a record 95 percent across all sports for the second straight season. In addition, each of Nebraska's athletic programs achieved an NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 955 or higher, including 16 programs scoring 980 or better out of 1,000. It represented the eighth consecutive year that all of Nebraska's teams scored 950 or better in the APR.

NEBRASKA FEATURES EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT-ATHLETE BENEFITS

All scholarship student-athletes across all sports have their scholarship calculated based on the full cost of attendance at Nebraska. Every student-athlete is offered an Apple MacBook Air laptop computer to enhance their learning opportunities. Nebraska also created the first known Post-Eligibility Opportunity (PEO) program, where every studentathlete who graduated, lettered and exhausted their athletic eligibility has the opportunity to pursue an internship, participate in a study abroad program or attend graduate school with Nebraska's support.

Nebraska has increased its resources and support in all academic and performance-related areas, including Academic Services, Life Skills, Athletic Medicine, Sport Psychology, Athletic Training, Strength and Conditioning, NAPL, Nutrition and Dining Services and Sports Analytics.





The Elite 90, an award founded by the NCAA, recognizes the essence of the student-athlete by honoring the individuals who have reached the pinnacle of competition at the national championship level in their sport, while also achieving the highest academic standard among their peers. The Elite 90 is presented to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative grade-point average participating at the finals site for each of the NCAA's 90 championships.

AWARD CRITERIA

The student-athletes must be at least sophomores academically and athletically, and in at least their second year (in any sport) at their current institution. The student-athletes must be active members on the roster, eligible for the championship, and members of the designated squad size at the championship site in sports with squad size limitations.

Credits completed shall only consist of those credits accumulated at the current institution and shall not include any transfer or AP credits.

Only undergraduate GPA is applicable. If the student-athletes have graduated and are in graduate school, they are still eligible for the award but consideration will be based strictly on an undergraduate GPA. Graduate students must be in good academic standing with the university.

Student-athletes are only eligible to win the award once per academic year, even if they participate in more than one sport.

WAYNE DUKE POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Wayne Duke Postgraduate Award is named for the former Big Ten Conference commissioner who served from 1971 to 1989. While leading the Big Ten, Duke spent much of his time working to improve academic standards and graduation rates for student-athletes.

The Wayne Duke Postgraduate Award (\$10,000) is presented by the Indianapolis Big Ten Community Partnership. The Award is an annual scholarship recognizing one male and one female Big Ten senior studentathlete pursuing a postgraduate degree for achievements in academics, athletics, civic service and leadership. Each Big Ten institution may nominate one male and one female student-athlete.

NATIONAL FOOTBALL FOUNDATION SCHOLAR-ATHLETES

The NFF National Scholar-Athlete Awards were established in 1959 as the first initiative in history to honor scholar-athletes with postgraduate scholarships for their combined athletic, academic and leadership abilities. To date, the program has awarded more than \$11.5 million to 854 individuals since its inception. The program currently provides approximately \$300,000 each year in postgraduate scholarships to the nation's top scholar-athletes from all levels of collegiate play.

Nominated by their schools, which are limited to one nominee each, candidates must be a senior or graduate student in their final year of eligibility, have at least a 3.2 GPA on a 4.0 scale, have outstanding football ability as a first-team

player or significant contributor and have demonstrated strong leadership and citizenship. The NFF Awards Committee, which is comprised of a nationally recognized group of media, College Football Hall of Fame inductees and athletic administrators, traditionally selects 12-15 scholar-athletes for these prestigious \$18,000 scholarships.

The committee also designates one of the recipients as the top college football scholar-athlete in the nation, an honor that comes with The William V. Campbell Trophy (renamed from the Vincent dePaul Draddy Award in 2009). The Campbell Trophy comes with a \$25,000 scholarship.




