HUSKERS HOST CAL STATE FULLERTON IN SUNDAY MATINEE

The Nebraska men's basketball team looks to start a season with a 7-0 record for the first time in more than 30 years on Sunday afternoon, as the Huskers host Cal State Fullerton at Pinnacle Bank Arena. Tipoff between the Huskers and Titans is set for 1 p.m. and tickets are available for the matchup by visiting Huskers.com/Tickets or at PBA beginning at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday.

The Huskers (6-0) came off a hard-fought 89-79 win over Duquesne on Wednesday night. Juwan Gary scored nine of his career-high 20 points in a 13-0 second-half run that broke open a one-point game. The Huskers shot 52 percent from the floor in the second half and went 28-of-31 from the charity stripe, including 21-of-22 in the second half.

Gary has been a force since returning to the lineup on Nov. 15, averaging 17.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game over the last three contests. He has tied or set career highs in scoring twice and is shooting 65 percent from the floor.

NU has done it with balance, as four Huskers average at least 14.0 ppg and the team ranks fourth in the Big Ten in scoring at 81.0 points per game. NU had five players in double-figures on Wednesday, including a season-high 23 from Keisei Tominaga.

Cal State Fullerton (2-3) has been off since a 74-67 win over Southern Miss on Monday. Max Jones led the Titans with 19 points while DJ Brewton added 15 points, as Cal State Fullerton shot 52 percent from the floor while holding Southern Miss to 40 percent shooting. Jones, an All-Big West selection last season, leads the Titans in scoring at 16.2 points per game.

2 Nebraska tied a school record with two turnovers in the win over Duquesne on Wednesday. The Huskers did not commit a turnover in the final 37:01 of action in matching a school record originally set in 2013.

LOOKING AT CAL STATE FULLERTON

Cal State Fullerton comes to Lincoln with a 2-3 record following a 1-1 showing at the Jacksonville Classic. The Titans lost to Cornell in the opener but bounced back with a 74-67 win over Southern Miss on Monday. Cal State Fullerton has played four of its first five games away from home, including games at San Diego State and UCF. Following Sunday's game, the Titans will leave the state one more time before Big West play begins on Dec. 28.

The Titans returned a trio of starters from a team that won 20 games and was the Big West Tournament runner-up. Junior guard Max Jones leads the returnees, as the All-Big West selection is averaging 16.2 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game. Jones has a pair of 20-point efforts, including 23 points against Cornell. DJ Brewton has emerged as a scoring threat after transferring from Alcorn State. Brewton, a first-team All-SWAC selection in 2022-23, is averaging 13.0 ppg and has been in double figures in four of the first five contests. The Titans have missed the services of Tory San Antonio, who was a three-year starter and reigning Big West Defensive Player of the Year. He missed the first five games with an injury.

Dedrique Taylor is in his 11th season at Cal State Fullerton and helped the Titans become a consistent threat in the Big West. He guided the Titans to the Big West Tournament title game in four of the past six events, including tournament titles in 2018 and 2022. He is the only coach to take the Titans to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances and has guided Cal State Fullerton to three 20-win seasons, including each of the past two years. Previously, he was an assistant coach at Arizona State from 2006 to 2013, serving as associate head coach in his final three seasons at the school.

Nebraska is 2-0 all-time against Cal State Fullerton, including an 86-62 Husker win in Lincoln on Dec. 22, 2018. The other meeting was a 111-74 Husker win on Dec. 4, 1967. NU is 14-10 all-time against members of the Big West Conference and Sunday's meeting is the first for NU against a Big West foe since the 2018 game with Cal State Fullerton.

LAST TIME OUT

Juwan Gary had nine of his career-high 20 points in a 13-0 second-half run as Nebraska improved to 6-0 for the first time since 2008-09 with an 89-79 win over Duquesne. The Huskers led 55-54 with 13:35 left before the Huskers took control behind Gary. The junior forward had nine points in the spurt including five straight points to give NU a 68-54 lead. NU held the Dukes scoreless for nearly four minutes to finally get some breathing room in the second half.

6 The 6-0 start marks the 10th time in school history that Nebraska has opened a season with a 6-0 mark. Only four teams in school history have opened a year with seven-or-more wins (1992-93, 1984-85, 1977-78 and 1915-16). It is the Huskers' best start since joining the Big Ten in 2011-12.

Gary hit 7-of-10 shots from the floor, including a pair of 3-pointers, and went 4-of-4 from the line. He also added five boards in the win. Keisei Tominaga led NU with 23 points as the Huskers put five players in double figures and went 28-of-31 from the foul line, including 21-of-22 in the second half. Josiah Allick had 12 points, seven rebounds and five assists while Brice Williams and Rienk Mast added 11 and 10 points respectively.

WORTH NOTING

• The Huskers are 12-3 over the last 15 games dating back to Feb. 1, 2023. A big reason for that is NU's offense, as NU has averaged 77.1 ppg on 48 percent shooting in that stretch. For the first 23 games last year until Feb. 1, NU was at 65.4 ppg. NU has scored 70+ points in 13 of the past 15 games after reaching that mark just seven times in the first 23 games of last season.

• Nebraska has been stout on the defensive end during the early portion of the season. The Huskers are among the Big Ten leaders in points per game (60.2, third), field goal percentage defense (.351, second) and rebound margin (+9.8, third).

• Nebraska's bench has provided a spark early on, averaging 27.3 points per game in the first six contests. The Huskers' leading scorer has come from the bench three times (Hoiberg-Lindenwood; Wilcher-Rider; Gary-Stony Brook), and NU has had at least one double-figure effort from its bench in the first six contests.

• Juwan Gary's 20-point effort against Duquesne marked the seventh time under Fred Hoiberg that NU had a player score at least 20 points off the bench.

• Nebraska had multiple 20-point scorers against Duquesne (Keisei Tominaga-23; Juwan-Gary 20) for the eighth time in Fred Hoiberg's five seasons.

• Rienk Mast now has 23 career double-doubles entering Sunday's game with Cal State Fullerton. The 6-foot-10 forward is 20th nationally among all active players and trails only Zach Edey (44) among current Big Ten players. Mast's three double-doubles is second in the Big Ten and 10th nationally.

• Nebraska is 19-4 under Hoiberg when scoring at least 80 points including 14-1 over the last three seasons. The only loss was a 104-100 quadruple overtime game at North Carolina State on Dec. 1, 2021. NU has won its last 12 games when reaching the 80-point plateau.

• Nebraska regained its top two returning scorers last week, as Keisei Tominaga (13.1 ppg in 2022-23) returned from an ankle injury on Monday and Juwan Gary (9.6 ppg, 6.5 pg) made his 2023-24 debut on Wednesday vs. Stony Brook. Tominaga missed NU's first two games, while Gary, who had off-season shoulder surgery had not played since suffering the injury on Jan. 10, 2023.

• Nebraska is 61-15 (.805) in non-conference games at Pinnacle Bank Arena since the building opened in 2013.

FINDING BALANCE

Nebraska relied on its depth and balance early in the season. While the Huskers have four players averaging double figures, five others are between 4.0 and 7.7 ppg after six games.

• Nebraska has had eight different players reach double figures and have had a different leading scorer in each of the first six games.

• No Husker averages more than 28 minutes per game, while 10 Huskers are averaging double figures in minutes. Despite the number of different lineups NU has been forced to use, the Huskers have had at least eight players play double-figure minutes in each of the first six games.

• NU has gotten at least one double-figure effort from its bench in each of the first six contests. The Huskers have gotten over 33 percent of their scoring from the bench over the first six contests.

Postgame Notes

•-With the win, Nebraska improved to 6-0 for the first time since the 2008-09 season. The six-game winning streak is NU's longest since a six-game win streak in 2018.

•-The Huskers scored a season-high 89 points, scoring more than 80 points for the fifth time in six games. The 89 points was NU's highest total since scoring 93 at Penn State on Feb. 27, 2022.

•- The Huskers' 10-point win marked their sixth straight double-digit victory, the first time that has happened for the Huskers since 2010-11.

•- Nebraska went 28-of-31 from the free throw line (90.3 percent), NU's best effort since going 21-of-23 (91 percent) against Oklahoma State on Dec. 16, 2018.

•-The Huskers scored on each of their first 16 possessions in the second half.

•-Nebraska committed only two turnovers in the game, tying a school record set against Purdue on Jan. 16, 2013.

MAST'S MASSIVE NIGHT

Rienk Mast put together a strong performance in Nebraska's win against Florida A&M on Nov. 9. The 6-foot-10 forward had game highs of 20 points and 16 rebounds for his first double-double as a Husker.

- He became the first Husker in the Big Ten era (2011-12 to present) to have a game with at least 20 points and 15 rebounds, and the first Husker to do so since All-Big 12 performer Aleks Maric in 2008.
- Since 1990, only six Huskers have had games with at least 20 points and 15 rebounds. That list includes Aleks Maric, Kimani Ffriend, Venson Hamilton, Mikki Moore and Eric Piatkowski.

• Mast's 16 rebounds were the most by a Husker since Yvan Ouedraogo had 19 rebounds against Northwestern on March 1, 2020, and the second-highest rebound total in Hoiberg's four-plus seasons at Nebraska.

• Mast is in the top 20 in the Big Ten in both scoring (14.0 ppg) and rebounding (10.3 rpg) while averaging 2.8 assists per game. Mast is the only power conference player in the nation averaging a double-double with at least 2.5 assists per game as of Nov. 24.

NEW FACES, NEW ROLES

Nebraska made a big splash in the transfer portal, adding five players to the roster, and their impact is already being felt during the early portion of the season. The group of Josiah Allick (New Mexico), Jarron Coleman (Bradley), Rienk Mast (Bradley), Ahron Ulis (Iowa) and Brice Williams (Charlotte) combined for more than 4,300 points, 2,100 rebounds and 800 assists entering this year.

Mast is averaging 14.0 points per game while leading the Huskers in rebounding (10.3 rpg) and ranks second in assists (2.8 apg). He is the only power conference player as of Nov. 24 averaging at least 10.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game. Mast currently ranks third in the Big Ten in rebounding and 17th in scoring. The 6-foot-10 forward has been in double figures in all six contests - the only Husker to do so - including a 20-point, 16-rebound effort against Florida A&M.

Allick has been a force inside, averaging 7.7 points per game and 6.2 rebounds per game. He is second on the team and 17th in the Big Ten in rebounds and is a big reason why the Huskers are among the Big Ten leaders in rebounding margin. Allick has three double-figure efforts, including 12 points, seven rebounds and five assists vs. Duquesne.

Williams has started all six contests and is second on the team in scoring (15.4 ppg) while averaging 4.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game. The 6-foot-7 guard is 15th in the Big Ten in scoring and has been in double figures five times this season, highlighted by a 25-point effort in the win against Oregon State on Nov. 17 and a 17-point, nine-rebound, four-assist effort against Stony Brook on Nov. 15.

Coleman has come off the bench in all five contests and leads Nebraska in assists at 3.0 per game. He has a 2.6-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio while chipping in 3.2 points and 2.8 rebounds per outing.

IMPROVED BOARD WORK

One of the areas where Nebraska has made significant improvement is on the boards. The additions of Rienk Mast, Josiah Allick and Brice Williams along with the return of Juwan Gary have made the Huskers formidable on the glass.

- Nebraska has a +9.8 rebound margin through six games to tie for third in the Big Ten. Last season the Huskers were 11th in rebound margin (-1.0)
- NU had a positive rebound margin (+3.1) prior to Juwan Gary's season-ending injury last January. Gary was second on the team in rebounding (6.5 rpg) and 15th in the Big Ten in that category on Jan. 10. Over the final 16 games of the 2022-23 season, NU was outrebounded by 5.1 rebounds per game.

• Mast (MVC) and Allick (Mountain West) both ranked second in their respective conferences in 2022-23 in rebounding, while Williams was 15th in Conference USA. In addition, Mast led the MVC in rebounding during the 2021-22 season.

• NU out-rebounded four straight opponents by at least 10 boards, the first time that has happened since the first four games of the 2004-05 season, before the streak was snapped on Wednesday.

TOMINAGA NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN

Nebraska senior guard Keisei Tominaga was honored as one of 10 players selected to the preseason All-Big Ten team. He became just the third Husker to be named preseason All-Big Ten since Nebraska joined the conference in 2011-12, joining James Palmer Jr. (2018) and Terran Petteway (2014). Last season, he averaged 13.1 points per game on 53 percent shooting, including 40 percent from 3-point range, while appearing in all 32 contests. Tominaga led the Huskers in 3-pointers with 66 and was one of only six players nationally to average double figures and shoot 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from 3-point range and 85 percent from the foul line.

During Big Ten play, he led NU in scoring at 14.2 ppg to rank 15th in the conference while also ranking among Big Ten leaders in field goal percentage (.512, seventh) and 3-pointers per game (2.3, sixth) as he shot 41 percent from beyond the arc. He had seven of his nine 20-point games during Big Ten contests, including a career-high 30-point effort against Penn State, and added 23 points in NU's loss to Minnesota in the Big Ten Tournament.

Tominaga has played in NU's last four games since returning against Rider on Nov. 13 and is averaging 14.0 points per game. His two 3-pointers in the second half against Rider started a 17-0 spurt that put the game away. Tominaga comes off a season-high 23-point effort against Duquesne on Wednesday.

A QUICK LOOK AT THE HUSKERS

Nebraska entered the 2023-24 season with its most experienced roster in Fred Hoiberg's five seasons at the helm. The Huskers returned seven letterwinners and three redshirts while adding seven new players to the roster.

- For the first time since 2018-19 and the third time since 2012-13, the Huskers return more than 50 percent of their scoring from the previous year.
- NU also returned 86 starts, which is the most since the 2018-19 NIT team. That breakdown is as follows: C.J. Wilcher (26); Keisei Tominaga (25); Juwan Gary (17); Jamarques Lawrence (12); Blaise Keita (5); Sam Hoiberg (1).
- The Huskers return five of their top eight scorers from a year ago, as Keisei Tominaga's 13.1 ppg is the highest for a Husker returnee since James Palmer Jr. in 2018-19 (17.2 ppg).
- The 2023-24 Huskers are an experienced bunch with nine of the 13 scholarship players in at least their fourth season of college basketball. The group features one sixth-year senior in Jarron Coleman and five others who are in their fifth season of college basketball.
- The 2023-24 roster combined for 766 appearances, including 409 starts, at the Division I level entering the season. That does not include two seasons of junior college basketball for both Keisei Tominaga and Blaise Keita.

HUSKERS TO BE CHALLENGED IN 2023-24

Nebraska will play 12 games this season against ranked teams or teams receiving votes in either the Associated Press or the USA Today Coaches preseason polls.

- Nebraska's home schedule features three preseason top-10 opponents in No. 3/2 Purdue, No. 4/4 Michigan State and No. 8/8 Creighton. In addition, NU also hosts three other teams (Wisconsin, Indiana and Ohio State receiving votes.
- Nebraska travels to No. 25/RV Illinois and makes trips to four other teams that received preseason votes in Kansas State, Maryland, Indiana and Ohio State.

TOMINAGA, MAST SPEND SUMMERS WITH NATIONAL TEAMS

A pair of Huskers spent the summer representing their national teams in international events. Rienk Mast represented the Netherlands in the FIBA Olympic Pre-Qualifying Tournament in Turkey, while Keisei Tominaga played for Japan in the FIBA World Cup.

- Mast played in all three games for the Netherlands, averaging 6.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.3 assists per game as the team posted a 1-2 record. His best performance was an eight-point, seven-rebound effort in a win over Belgium.
- Tominaga played in all five games for Japan, averaging 11.4 points per game in helping the team qualify for the 2024 Paris Olympics as the highest finishing team from Asia. He was named player of the game in the win over Cape Verde, finishing with 22 points on 8-of-11 shooting from the field, including 6-of-8 from 3-point range. Of the five NCAA players who played in the World Cup, Tominaga was the only one to average double figures.

MCGOWENS HELPS USA TO GOLD

Former Nebraska men's basketball player Trey McGowens earned a gold medal this past October, leading Team USA to a gold medal in the FIBA 3x3 U23 World Cup on Sunday in Lublin, Poland.

McGowens, who played at Nebraska for two seasons (2020-22), was named MVP of the Tournament and named to the Team of the Tournament, as the United States went 7-0. McGowens, who played for the Long Island Nets in the NBA G League last season, led all tournament players with 54 points during the competition.

At Nebraska, McGowens was a two-year starter for the Huskers (2020-22). He averaged 9.2 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game at NU while he was often assigned to the opponent's top perimeter scoring threat.

HOIBERG'S HUSKER TIES

While Fred Hoiberg grew up in Ames and played his high school (Ames High School) and college basketball (Iowa State) there, he was born in Lincoln and has numerous ties to the city and to the University of Nebraska.

- Fred's father (Eric) and mother (Karen) both earned their undergraduate degrees from Nebraska in 1966. In fact, Eric earned his undergraduate degree, Master's degree, and Ph.D. in sociology from the university.

- His maternal grandfather was former Husker basketball coach Jerry Bush. Known as the "Big Bear of the Coliseum," Bush guided NU from 1955 to 1963, and directed two of the greatest upsets ever – a 43-41 victory over top-ranked Kansas and Wilt Chamberlain, and a 55-48 victory over No. 4 Kansas State and Olympian Bob Boozer during the 1957-58 campaign.

- His paternal grandfather (Otto) received his Master's Degree and Ph.D from Nebraska. He joined the faculty of the University of Nebraska in 1948, where he taught sociology and served as director of the community development program in the University of Nebraska Extension Division.

- Fred's son (Sam) is in his third season on the Husker basketball team after walking on. Fred and Sam are one of 22 father-son duos in Division I this season.

Rice (16.0 ppg) both averaged at least 16 points per game. Redshirt freshman Cale Jacobsen led NU in rebounding at 8.3 per game and tied Jarmarques Lawrence for the team high in assists per game (4.3 apg).

HUSKER COACHING STAFF RETURNS INTACT

Nebraska's full-time coaching staff remains the same as it was during the 2022-23 season with Nate Loenser, Adam Howard and Ernie Zeigler joining Head Coach Fred Hoiberg on the Husker bench.

- Loenser begins his third season on the Husker staff. He joined the Husker program after spending five seasons with the Chicago Bulls organization. Loenser was an assistant coach for the Bulls under both Fred Hoiberg and Jim Boylan for three seasons. He also served as the Bulls' video coordinator and head coach of the Windy City Bulls. Loenser worked with Hoiberg at Iowa State for two seasons.

- Howard is in his second year on the coaching staff. He was selected to participate in the 2023 TopConnect Basketball Symposium, an event featuring some of the nation's top assistant coaches. Prior to joining the NU staff, he spent four years at South Alabama, helping the program to 75 wins in that span after the program had seven straight losing seasons. In 2021-22, South Alabama won 21 games, the school's highest total since 2008. Howard also coached at Troy, Tennessee, Southern Miss and Morehead State after playing collegiately at Western Kentucky.

- Zeigler is also in his second year at Nebraska. He joined the NU staff in August of 2022 after spending six years on Ben Howland's staff at Mississippi State. The Bulldogs had four postseason appearances between 2018-22. Zeigler spent six seasons as the head coach at Central Michigan (2007-12) and previously served stints at UCLA, Pittsburgh, Kansas State, Detroit, and Bowling Green.

QUICK HITTERS

- Nebraska improved its win total from 10 to 16 games in 2022-23. NU was one of four Big Ten teams which increased its win total by at least six games last season (also Northwestern, Maryland and Penn State). Of Nebraska's 16 losses this season, 12 were against NCAA Tournament qualifiers.

Nebraska has improved its season record in each of the last three years under Fred Hoiberg and increased its win total in each of the last two seasons. If Nebraska can increase its win total in 2023-24, it will mark the first time since the mid-1960s (1963-64 to 1965-66) that the Huskers increased their win total for three straight years.

- Nebraska's nine Big Ten wins were the most since winning a school-record 13 Big Ten games in 2017-18. It was NU's third-highest conference win total since joining the Big Ten in 2011-12. In all, 11 Big Ten teams reached postseason play, including eight NCAA Tournament teams, in 2022-23.

- Nebraska had multiple All-Big Ten selections with Derrick Walker and Keisei Tominaga. It marked the first time since 2017-18 that NU had multiple all-conference picks. Walker became the first Husker to receive second team or higher All-Big Ten honors since James Palmer Jr. in 2017-18.

HUSKER ROSTER HAS INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

NU's roster has had an international flavor in recent seasons and that trend will continue in 2023-24. Four Huskers hail from overseas, including Keisei Tominaga (Moriyama Nagoya Aichi, Japan), Matar Diop (Dakar, Senegal), Blaise Keita (Bamako, Mali), and Rienk Mast (Groningen, Netherlands).

In five seasons under Hoiberg, NU has had players on its roster from a host of countries, including Australia, Canada, England, France, Iceland, Lithuania, and Slovenia.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Several members of the 2023-24 Huskers have family members who have played basketball at the college or professional levels. The list is led by Fred Hoiberg, who played in the NBA for a decade after a standout career at Iowa State. In addition, Ramel Lloyd was a Parade All-American who scored over 1,600 points at the college level at Syracuse and Long Beach State, while Henry Williams scored a school-record 2,383 points at Charlotte and his number 34 jersey was retired by the school. Keisei Tominaga's father didn't play college basketball but was a center on the Japanese national team at the 1998 FIBA World Championship and played professionally in Japan for a decade.

NEBRASKA HEAD COACH FRED HOIBERG

NEBRASKA (2019-PRESENT)

- Hired as Nebraska's 28th men's basketball coach on March 30, 2019, a position his grandfather (Jerry Bush) held for nine seasons from 1954 to 1963.
- Is the only coach in school history with two road wins against top-10 teams
- Guided Nebraska to three consecutive road wins over ranked opponents (No. 23 Ohio State and No. 10 Wisconsin in 2021-22 and No. 7 Creighton in 2022-23) for the first time in school history
- Brought in the highest-ranked recruiting class in school history, as his 2021 class was ranked 13th nationally by ESPN.com
- Had NBA Draft Picks in both 2021 (Dalano Banton) and 2022 (Bryce McGowens) and has produced 12 players who have reached the NBA

CHICAGO BULLS (2015-18)

- Coached the Chicago Bulls for three-plus seasons, posting a 115-155 record.
- Became just the fifth coach in franchise history to post a winning record in his debut season.
- Took the Bulls to the 2017 NBA Playoffs where they won the first two games against the top-seeded Boston Celtics, as the Bulls were the first No. 8 seed to take a 2-0 lead against a No. 1 seed since 1993.
- Was the fifth coach in NBA history to have each of his first two career playoff victories come on the road.

IOWA STATE (2010-15)

- Served as head coach at his alma mater for five seasons, posting a 115-56 record, which is the top winning percentage in school history (.673).
- Led the Cyclones to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances - a program record - while his 115 wins were the most in a five-year stretch in school history.
- Guided Iowa State to back-to-back Big 12 Tournament titles in 2014 and 2015.
- Produced four All-Americans, 12 All-Big 12 honorees and 10 players who played in the NBA.
- Named Big 12 Coach of the Year in 2012, as the Cyclones went from three conference wins to 12 in one season.
- Won 28 games and reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2014.
- Led the Big 12 in scoring offense in two of his last four seasons and topped the conference in 3-pointers four times in five years.

MINNESOTA TIMBERWOLVES (2005-10)

- Served as Vice President of Basketball Operations in 2009-10, overseeing the day-to-day operations of basketball programs including college and pro scouting, salary cap management and NBA Draft preparations.
- Was the Assistant General Manager for three seasons, helping the Timberwolves orchestrate a draft-day trade for five-time all-star Kevin Love in 2008.

AS AN NBA PLAYER (1995-2005)

- Spent 10 years in the NBA with the Indiana Pacers (four seasons), Chicago Bulls (four seasons) and Minnesota Timberwolves (two seasons) after being selected in the second round of the 1995 NBA Draft.
- Was a member of three NBA Playoff Teams, including a Timberwolves team that reached the 2004 Western Conference Finals.
- Shot 40 percent from 3-point range during his career and led the NBA in 3-point shooting in his final season (48.3, 2004-05).
- Ended his NBA career abruptly at the age of 33 after undergoing open-heart surgery to repair an aneurysm in his aortic root.

AS A PLAYER AT IOWA STATE (1991-95)

- Started all four seasons at Iowa State, averaging 15.8 points, 6.9 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.6 steals per game in his collegiate career.
- His No. 32 was retired by Iowa State in 1997 and Hoiberg is a member of the Iowa State Hall of Fame.
- Garnered third-team All-America honors as a senior in 1994-95, averaging 19.9 points per game to help the Cyclones win a then-school-record 23 games and was named Big Eight Co-Male Athlete of the Year in 1995.
- Two-time Academic All-American who was inducted into the CSC Academic Hall of Fame in 2016.

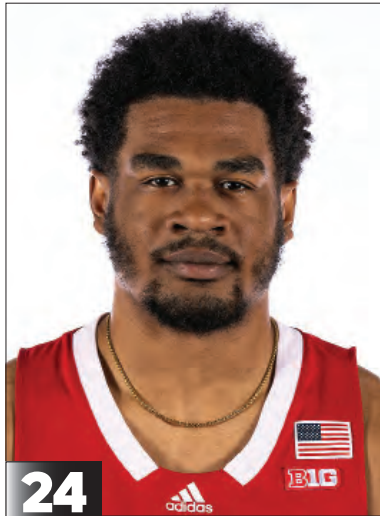
