## **New-Look Weekend Rotation**

- With two weekend starters taken in the 2023 MLB Draft, it'll be a new-look weekend rotation for the Huskers this year.
- Junior Drew Christo takes the mound Thursday night after making a relief appearance against Oklahoma last weekend. The Elkhorn, Neb., native pitched two innings, allowing two runs on pair of hits while striking out two and issuing two walks to the Sooners on Sunday.
- Brett Sears is set to toe the rubber on Friday night after getting the nod as Nebraska's starter on Opening Day last weekend. Sears got the nodecision in a 5.1-inning effort while making his first career start. The Westphalia, lowa, native allowed one run on three hits and struck out seven in Nebraska's 4-1 win against Baylor.
- Will Walsh is scheduled to get the ball for the second consecutive Saturday for the NU pitching staff. The redshirt junior threw 5.2 innings against No. 21 Texas Tech, allowing three runs on seven hits and striking out four Red Raiders.
- Caleb Clark gets the nod in the series finale on Sunday after serving as Nebraska's Sunday starter last weekend at the Shriners Children's College Showdown. Clark allowed just one run on three hits in 2.2 innings of work. The Orillia, Ontario, native struck out three OU hitters and surrendered a trio of walks in the series finale.

## **Newcomers In the Pen**

- Tucker Timmerman appeared in two relief outings last weekend, recording his first career win while making his collegiate debut against Baylor on Friday.
- Evan Borst retired all four batters he faced in Sunday's matchup against Oklahoma, recording

- the final out in the seventh and hurling a scoreless eighth frame.
- Kyle Froehlich also made his debut with the Big Red on Sunday, the Northwestern State transfer retired the side in order in the sixth inning.
- Mason McConnaughey allowed two earned runs in his Husker debut against No. 21 Texas Tech, despite punching out two of four batters he faced.
- Ty Horn tied for the longest relief appearance from a Husker reliever last weekend, going 1.2 innings on Saturday vs. No. 21 Texas Tech while surrendering just one hit.
- Bobby Olsen struck out his only batter faced on Saturday against the 21st-ranked Red Raiders, posting his 108th career strikeout at the DI level after spending four years at Brown.

## **Sears Shines in Season Opener**

- Making his first career start with the Huskers, Opening-Day starter Brett Sears had a strong performance in a 5.1-inning effort in Nebraska's 4-1 win against Baylor on Friday.
- The Westphalia, Iowa, native allowed one run on three hits and struck out seven Bears, matching his career high vs. South Dakota State last season.
- Sears is one of 12 starting pitchers nationally to throw at least five innings with seven-plus strikeouts and one or fewer earned runs on the opening weekend of the season.

## **Timmerman Collects Rare Win on Opening Day**

- Tucker Timmerman became the first Nebraska freshman to record a win on Opening Day since at least 1999.
- The Beatrice, Neb., native made his collegiate debut in a tied game in the bottom of the sixth inning against Baylor and hurled 1.2 scoreless innings in relief.
- Along with being the first freshman, Timmerman becomes the fourth underclassman to record a win in the season opener for the Huskers, joining sophomores Eric Rose (2009), Tony Watson (2006) and Zach Kroenke (2004).

## Carey's Strong Sophomore Start at Shortstop

- Dylan Carey started all three games for the Big Red last weekend at shortstop, going 4-for-13 (.308) in the three-hole spot.
- The Castle Rock, Colo., native drove in a teamhigh three runs, all of which came with two outs, including an RBI single against Baylor and a two-run double vs. No. 21 Texas Tech.
- The junior has started 23 consecutive games for NU dating back to last season.
- Carey started 53 games in his first season with the Huskers in 2023, which is the most games started by a Husker freshman since Ryan Boldt (60) in 2014.

## Silva Impresses in Big Red Debut

- Riley Silva secured four hits at the Shriners Children's College Showdown at Globe Life Field last weekend, giving him a .364 batting average (4-for-11) heading into Nebraska's series at Grand Canyon.
- Silva also swiped two bases, the only Husker with multiple on the weekend, and tied for a a team-high with a trio of runs scored.

## Small-Ball Approach Added to Big Red Offense

• After bashing a school-record 97 homers last



season, the Husker offense has shifted to a small-ball approach to begin the 2024 campaign.

- Cayden Brumbaugh has laid down a team-high two sacrifice bunts, while Riley Silva has swiped a team-leading two stolen bases through three games.
- The Big Red are one of four teams nationally to steal five bases and average 1.3 sacrifice bunts per game or higher over the season-opening weekend.

## First Home Run in First Plate Appearance

• Garrett Anglim launched a 372-foot home run to left field on Friday afternoon vs. Baylor, becoming the first Husker to homer in his first at-bat of the season since Max Anderson in 2021 against Purdue.

## **Rob Childress Pitching Factory**

- Proven to be one of the nation's top pitching coaches at the collegiate level, Rob Childress has produced 24 All-Americans and 39 top-10 round draft picks in his 24 seasons directing the pitching at Nebraska and Texas A&M.
- Under his tutelage, 79 pitchers have been drafted or signed as free agents during his time with the Huskers and Aggies.
- Childress' pitching staffs have finished in the top-15 in the country in ERA eight times since 2000, including top-three finishes on three occasions. Five of his pitching staffs have finished in the top-25 nationally in strikeouts per nine innings since 2010, including four times in the top 10.
- In his first stint at Nebraska, the Huskers produced five of the top six single-season strikeout totals in school history, including a school-record 538 strikeouts in 2005, while issuing fewer than three walks per game in his final five seasons in Lincoln.

## **Swansen One of Nation's Top Returning Bats**

- After a limited role as a freshman in 2022, Gabe Swansen had a breakout sophomore campaign with 18 homers and 57 RBI while hitting .291 at the plate in 2023.
- The second-team All-Big Ten selection is one of 22 players nationally to return this season after hitting at least .290 at the plate with 18 home runs and 57 runs driven in.
- Nine of the 22 returning players are at the Power Five level, highlighted by Jac Caglianone (Florida), Gavin Kash (Texas Tech) and Charlie Condon (Georgia).

## Silva's Speed on the Basepath

- Riley Silva joins the Huskers as a junior college transfer from Barton Community College, hitting .361 at the plate with 11 doubles, seven triples and 41 RBI across his two seasons with the Cougars.
- The Cambridge, Ontario, native was one of three NJCAA DI players to post a .350+ batting with 40-plus stolen bases and at least 70 runs last season.
- Silva's 44 stolen bases were the second-most in program history in a single-season, as he became one of four Cougars in program history to reach 40 stolen bases in a season.
- The Barton CC transfer garnered Second-Team All-Region VI and First-Team All-KJCCC recognition as a sophomore in 2023.

## Dynamic Duo in NJCAA DI

- Rhett Stokes and Joshua Overbeek finished last season as two of 20 NJCAA DI players to hit at least .415 at the plate with 32-plus extra-base hits and 55-plus RBI.
- A product of Pitt and Cisco College, Overbeek appeared in 56 games with the Wranglers in 2023, compiling 21 multi-hit games and 14 multi-RBI performances at Cisco.
- Stokes spent two seasons at New Mexico Military Institute, where he hit .399 with 32 doubles, 16 triples, 19 homers, 98 RBI, 165 runs and 35 stolen bases in two seasons with the Broncos.
- Stokes finished the 2023 campaign as one of five NJCAA DI players to post an on-base percentage of .560-plus, adding 20 doubles and leading all of junior college with 101 runs.

## Four Huskers Taken in 2023 MLB Draft

- The Huskers have had at least three players picked in the MLB Draft 10 times since 2010 after Brice Matthews, Max Anderson, Emmett Olson and Jace Kaminska had their names called in the 2023 MLB Draft.
- Last year's draft marked the fourth time in program history that the Huskers had at least four players picked in the top 10 rounds. The last time the Big Red had four Huskers go in the first 10 rounds was back in 2005.
- Matthews became the seventh first-round selection in NU history with the 28th overall pick by the Houston Astros. The NU junior was a Dick Howser Trophy semifinalist and second-team All-American by the NCBWA after batting .359 with 11 doubles, two triples, 20 home runs, 67 RBI and 61 runs scored in 2023.
- Anderson heard his name called with the 45th overall pick in the second round to become the fifth second-round selection in program history. The Omaha native was a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy and a consensus second-team All-American by all media outlets after hitting .414 with 20 doubles, three triples, 21 home runs, 70 RBI and 51 runs scored in 2023.
- Olson was the third Husker to be taken, as he was the 110th overall pick by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round. The NU junior went 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA in 15 starts as the starter on Friday night for the Huskers. Olson compiled 80 strikeouts with 30 walks in 82 innings and held opponents to a .227 batting average.
- Kaminska was taken by the Colorado Rockies in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. The Wichita State transfer went 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA in 14 starts for the Huskers. Kaminska totaled 57 strikeouts with 15 walks in 72 innings while holding opponents to a .235 hitting clip.

## Harvell, Sirianni Recognized by D1Baseball

- Assistant coaches Lance Harvell and Mike Sirianni were recognized by D1Baseball as two of the "Top 100 Assistant Coaches on the Rise" in October of 2023.
- Nebraska is one of 20 programs nationally with at least two assistant coaches on the list, including one of three Big Ten programs.
- Entering his fifth season with the Huskers, Harvell coaches hitters and outfielders and serves as NU's third-base coach.
- Sirianni is in his first season with the Huskers after spending the previous four seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Wichita State.

## Coaches at the Alma Mater

• Head coach Will Bolt is one of 54 DI coaches leading their alma mater this season. A member of Dave Van Horn's first recruiting class, Bolt was a four-year starter and team captain on Nebraska's 2001 and 2002 College World Series teams. He earned his bachelor's degree in communication studies in 2003 before earning his master's degree in 2006.

## **NU Among Nation's Best in Attendance**

• Nebraska has led the Big Ten in attendance every season since joining the Big Ten in 2012

and ranks 10th nationally in average attendance in the last 12 seasons with 4,123 fans per game.

- The Big Red have ranked in the Top 20 in average attendance in each season since 2012, climbing as high as sixth in 2017 and 2021.
- The Huskers have finished in the top 15 in average attendance in every season since 2015, joining LSU, Ole Miss, Arkansas, South Carolina, Mississippi State, Texas and Florida as the only eight programs to accomplish the feat.

# HEAD COACH WILL BOLT 7

One of the catalysts in Nebraska baseball's rise to national prominence in his playing days, Will Bolt returned to his alma mater as former athletic director Bill Moos named Bolt the 24th head coach of the Husker baseball program on June 14, 2019. He enters his third season at the helm in 2022.

Bolt captained the Huskers' first two College World Series teams in 2001 and 2002, and has 12 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience, having served in assistant coaching roles at Texas A&M and Nebraska. Bolt also spent four years as the head coach at Texarkana College.

## Nebraska Head Coach

In 2023, the Huskers had four players picked in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft for the first time since 2005. Fueled by Second-Team All-American Max Anderson and first-round draft pick Brice Matthews, the Nebraska offense belted a school-record 97 home runs. Anderson became the first Husker since 2001 to hit above .400 at the plate with a .414 batting average while hitting the fifthmost homers in program history with 21 last season. Matthews became the first player in program history and second player all-time in the Big Ten to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season.

The 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year, Bolt guided Nebraska to its second Big Ten regular-season championship in 2021. The Huskers compiled a 34-14 record, including a 31-12 record in Big Ten play, with NU capturing the league crown by 3.5 games. Nebraska also advanced to its first regional final since 2007 while posting a 3-2 record in the NCAA Fayetteville Regional.

In addition to Bolt's coaching accolade, NU counted the Big Ten Player of the Year in Spencer Schwellenbach, the Big Ten Freshman of the Year in Max Anderson and four first-team All-Big Ten honorees -- its most since joining the league. Schwellenbach was also tabbed the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year and a first-team All-American, and Anderson picked up Freshman All-America recognition.

Three NU hurlers were selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, with Schwellenbach in the second round (59th overall) by the Atlanta Braves, Cade Povich going in the third round (98th overall) by the Minnesota Twins and Cam Wynne picked in the 20th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Bolt and his coaching staff have done impressive work in recruiting since their arrival in Lincoln. The Huskers' 15-member 2021 recruiting class, which included a trio of top-200 prospects, was ranked 20th by Perfect Game, 21st by Baseball America and 36th by Collegiate Baseball.

Nebraska's 2020 season -- Bolt's first at the helm -- was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

## Texas A&M Assistant Coach

Bolt spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Texas A&M under former NU assistant Rob Childress. In that span, the Aggies went 219-98-1 (.690) with five straight NCAA Regional appearances, three Regional titles, an SEC Tournament title in 2016 and an appearance in the 2017 College World Series.

Bolt's primary functions on the Aggie staff included coordinating the offensive game, mentoring the infielders and serving as third base coach. The Aggies finished in the top-25 nationally in batting average twice under his tutelage, and finished in the top five of the SEC in hitting or runs scored in four of his five seasons with the Aggies. He tutored 12 hitters who were selected in the MLB Draft during his tenure in College Station, including six players selected in the top-10 rounds, and seven players who earned first- or second-team All-SEC honors.

In 2019, the Aggie offense was led by Braden Shewmake, who was the No. 21 overall selection in the Major League Baseball Draft by the Atlanta Braves. Shewmake hit .313 with six homers, 47 RBI and 45 runs scored en route to becoming the school's first MLB first-round pick since 2012. The Aggies won 39 games and reached the championship game of the Morgantown Regional.

In 2018, the Aggies went 40-22 and reached an NCAA Regional behind the emergence of Michael Helman, who finished 15th in the nation in hits (92), and logged a .369 batting average, .451 on-base percentage and 61 runs to rank in the top 50 nationally.

The Aggies made a run to the College World Series in 2017, finishing the season with a 41-23 mark behind the rise of Shewmake, who earned All-America honors and was named National Freshman of the Year and SEC Freshman of the Year after hitting .328 with 11 homers and 69 RBI.

Bolt guided a prolific Texas A&M offense to 49 runs and an SEC Tournament title in 2016, as the Aggies led the SEC in batting average, runs scored, hits, home runs, on-base percentage and slugging percentage while ranking in the top-25 nationally in seven categories, including hits (712, second), runs (471, ninth), batting average (.311, 15th), doubles (129, 20th), home runs (62, 22nd), slugging percentage (.467, 22nd) and scoring offense (7.2 runs per game, 23rd). The Aggies were led by All-American Boomer White, who hit .386 with five homers, 46 RBI and 49 runs scored while striking out just 16 times in 259 plate appearances en route to SEC Player-of-the-Year honors.

Bolt made an immediate impact for the Texas A&M offense in his first season, as the Aggies ranked second in the SEC in hitting (.299) and third in runs scored (6.6) during his first season in College Station. The Aggies opened the season with an SEC-record 24-game win streak on their way to a 50-



win season and a Super Regional appearance. That year, the Aggies ranked among the national leaders in home runs (third, 70), hits (655, seventh), runs (424, 15th) and slugging percentage (.457, 15th).

## Nebraska Associate Head Coach

Bolt was associate head coach for the Huskers from 2012 to 2014, serving under Darin Erstad. Bolt tutored four players to first-team All-Big Ten honors, including two-time selections Chad Christensen, Michael Pritchard and Pat Kelly.

Nebraska was one of the top offenses in the Big Ten during his final year in Lincoln in 2014, ranking 19th nationally in hits (623), 30th in triples (19) and 31st in batting average (.293) as Nebraska won 41 games and reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. Nebraska's defense was also one of the best units in the country. With new starters at first base, third base, shortstop, left field and center field, the Huskers ranked 21st in the country with a .976 fielding percentage.

Under Bolt's watch in 2013, Nebraska's defense turned in its best performance in school history. The Huskers ranked second in the nation with a .981 fielding percentage, setting school and Big Ten records. The Husker offense improved under Bolt's tutelage in 2013, ranking in the top three in the Big Ten in eight offensive categories. In conference play, the Huskers led the conference in batting average (.335), on-base percentage (.401), runs (180), hits (307) and RBIs (159).

In Bolt's first season at Nebraska in 2012, he helped raise the team batting average by 45 points, as the Huskers ranked eighth nationally with a .315 clip as a squad. NU was eighth nationally in scoring offense, leading the Big Ten with 7.1 runs per game, while also topping the conference in homers (47), on-base percentage (.384) and runs scored (413). Pritchard, a thirdteam All-American, was one of six Husker hitters to earn all-conference recognition.

## Texarkana College Head Coach

Before joining Erstad's staff, Bolt served four years as head coach at Texarkana College from 2008 to 2011. He led the Bulldogs to a pair of Region XIV championships during his fouryear stint. Bolt guided the Bulldogs to back-to-back Region XIV championships (2009 and 2010) during a stretch of four straight Regional Tournament appearances and four 30-plus win seasons. Bolt, who was 140-82 (.631) at Texarkana, helped over 20 players sign with Division I schools.

## Texas A&M Volunteer Assistant Coach

Bolt headed back to his home state in 2006 and spent two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach at Texas A&M. In 2007, he was on staff when the

Aggies advanced to the Super Regionals, while producing a 49-18 overall record and claiming the program's first Big 12 Tournament title. In College Station, Bolt specialized in infield work and helped tutor All-Americans Brandon Hicks and Blake Stouffer, who were each drafted in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft.

## Nebraska Volunteer Assistant Coach

Bolt began his collegiate coaching career as a volunteer assistant at Nebraska in 2005, working with the Husker infielders and hitters. Behind National Player of the Year Alex Gordon, the Huskers compiled a school-record 57 wins and swept the Big 12 regular-season and Tournament championships. Nebraska finished the season with a then-school record .975 fielding percentage and included an infield that featured Gordon, first-team All-Big 12 performer Curtis Ledbetter and Joe Simokaitis, a secondteam All-Big 12 pick.

**Nebraska Playing Career** A member of Dave Van Horn's first recruiting class, Bolt was a four-year starter and team captain on Nebraska's 2001 and 2002 College World Series teams. The infielder played an instrumental role in helping Nebraska to four NCAA Regionals, three Super Regionals and back-to-back College World Series appearances.

Bolt was the Minneapolis Regional MVP as a sophomore, hitting .545 in three games to lead the Big Red to its first-ever NCAA Regional title. The following year, Bolt made one of the most memorable plays in school history, catching the final out of the 2001 Super Regional against Rice to send the Big Red to its first-ever College World Series.

Bolt finished his career holding six school records, including games played (251), games started (242), at-bats (922), hits (281), doubles (56) and assists (639). Bolt remains in the school's top five in several categories, including doubles (first, 56), games played (second, 251), assists (second, 639), hits (third, 281) and runs scored (fifth, 197).

Following his playing career, he began his coaching career as a graduate manager at Nebraska in 2004 before serving as head coach for the Parkville Sluggers (M.I.N.K. League) the following summer.

## Personal

A native of Conroe, Texas, Bolt and his wife, Lauren, were married in July 2005. They have two sons, Jaxon and Austin, and one daughter, Bella. Bolt graduated from Nebraska in 2003 with a degree in communication studies before earning his master's degree in 2006. Lauren graduated from Nebraska in 2005 with a degree in journalism.

- With 78 occurrences, a 3-2 win is the most common result for Nebraska baseball, followed by defeats of 3-2 and 4-3 with 69 occurrences each.
- Since 2000, there have been 19 scorigami scores, including the most recent occurrence of the 16-16 tie last season in the series finale at San Diego.
- Five runs scored (402 occurrences) is the most common for the Huskers, while three runs scored (494 occurrences) is the most common for opponents.
- 26,378 runs scored, 20,825 runs allowed in 4,048 games in 118 seasons for an all-time record of 2,326-1704-18.


