GAME NOTES

NEBRASKA NOTES

- Nebraska joins Maryland as the only teams with back-to-back wins at this year's tournament.
- The Cornhuskers have advanced to the Big Ten Semifinals for the second time in three years.
- Nebraska reached today's quarterfinals with an eight-point win over Purdue on Thursday.
- Alexis Markowski (22 points, 12 rebounds) collected the 39th double-double of her career, which is one shy of matching the school record.
- Nebraska finished with a 44-30 advantage in rebounds.

MICHIGAN STATE NOTES

- All-Big Ten selection Julia Ayrault reached 25+ points for the fourth time this season.
- With three blocks, Ayrault also moved into fourth place on the school's all-time list (135).
- Michigan State saw its five-game winning streak snapped.
- MSU held a 14-6 edge in bench points.
- The Spartans were playing as a No. 4 seed for only the second time in program history.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- This afternoon's contest was a rematch of last year's Big Ten Second Round game, which MSU won 67-64.
- Nebraska leads the all-time series versus Michigan State, 12-6. Nebraska won the Big Ten opener for both teams, 80-74, on Dec. 9 in East Lansing, Mich.
- Second-straight upset of Friday's First Session.
