GAME NOTES

MARYLAND NOTES

- Maryland placed five scorers in double-figures.
- Bri McDaniel became the third Terrapin this season to surpass 400 points (now has 406), joining Shyanne Sellers (479) and Jakia Brown-Turner (427).
- Brown-Turner eclipsed 200 rebounds for the first time in her career.
- Lost for just the fifth time in 27 Big Ten Tournament games; now own a 6-2 record in the semifinals.
- Maryland advanced to today's semifinal with a win over 4th-ranked Ohio State on Friday, the Terps' first victory over a Top 5 opponent since 2014.

NEBRASKA NOTES

- Nebraska won its third game in as many days to advance to the Big Ten Championship Game. It will be the Cornhuskers' first final since 2014 (when they won) and third appearance overall.
- The Cornhuskers have won six of their last seven contests.
- Nebraska improved to 18-0 when leading at the half.
- Finished with 29 bench points.
- Jaz Shelley shot 50 percent from the 3-point line (6-for-12), finishing with a season-high 30 points. Shelley also distributed nine assists playing all 40 minutes.
- Alex Markowski surpassed 500 points on the season.

MISCELLANEOUS/TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Maryland dropped its third game in 19 meetings against Nebraska. It was also Nebraska's first win against Maryland in the Big Ten Tournament (series is 2-1).
