3 Brett Sears ranks in the top 10 nationally in three statistical categories, as he enters the weekend third in WHIP (0.51), eighth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (14.0) and 10th in hits allowed/9 inn. (3.91).

Follow the Game

- All three games of this weekend's series vs. Nicholls can be seen on B1G+.
- Fans can also listen to Greg Sharpe and Ben McLaughlin call the action this weekend on the Huskers Radio Network.
- Every game this season can be heard for free on Huskers.com and the Official Nebraska Huskers App for both iOS and android devices.

Nebraska vs. Nicholls

- Nebraska is 5-2 in the all-time series against Nicholls after taking two of three games in a relocated series played last season in Manhattan, Kan.
- The Huskers held on for a 2-1 win in seven innings in the series opener and rolled to a 17-1 rout of the Colonels in game two.
- The Big Red are 2-1 against Nicholls in Lincoln after winning the series against the Colonels at Hawks Field at Haymarket Park in 2016.

Nebraska Records Best 10-Game Start Since '08

- Nebraska recorded its best 10-game start since 2008 with a 7-3 mark through the first three weekends of the season.
- Since going 8-2 in 2008, the Big Red have won six of its first 10 games in six seasons, never reaching the seven-win mark until this year.

Stokes Named Big Ten Player of the Week

- Junior Rhett Stokes has been named the Big Ten's Player of the Week, the league office announced Monday afternoon.
- Stokes hit .750 (9-for-12) with four doubles, five RBI and two runs in three games vs. South Alabama, while recording a 1.083 slugging percentage and .750 on-base percentage.
- The Roswell, N.M., native became the first Husker since 2021 to record three consecutive three-hit games.
- Stokes went 3-for-4 with two doubles and a run in the series opener on Friday, followed by a 3-for-4 performance with three RBI on Saturday afternoon.
- The junior had a 3-for-4 day with two doubles and a pair of RBI in Sunday's series finale, including the game-tying two-RBI single in the fifth inning.

Weekend Rotation for the Big Red

- With two weekend starters taken in the 2023 MLB Draft, it's a new-look weekend rotation for the Huskers this year.
- Junior Drew Christo takes the mound Friday night after suffering his first loss of the season in the series opener vs. South Alabama last weekend. The Elkhorn, Neb., native is 1-1 on the season with a 5.68 ERA and 12 strikeouts in 19 innings.
- Brett Sears is set to toe the rubber on Saturday afternoon. Sears is 2-0 in four starts, posting a 1.78 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 25.1 innings, while holding opponents to a .125 hitting clip.
- Freshman Ty Horn gets the nod for the second consecutive Sunday. Horn is 1-0 on the season with a save and a 2.79 ERA in 9.2 innings across four appearances.

Huskers Control the Running Game

- Nebraska enters the weekend as one of nine teams nationally to limit opponents to four stolen bases or fewer this season.

- The Huskers have limited opponents to just four stolen base attempts on the season and are one of three teams to hold opponents to four stolen base attempts or less on the year.

Sears Shines in Starting Role

- Brett Sears limited South Alabama to just two runs on four hits in his fourth start last Saturday night, notching his third consecutive quality start for the Huskers.
- The right-hander has struck out seven-plus batters in four consecutive starts to begin the season, with opponents hitting just .125 (11-for-88) against Sears.
- Sears' eight innings on Saturday were the most by a Husker since Will Walsh tossed a complete game against Michigan State in the Big Ten Tournament last season.
- In three starts, Sears is 2-0 with a 1.78 ERA and is one of two starting pitchers in Division I this season with 25-plus innings pitched, 28-plus strikeouts and five earned runs or fewer.

Caron's RBI Production Through 13 Games

- Josh Caron has been a contributor to the NU offense this season, hitting .263 at the plate with a triple, four home runs, 15 RBI and 11 runs.
- Since 2012, Caron is one of five Huskers to drive in 15-plus runs in Nebraska's first 13 games to start the season. Caron's 15 RBI are tied for third-most, trailing Jesse Wilkening (2018) and Brice Matthews (2023).

Stone Heating Up in the Cleanup Spot

- Tyler Stone has hits in 10 of his last 11 starts, going 15-for-46 (.326) over that stretch with three doubles, four home runs and 15 RBI.
- Stone has five games this season with multiple RBI, which is the most by a Husker this season and leads all qualified Nebraska hitters with a .947 OPS.
- The Scottsdale, Ariz., native has multiple runs in each of his last three games, becoming the fifth Husker this season to post a double-digit run total.

Starts at the Top With Brumbaugh

- Cayden Brumbaugh has been a force in the leadoff spot for the Huskers, leading Nebraska with 17 hits and six multi-hit efforts through the first 15 games.
- Brumbaugh has hits in nine of his last 10 games, going 15-for-44 (.341) over that stretch with five doubles, four RBI and eight runs scored.

Evans Provides Spark for Husker Bats

- Cole Evans became the second Husker this season to post four or more hits in a game, finishing 4-for-5 with a double and an RBI in an 8-6 win at Wichita State on Tuesday.

• Evans is hitting .320 (16-for-50) this season with three doubles, a home run and nine runs driven in.

Silva an Offensive Catalyst for NU Offense

- Since moving up in the lineup to the No. 2 spot for the NU offense, Riley Silva has gone 11-for-32 (.344) at the plate with a double and two RBI.
- Silva has reached base safely in 13 of his 14 games to begin the season, leading all qualified Huskers with a .453 on-base percentage.
- The Cambridge, Ontario, native paces the Big Red in runs (16), stolen bases (9) and hit-by-pitches (10), as he is one of 11 Division I players to be hit 10-plus times this season.

Overbeek Returns to the Nebraska Lineup

- Joshua Overbeek returned to the lineup at third base for the Huskers at Wichita State on Wednesday for the first time since Feb. 17 vs. Oklahoma, going 1-for-4 with a double.

First Homer Without Leaving the Yard

- Max Buettenback picked up his first career home run in a pinch-hitting appearance in the ninth inning at Wichita State on Wednesday, slugging an inside-the-park home run down the left-field line.
- With the homer, Buettenback recorded Nebraska's first inside-the-park homer since Joe Acker vs. Rutgers in 2021.

Timely Two-Out Hitting for the Huskers

- The Husker offense has found success at the plate with two outs this season.
- Nebraska is hitting .330 (60-for-182) and has recorded 43 of its 88 RBI this season with two outs.
- 16 Huskers have recorded a two-out hit through the first 15 games, including six Huskers with at least four hits.

Small-Ball Approach Added to Big Red Offense

- After bashing a school-record 97 homers last season, the Husker offense has shifted to a small-ball approach to begin the 2024 campaign.
- Nebraska ranks ninth nationally with 14 sacrifice bunts on the season, led by Riley Silva's team-leading four sacrifice bunts in the first 15 games.

Rob Childress Pitching Factory

- Proven to be one of the nation's top pitching coaches at the collegiate level, Rob Childress has produced 24 All-Americans and 39 top-10 round draft picks in his 24 seasons directing the pitching at Nebraska and Texas A&M.

• Under his tutelage, 79 pitchers have been drafted or signed as free agents during his time with the Huskers and Aggies.

• Childress' pitching staffs have finished in the top-15 in the country in ERA eight times since 2000, including top-three finishes on three occasions. Five of his pitching staffs have finished in the top-25 nationally in strikeouts per nine innings since 2010, including four times in the top 10.

• In his first stint at Nebraska, the Huskers produced five of the top six single-season strikeout totals in school history, including a school-record 538 strikeouts in 2005, while issuing fewer than three walks per game in his final five seasons in Lincoln.

Bradford Belts First Pinch-Hit HR Since 2019

- Clay Bradford launched a pinch-hit three-run

home run in last Saturday's win against South Alabama, marking Nebraska's first pinch-hit homer since Ty Roseberry did so against Purdue in 2019.

Timmerman Collects Rare Win on Opening Day

- Tucker Timmerman became the first Nebraska freshman to record a win on Opening Day since at least 1999.
- The Beatrice, Neb., native made his collegiate debut in a tied game in the bottom of the sixth inning against Baylor and hurled 1.2 scoreless innings in relief.
- Along with being the first freshman, Timmerman becomes the fourth underclassman to record a win in the season opener for the Huskers, joining sophomores Eric Rose (2009), Tony Watson (2006) and Zach Kroenke (2004).

The Canadian Connection

- Nebraska has bolstered its roster this season with six Canadian players, marking the third consecutive season with at least one player from the Great White North on the NU roster.
- The Huskers are one of five programs nationally with at least five Canadians on the roster and have the third most, trailing Niagara and Canisius with 14 and nine, respectively.

JUCO Class Receives National Recognition

- It marked the second consecutive season with a top-10 JUCO class for Nebraska after last year's class finished ninth, behind the likes of Arkansas, Tennessee, Ole Miss and Arizona.
- The class features Evan Borst (RHP), Casey Daiss (RHP), Dylan Hufft (INF), Aaron Manias (INF), Mason McConnaughey (RHP), Joshua Overbeek (INF), Riley Silva (OF), Rhett Stokes (INF) and Tyler Stone (INF).

Mining the Junior College Ranks

- Of the 42 Huskers on this year's team, 16 Huskers spent time playing at least one season at the junior college level at some time prior to arriving in Lincoln.
- Two players hail from Iowa Centra CC, while Alvin CC, Barton County CC, Cisco College, Cloud County CC, Colby CC, College of Southern Nevada, Howard College, Iowa Western CC, Johnson County CC, New Mexico Military Institute, Parkland College, Pasco Hernandez JC and Wharton County JC all had one Husker come through their respective programs.

Four Huskers Taken in 2023 MLB Draft

- The Huskers have had at least three players picked in the MLB Draft 10 times since 2010 after Brice Matthews, Max Anderson, Emmett Olson and Jace Kaminska had their names called in the 2023 MLB Draft.
- Last year's draft marked the fourth time in program history that the Huskers had at least four players picked in the top 10 rounds. The last time the Big Red had four Huskers go in the first 10 rounds was back in 2005.
- Matthews became the seventh first-round selection in NU history with the 28th overall pick by the Houston Astros. The NU junior was a Dick Howser Trophy semifinalist and second-team All-American by the NCBWA after batting .359 with 11 doubles, two triples, 20 home runs, 67 RBI and 61 runs scored in 2023.
- Anderson heard his name called with the 45th overall pick in the second round to become the fifth second-round selection in program history. The Omaha native was a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy and a consensus second-team All-American by all media outlets after hitting .414 with 20 doubles, three triples, 21 home runs, 70 RBI and 51 runs scored in 2023.
- Olson was the third Husker to be taken, as he was the 110th overall pick by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round. The NU junior went 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA in 15 starts as the starter on Friday night for the Huskers. Olson compiled 80 strikeouts with 30 walks in 82 innings and held opponents to a .227 batting average.
- Kaminska was taken by the Colorado Rockies in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. The Wichita State transfer went 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA in 14 starts for the Huskers. Kaminska totaled 57 strikeouts with 15 walks in 72 innings while holding opponents to a .235 hitting clip.

Harvell, Sirianni Recognized by D1Baseball

- Assistant coaches Lance Harvell and Mike Sirianni were recognized by D1Baseball as two of the "Top 100 Assistant Coaches on the Rise" in October of 2023.
- Nebraska is one of 20 programs nationally with at least two assistant coaches on the list, including one of three Big Ten programs.
- Entering his fifth season with the Huskers, Harvell coaches hitters and outfielders and serves as NU's third-base coach.
- Sirianni is in his first season with the Huskers after spending the previous four seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Wichita State.

Coaches at the Alma Mater

- Head coach Will Bolt is one of 54 DI coaches leading their alma mater this season. A member of Dave Van Horn's first recruiting class, Bolt was a four-year starter and team captain on Nebraska's 2001 and 2002 College World Series teams. He earned his bachelor's degree in communication studies in 2003 before earning his master's degree in 2006.

#ProBigRed: Huskers in Spring Training

- With MLB spring training underway, seven former Huskers have reported to various spring training camps across Florida and Arizona this month.
- Jake Meyers and Brice Matthews earned invites

from the Astros, while Aaron Bummer and Jake McSteen received invites from the Braves. Matt Waldron (Padres), Cade Povich (Orioles) and Cam Wynne (Phillies) are also Huskers to keep an eye on this spring.

NU Among Nation's Best in Attendance

- Nebraska has led the Big Ten in attendance every season since joining the Big Ten in 2012 and ranks 10th nationally in average attendance in the last 12 seasons with 4,123 fans per game.
- The Big Red have ranked in the Top 20 in average attendance in each season since 2012, climbing as high as sixth in 2017 and 2021.
- The Huskers have finished in the top 15 in average attendance in every season since 2015, joining LSU, Ole Miss, Arkansas, South Carolina, Mississippi State, Texas and Florida as the only eight programs to accomplish the feat.

Hawks Field Celebrates 23rd Year in 2024

- The 2024 campaign marks Nebraska's 23rd year playing home games at Hawks Field at Haymarket Park. The Huskers moved to Hawks Field in 2002 after playing at Buck Beltzer Stadium for 23 years from 1979 to 2001.
- Nebraska enters 2024 with a 408-165-1 record at Hawks Field and hasn't had a losing season at home in each of the last 22 seasons. This season, the Huskers have 27 home games scheduled.

Gordon Enters College Baseball Hall of Fame

- Former Nebraska baseball standout Alex Gordon was one of 12 inductees to the College Baseball Hall of Fame's Class of 2023 on February 15, 2024.
- After earning freshman All-America honors in 2003, Gordon was honored as a first-team All-American in both 2004 and 2005. He was the consensus national player of the year, while winning the Golden Spikes, Brooks Wallace, Dick Howser and the ABCA National Player of the Year Awards. In addition to his accolades at the national level, Gordon was the two-time District Player of the Year and two-time Big 12 Player of the Year. A third baseman with the Huskers, Gordon led the Big Red to a school-record 57 victories in 2005, when Nebraska captured its first College World Series victory. A career .355 hitter in three seasons at Nebraska, Gordon finished his NU career in the top 10 of eight offensive categories, as he was third in total bases (447), fourth in home runs (44), runs batted in (189) and doubles (53), eighth in runs (188), ninth in hits (249) and slugging percentage (.657) and 10th in triples (11).

One of the catalysts in Nebraska baseball's rise to national prominence in his playing days, Will Bolt returned to his alma mater as former athletic director Bill Moos named Bolt the 24th head coach of the Husker baseball program on June 14, 2019. He enters his third season at the helm in 2022.

Bolt captained the Huskers' first two College World Series teams in 2001 and 2002, and has 12 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience, having served in assistant coaching roles at Texas A&M and Nebraska. Bolt also spent four years as the head coach at Texarkana College.

Nebraska Head Coach

In 2023, the Huskers had four players picked in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft for the first time since 2005. Fueled by Second-Team All-American Max Anderson and first-round draft pick Brice Matthews, the Nebraska offense belted a school-record 97 home runs. Anderson became the first Husker since 2001 to hit above .400 at the plate with a .414 batting average while hitting the fifth-most homers in program history with 21 last season. Matthews became the first player in program history and second player all-time in the Big Ten to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season.

The 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year, Bolt guided Nebraska to its second Big Ten regular-season championship in 2021. The Huskers compiled a 34-14 record, including a 31-12 record in Big Ten play, with NU capturing the league crown by 3.5 games. Nebraska also advanced to its first regional final since 2007 while posting a 3-2 record in the NCAA Fayetteville Regional.

In addition to Bolt's coaching accolade, NU counted the Big Ten Player of the Year in Spencer Schwellenbach, the Big Ten Freshman of the Year in Max Anderson and four first-team All-Big Ten honorees -- its most since joining the league. Schwellenbach was also tabbed the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year and a first-team All-American, and Anderson picked up Freshman All-America recognition.

Three NU hurlers were selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, with Schwellenbach in the second round (59th overall) by the Atlanta Braves, Cade Povich going in the third round (98th overall) by the Minnesota Twins and Cam Wynne picked in the 20th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Bolt and his coaching staff have done impressive work in recruiting since their arrival in Lincoln. The Huskers' 15-member 2021 recruiting class, which included a trio of top-200 prospects, was ranked 20th by Perfect Game, 21st by Baseball America and 36th by Collegiate Baseball.

Nebraska's 2020 season -- Bolt's first at the helm -- was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Texas A&M Assistant Coach

Bolt spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Texas A&M under former NU assistant Rob Childress. In that span, the Aggies went 219-98-1 (.690) with five straight NCAA Regional appearances, three Regional titles, an SEC Tournament title in 2016 and an appearance in the 2017 College World Series.

Bolt's primary functions on the Aggie staff included coordinating the offensive game, mentoring the infielders and serving as third base coach. The Aggies finished in the top-25 nationally in batting average twice under his tutelage, and finished in the top five of the SEC in hitting or runs scored in four of his five seasons with the Aggies. He tutored 12 hitters who were selected in the MLB Draft during his tenure in College Station, including six players selected in the top-10 rounds, and seven players who earned first- or second-team All-SEC honors.

In 2019, the Aggie offense was led by Braden Shewmake, who was the No. 21 overall selection in the Major League Baseball Draft by the Atlanta Braves. Shewmake hit .313 with six homers, 47 RBI and 45 runs scored en route to becoming the school's first MLB first-round pick since 2012. The Aggies won 39 games and reached the championship game of the Morgantown Regional.

In 2018, the Aggies went 40-22 and reached an NCAA Regional behind the emergence of Michael Helman, who finished 15th in the nation in hits (92), and logged a .369 batting average, .451 on-base percentage and 61 runs to rank in the top 50 nationally.

The Aggies made a run to the College World Series in 2017, finishing the season with a 41-23 mark behind the rise of Shewmake, who earned All-America honors and was named National Freshman of the Year and SEC Freshman of the Year after hitting .328 with 11 homers and 69 RBI.

Bolt guided a prolific Texas A&M offense to 49 runs and an SEC Tournament title in 2016, as the Aggies led the SEC in batting average, runs scored, hits, home runs, on-base percentage and slugging percentage while ranking in the top-25 nationally in seven categories, including hits (712, second), runs (471, ninth), batting average (.311, 15th), doubles (129, 20th), home runs (62, 22nd), slugging percentage (.467, 22nd) and scoring offense (7.2 runs per game, 23rd). The Aggies were led by All-American Boomer White, who hit .386 with five homers, 46 RBI and 49 runs scored while striking out just 16 times in 259 plate appearances en route to SEC Player-of-the-Year honors.

Bolt made an immediate impact for the Texas A&M offense in his first season, as the Aggies ranked second in the SEC in hitting (.299) and third in runs scored (6.6) during his first season in College Station. The Aggies opened the season with an SEC-record 24-game win streak on their way to a 50-

win season and a Super Regional appearance. That year, the Aggies ranked among the national leaders in home runs (third, 70), hits (655, seventh), runs (424, 15th) and slugging percentage (.457, 15th).

Nebraska Associate Head Coach

Bolt was associate head coach for the Huskers from 2012 to 2014, serving under Darin Erstad. Bolt tutored four players to first-team All-Big Ten honors, including two-time selections Chad Christensen, Michael Pritchard and Pat Kelly.

Nebraska was one of the top offenses in the Big Ten during his final year in Lincoln in 2014, ranking 19th nationally in hits (623), 30th in triples (19) and 31st in batting average (.293) as Nebraska won 41 games and reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. Nebraska's defense was also one of the best units in the country. With new starters at first base, third base, shortstop, left field and center field, the Huskers ranked 21st in the country with a .976 fielding percentage.

Under Bolt's watch in 2013, Nebraska's defense turned in its best performance in school history. The Huskers ranked second in the nation with a .981 fielding percentage, setting school and Big Ten records. The Husker offense improved under Bolt's tutelage in 2013, ranking in the top three in the Big Ten in eight offensive categories. In conference play, the Huskers led the conference in batting average (.335), on-base percentage (.401), runs (180), hits (307) and RBIs (159).

In Bolt's first season at Nebraska in 2012, he helped raise the team batting average by 45 points, as the Huskers ranked eighth nationally with a .315 clip as a squad. NU was eighth nationally in scoring offense, leading the Big Ten with 7.1 runs per game, while also topping the conference in homers (47), on-base percentage (.384) and runs scored (413). Pritchard, a third-team All-American, was one of six Husker hitters to earn all-conference recognition.

Texarkana College Head Coach

Before joining Erstad's staff, Bolt served four years as head coach at Texarkana College from 2008 to 2011. He led the Bulldogs to a pair of Region XIV championships during his four-year stint. Bolt guided the Bulldogs to back-to-back Region XIV championships (2009 and 2010) during a stretch of four straight Regional Tournament appearances and four 30-plus win seasons. Bolt, who was 140-82 (.631) at Texarkana, helped over 20 players sign with Division I schools.

Texas A&M Volunteer Assistant Coach

Bolt headed back to his home state in 2006 and spent two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach at Texas A&M. In 2007, he was on staff when the

Aggies advanced to the Super Regionals, while producing a 49-18 overall record and claiming the program's first Big 12 Tournament title. In College Station, Bolt specialized in infield work and helped tutor All-Americans Brandon Hicks and Blake Stouffer, who were each drafted in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft.

Nebraska Volunteer Assistant Coach

Bolt began his collegiate coaching career as a volunteer assistant at Nebraska in 2005, working with the Husker infielders and hitters. Behind National Player of the Year Alex Gordon, the Huskers compiled a school-record 57 wins and swept the Big 12 regular-season and Tournament championships. Nebraska finished the season with a then-school record .975 fielding percentage and included an infield that featured Gordon, first-team All-Big 12 performer Curtis Ledbetter and Joe Simokaitis, a second-team All-Big 12 pick.

Nebraska Playing Career

A member of Dave Van Horn's first recruiting class, Bolt was a four-year starter and team captain on Nebraska's 2001 and 2002 College World Series teams. The infielder played an instrumental role in helping Nebraska to four NCAA Regionals, three Super Regionals and back-to-back College World Series appearances.

Bolt was the Minneapolis Regional MVP as a sophomore, hitting .545 in three games to lead the Big Red to its first-ever NCAA Regional title. The following year, Bolt made one of the most memorable plays in school history, catching the final out of the 2001 Super Regional against Rice to send the Big Red to its first-ever College World Series.

Bolt finished his career holding six school records, including games played (251), games started (242), at-bats (922), hits (281), doubles (56) and assists (639). Bolt remains in the school's top five in several categories, including doubles (first, 56), games played (second, 251), assists (second, 639), hits (third, 281) and runs scored (fifth, 197).

Following his playing career, he began his coaching career as a graduate manager at Nebraska in 2004 before serving as head coach for the Parkville Sluggers (M.I.N.K. League) the following summer.

Personal

A native of Conroe, Texas, Bolt and his wife, Lauren, were married in July 2005. They have two sons, Jaxon and Austin, and one daughter, Bella. Bolt graduated from Nebraska in 2003 with a degree in communication studies before earning his master's degree in 2006. Lauren graduated from Nebraska in 2005 with a degree in journalism.

NEBRASKA BASEBALL SCORIGAMI

A scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before. Generally associated with the NFL, the term was coined by SB Nation sportswriter Jon Bois in 2016. Through the 2023 season, there have been 1,084 unique scores ("scorigamis") in NFL history.

NEBRASKA BASEBALL SCORIGAMI TRENDS

- Through 4,060 games in Nebraska baseball history, there have been 401 unique score combinations.
- The most common score is 3-2 (147 occurrences), followed by 4-3 (136 occurrences).
- Five of the six most common scores are one-run games, with the exception of 5-3 (100 times).
- With 78 occurrences, a 3-2 win is the most common result for Nebraska baseball, followed by defeats of 3-2 and 4-3 with 69 occurrences each.
- Since 2000, there have been 19 scorigami scores, including the most recent occurrence of the 16-16 tie last season in the series finale at San Diego.
- Five runs scored (405 occurrences) is the most common for the Huskers, while three runs scored (495 occurrences) is the most common for opponents.
- **26,466** runs scored, **20,890** runs allowed in **4,060** games in **118** seasons for an all-time record of **2,335-1707-18**.

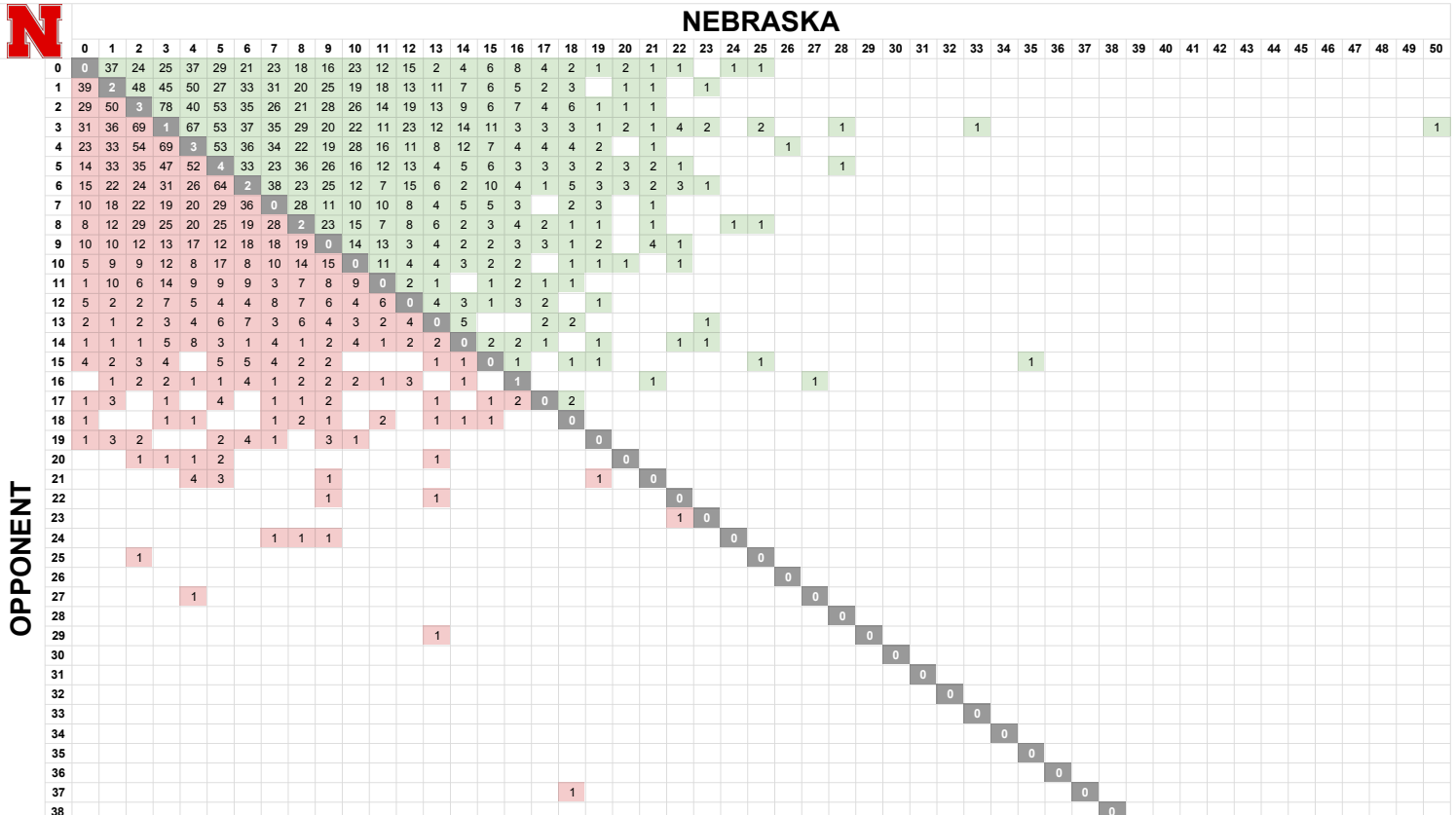
