Point system: NTCA submitted ballots rank the top ten first year student athletes in the sport of NCAA bowling. Each position has a designated point value, ranging from sixteen points for first place and one point for tenth place. To be ranked student athletes need to equal or surpass the minimum vote criteria, which is one vote for every three ballots submitted. The actual ranking position is determined by using the adjusted point standings, which lists in priority order the total points a student athlete has accumulated after the highest and lowest votes are dropped.

The specific point values follow: 1st place =16 points, 2nd =13, 3rd =11, 4th =9, 5th =7, 6th =5, 7th =4, 8th =3, 9th =2, 10th =1.
