The Mountain Pacific Sports Federation... Tomorrow's Olympians Today

The Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) was established in 1992 to serve the competitive needs of member institutions from the Big West, Pacific-10, Mountain West, Western Athletic and West Coast conferences and other selected universities in the western United States, to provide championship competition for Division I intercollegiate Olympic sports in a conference setting.

The conference operates under Executive Director Al Beard and has been home to the Nebraska men's gymnastics program since 1995. Since then, the Huskers have taken home a pair of MPSF team championships and garnered 13 individual titles.

In 2009-10, four MPSF teams won NCAA championships with more than a dozen teams and hundreds of student-athletes competing in NCAA postseason competition.

USC won both the NCAA men's and women's water polo titles, while Stanford took the NCAA men's volleyball crown. The Oregon women's indoor track and field also won its first NCAA title.

Oklahoma won its 10th MPSF men's gymnastics championship in its home arena at McCasland Field House in Norman, Okla., April 3, 2010.

Nebraska finished fourth at the 2010 MPSF Championships with a score of 341.650, as Kyle Shanahan led the Huskers with a seventh-place finish in the individual all-around competition.

Andreas Hofer added an eighth-place showing in the all-around competition.

The MPSF was well-represented at the 2010 NCAA Men's Gymnastics Championships held in West Point, N.Y. Stanford led the charge with a runner-up finish, while Oklahoma added a third-place team finish. California gave the MPSF three of the top five teams in the nation with a fifth-place showing.

Nebraska contributed a ninth-place team finish at the NCAA Championships, while Anthony Ingrelli captured All-America honors on still rings.

Nebraska will compete in its final year in the MPSF in 2011, before joining the Big Ten Conference for the 2011-12 athletic campaign.

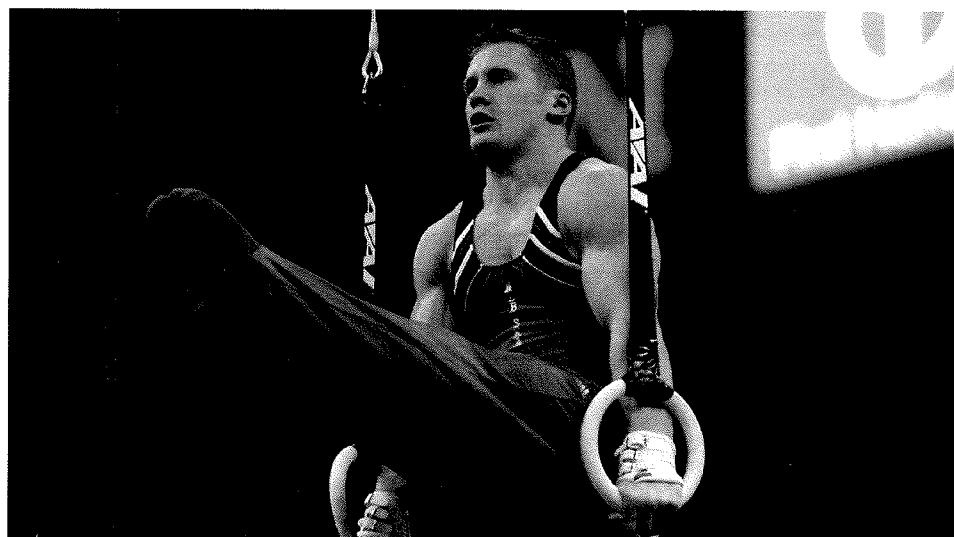

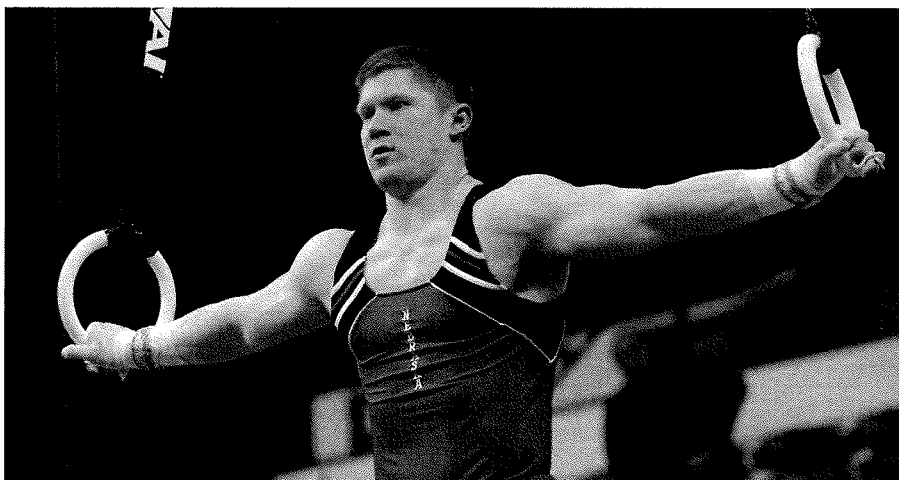
