INTRODUCTION

The 2023-24 Nebraska Athletics Academic Achievement book highlights the academic and leadership accomplishments of Husker student-athletes. The information in this book is useful to review prior to meeting with prospective students, alumni and current student-athletes regarding the success of their peers. The Academic Center staff congratulates the individual student-athletes and their coaches for their significant achievements during the 2023-24 academic year.

The "Highlighting the Huskers" pages showcase the stellar achievements that are further detailed throughout the book. The Husker academic program has consistently been a leader in College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans. This past year, the Huskers increased their Big Tenleading total to 362. Nebraska continues to lead the nation with 18 NCAA Today's Top 10 Award winners. This award is considered the highest level of honor in NCAA recognition.

Nebraska had a school-record 154 student-athletes graduate between December of 2023 and August of 2024. Since 1892, 7,007 Nebraska student-athletes have both lettered and graduated from the University.

The Academic Achievement in Athletics book also highlights other historic accomplishments by Nebraska student-athletes, including the 105 Huskers who have earned NCAA Postgraduate Scholarships since 1970, the 201 Huskers who have earned prestigious 1A FAR Academic Excellence Awards since 2011, and the 15 Huskers who have claimed NCAA Elite 90 awards since 2010.

The 34th annual A Night at the Lied academic awards ceremony celebrated the achievements of Nebraska's student-athletes in April 2024. The celebration highlighted Nebraska's academic and life skills excellence. At the event, 355 student-athletes were honored for earning a 3.0 or higher gradepoint average. Herman Team GPA awards were presented to the men's tennis and women's golf teams. Ethan Piper (football) and Billie Andrews (softball) were chosen as the 2024 Nebraska Most Outstanding Student-Athletes for their commitment to excellence in academics, athletics and service. Piper and Andrews also captured Nebraska's Big Ten Medals of Honor.

The Hewit Academic staff is honored to work with Nebraska's incredible student-athletes. The staff believes student-athletes should be recognized for their hard work and dedication to academics, athletics and outreach. The 2024-25 academic year will bring new successes by student-athletes in the classroom, in competition and in the community.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT: HIGHLIGHTING THE HUSKERS

- Student-athletes across all sports posted a 3.425 cumulative GPA in the spring of 2024, the best cumulative GPA ever achieved by the Huskers.
- Nebraska's cumulative 3.415 fall semester GPA in 2023 was the best in history for Husker student-athletes in a fall semester.
- Across all sports, Nebraska produced a 94 percent Graduation Success Rate.
- An impressive group of 154 Husker student-athletes earned their degrees in December 2023, May 2024 or August 2024.
- A total of 306 Nebraska student-athletes earned Academic All-Big Ten recognition in 2023-24.
- A total of 870 student-athletes were honored on the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll in the Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 semesters for earning a 3.000 or better term GPA.
- Husker student-athletes combined for 162 perfect 4.000 GPA semesters in the fall and spring of 2023-24.
- A total of 115 Nebraska student-athletes were named Big Ten Distinguished Scholars for earning a 3.700 or higher GPA during the 2023-24 academic year.
- A record-setting group of 23 Huskers earned the Division 1A FAR Academic Excellence Award in 2024, presented to studentathletes who graduate with a 3.800 or higher cumulative GPA.
- Nebraska leads the nation with 18 NCAA Today's Top 10 Award recipients. The Top 10 Award is considered among the most prestigious honors presented to senior scholar-athletes.
- Nebraska leads the Big Ten and ranks second in NCAA Division I with 362 CSC Academic All-Americans.

- Eleanor Dale (soccer), Lexi Rodriguez (volleyball), Axelina Johansson (women's track and field), Till Steinforth (men's track and field) and Tyus Wilson (men's track and field) captured CSC First-Team Academic All-America honors in 2023-24. Sarah Weber (soccer), Billie Andrews (softball), Brett Sears (baseball) and Micaylon Moore (men's track and field) added CSC Second-Team Academic All-America accolades, while Emanuela Casadei (women's track and field) and Asher Cohen (men's gymnastics) contributed third-team honors.
- A total of 52 Huskers across all sports earned Academic All-District honors from the College Sports Communicators in 2023-24.
- Ethan Piper (football) and Billie Andrews (softball) were named Nebraska's Most Outstanding Student-Athletes for 2024. They were also Nebraska's Big Ten Medal of Honor recipients.
- Lindsey Thiele (women's golf) and Kolby Heinerikson (men's track and field) claimed Big Ten Postgraduate Scholarships that were each worth \$7,500 toward their continuing educations.
- Nebraska recognized 355 scholar-athletes, who matriculated at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln for at least one year, for earning a 3.000 or higher GPA.
- Matthias Algarin, Katelyn Mullinax and Emma Ralston (track and field), Sydney Gray and Abbie Squier (softball), Kinsey Davis (women's gymnastics), Emily Haimes (swimming and diving), Ethan Piper (football) and Lindsey Thiele (women's golf) were recognized as Nebraska Outstanding Scholars for maintaining a 3.900 or higher undergraduate cumulative GPA while completing their final season athletically or graduating.
- The men's tennis team (3.460 GPA) and the women's golf team (3.736 GPA) claimed the Herman Team GPA Awards for the 2023 calendar year.

HUSKERS PRODUCE RECORD ACADEMIC PERFORMANCES

University of Nebraska student-athletes produced another outstanding year in the classroom, the community and in competition to continue NU's tradition of success in 2023-24. The Huskers increased their Big Ten Conference-leading total of all-time College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-Americans to 362 with the addition of 11 first-, second- or third-team All-Americans in 2023-24. First-team award winners Eleanor Dale, Axelina Johansson, Lexi Rodriguez, Till Steinforth and Tyus Wilson, joined second-team honorees Billie Andrews, Micaylon Moore, Brett Sears, Sarah Weber and third-team selections Emanuela Casadei and Asher Cohen as CSC Academic All-American Huskers.

Nebraska is one of only five NCAA Division I schools with 200 CSC Academic All-Americans, joining Stanford (373), Notre Dame (278), Alabama (234) and Penn State (233).

The Huskers also extended their nation-leading streak to 54 consecutive years with at least one Academic All-American.

During the spring semester of 2024, all of Nebraska's studentathletes combined for a 3.425 cumulative grade-point average - the best cumulative GPA in school history.

A total of 870 awards were issued for the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Fall (446) and Spring (424) Honor Rolls, recognizing Husker student-athletes who produced a 3.000 GPA or better during a semester. Among that group, Huskers produced 162 perfect 4.000 GPA semesters.

A total of 115 Nebraska student-athletes were honored as Big Ten Distinguished Scholars for posting 3.700 grade-point averages or better in 2023-24. The Huskers also produced 306 Academic All-Big Ten selections for the year across all sports.

Nebraska's CSC Academic All-America success continues to set the standard for the more than 2,100 NCAA, NAIA and NJCAA institutions across North America. The Husker football team leads all individual sport programs in the nation with 108 all-time CSC Academic All-America awards, while the Nebraska volleyball (41, No. 1) program leads the nation across all women's sports.


Nebraska's 61 combined CSC Academic All-America honors since 2002 for the men's and women's track and field programs lead the nation. The Husker men's and women's track and field programs have combined for 75 CSC Academic All-America awards since 1985.

Till Steinforth (Saxony-Anhalt, Germany) was named a CSC First-Team Academic All-American with a 3.90 GPA as an architectural studies major. A first-team All-American in the decathlon (2023), heptathlon (2024) and the long jump (2024), Steinforth was also a Big Ten champion in both the decathlon (2023) and the long jump (2024). He was named Nebraska's Male Athlete of the Year in 2024.

CSC First-Team Academic All-American Eleanor Dale was named Nebraska's 2024 Female Athlete of the Year. The senior from Billingham,

England, led NCAA Division I with 28 goals scored to capture first-team All-America honors on the field for the Huskers in 2023. She also led Nebraska to the NCAA Elite Eight and a Big Ten regular-season title. One of three finalists for the MAC Hermann Trophy as the nation's top player, Dale carried a 3.84 GPA as a criminology and criminal justice major.

Offensive lineman Ethan Piper (Norfolk, Neb.) claimed Nebraska's Most Outstanding Male Student-Athlete award and was NU's Big Ten Medal of Honor recipient for 2023-24. Billie Andrews (Gretna, Neb.) was Nebraska's Most Outstanding Female Student-Athlete and Big Ten Medal of Honor recipient. Andrews earned CSC Second-Team Academic All-America honors and was a two-time All-American at shortstop for the Husker softball team.

HUSKERS CELEBRATE GRADUATIONS OF 154 STUDENT-ATHLETES

Across all sports, a record total of 154 Husker student-athletes earned their degrees from the University of Nebraska from December 2023 through August of 2024. Nebraska's 33 student-athlete graduates in December of 2023, joined a record-setting class of 109 graduates in May of 2024, while 12 Huskers earned their degrees in August of 2024.

355 HUSKERS EARN ACADEMIC MEDALLIONS

Nebraska celebrated its academic, athletic and life skills accomplishments across all sports during the 34th annual "A Night at the Lied" in April. The award ceremony honored the elite performers in competition, in the classroom and in the community, which included the presentations of 355 honor medallions to high-performing Husker student-athletes.

The women's golf team (3.736 GPA) and the men's tennis team (3.460 GPA) claimed the 30th annual Herman Awards. The awards are presented to the Husker squads with the top team grade-point averages. The men's tennis team captured its 11th award in program history, while the women's golf team claimed its second award and its first since 2003.

All-American Bergen Reilly (volleyball) was named the Female Freshman Athlete of the Year across all sports, while Antrell Taylor (wrestling) was the Male Freshman Athlete of the Year.

Nine Huskers claimed Outstanding Scholar Awards, including Matthias Algarin, Katelyn Mullinax and Emma Ralston (track and field), Sydney Gray and Abbie Squier (softball), Kinsey Davis (women's gymnastics), Emily Haimes (swimming and diving), Ethan Piper (football) and Lindsey Thiele (women's golf).

Thiele also joined Sadio Fenner (men's track and field) in earning the Life Skills program's top individual honors as Heart & Soul Award winners.

HUSKERS EARN 306 ACADEMIC ALL-BIG TEN AWARDS IN 2023-24

Across all sports, Nebraska student-athletes captured 306 Academic All-Big Ten selections in 2023-24, while 115 Huskers claimed Big Ten Conference Distinguished Scholar awards. Those student-athletes produced 3.700 or better grade-point averages during the fall and spring semesters of 2023-24.

Husker student-athletes also earned 870 spots on the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll during the fall or spring semesters of 2023-24. To earn a spot on the Nebraska Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll, a student-athlete must earn a 3.000 grade-point average during the semester.

During the fall or spring semesters, 162 Husker student-athletes produced perfect 4.000 semester GPAs.

NEBRASKA CAPS 2023-24 WITH OLYMPIC APPEARANCES

A total of 13 current and former Nebraska student-athletes earned appearances on their respective Olympic teams in Paris during the summer of 2024. Current Husker Academic All-Americans Axelina Johansson (Sweden) and Till Steinforth (Germany) along with recent Nebraska graduate and two-time NCAA champion Rhema Otabor (Bahamas) led Nebraska's strong group of student-athletes in France. Johansson finished 10th in the women's shot put, while Steinforth claimed 15th place in the decathlon. Otabor took 27th in the women's javelin.

A trio of former Husker volleyball players (Jordan Larson, Kelsey Robinson, Justine Wong-Orantes) also helped the USA women to a silver medal in Paris.

Other Huskers competing in Paris included track and field athletes Mine De Klerk (South Africa), Maggie Malone-Hardin (USA) and Nick Percy (Great Britain), along with men's basketball players Jack McVeigh (Australia) and Keisei Tominaga (Japan). Gymnasts Yanni Chronopoulos and Emma Spence were also alternates for the Canadian men's and women's teams in Paris.

NCAA ELITE 90 AWARDS

The Elite 90, an award founded by the NCAA, recognizes the essence of the student-athlete by honoring the individuals who have reached the pinnacle of competition at the national championship level in their sport, while also achieving the highest academic standard among their peers. The Elite 90 is presented to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative grade-point average participating at the finals site for each of the NCAA's 90 championships. Nebraska student-athletes have captured 15 NCAA Elite 90 awards across all sports.

AWARD CRITERIA

The student-athletes must be at least sophomores academically and athletically, and in at least their second year (in any sport) at their current institution. The student-athletes must be active members on the roster, eligible for the championship, and members of the designated squad size at the championship site in sports with squad size limitations.

Credits completed shall only consist of those credits accumulated at the current institution and shall not include any transfer or AP credits.

Only undergraduate GPA is applicable. If the student-athletes have graduated and are in graduate school, they are still eligible for the award but consideration will be based strictly on an undergraduate GPA. Graduate students must be in good academic standing with the university.

Student-athletes are only eligible to win the award once per academic year, even if they participate in more than one sport.

NATIONAL FOOTBALL FOUNDATION SCHOLAR-ATHLETES

The NFF National Scholar-Athlete Awards were established in 1959 as the first initiative in history to honor scholar-athletes with postgraduate scholarships for their combined athletic, academic and leadership abilities. To date, the program has awarded more than \$11.5 million to 854 individuals since its inception. The program currently provides approximately \$300,000 each year in postgraduate scholarships to the nation's top scholar-athletes from all levels of collegiate play.

Nominated by their schools, which are limited to one nominee each, candidates must be a senior or graduate student in their final year of eligibility, have at least a 3.2 GPA on a 4.0 scale, have outstanding football ability as a first-team player or significant contributor and have demonstrated strong leadership and citizenship. The NFF Awards Committee, which is comprised of a nationally recognized group of media, College Football Hall of Fame inductees and athletic administrators, traditionally selects 12-15 scholar-athletes for these prestigious \$18,000 scholarships.

The committee also designates one of the recipients as the top college football scholar-athlete in the nation, an honor that comes with The William V. Campbell Trophy (renamed from the Vincent dePaul Draddy Award in 2009). The Campbell Trophy comes with a \$25,000 scholarship.




