### **SCOUTING THE OMAHA MAVERICKS**

Carrie Banks enters her fifth season leading Omaha, after the Mavericks struggled to an 8-23 overall record, including a 3-13 mark in the Summit League in 2023-24.

Senior Grace Cave, a 5-7 guard from Weeping Water, Neb., returns to fuel the Maverick backcourt. Cave led Omaha in scoring (12.3 ppg), assists (3.3 apg) and steals (1.5 spg), while ranking second on the team with 4.0 rebounds per game last season. Cave led the Mavs with a game-high 26 points on 4-of-7 three-point shooting while adding four assists in a 96-79 exhibition loss at Drake (Oct. 27).

Fellow returning starter Katie Keitges adds more experience. The 5-8 graduate guard from Knoxville, Iowa, averaged 6.3 points while leading the team with 55 three-pointers (.393) a year ago. She also led the team with 26 starts. Keitges managed seven points on 2-of-3 three-point shooting while adding three assists in the exhibition loss at Drake.

Millard South grad Cora Olsen returns for her sophomore season after starting 11 games as a freshman. The 5-9 forward managed 5.4 points and 2.5 rebounds in just over 15 minutes per game in 2023-24. She was UNO's second-leading scorer with 13 points in 30 minutes at Drake (Oct. 27).

Senior Morgann Gardner rounds out Omaha's probable starting five. The 6-2 forward from Racine, Wis., had four points and three rebounds at Drake after averaging 7.1 points and 3.5 rebounds for the Mavs last season. Gardner led UNO with a 48.2 field goal percentage a year ago, including 15-for-37 (.405) shooting from long range. Gardner joins Cave and Keitges as the only active Mavs to play in the season-opening loss at Nebraska in 2022-23.

While Gardner, Cave, Keitges and Olsen give Omaha four returning players with starting experience, the only other returner is sophomore Ali Stephens. The 5-11 forward averaged 1.4 points after playing in 13 games last season.

Newcomer Aaliyah Moore, a 6-1 senior transfer from Loyola Chicago, added seven points in the exhibition loss to the Bulldogs. Moore also led the Mavs with seven rebounds. She is one of 10 newcomers on the Omaha roster, joining Lauren Perry, Alana Powell and Harriet Ford in getting action at Drake. Ford is one of five freshmen on the roster.

# **HUSKERS OPEN SEASON WITH OMAHA**

Nebraska tips off its 2024-25 regular season by battling the Omaha Mavericks today at Pinnacle Bank Arena.

The game is part of a men's and women's basketball double-header today at PBA, as the Husker men open their season against UTRGV at 7 p.m.

The Husker women enter 2024-25 after producing their best season in a decade in 2023-24. Nebraska fought its way to the second round of the 2024 NCAA Tournament after running to the Big Ten Tournament Championship Game in Minneapolis.

The Huskers, who are No. 23 in both the Associated Press and USA Today/WBCA Top 25 rankings, are led by returning first-team All-Big Ten performer Alexis Markowski. The 6-3 center out of Lincoln Pius X High School earned her third consecutive first-team preseason All-Big Ten nod after averaging team bests of 15.7 points and 10.5 rebounds for the Big Red as a junior.

Last week, Markowski was named one of 50 candidates for the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy and one of 20 candidates for the Lisa Leslie National Center of the Year Award. It is the third straight season Markowski has been on those prestigious preseason lists.

Markowski opened 2024-25 with 16 points and 10 rebounds in an exhibition win over Doane (Oct. 27).

Reigning Big Ten Freshman of the Year Natalie Potts joined Markowski in the starting lineup for all 35 games last season. The 6-2 forward from O'Fallon, Mo., was an eight-time Big Ten Freshman of the Week and averaged 10.2 points and 5.5 rebounds for the Huskers. She also led the Big Red in blocked shots. Potts had nine points, seven rebounds, two blocks and two steals in last Sunday's win over Doane.

The Huskers are also eager for the return of 2022-23 starter Allison Weidner (Humphrey, Neb.) along with the much-anticipated debut of two-time Nebraska High School Player of the Year Britt Prince (Elkhorn, Neb.) to the NU backcourt.

Weidner averaged 10.2 points, 6.2 rebounds and 2.4 assists over 13 games as a starter for the Huskers as a sophomore in 2022-23. She missed Nebraska's final 20 games that season and all 35 games for the Big Red a year ago with back-to-back leg injuries. Weidner had seven points, two rebounds, two assists and three steals in the exhibition victory over Doane.

Prince, who led Elkhorn North to four consecutive Class B state championships, was the No. 16 recruit in the nation by Prospects Nation. She closed her high school career with a Nebraska Class B record 2,491 points - surpassing Husker All-American and Nebraska Athletic Hall of Famer Jordan Hooper's previous mark of 2,078. Prince averaged 27.0 points, 10.3 rebounds, 6.3 assists and 2.9 steals to win her second straight Nebraska High School Player-of-the-Year honors in 2023-24.

She had 12 points, two assists and three steals in the exhibition win over Doane.

# **NEBRASKA VS. OMAHA SERIES HISTORY**

- Nebraska leads the all-time series with Omaha 17-9, including a 100-36 win in the most recent meeting at Pinnacle Bank Arena (Nov. 7, 2022).
- Today's game marks just the fourth regular-season meeting between the two University of Nebraska system schools since 1987. The Huskers fought their way to a 66-58 win over the Mavs at PBA on Nov. 22, 2016, after beating Omaha 80-44 at the Devaney Center on Nov. 26, 2010.
- Omaha defeated Nebraska 47-41 in Lincoln (Dec. 4, 1974) the second game in Nebraska women's basketball history.
- The Huskers and Mavs faced each other 19 times in the 1970s, with Nebraska going 12-7 in those meetings. The Huskers are 5-2 against Omaha since 1980.

### THREE THINGS TO WATCH

- Alexis Markowski needs 44 rebounds to become just the sixth player in Nebraska women's basketball history to reach 1,000 career boards. Janet Smith (1979-82) owns the school record with 1,280 rebounds, while Emily Cady (2012-15) ranks second with 1,114. First-team All-Americans and conference players of the year Jordan Hooper (1,110), Kelsey Griffin (1,019) and Karen Jennings (1,000), who won the 1993 Wade Trophy, round out the Husker women with 1,000 career rebounds.
- **2** Markowski enters the 2024-25 season tied with Husker All-Americans Jordan Hooper and Kelsey Griffin for the Nebraska record with 40 career double-doubles. Markowski produced 19 double-doubles a year ago, after putting up 15 double-doubles as a sophomore in 2022-23. Markowski's 2023-24 double-doubles included a massive 20-point, 21-rebound effort in a road win at Purdue (Feb. 17, 2024). Her most recent double-double came with 23 points and 13 rebounds against No. 3 lowa in the Big Ten Championship Game (March 10, 2024).
- 3 Nebraska has hit 10 or more three-pointers 40 times in the last 108 games, including 12 times in 2023-24. The Huskers hit a season-best 16-of-35 threes in a win over UNCW (Dec. 5). Nebraska set a school record with 292 made threes in 2023-24 and have produced the three highest season totals in school history the past three years.

# **FACTS & FIGURES**

- The Huskers have hit at least one three-pointer in 499 straight regular-season games dating back to a loss at UTEP on Dec. 20, 2009. Nebraska has hit at least two three-pointers in 378 consecutive games.
- Nebraska is 47-3 all-time in home season openers, including a 90-42 win over Northwestern State (Nov. 6, 2023). Nebraska's only season-opening home losses have come to Drake (2018), South Dakota State (2005) and Kansas (1980).
- Today's Life Skills Sportsmanship Pep Rally attracted a record 75 schools from across the state of Nebraska with more than 3,800 middle grade students and accompanying adults in attendance.
