THE MATCHUP

The No. 3 Nebraska wrestling team will open the 2024-25 season on Friday, Nov. 8 at the Devaney Center as the Huskers host Utah Valley. The dual will begin at 6 p.m. (CT) and will be streamed on Big Ten Plus, and tickets for the dual can be purchased at huskers.com/tickets. Takedown foam fingers will be given away to the first 750 fans in attendance.

Friday's dual marks the Huskers' first competition since junior Brock Hardy (141) led Nebraska with a third-place finish at the 2024 NCAA Championships, and NU scored 60.5 points to claim ninth overall. Five Huskers competed in the NCAA medal round, highlighted by Hardy's upset victory and alum Peyton Robb's win to conclude his Husker career with his fourth all-american honor.

Four of last season's All-Americans return including 24 letterwinners and eight NCAA qualifiers, as the Huskers look to continue last season's momentum.

HISTORY: Nebraska is undefeated in the all-time series with the Wolverines, defeating UVU in three neutral site duals. Most recently, NU topped Utah Valley in January 2011, 22-12, in Texas at the Lone Star Duals.

UP NEXT: Nebraska will travel east to face Campbell and No. 24 North Carolina on November 15. The Huskers will face the Camels at 3:30 p.m. (CT) in Buies Creek and the Tar Heels in Chapel Hill at 6: 30 p.m. (CT).

2023-24 RECAP

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Husker sophomore Brock Hardy (141) led the Huskers with a third-place finish at the 2024 NCAA Championships, and the Nebraska wrestling team scored 60.5 points to claim ninth overall.

Five Huskers competed in the NCAA medal round, highlighted by Hardy's upset victory and Peyton Robb's win to conclude his Husker career with his fourth all-american honor.

Nebraska's five NCAA All-Americans marks the fifth time in seven years the program has had four or more claim the award. Since 2012, Nebraska has had at least two wrestlers receive All-American honors, and the program has earned a total of 136 combined awards from 75 wrestlers.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

For the second-straight year, the Huskers have a Big Ten Champ as Ridge Lovett claimed the crown at 149 and the Nebraska wrestling team finished third at the 2024 Big Ten Championships with 118.0 team points.

The Huskers put eight wrestlers in the final, third-place and fifth-place bouts combined this weekend and clinched nine automatic bids to the NCAA Championships.



BACK POINTS

HUSKERS TO FACE STRONG SCHEDULE

The Nebraska wrestling team has released its 2024-25 schedule, slated to host Big Ten foe and the reigning national champion Nittany Lions. The Huskers will face six of the top-25 finishers from last season's NCAA Championships, Coach Mark Manning announced Tuesday.

The Big Red will open the season at home, hosting Utah Valley on Nov. 8. Then NU hits the road for two duals and two invitationals. The Huskers visit North Carolina to face Campbell and North Carolina on Nov. 15, before taking on the Navy Classic on Nov. 23 and the Cliff Keen Invitational on Dec. 6 and Dec. 7.

On Dec. 20, NU will host Augustana and in-state competitor UNK in one evening. The Big Red will finish non-conference duals with a road matchup at Northern Iowa on Jan. 5, who finished 14th at last year's NCAA Championships.

Conference competition will consist of eight duals, four home and four away. The Big Ten matchups will open at home on Jan. 11, as the Huskers host Minnesota. Less than a week later, the Huskers welcome Penn State on Jan. 17, as they host the Nittany Lions for the first time since 2019.

The following weekend, NU takes on Michigan on Jan. 24 and Michigan State on Jan. 26. The Wolverines are another top conference and national competitor, after finishing the 2023-24 season in 3rd at the NCAA Championships. Returning to the Bob Devaney Sports Center, the Huskers close out January with the Badgers on Jan. 31.

On Feb. 7, the Big Red take on preseason No. 2 Iowa in Iowa City. The Huskers will have their final home dual on Feb. 16, hosting the Hoosiers before concluding the regular season on the road, at Purdue on Feb. 23. The Big Ten Championships will be March 8-9, hosted at the Welsh-Ryan Arena by Northwestern. The 2024-25 NCAA Championships will be held in Philadelphia, Pa., at the Wells Fargo Center, March 20-22.

LOVETT LOOKS TO EARN FOURTH ALL-AMERICAN AWARD

A 149-pound senior from Post Falls, Idaho, Ridge Lovett returns looking to become the sixth four-time Nebraska All-American. Lovett is currently one of 16 three-time All-Americans in the history of Nebraska wrestling. Last season, he claimed the Big Ten Championship title and his sixth-place finish at NCAAs cemented his All-American status. Lovett enters his senior season with a career record of 76-19.

FOUR ALL-AMERICANS RETURN TO LEAD NU

Nebraska will be guided by a strong group of veteran returners in 2024-25. NU loses only two senior starters, but returns eight starters as they get set for this year's campaign. Brock Hardy, Ridge Lovett, Caleb Smith and Antrell Taylor all return as all-americans, as well as Bubba Wilson, Lenny Pinto and Silas Allred who look to capitalize on last year's success. Nine total Huskers qualified for the NCAA Championships in 2023-24 and eight were seeded in the top 20 of their weight classes.

DUAL EXPERIENCE A PLUS FOR NU

The Huskers have 12 wrestlers this season with dual experience, including all-americans Brock Hardy, Ridge Lovett, Caleb Smith and Antrell Taylor. Along with the four aforementioned wrestlers, Jacob Van Dee, Lenny Pinto and Silas Allred return as NCAA qualifiers who gained significant dual experience last season. As a team, NU won 12 of its 14 duals overall and six of its eight Big Ten duals.

FRESHMEN SUCCESS

Projected 197-pound starter Camden McDanel is one of only three Huskers on the current roster to start his freshman season, joined by junior Brock Hardy and senior Ridge Lovett. In 2019-20, Lovett wrestled to a seventh-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA appearance, while Hardy finished the 2020-21 season with a 3-3 dual record. James Green was the most recent Husker wrestler to earn All-America honors as a freshman, finishing seventh at the 2012 NCAA Championships.



'22 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Former Husker Jordan Burroughs became the most decorated champion in U.S. wrestling history, defeating Iran's Mohammad Nokhodilarimi, 4-2, to capture the men's freestyle 79 kg title at the World Championships.

Burroughs' victory marked his sixth World Championship, the most ever by an American freestyle wrestler. Burroughs was also the 2008 Olympic champion, and his seven combined World and Olympic titles are also the most by an American wrestler.

Burroughs, who also defeated Nokhodilarimi in last year's final, battled to World Championship gold medals in 2011, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2021 and 2022.

Burroughs faced Turkmenistan's Sahergeldi Saparmyradov in the first match of the tournament and rolled to a 11-1 technical fall. In the second round, Burroughs defeated North Macedonia's Dejan Mitrov 12-1 in less than a minute. In the quarterfinals, Burroughs jumped to an early lead and rolled to a 10-0 victory over Kyrgyzstan's Arsalan Budazhapov.

Burroughs advanced to his sixth world championship match by dominating Bulgaria's Ali Pasha Ruslanovich Umarpashaev, 9-2.




