# **SCOUTING THE PENN STATE LADY LIONS**

Penn State comes to Lincoln trying to snap a three-game losing streak after suffering an 80-68 loss to No. 23 lowa on its home court at the Bryce Jordan Center in University Park, Pa., on New Year's Day. That loss followed a 90-54 drubbing at Minnesota (Dec. 28), after a 68-65 loss at Kansas (Dec. 15).

The Lady Lions also lost 75-60 to Indiana in their Big Ten home opener (Dec. 7), just days after a 72-67 home loss to St. John's to tip off December. Penn State's lone win in the past five weeks came at Providence (68-51).

Penn State is led by transfer center Gracie Merkle. The 6-6 redshirt sophomore from Bellarmine is averaging team bests of 18.4 points and 9.4 rebounds while hitting 67.3 percent of her shots from the field. She also leads PSU with 27 blocks on the year. Although Merkle ranks fifth overall in the conference in both scoring and rebounding, she has averaged just 9.7 points and 6.7 rebounds in three Big Ten games despite hitting 75 percent (12-16) of her field goal attempts.

Graduate guard Gabby Elliott has been the driving force for the Penn State offense in three league games, averaging 21.3 points per game. Elliott, a former Michigan State Spartan, has hit 59.5 percent of her shots, including a scorching 62.5 percent (10-16) of her threes in Big Ten play. She hit a career-best 7-of-11 threes on her way to a career-high 32 points in Wednesday's loss to lowa. In 11 non-conference games, Elliott averaged just 7.7 points and went 8-of-25 (.32) from three. In her last two games, she is 10-for-15 from deep after going 3-for-15 the previous eight games.

Redshirt sophomore Moriah Murray ranks second on the team in scoring this season at 13.1 points. She also ranks among Big Ten leaders with 3.1 threes per game. However, she is 0-for-13 beyond the arc in league play and averaging just 2.7 points per game after going 44-of-101 (.436) against non-conference foes.

Illinois transfer Jayla Oden (9.4 ppg) and Notre Dame transfer Alli Campbell (8.4 ppg) round out the PSU starting five.

## **HUSKERS BACK HOME TO FACE PENN STATE**

Nebraska returns to its home court today hoping to snap a three-game losing streak when the Huskers take on Penn State.

The Huskers, who own a 12-game home winning streak at Pinnacle Bank Arena including a 9-0 home mark this season, dropped three straight away from home against current top-15 teams during the holiday break. The combined record of NU's last three foes - No. 13 Georgia Tech (15-0), No. 1 UCLA (14-0) and No. 4 USC (13-1) is a combined 42-1.

While the Huskers can take solace in the quality of their opponents, they know they are going to need improved play to navigate the strength of the Big Ten Conference.

The only mainstay in Nebraska's lineup this season has been senior All-America candidate Alexis Markowski. The three-time All-Big Ten center is averaging 13.6 points, 7.9 rebounds and 1.7 assists this season while starting all 14 games.

Since the loss of 2024 Big Ten Freshman of the Year Natalie Potts to a seasonending knee injury against North Alabama (Nov. 19), Jessica Petrie, Amiah Hargrove and Kendall Coley have all started at power forward. All three have provided contributions and will need to continue to grow to help the Big Red.

Two-time Nebraska High School Player-of-the-Year Britt Prince continues to show her talent as one of the Big Ten's best freshmen. The 5-11 point guard is averaging 12.4 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.1 assists, including 10 points, eight boards and four assists at No. 4 USC on New Year's Day.

Logan Nissley is also returning to form after offseason surgery. The 6-0 guard who was a member of the Big Ten All-Freshman Team a year ago pumped in 14 points and knocked down four three-pointers to lead the Huskers at USC. Nissley is averaging 7.4 points per game and leads the Huskers with 23 threes on the year.

Callin Hake also has provided leadership and an emotional spark both offensively and defensively early this season. Hake is averaging 7.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.1 assists.

Nebraska continues to get contributions up and down its roster, including significant help from 6-5 freshman center Petra Bozan (5.5 ppg, 3.5 rpg), transfer guard Alberte Rimdal (6.7 ppg), Allison Weidner and Kendall Moriarty.

## **NEBRASKA VS. PENN STATE SERIES**

- Nebraska leads the all-time series with Penn State, 11-9, but the Lady Lions recorded an 82-73 victory over the Huskers in University Park, Pa., in the most recent meeting (Jan. 21, 2024). Alexis Markowski led Nebraska with 16 points and 19 rebounds, but Ashley Owusu answered with 20 points in a start for Penn State.
- Markowski is the only returning starter for the Huskers from last year's game, while none of the five Penn State starters are back this year. Nebraska returns players who combined for 39 points and 29 rebounds in 105 minutes last year. Penn State's returning players combined for five points in 26 total minutes.
- The Huskers have won eight consecutive home games against Penn State at Pinnacle Bank Arena dating back to an 82-67 loss to the Lady Lions in Nebraska's final home game at the Devaney Center (March 3, 2013).
- Nebraska rolled to an 80-51 win over Penn State in the last meeting at PBA (Jan. 11, 2023). Markowski notched a double-double with 11 points and 15 rebounds, while Callin Hake erupted for a then-career-high 16 points on 4-of-6 three-point shooting off the bench.
- Penn State won five of the first six all-time meetings, dating back to a 102-66 win over the Huskers in University Park on Jan. 2, 1993.

### THREE THINGS TO WATCH

- **1** Alexis Markowski enters today's game at No. 4 in Husker history with 1,066 rebounds after getting nine boards at No. 4 USC (Jan. 1). Janet Smith (1979-82) owns the school record with 1,280 rebounds, while Emily Cady (2012-15) ranks second with 1,114. First-team All-American and 2014 Big Ten Player of the Year Jordan Hooper ranks third with 1,110. Markowski needs 14 rebounds to catch Nebraska men's basketball career leader Venson Hamilton (1,080, 1996-99).
- **2** Markowski owns 45 career double-doubles, including five this season. Husker All-Americans Jordan Hooper (2011-14) and Kelsey Griffin (2006-10) are tied for second in career double-doubles with 40.
- **3** Nebraska has hit 10 or more three-pointers 44 times in the last 122 games, including a school-record 20 three-pointers in a win over South Dakota in Sioux Falls. The Big Red also hit 14 threes in a win over Southeastern Louisiana (Nov. 9), 12 threes in the win over Kansas City (Nov. 26) and 12 more in a win over Minnesota (Dec. 8). Nebraska leads the Big Ten with 8.4 three-pointers made per game this season.
- Nebraska is 8-2 all-time against Penn State in Lincoln, including 8-0 at PBA. PSU owns a 6-3 edge all-time at University Park.
- Fourteen of the 20 meetings have been decided by double digits.

#### **FACTS & FIGURES**

- Nebraska has won its first nine home games at Pinnacle Bank Arena this season by an average of 26.2 points per game.
- The Huskers lead the Big Ten and rank 24th nationally with a .370 three-point field goal percentage.
- The Huskers have hit at least one three-pointer in 513 straight regular-season games dating back to a loss at UTEP on Dec. 20, 2009. Nebraska has hit at least two three-pointers in 392 consecutive games.
