SCOUTING THE OHIO STATE BUCKEYES

Coach Kevin McGuff leads his 12th Ohio State team in Sunday's game ranked No. 12 nationally after fighting to a 74-66 win over No. 8 Maryland Thursday night in Columbus.

McGuff led Ohió State to the 2024 Big Ten regular-season title with a 16-2 record as part of a 26-6 overall campaign. The Buckeyes advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

The 2024-25 Buckeyes suffered their first loss with a 62-59 setback at Penn State last Sunday. Freshman Jaloni Cambridge, who is averaging 15.7 points and a team-best 4.0 assists on the season, did not play at Penn State because of illness. Cambridge led OSU with 27 points in a win over Wisconsin (Jan. 16), earning a share of Big Ten Freshman-of-the-Week honors with Nebraska's Britt Prince (Jan. 20). Cambridge returned with a game-high 20 points in the win over Maryland. She has been OSU's leading scorer (17.0 ppg) in conference play, while adding 5.4 rebounds and 3.4 assists.

All-Big Ten forward Cotie McMahon leads Ohio State with 16.5 points while adding 4.6 rebounds per game. McMahon missed time earlier this season with a lower leg injury.

Transfer Chance Gray has provided a long-range threat for the Buckeyes. Gray ranks third on the team in scoring (15.1 ppg), while hitting a team-best 52-of-132 threes (.394). The rest of the Buckeyes have connected on just 78-of-255 (.306) three-point attempts.

Another transfer, Ajae Petty, has pitched in 10.4 points and a team-leading 7.5 rebounds. Petty (.593) and senior staple Taylor Thierry (.583) provide the Buckeyes with consistent and efficient production. Thierry gives OSU five players averaging in double figures with 10.4 points and 5.6 rebounds, while leading the Buckeyes with 2.4 steals per game.

Ohio State features a deep rotation that includes Ava Watson (5.8 ppg), who ranks second on the team with 24 three-pointers, Kennedy Cambridge (4.9 ppg), Elsa Lemmila (4.6 ppg), Madison Greene (4.4 ppg) and Eboni Walker (2.6 ppg).

The Buckeyes own a Big Ten-best 11.4 turnover margin while adding a plus-0.2 rebounding margin. They have forced 24.1 turnovers per game, including 19.8 in Big Ten play. OSU has been out-rebounded, 40.4-32.5, in league play.

HUSKERS PACK PBA FOR NO. 12 BUCKEYES

Nebraska shoots for a big crowd in a top-25 showdown with No. 12 Ohio State in NU's annual Pack PBA game this afternoon.

The Huskers, who returned to the USA Today/WBCA rankings at No. 25 following a 91-60 win over Wisconsin on Monday night at PBA, head into today's game riding a five-game winning streak. The victory over the Badgers also pushed Nebraska's Big Ten-best home-court winning streak to 15 games, including a 12-0 mark this season.

Big Ten Freshman-of-the-Year candidate Britt Prince continues to surge in conference play with six consecutive games in double figures after going for 14 points, seven rebounds and three steals against Wisconsin. Prince, who shared her first Big Ten Freshman-of-the-Week award with Ohio State's Jaloni Cambridge on Monday, also captured USBWA National Freshman-of-the-Week honors on Tuesday. Prince's first national honors came after scoring 22 points on a career-high five three-pointers, while adding seven rebounds, five assists and a career-high six steals in Nebraska's 87-84 OT win at Iowa (Jan. 16).

Three-time All-Big Ten center Alexis Markowski also has put up double figures in six straight games, including 12 points, seven rebounds and five assists in the win over Wisconsin. Markowski leads a balanced and deep Nebraska offense in both scoring (14.5 ppg) and rebounding (8.2 rpg). She joins All-American and 2014 Big Ten Player-of-the-Year Jordan Hooper as the only Huskers in history to achieve the combined career milestones of 1,600 points and 1,100 rebounds.

NEBRASKA VS. OHIO STATE SERIES

- Ohio State leads the all-time series with Nebraska, 14-9, with NU's most recent win coming in a 63-55 victory over the No. 15 Buckeyes at Pinnacle Bank Arena on Jan. 16, 2021. Sunday's game marks the fifth consecutive meeting that Ohio State enters ranked in the top 25.
- Last season, the No. 2 Buckeyes rolled to an 80-47 win over the Huskers on Valentine's Day in Columbus. The Ohio State win came just three days after Nebraska knocked off No. 2 Iowa, 82-79, at Pinnacle Bank Arena, as the Huskers faced the nation's No. 2 team in back-to-back games.
- Cotie McMahon led Ohio State with 20 points and 10 rebounds, as the Buckeyes forced 30 Nebraska turnovers. No Huskers produced double figures in points, but Alexis Markowski just missed a double-double with nine points and 16 rebounds.
- In the most recent meeting in Lincoln, No. 3 and unbeaten (17-0) Ohio State outlasted the Huskers, 76-67, on Jan. 14, 2023.
- Ohio State leads the all-time series in Lincoln, 6-4, while the Buckeyes hold an 8-4 edge in Columbus. Nebraska won the lone neutral site meeting between the teams with a 71-57 victory at the Big Ten Tournament in Indianapolis (March 3, 2012).
- Nebraska reeled off a five-game winning streak in the series from 2012 to 2014, but Ohio State answered with five straight wins (2015-17). The series dates back to a 63-54 Nebraska win in Columbus, Ohio on Dec. 2, 1990. OSU won the first meeting between the teams as Big Ten foes, 82-68, in Columbus on Jan. 19, 2012.

FACTS & FIGURES

• Nebraska's 91-60 win over Wisconsin (Jan. 20) pushed the Huskers' home-court winning streak to a Big Ten-best 15 games, dating back to an 82-79 win over No. 2 lowa (Feb. 11, 2024). Other than single-digit wins over No. 20 Michigan State (Jan. 8, 2025) and lowa, the Huskers have won the other 12 games in the streak by double digits. NU has won its first 12 home games at Pinnacle Bank Arena this season by an average of 23.6 points per game.

THREE THINGS TO WATCH

- Alexis Markowski enters today's game at No. 3 in Husker history with 1,112 rebounds. She needs just three boards to surpass Emily Cady (2012-15) at No. 2 on Nebraska's all-time rebound list with 1,114. Janet Smith (1979-82) owns the school record with 1,280 rebounds. Markowski (1,639 points, 1,112) and Jordan Hooper (2,357 points, 1,110 rebounds) are the only Huskers in history with 1,600 points and 1,100 career rebounds.
- **2** Graduate guard Allison Weidner will be presented with the Stephanie Bolli #34 Women's Basketball Endowed Scholarship during the first quarter of today's game. The scholarship, which is presented by the former Husker Academic All-American who was a senior captain on Nebraska's 1988 Big Eight Championship team, is given to a graduate of a Nebraska high school outside the Lincoln and Omaha metro areas who displays a Nebraska work ethic, prioritizes team goals over personal goals and meets or exceeds current Academic All-Big Ten standards/demonstrates a high level of academic achievement. Weidner, from Humphrey, Neb., earned her bachelor's degree from Nebraska in December. She was the inaugural winner of the scholarship in 2024.
- **3** Nebraska has hit 10 or more three-pointers 46 times in the last 127 games, including a school-record 20 threes in a win over South Dakota in Sioux Falls. The Big Red also hit a PBA-record-tying 16 threes in a win over Wisconsin (Jan. 20), 14 threes in a win over Southeastern Louisiana (Nov. 9), 13 in a win at lowa (Jan. 16), 12 threes in the win over Kansas City (Nov. 26) and 12 more in a win over Minnesota (Dec. 8). Nebraska leads the Big Ten with 8.5 three-pointers made per game this season.
- The Huskers lead the Big Ten in three-point field goals made per game (8.5), including a PBA-record-tying 16 threes in the win over Wisconsin. Nebraska has hit 41-of-104 (.394) of its three-pointers in four home Big Ten wins, including 12-of-28 against Minnesota (Dec. 8).
- The Huskers have hit at least one three-pointer in 518 straight regular-season games dating back to a loss at UTEP on Dec. 20, 2009. Nebraska has hit at least two three-pointers in 397 consecutive games.
