#### **FOLLOW THE GAME**

#### **NEBRASKA VS. LOUISIANA**

- Through 10 all-time meetings, Nebraska holds a 6-3-1 advantage in the all-time series against Louisiana.
- The Huskers are 3-1-1 in five games against the Cajuns in Lafayette after opening the 2009 campaign with a four-game set, where the Big Red went 2-1-1 in the season-opening series.
- Nebraska picked up a 6-3 win at Louisiana in the Mardi Gras Ball in the second weekend of the 2001 season.

#### **FAMILIAR FACES IN THE DUGOUT**

- Despite not having met on the diamond since 2009, there will be some familiar faces in the Husker and Cajun dugouts this weekend.
- Louisiana head coach Matt Deggs has worked multiple seasons on the same staff has head coach Will Bolt and assistant coaches Rob Childress and Lance Harvell.
- Deggs and Bolt worked together under Rob Childress at Texas A&M during the 2006 and 2007 seasons, where Bolt served as a volunteer assistant.
- Childress coached Deggs at Northwood in 1993 and later worked on the same coaching staff as Deggs at Northwestern State under Dave Van Horn in 1996 and 1997. The two later reunited in College Station, where Deggs worked as an assistant coach on Childress' coaching staff at Texas A&M in 2006-10.
- Harvell worked with Deggs at three different stops in his coaching career. Harvell was a graduate assistant at Texas A&M in 2008-09 when Deggs was an assistant coach. Harvell and Deggs were assistant coaches on the Louisiana coaching staff in 2013-14, before Deggs went on to be the head coach at Sam Houston. Prior to arriving in Lincoln, Harvell was an assistant on Deggs' staff at Sam Houston in 2015-19.

#### IN THE POLLS

- Nebraska appeared at No. 24 in the D1Baseball and NCBWA preseason rankings and received votes in the USA Today/ Coaches preseason poll.
- The Big Red moved up to No. 23 in the D1Baseball rankings and rose to No. 22 in the NCBWA rankings after going 2-1 last weekend in the MLB Desert Invitational.
- The Huskers are one of three Big Ten teams to appear in the rankings after opening weekend, with Oregon appearing in four polls (11th/D1Baseball, 11th/NCBWA, 14th/Perfect

Game, 19th/Baseball America) and Michigan tabbed No. 25 in Baseball America's rankings.

#### FIRST RANKED WIN ON OPENING WEEKEND SINCE 2006

- With a 6-4 win against No. 16 Vanderbilt at the MLB Desert Invitational, Nebraska picked up its first ranked win on opening weekend since the Big Red recorded a 4-3 win against No. 24 NC State in 2006.
- The Huskers have played nine games against eight ranked teams on opening weekend since the 2001 campaign.
- Since the win over No. 24 NC State in 2006, the Big Red suffered opening weekend losses to No. 22 Cal State Fullerton (DH) in 2013, No. 2 Oregon State in 2014 and No. 21 Texas Tech in 2024 before picking up last weekend's win against the No. 16 Commodores.

#### **BIG RED IN EARLY SEASON TOURNAMENTS**

- For the fourth and fifth times in six seasons under Bolt, Nebraska will play in a weekend tournament during non-conference action, as the Huskers are set to play in a pair of neutral-site events this season.
- The Huskers opened this season at the MLB Desert Invitational in Arizona, where the Big Red went 2-1 and picked up victories against No. 16 Vanderbilt and San Diego State.
- This season is the third straight year taking part in a neutralsite tournament for the Big Red after the Huskers played in the Shriners Children's College Showdown (2024) and Cambria College Classic (2023).

#### A LOOK AT THE WEEKEND ROTATION

- •With Brett Sears taken in the 2024 MLB Draft and Drew Christo's transition to the bullpen, it'll be a new-look weekend rotation for the Huskers this year.
- Mason McConnaughey takes the mound on Friday's series opener at Louisiana. The junior is 0-1 on the season after allowing six runs on five hits and striking out nine in 3.2 innings of work in Nebraska's season opener vs. UC Irvine last weekend.
- Sophomore Ty Horn gets the nod on Saturday after dealing four strong innings in a no-decision vs. No. 16 Vanderbilt last weekend. Horn surrendered three runs across four hits and tallied six punchouts with a pair of walks in four frames against the Commodores.
- Redshirt senior Will Walsh is scheduled to start Sunday's series finale after tossing seven scoreless innings against San Diego State last weekend. Walsh allowed five hits and struck out six in his fourth career start of at least seven innings.

#### **MCCONNAUGHEY BRINGS IN PRESEASON ACCOLADES**

- Coming off a second-team All-Big Ten campaign last season, junior Mason McConnaughey drew Preseason All-America recognition, earning third-team honors from D1Baseball and second-team accolades from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.
- McConnaughey was one of 55 players across high school and college baseball named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, USA Baseball announced earlier this month.
- The Topeka, Kan., native is the first Husker named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List since Ryan Boldt in 2016.



#### **BIG-GAME GABE PACING BIG RED OFFENSE**

- Senior Gabe Swansen picked up where he left off from Nebraska's postseason run in 2024, driving in all six runs in the Huskers' 6-4 win over No. 16 Vanderbilt at the MLB Desert Invitational last weekend.
- Swansen totaled a career-high six RBI for the third time in his career after hitting 3-for-4 with a pair of doubles and a home run in the win against the Commodores.
- Going back to the Big Ten Tournament in 2024, Swansen is hitting .426 at the plate with eight doubles, eight homers, 25 RBI and 12 runs scored in NU's last 13 games.

#### **LUCKY NUMBER SIX IN THE BOLT ERA**

- Nebraska is 106-21 under head coach Will Bolt when scoring at least six runs.
- The Big Red scored six-plus runs in both wins on opening weekend, defeating No. 16 Vanderbilt (6-4) and San Diego State (13-0).
- The Husker offense reached the six-run mark 34 times last season, compiling a 28-6 record.
- Nebraska scored six-plus runs in 33 contests (26-7) in 2023 after tallying at least six runs 23 times (19-4) in 2022, 28 times (26-2) in 2021 and seven times (5-2) in 2020.

#### **FLASHING THE LEATHER**

 As of Feb. 20, Nebraska is one of five teams nationally—and one of just two Power 4 teams—that has not committed an error this season.

#### **SWANSEN NEARING ALL-TIME HOME RUN LIST**

- With 28 career homers in his time at Nebraska, Gabe Swansen needs seven more homers in 2025 to reach the top 10 in career home runs by a Husker.
- In his time in Lincoln, Swansen has hit .283 at the plate with 22 doubles, 28 home runs, 94 RBI and 69 runs scored in 110 career games.
- The Johnston, Iowa, native paced the Husker offense in the postseason last year, hitting .500 (19-of-38) with six doubles, seven homers, 16 RBI and 10 runs scored in NU's nine postseason games in the Big Ten Tournament and Stillwater Regional.

- The NU pitching staff saw three freshmen put up strong outings in their Husker debut on the mound last weekend.
- Redshirt freshman Carson Jasa and true freshmen Pryce Bender and Colin Nowaczyk combined to deal 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing four combined hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
- Bender and Nowaczyk made their collegiate debut in Nebraska's season opener vs. UC Irvine, Jasa took the mound for the final two innings in the Huskers' shutout win against

#### **BATS IN THE NEBRASKA LINEUP**

- Leadoff hitter Cayden Brumbaugh has a team-best two multi-hit games for the NU offense, picking up a pair of two-hit performances last the MLB Desert Invitational.
- Max Buettenback leads the Huskers with six runs scored and drove in a career-high four RBI against San Diego State.
- Dylan Carey is batting .286 through four games, while Case Sanderson holds a .308 batting average and has reached base in nine consecutive games going back to last season.
- Gabe Swansen is 19th nationally with nine runs driven in through four games and is one of two Huskers with three extra-base hits on the year.
- Cael Frost is one of two Huskers to reach base in all four games this season, while Joshua Overbeek has tallied a .375 batting average and .545 on-base percentage in three starts.
- Hogan Helligso recorded NU's first hit of the year and has made three starts in the lineup behind the dish.
- Riley Silva is hitting .300 and has stolen one base in three starts, while Rhett Stokes is 2-for-5 for two games, including a start on Opening Day against UC Irvine.
- Will Jesske went 2-for-4 in his first career start at catcher against San Diego State, and Robby Bolin has totaled two hits and a pair of runs while seeing action in all four of NU's games.

#### **HUSKERS IN THE PEN**

- Luke Broderick has appeared in two games for the NU bullpen, including a one-inning save in 6-4 win against No. 16 Vanderbilt.
- Jalen Worthley is 1-0 on the season after dealing 1.2 scoreless innings in the Big Red's win over the Commodores last weekend.
- Jackson Brockett is available out of the bullpen this weekend after making the start at Grand Canyon on Monday. The southpaw holds a 1.50 ERA and three strikeouts in six innings this season.
- Grant Cleavinger and Caleb Clark have combined for one inning and two punchouts, while Drew Christo is one of two NU relievers with two appearances through the first four games.
- Carson Jasa, Pryce Bender and Colin Nowaczyk made their collegiate debut last weekend on the mound and combined for 5.2 shutout innings with four strikeouts.

#### **BIG RED ON THE RISE**

- Nebraska is the only P4 program and one of four teams nationally to record at least a seven-win improvement in each of the last two seasons.
- The Huskers saw a 10-win improvement in 2023 after improving their win total by seven and compiling a 40-22 overall record last season.

#### **ROB CHILDRESS PITCHING FACTORY**

- Proven to be one of the nation's top pitching coaches at the collegiate level, Rob Childress has produced 25 All-Americans and 40 top-10 round draft picks in his 25 seasons directing the pitching at Nebraska and Texas A&M.
- Under his tutelage, 80 pitchers have been drafted or signed as free agents during his time with the Huskers and Aggies.
- Childress' pitching staffs have finished in the top.15 in the country in ERA eight times since 2000, including top-three finishes on three occasions. Five of his pitching staffs have finished in the top.25 nationally in strikeouts per nine innings

since 2010, including four times in the top 10.

- In his nine seasons at the helm of the NU pitching staff, the Huskers have produced six of the top 10 single-season strikeout totals in school history, including a school-record 538 strikeouts in 2005. The NU pitchers fell 11 punchouts shy of tying the school record last season, compiling the second-most strikeouts in program history with 527 strikeouts in 2024.
- Childress' pitching staffs have completed 11 seasons with a walks-per-innings below three, including a season-low 2.51 walks/9 inn. at Nebraska in 2000 and Texas A&M in 2011.

#### **BRODERICK NAMED TO STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST**

- Junior closer Luke Broderick earned a spot on the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association's Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List, the organization announced last week. The award is given to the top relief pitcher in Division I Baseball each season.
- Broderick, a right-hander from Omaha, Neb., is one of 76 players on the list. The right-hander spent two seasons as a starter at lowa Western CC before coming to Lincoln and transitioning into a closer in the fall.
- Broderick was one of 24 players selected to the USA NJCAA All-Star Team last summer, helping Team USA to a championship appearance at the historic Honkbalweek Haarlem. The Omaha, Neb., native allowed just three hits and didn't give up a run with six punchouts and two walks in a 3.1-inning outing for the Stars and Stripes.
- In his two years with the Reivers, Broderick posted an 8-1 record with a 5.75 ERA and 69 strikeouts in 56.1 innings across 21 appearances, including 15 starts. Broderick earned all-conference recognition after going 7-1 with a 3.21 ERA and 56 strikeouts in 42 innings in 2024.

#### MINING THE JUNIOR COLLEGE RANKS

- Of the 40 Husker on this year's squad, 13 Huskers spent time playing at least one season at the junior college level at some point prior to arriving in Lincoln.
- Two players hail from Barton County CC and Iowa Western CC, while Cisco College, Hutchinson CC, Kirkwood CC, New Mexico Military Institute, Pasco Hernandez JC and Weatherford JC all had one Husker come through their respective programs.

- Nebraska had five players listed in D1Baseball's Preseason Player Rankings released throughout the month of February.
- Cael Frost and Gabe Swansen were ranked No. 27 and 95, respectively, in the list of the top 100 outfielders. Frost batted .343 with 21 homers and 59 RBI as the Summit League Player of the Year at South Dakota State last season, while Swansen hit .327 at the plate with eight home runs and 22 RBI in 34 games in 2024.
- Mason McConnaughey checked in at No. 14 in the top 150 starting pitchers after going 9-3 with a 3.45 ERA and 91 strikeouts in 73 innings last season.
- Luke Broderick and Drew Christo were ranked No. 84 and 95, respectively, in the list of the top 100 relievers. Broderick comes to Lincoln after spending the last two years at Iowa Western CC, while Christo went 3-3 with a save and a 4.62 ERA in 17 appearances in 2024.

#### **BOLIN, BRODERICK DON THE STARS AND STRIPES**

- Juniors Robby Bolin and Luke Broderick helped the USA NJCAA All-Star Team to a championship appearance at the historic Honkbalweek Haarlem last summer.
- Bolin earned recognition as Team USA's best hitter of the tournament after swiping a tournament-high five stolen bases and hitting .391 at the plate with nine hits, an RBI and six runs scored in the tournament's seven games.
- Broderick appeared in one game for the Stars and Stripes in a 3.1-inning outing, allowing just three hits and didn't give up a run while compiling six strikeouts and two walks.

#### TWO HUSKERS TAKEN IN 2024 MLB DRAFT

- The Huskers have at at least two players picked in the MLB Draft in eight of the last 10 drafts (excluding shortened 2020 Draft) after Josh Caron and Brett Sears heard their named called in the 2024 MLB Draft.
- Last year's draft marked the third time in the last four drafts that the Huskers had mulitiple players selected in the top 10 rounds
- Caron became the highest overall selection of a Husker catcher since 1985 with the fourth-round selection by the Seattle Mariners. The NU junior was one of two catchers nationally to hit at least .300 at the plate with 15-plus homers and 65 runs driven in last season after hitting .308 with 15 doubles, a triple, 16 home runs, 65 RBI and 46 runs for the Huskers in 2024.
- Sears heard his name called with the seventh-round selection by the Atlanta Braves to become the fifth Husker pitcher under head coach Will Bolt to be drafted in the first 10 rounds, joining Spencer Schwellenbach (2nd, 2021), Cade Povich (3rd, 2021), Emmett Olson (4th, 2023) and Jace Kaminska (10th, 2023). The unanimous Second-Team All-American was the Big Ten's Pitcher of the Year and a First-Team All-Big Ten selection after posting a 9-1 record with a 2.16 ERA and 101 punchouts in 104 innings.

#### **#PROBIGRED: HUSKERS IN SPRING TRAINING**

- With MLB spring training scheduled to start in February, seven former Huskers are set to report to various spring training camps across Florida and Arizona this month.
- Jake Meyers and Brice Matthews earned invites from the Astros, while Aaron Bummer and Spencer Schwellenbach received invites from the Braves. Matt Waldron (Padres), Cade Povich (Orioles) and Josh Caron (Mariners) are also Huskers to keep an eye on this spring.

#### **NU AMONG NATION'S BEST IN ATTENDANCE**

- Nebraska has led the Big Ten in attendance every season since joining the Big Ten in 2012 and ranks ninth nationally in average attendance in the last 13 seasons with 4,207 fans per game.
- The Big Red have ranked in the Top 20 in average attendance in each season since 2012, climbing as high as sixth in 2017 and 2021.
- The Huskers have finished in the top 15 in average attendance in every season since 2015, joining LSU, Ole Miss, Arkansas, South Carolina, Mississippi State, Texas and Florida as the only eight programs to accomplish the feat.

# WILL BOLT 7

One of the catalysts in Nebraska baseball's rise to national prominence in his playing days, Will Bolt returned to his alma mater as former athletic director Bill Moos named Bolt the 24th head coach of the Husker baseball program on June 14, 2019. He enters his sixth season at the helm in 2025.

Bolt captained the Huskers' first two College World Series teams in 2001 and 2002, and has 16 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience, having served in assistant coaching roles at Texas A&M and Nebraska. Bolt also spent four years as the head coach at Texarkana College.

#### **NEBRASKA HEAD COACH**

Bolt guided the Huskers to their first Big Ten Tournament title in program history after the Huskers fought off elimination five times with a perfect 5-0 mark, including a 2-1 win over Penn State in the Big Ten Championship game. The Huskers made their 18th NCAATournament appearance in program history and posted a 40-22 overall record, as the Big Red reached the 40-win mark for the first time since 2014 and the 19th time in program history.

Along with the Big Ten Tournament run, Brett Sears was a unanimous Second-Team All-American and was named the Big Ten's Pitcher of the Year before getting drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the seventh round of the MLB Draft. Josh Caron was selected in the fourth round by the Seattle Mariners, becoming the highest overall selection of a Husker catcher since 1985.

In 2023, the Huskers had four players picked in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft for the first time since 2005. Fueled by Second-Team All-American Max Anderson and first-round draft pick Brice Matthews, the Nebraska offense belted a school-record 97 home runs. Anderson became the first Husker since 2001 to hit above .400 at the plate with a .414 batting average while hitting the fifth-most homers in program history with 21 last season. Matthews became the first player in program history and second player all-time in the Big Ten to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season.

The 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year, Bolt guided Nebraska to its second Big Ten regular-season championship in 2021. The Huskers compiled a 34-14 record, including a 31-12 record in Big Ten play, with NU capturing the league crown by 3.5 games. Nebraska also advanced to its first regional final since 2007 while posting a 3-2 record in the NCAA Fayetteville Regional.

In addition to Bolt's coaching accolade, NU counted the Big Ten Player of the Year in Spencer Schwellenbach, the Big Ten Freshman of the Year in Max Anderson and four first-team All-Big Ten honorees -- its most since joining the league. Schwellenbach was also tabbed the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year and a first-team All-American, and Anderson picked up Freshman All-America recognition.

Three NU hurlers were selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, with Schwellenbach in the second round (59th overall) by the Atlanta Braves, Cade Povich going in the third round (98th overall) by the Minnesota Twins and Cam Wynne picked in the 20th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Bolt and his coaching staff have done impressive work in recruiting since their arrival in Lincoln. The Huskers' 15-member 2021 recruiting class, which included a trio of top-200 prospects, was ranked 20th by Perfect Game, 21st by Baseball America and 36th by Collegiate Baseball.

Nebraska's 2020 season -- Bolt's first at the helm -- was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### TEXAS A&M ASSISTANT COACH

Bolt spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Texas A&M under former NU assistant Rob Childress. In that span, the Aggies went 219-98-1 (.690) with five straight NCAA Regional appearances, three Regional titles, an SEC Tournament title in 2016 and an appearance in the 2017 College World Series.

Bolt's primary functions on the Aggie staff included coordinating the offensive game, mentoring the infielders and serving as third base coach. The Aggies finished in the top-25 nationally in batting average twice under his tutelage, and finished in the top five of the SEC in hitting or runs scored in four of his five seasons with the Aggies. He tutored 12 hitters who were selected in the MLB Draft during his tenure in College Station, including six players selected in the top-10 rounds, and seven players who earned first- or second-team All-SEC honors.

In 2019, the Aggie offense was led by Braden Shewmake, who was the No. 21 overall selection in the Major League Baseball Draft by the Atlanta Braves. Shewmake hit .313 with six homers, 47 RBI and 45 runs scored en route to becoming the school's first MLB first-round pick since 2012. The Aggies won 39 games and reached the championship game of the Morgantown Regional.

In 2018, the Aggies went 40-22 and reached an NCAA Regional behind the emergence of Michael Helman, who finished 15th in the nation in hits (92), and logged a .369 batting average, .451 on-base percentage and 61 runs to rank in the top 50 nationally.

The Aggies made a run to the College World Series in 2017, finishing the season with a 41-23 mark behind the rise of Shewmake, who earned All-America honors and was named National Freshman of the Year and SEC Freshman of the Year after hitting .328 with 11 homers and 69 RBI.

Bolt guided a prolific Texas A&M offense to 49 runs and an SEC Tournament title in 2016, as the Aggies led the SEC in batting average, runs scored, hits, home runs, on-base percentage and slugging percentage while ranking in the top-25 nationally in seven categories, including hits (712, second), runs (471, ninth), batting average (.311, 15th), doubles (129, 20th), home runs (62, 22nd), slugging percentage (.467, 22nd) and scoring offense (7.2 runs per game, 23rd). The Aggies were led by All-American Boomer White, who hit .386 with five homers, 46 RBI and 49 runs scored while striking out just 16 times in 259 plate appearances en route to SEC Player-of-the-Year honors.

Bolt made an immediate impact for the Texas A&M offense in his first season, as the Aggies ranked second in the SEC in hitting (.299) and third in runs scored (6.6) during his first season in College Station. The Aggies opened the season with an SEC-record



24-game win streak on their way to a 50-win season and a Super Regional appearance. That year, the Aggies ranked among the national leaders in home runs (third, 70), hits (655, seventh), runs (424, 15th) and slugging percentage (.457, 15th).

#### **NEBRASKA ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH**

Bolt was associate head coach for the Huskers from 2012 to 2014, serving under Darin Erstad. Bolt tutored four players to firstteam All-Big Ten honors, including two-time selections Chad Christensen, Michael Pritchard and Pat Kelly.

Nebraska was one of the top offenses in the Big Ten during his final year in Lincoln in 2014, ranking 19th nationally in hits (623), 30th in triples (19) and 31st in batting average (.293) as Nebraska won 41 games and reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. Nebraska's defense was also one of the best units in the country. With new starters at first base, third base, shortstop, left field and center field, the Huskers ranked 21st in the country with a .976 fielding percentage.

Under Bolt's watch in 2013, Nebraska's defense turned in its best performance in school history. The Huskers ranked second in the nation with a .981 fielding percentage, setting school and Big Ten records. The Husker offense improved under Bolt's tutelage in 2013, ranking in the top three in the Big Ten in eight offensive categories. In conference play, the Huskers led the conference in batting average (.335), on-base percentage (.401), runs (180), hits (307) and RBIs (159).

In Bolt's first season at Nebraska in 2012, he helped raise the team batting average by 45 points, as the Huskers ranked eighth nationally with a .315 clip as a squad. NU was eighth nationally in scoring offense, leading the Big Ten with 7.1 runs per game, while also topping the conference in homers (47), on-base percentage (.384) and runs scored (413). Pritchard, a third-team All-American, was one of six Husker hitters to earn all-conference recognition.

#### **TEXARKANA COLLEGE HEAD COACH**

Before joining Erstad's staff, Bolt served four years as head coach at Texarkana College from 2008 to 2011. He led the Bulldogs to a pair of Region XIV championships during his four-year stint. Bolt guided the Bulldogs to back-to-back Region XIV championships (2009 and 2010) during a stretch of four straight Regional Tournament appearances and four 30-plus win seasons. Bolt, who was 140-82 (.631) at Texarkana, helped over 20 players sign with Division I schools.

#### **TEXAS A&M VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH**

Bolt headed back to his home state in 2006 and spent two seasons as a volunteer assistant coach at Texas A&M. In 2007, he was on staff when the Aggies advanced to the Super Regionals, while producing a 49-18 overall record and claiming the program's first Big 12 Tournament title. In College Station, Bolt specialized in infield work and helped tutor All-Americans Brandon Hicks and Blake Stouffer, who were each drafted in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft.

#### **NEBRASKA VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH**

Bolt began his collegiate coaching career as a volunteer assistant at Nebraska in 2005, working with the Husker infielders and hitters. Behind National Player of the Year Alex Gordon, the Huskers compiled a school-record 57 wins and swept the Big 12 regular-season and Tournament championships. Nebraska finished the season with a then-school record .975 fielding percentage and included an infield that featured Gordon, first-team All-Big 12 performer Curtis Ledbetter and Joe Simokaitis, a second-team All-Big 12 pick.

#### **NEBRASKA PLAYING CAREER**

A member of Dave Van Horn's first recruiting class, Bolt was a four-year starter and team captain on Nebraska's 2001 and 2002 College World Series teams. The infielder played an instrumental role in helping Nebraska to four NCAA Regionals, three Super Regionals and back-to-back College World Series appearances.

Bolt was the Minneapolis Regional MVP as a sophomore, hitting .545 in three games to lead the Big Red to its first-ever NCAA Regional title. The following year, Bolt made one of the most memorable plays in school history, catching the final out of the 2001 Super Regional against Rice to send the Big Red to its first-ever College World Series.

Bolt finished his career holding six school records, including games played (251), games started (242), at-bats (922), hits (281), doubles (56) and assists (639). Bolt remains in the school's top five in several categories, including doubles (first, 56), games played (second, 251), assists (second, 639), hits (third, 281) and runs scored (fifth, 197).

Following his playing career, he began his coaching career as a graduate manager at Nebraska in 2004 before serving as head coach for the Parkville Sluggers (M.I.N.K. League) the following summer.

A native of Conroe, Texas, Bolt and his wife, Lauren, were married in July 2005. They have two sons, Jaxon and Austin, and one daughter, Bella. Bolt graduated from Nebraska in 2003 with a degree in communication studies before earning his master's degree in 2006. Lauren graduated from Nebraska in 2005 with a degree in journalism.

A scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before. Generally associated with the NFL, the term was coined by SB Nation sportswriter Jon Bois in 2016. Through the 2024 season, there have been 1,091 unique scores ("scorigamis") in NFL history.

#### **NEBRASKA BASEBALL SCORIGAMI TRENDS**

- Through 4,111 games in Nebraska baseball history, there have been 402 unique score combinations.
- The most common score is 3-2 (147 occurrences), followed by 4-3 (136 occurrences).
- Five of the six most common scores are one-run games, with the exception of 5-3 (101 times).
- With 78 occurrences, a 3-2 win is the most common result for Nebraska baseball, followed by defeats of 3-2 and 4-3 with 69
- Since 2000, there have been 20 scorigami scores, including the most recent occurrence of Florida's 17-11 win over Nebraska in the Stillwater Regional last season.
- Five runs scored (410 occurrences) is the most common for the Huskers, while three runs scored (500 occurrences) is the most common for opponents.
- 26,809 runs scored, 21,147 runs allowed in 4,111 games in 119 seasons for an all-time record of 2,367-1726-18.
