MATCH PREVIEW

• The No. 1 Nebraska volleyball team is back on the road this weekend for a pair of matches in Michigan.
• The Huskers battle Michigan State on Friday at 6 p.m. (CT) at the Breslin Center in East Lansing.
• Nebraska then faces Michigan on Sunday at 1 p.m. (CT) at the Crisler Center in Ann Arbor.
• Both matches will not be televised but will have B1G+ streams.
• Huskers Radio Network with John Baylor and Lauren (Cook) West will broadcast all the action on their volleyball affiliate stations, on Huskers.com and on the Huskers App.

ABOUT THE HUSKERS

• Nebraska is off to a 16-0 start for just the second time since joining the Big Ten in 2011. The 2023 Huskers started the year 27-0.
• Nebraska has recorded seven sweeps in a row, its most since 10 in a row in 2010.
• NU's offense ranks first nationally with a .327 hitting percentage. The Huskers haven't hit better than .300 in a season since 2007 (.327). The school record for hitting percentage in a season is .331 in 1986.
• The Huskers rank second in the nation in opponent hitting percentage at .109. NU led the nation in opponent hitting percentage in 2022 and 2023 and was sixth in 2024.
• The school record for opponent hitting percentage in a season is .103 in 2004.
• The gap between Nebraska's hitting percentage and opponent hitting percentage is .218, by far the best in the nation. The next closest is Wisconsin (.165), Tennessee (.163) and Hofstra (.159).
• Nebraska is 44-0 this season in sets when reaching the red zone (20 points) first.
• Over the last five seasons (2021-25), Dani Busboom Kelly has a 136-15 record for an .901 win percentage, which is the best by any Division I head coach in that span.
• Outside hitter Harper Murray is having a sensational

junior season. She leads the team with 3.72 kills per set and is hitting .314. Murray averages 2.22 digs per set and has a team-high 15 aces.
• Murray is 12 kills away from becoming the 25th Husker in school history to reach 1,000 career kills.
• Murray is tied for 10th in school history in the rally-scoring era in career aces with 90. One more ace will move her past Kenzie Knuckles, and three more will tie Michelle Lynch for ninth all-time at 93.
• Senior middle blocker Rebekah Allick is off to a strong start in her final year as a Husker with 2.59 kills per set on .416 hitting with 1.28 blocks per set. Her hitting percentage ranks third in the Big Ten.
• Allick ranks No. 5 in career blocks at Nebraska in the rally scoring era with 474.
• Junior setter Bergen Reilly paces the Husker attack with 9.88 assists per set, and she also contributes a team-high 2.92 digs per set.
• Reilly ranks No. 5 in school history in career assists in the rally scoring era with 3,098. She needs 100 more to tie Lauren Cook (3,198).
• Junior middle blocker Andi Jackson is averaging 2.55 kills per set on .397 hitting with 1.04 blocks per set.
• Jackson has a career hitting percentage of .416, which is the No. 1 mark in school history and the No. 1 mark among active Division I players.
• Jackson has been heating up of late, averaging 2.85 kills per set on .474 hitting over her last 10 matches.
• Senior outside hitter Taylor Landfair provides 1.95 kills per set. Landfair has played in 136 career matches, which is second most by any active Division I player. Her 1,421 career kills rank sixth among active DI players.
• Freshman opposite hitter Virginia Adriano adds 2.05 kills per set.
• Olivia Mauch (2.85 digs per set) and Laney Choboy (2.58 digs per set) lead the Husker back row.
• Nebraska's non-conference schedule included matches against three top-10 teams and five ranked teams. The

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE

- Michigan State enters Friday's match coming off a sweep over then-No. 20 Indiana to improve to 14-2 (4-2 Big Ten). Picked to finish 14th in the Big Ten Preseason Poll, Michigan State under first-year head coach Kristen Kelsay sits in a tie for fifth through six matches.
- Junior outside hitter Taylah Holdem averages a team-high 4.16 kills per set on .276 hitting. Holdem missed eight matches due to injury before returning to the lineup as a serving sub on Sunday against Indiana.
- Freshman setter and Lincoln native Malayah Long (10.28 assists per set) is a two-time Big Ten Freshman of the Week.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

- Michigan is 12-5 overall and 2-4 in Big Ten play. The Wolverines play at Northwestern on Thursday night.
- Allison Jacobs leads Michigan with 4.24 kills per set.
- The Wolverines rank 13th nationally with a .288 hitting percentage. They're allowing their opponents to hit .226.

SERIES HISTORY

- Nebraska is 28-2-2 against Michigan State and has won 17 in a row. The teams played last year in East Lansing with Nebraska winning 25-15, 25-19, 25-15.
- Nebraska is 25-3 against Michigan and has won 17 straight in the series. The Huskers defeated the Wolverines on Sept. 24 in Lincoln, 25-22, 25-10, 25-13.

BIG TEN ANNOUNCES DISCOVER CHALLENGE

- Select conference matches played during the month of October will count toward the Big Ten Discover Volleyball Challenge, which is in its inaugural season. Each team will play five designated challenge matches throughout the month, with the winner determined by the highest win total across the five games.
- Friday's match at Michigan State will count for both teams in the Discover Challenge. Both Nebraska and Michigan State sit at 2-0, tied with Indiana and Purdue for the standings lead. Those two teams square off Thursday night.

RETURNEE RUNDOWN

- Junior outside hitter Harper Murray was an AVCA Second Team All-American last year, leading the Huskers in kills with 3.40 per set and a team-high 39 service aces. Murray is a two-time All-Big Ten First Team selection and two-time AVCA All-American.
- Junior setter Bergen Reilly is the first player in Big Ten history to win Big Ten Setter of the Year as both a freshman and sophomore, and she is coming off her second straight AVCA All-America Second Team honor. Reilly averaged 11.08 assists per set in 2024 while leading the Huskers to a .284 hitting percentage, their best since 2016.
- Junior middle blocker Andi Jackson had a breakout year in 2024, earning AVCA All-America First Team and All-Big Ten First Team. Jackson averaged 2.62 kills per set with a .439 hitting percentage, which ranked sixth in the nation. She also put up 1.18 blocks per set.
- Senior middle blocker Rebekah Allick recorded 1.82 kills per set in 2024 with a career-best .357 hitting percentage. She had a team-high 1.43 blocks per set, which ranked third among Big Ten players and 14th nationally. Allick ranks sixth in school history with 415 career blocks entering the 2025 season.
- Senior outside hitter Taylor Landfair returns after starting 20 matches in 2024, averaging 2.49 kills per set.
- Maisie Boesiger, Laney Choboy and Olivia Mauch all return in the back row for the Big Red. Mauch, a sophomore, had 196 digs and 21 aces in her first year as a Husker last season. Choboy, a junior, had 185 digs and 36 set assists. Boesiger, entering her senior season, played in

nine matches as a serving sub in 2024.

- Skyler Pierce will look to make an impact at outside hitter after redshirting in her first year at NU. Pierce had an accomplished prep career at Olathe Northwest in Kansas and was the MVP of the Under Armour All-America Game in 2024.

HUSKERS WELCOME EIGHT NEWCOMERS

- Eight of the 17 players on the 2025 roster are newcomers.
- Senior opposite hitter Allie Sczech is the lone transfer the Huskers brought in for 2025. Sczech was a two-time All-Big 12 Second Team performer at Baylor, averaging 2.44 kills per set with a .273 hitting percentage in 2024. Sczech posted a career-high 21 kills and hit .463 in Baylor's NCAA Tournament second round defeat to Dayton last year. She totaled 754 kills in three seasons at Baylor.
- In addition to Sczech, seven freshmen have joined the fold. Campbell Flynn (6-3, Setter), Ryan Hunter (6-2, Opposite Hitter), Keri Leimbach (5-4, Libero) and Teraya Sigler (6-3, Outside Hitter) all enrolled at Nebraska in January. Virginia Adriano (6-5, Opposite Hitter), Kenna Cogill (6-4, Middle Blocker) and Manaia Ogbechie (6-3, Middle Blocker) joined the Huskers in June.

BUSBOOM KELLY DEBUTS AS NEW HEAD COACH

- Nebraska native Dani Busboom Kelly was named the fourth head coach in program history on Jan. 29, 2025 by Nebraska Director of Athletics Troy Dannen. Busboom Kelly succeeds her former coach and mentor, John Cook, who announced his retirement following the 2024 season after 25 seasons as Nebraska's head volleyball coach.
- A Husker national champion player and assistant coach, Busboom Kelly spent eight years (2017-24) building Louisville into a national power. The Cardinals reached two NCAA Championship matches, three NCAA Semifinals, five regional finals and won four ACC titles.
- Busboom Kelly compiled a 203-44 (.822) record in her eight seasons at Louisville, including a 120-15 (.889) mark from 2021-24, which was the second-best winning percentage in the country during that span. In 2024, the Cardinals reached the NCAA Championship match for the second time in three seasons.
- Busboom Kelly was the starting libero on Nebraska's 2006 national championship team, and she was an assistant coach when the Huskers won the 2015 national championship in Omaha. She took the helm at Louisville late in 2016 after being named AVCA National Assistant Coach of the Year in her final season as a Husker assistant, and she guided the Cardinals to heights the program had never experienced.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Nebraska has won 53 home matches in a row dating back to Dec. 1, 2022, which is the longest active streak in the nation.
- The Huskers' home win streak is its longest since moving into the Devaney Center in 2013, and it's the third longest home win streak in program history.
- Nebraska's longest all-time home win streak was 88 matches from 2004-09.
- The Huskers went 22-0 at home in 2024, a school record for home wins in a season.
- Nebraska's second-longest home win streak is 61 matches from 1988-93.
- Nebraska has won 26 consecutive NCAA Tournament matches played in the Devaney Center, a school record.

REGENTS APPROVE NAMING OF JOHN COOK ARENA

- The home of Nebraska Volleyball will now officially bear the name of one of the legendary coaches in the history of the sport, as the University of Nebraska Board of Regents approved the naming of John Cook Arena at the Bob Devaney Sports Center.

• Cook retired in January following a remarkable 25-year run as the Huskers' head coach. He guided the Huskers to four national championships, 12 NCAA Semifinal appearances and 14 conference championships. Cook achieved a career record of 883-176 (.834), the fifth-best winning percentage all-time for a Division I volleyball coach. His record of 722-103 at Nebraska was the best winning percentage (.875) for any DI program from 2000-24.

• In addition to the naming of John Cook Arena at the Bob Devaney Sports Center, the project also includes a bronze statue honoring Cook on the north side of the Devaney Sports Center. Nationally recognized sculpture artist and Nebraska native George Lundeen was commissioned to produce the life-size tribute to Cook and his career.

• The court inside John Cook Arena will continue to hold the name of Terry Pettit Court to recognize Cook's predecessor and fellow Hall of Famer. Additionally, the full athletics complex will continue to be named the Bob Devaney Sports Center in honor of Nebraska Hall of Fame football coach and long-time athletic director Bob Devaney.

HUSKERS SET FOR 24 TV BROADCASTS

• Nebraska volleyball airs on television 24 times this season. The Huskers have 19 national TV appearances on Big Ten Network, FOX, FS1, NBC, ABC and ESPN.

• Additionally, Nebraska Public Media was granted the rights to televise the Red-White Scrimmage (Aug. 9), the Alumni Match (Aug. 16), and three regular-season home matches: Grand Canyon (Sept. 13), Maryland (Sept. 27) and Northwestern (Oct. 24).

• All matches that are televised on Nebraska Public Media are also streamed on B1G+. All home matches and Big Ten road matches not selected for TV are streamed on B1G+.

• NU's match at Lipscomb is available on ESPN+.

FOUR HUSKERS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN

• Four student-athletes from the Nebraska volleyball team were named to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team after a vote by the league's 18 head coaches.

• Juniors Andi Jackson, Harper Murray and Bergen Reilly were three of just five unanimous selections to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team. They were joined on the 20-player team by senior Rebekah Allick.

• The coaches picked Nebraska as the top team in the preseason poll. The Huskers won their fifth Big Ten title in 2024 with a 19-1 conference record to share the crown with Penn State. Nebraska finished the season at 33-3 and reached the NCAA Semifinals. Penn State, Wisconsin, Minnesota and UCLA rounded out the top five.

• Jackson, a junior middle blocker, had a breakout year in 2024, earning AVCA All-America First Team and unanimous All-Big Ten First Team honors. Jackson averaged 2.62 kills per set with a .439 hitting percentage, which ranked sixth in the nation and fourth in school history. She also put up 1.18 blocks per set.

• Murray, a junior outside hitter, was an AVCA Second Team All-American last year after earning third-team honors as a freshman. Murray led the Huskers in 2024 with 3.40 kills per set and a team-high 39 service aces. She is a two-time All-Big Ten First Team selection. Murray was selected to the NCAA Championship All-Tournament Team last season and was the NCAA Lincoln Regional Most Outstanding Player.

• Reilly, a junior setter, is the first player in Big Ten history to win Big Ten Setter of the Year as both a freshman and sophomore, and she is coming off her second straight AVCA All-America Second Team honor. Reilly averaged 11.08 assists per set in 2024 while leading the Huskers to a .284 hitting percentage, their best since 2016.

• Allick, a senior middle blocker, recorded 1.82 kills per set in 2024 with a career-best .357 hitting percentage. She had a team-high 1.43 blocks per set, which ranked third among Big Ten players and 14th nationally. Allick ranks sixth in

school history with 415 career blocks entering the 2025 season. She was an All-Big Ten Second Team selection in 2022 and 2023.

FOUR HUSKERS ON PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

• Rebekah Allick, Andi Jackson, Harper Murray and Bergen Reilly are on the AVCA Player of the Year Watch List. Jackson, Murray and Reilly were on the 30-player watch list announced in July. Allick was one of 17 additions to the list in October.

• The Player of the Year Watch List is compiled by the AVCA Division I Women's Volleyball Awards Committee. They will also be the group working on the additional phases of the Player of the Year process. Semifinalists will be named in November. Finalists will be announced on Dec. 15, and the Player of the Year Award will be presented in Kansas City at the AVCA Awards Banquet on Friday, Dec. 19.

FLYNN NAMED GATORADE NATIONAL POTY

• Freshman Campbell Flynn was named the Gatorade National Player of the Year on Jan. 10.

• Flynn, a 6-3 setter from Oakland, Mich., was a two-time Gatorade Michigan Volleyball Player of the Year. She recorded 730 assists and 180 digs in her senior season for Mercy High School, leading the Marlins to a 31-3 record and the Division I regional semifinals in 2024. Flynn also compiled 131 kills, 52 blocks and 36 service aces while posting a .394 hitting percentage at net.

• Flynn was a member of the U.S. U21 Women's National Team that won the gold medal at the NORCECA Championships in 2024 and was ranked as the nation's No. 4 overall recruit and top setter recruit in the Class of 2025 by PrepDig.com. Flynn concluded her prep volleyball career, which included a state championship in 2023, with 1,973 assists and 737 kills. She also competed in the Under Armour All-America Game. Off the court, Flynn maintained a 3.94 GPA in the classroom.

• Flynn is the sixth Husker all-time to be named the Gatorade National Player of the Year. The others are Harper Murray (2022-23), Ally Batenhorst (2020-21), Lexi Sun (2016-17), Mikaela Foecke (2014-15) and Gina Mancuso (2008-09).

FLYNN, SIGLER EARN GATORADE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

• In addition to being named Gatorade National Player of the Year, Campbell Flynn was named the Gatorade Michigan Volleyball Player of the Year for the second straight year, while fellow Husker newcomer Teraya Sigler was named the Gatorade Arizona Volleyball Player of the Year for the second straight time.

• Sigler, a 6-2 outside hitter from Scottsdale, Ariz., led Horizon High School to a 25-5 record and a fourth straight Conference 5A state championship in 2024. Sigler amassed 619 kills and 354 digs, including 33 kills and 20 digs in the state championship match. She also had 65 service aces and 28 blocks while posting a .398 hitting percentage.

• Ranked as the No. 1 recruit in the Class of 2025 by PrepDig.com, Sigler was a member of the U.S. U21 Women's National Team that won the gold medal at the NORCECA Championships in 2024. She concluded her prep volleyball career with 1,951 kills and 1,128 digs and competed in the Under Armour All-America Game.

• Since Volleyball Day in 2023, Nebraska has been part of 18 volleyball venue or school attendance records: Bob Devaney Sports Center, Memorial Stadium, Pinnacle Bank Arena, CHI Health Center Omaha, Bridgestone Arena (Nashville, Tenn.), Amalie Arena (Tampa, Fla.), Wilkinson Hall (Indiana), Xtream Arena (Iowa), Morgan Family Arena (Kansas State), Allen Arena (Lipscomb), XFINITY Center (Maryland), Breslin Center (Michigan State), Welsh-Ryan Arena (Northwestern), Covelli Center (Ohio State), Matthew Knight Arena (Oregon), Jersey Mike's Arena (Rutgers), Moody Coliseum (SMU) and Alaska Airlines Arena (Washington).

• 13 of the top 14 crowds in NCAA women's volleyball history have been matches featuring Nebraska.

• Nebraska's Sept. 16 match at Creighton at CHI Health Center Omaha drew a crowd of 17,675, an indoor regular-season record.

• Nebraska has sold out 345 consecutive regular-season matches, an NCAA women's record. The Huskers have led the nation in attendance every season since moving into the Bob Devaney Sports Center in 2013.

• Nebraska volleyball continues to lead the growth of women's college volleyball on television as well:

-Nebraska vs. Texas in the 2023 NCAA Championship on ABC drew 1.7 million viewers, an NCAA women's volleyball record.

-Nebraska vs. Kentucky on Aug. 31, 2025 drew 1.2 million viewers, an NCAA women's volleyball regular-season record for ESPN and ABC.

-Nebraska vs. Wisconsin on Oct. 21, 2023 drew 612,000 viewers, an NCAA women's volleyball record for Big Ten Network.

-Nebraska at Penn State on Oct. 3, 2025 averaged 1.05 million viewers, becoming the second most-watched match in network history.

DANI BUSBOOM KELLY

HEAD COACH • 1ST SEASON • NEBRASKA (2007)

Nebraska native Dani Busboom Kelly was named the fourth head coach in program history on Jan. 29, 2025 by Nebraska Director of Athletics Troy Dannen.

Busboom Kelly succeeds her former coach and mentor, John Cook, who announced his retirement following the 2024 season after 25 seasons as Nebraska's head volleyball coach.

A Husker national champion player and assistant coach, Busboom Kelly spent the last eight years building Louisville into a national power. The Cardinals reached two NCAA Championship matches, three NCAA Semifinals, five regional finals and won four ACC titles.

Busboom Kelly compiled a 203-44 (.822) record in her eight seasons at Louisville, including a 120-15 (.889) mark from 2021-24, which is the second-best winning percentage in the country during that span. In 2024, the Cardinals reached the NCAA Championship match for the second time in the last three seasons.

Busboom Kelly was the starting libero on Nebraska's 2006 national championship team, and she was an assistant coach when the Huskers won the 2015 national championship in Omaha. She took the helm at Louisville late in 2016 after being named AVCA National Assistant Coach of the Year in her final season as a Husker assistant, and she guided the Cardinals to heights the program had never experienced.

In her first season at Louisville in 2017, Busboom Kelly took over a program coming off a 12-18 season and led UofL to a 24-7 record, an ACC title and an NCAA Tournament appearance. Picked eighth in the ACC preseason poll, she coached two players to major conference postseason awards, ACC Setter of the Year (Wilma Rivera) and ACC Defensive Player of the Year (Molly Sauer). For her efforts, she was named the AVCA East Region Coach of the Year for the first of four times at Louisville. Following her first season, Busboom Kelly was named the head coach of the U.S. Collegiate National Team Europe Tour, leading them to the gold medal in the European Global Challenge.

The Cardinals continued to improve each season, reaching the NCAA Tournament Second Round in 2018 and the program's first-ever NCAA Regional Final in 2019. During the shortened 2020-21 season, Busboom Kelly's Cardinals went 15-3 and won the ACC Championship, and she was named ACC Coach of the Year.

Louisville broke through in a big way in 2021, winning 32 straight matches to begin the season before finishing the year in the NCAA Semifinals for the first time in program history. Busboom Kelly was again named ACC Coach of the Year as well as AVCA National Coach of the Year, as the Cardinals achieved their first No. 1 ranking in program history. She became the first woman in NCAA history to coach an undefeated regular season, and two Louisville players (Tori Dilfer and Anna Stevenson) earned the program's first-ever AVCA All-America First Team honors.

The Cardinals finished 31-3 in 2022 and reached the NCAA Final for the first time in school history, falling to top-seeded Texas. Busboom Kelly was the ACC Coach of the Year for the third year in a row, as the Cardinals won their third straight ACC title. Claire Chaussee was voted ACC Player of the Year, and Amaya Tillman won the NCAA Elite 90 Award for having the best cumulative GPA at the NCAA Championship.

After going 27-5 in 2023 with another regional final appearance and another ACC Player of the Year honor (Anna DeBeer), the Cardinals began the 2024 season with pressure to get back to the NCAA Semifinals, which were being played at the KFC Yum! Center in Louisville. Not only did the Cardinals qualify for the NCAA Semifinals in their own city, they also impressively turned aside top-seeded Pittsburgh, 3-1, despite losing their top hitter DeBeer for the tournament early in set four.

Prior to her time at Louisville, Busboom Kelly played a vital role on the Husker coaching staff, assisting with Nebraska's setters, liberos, outside hitters and recruiting. Regarded as one of the best recruiters in the nation, Busboom Kelly helped Nebraska's resurgence to the forefront of college volleyball, as the Huskers captured the 2015 NCAA Championship at the CenturyLink Center in Omaha, the same place Busboom Kelly won the national title as a player for the Huskers in 2006.

Behind Busboom Kelly's recruiting efforts, the Huskers' 2013 signing class was ranked No. 1 in the nation by PrepVolleyball.com, and the 2015 class was also a top-five class. From that group Mikaela Foecke went on to become the third freshman to be named Most Outstanding Player of the NCAA Championship.

Busboom Kelly helped the Huskers to a 134-30 record and NCAA Regional Final appearances in all five seasons. Before joining the Husker staff in 2012, she was an assistant coach at Tennessee from 2009-10, and an assistant coach at Louisville in 2011.

As a captain at Nebraska, Busboom moved from setter to libero in 2006 to help Nebraska's defense and finished her career as one of only two players to rank among NU's all-time leaders in both digs (1,281) and assists (2,873). She was a four-year starter for Cook, guiding NU to a 124-10 record, three Big 12 titles, two NCAA Final appearances and a national title in 2006.

In addition to her accomplishments on the court, Busboom excelled off the court for the Huskers. She was a 2006 second-team Academic All-District VII selection, while earning six Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll accolades and becoming a three-time first-team Academic All-Big 12 honoree. She earned a bachelor's degree in communication studies from Nebraska in 2007.

Dani and her husband, former Nebraska football player Lane Kelly, were married in the summer of 2010 and have two sons, Boone and Jett.
