SCOUTING THE SAMFORD BULLDOGS

First-year head coach Matt Wise brings Samford to Lincoln after leading the Bulldogs to a 75-53 win over NCAA Division II Montevallo on Education Day at the Pete Hanna Center in Birmingham Monday.

Sophomore guard Briana Rivera scored a game-high 18 points to lead three Bulldog starters in double figures. The 5-5 transfer from Austin Peay hit 5-of-14 three-point attempts in the win.

Redshirt sophomore Aubrey Blankenship added 13 points, five rebounds and four assists, while freshman guard Francie Morris pitched in 12 points and six boards.

Redshirt senior center Emily Snoddy (formerly Bowman), who was a 2025 SoCon All-Defensive selection, contributed 11 rebounds, including seven offensive boards, and a pair of blocked shots for the Bulldogs.

Freshman Carla Baguda, a 6-2 forward, also grabbed 11 rebounds and notched three blocks to go along with four points off the bench.

Graduate guard Jada Knight produced eight points and a game-high five assists in a starting role, while senior Sierra Godbolt also put up eight points off the bench.

Snoddy (22 starts, 9.9 ppg, 7.4 rpg), Godbolt (17 starts, 5.4 ppg, 2.2 rpg) and Blankenship (16 starts, 5.0 ppg, 2.9 rpg) were part-time starters alongside current Husker Claire Johnson (14 starts) for the Bulldogs last season. Johnson was Samford's leading scorer (12.2 ppg) and a second-team All-SoCon selection in 2024-25.

Alyssa Tarpley (2.3 ppg, 1.2 rpg), Jada Knight (1.2 ppg) and Martha Bishop were also teammates of Johnson last season, while Matt Wise, Sally Higgins, Charity Brown and Walker Martin were all on staff under then-Head Coach Carley Kuhns, who completed her sixth season in 2024-25.

Samford, which went 12-19 and 7-7 in the SoCon in 2024-25, plays upcoming games against power conference teams at Florida (Nov. 13), at Alabama (Nov. 19), at Minnesota (Dec. 1) and at Mississippi State (Dec. 28).

HUSKERS READY FOR BATTLE WITH BULLDOGS

Nebraska continues its three-game season-opening home stand by battling the Samford Bulldogs today at Pinnacle Bank Arena.

The Huskers tipped off the 2025-26 campaign with an impressive 103-46 victory over Northwestern State on Monday.

Claire Johnson, a 5-9 sophomore transfer who earned second-team All-SoCon honors at Samford last season, led five Huskers in double figures with 21 points in her Big Red debut.

Fellow sophomore Britt Prince, a 2025 Big Ten All-Freshman choice, added 19 points and five rebounds, while a third sophomore - center Petra Bozan - pitched in 11 points and three boards in her first collegiate start.

Senior starter Callin Hake (13 points) and junior starter Jessica Petrie (11 points, 7 rebounds) rounded out the Huskers in double figures, while junior transfer Emily Fisher added career bests with nine points, three assists and four steals in her Nebraska debut.

As a team, Nebraska raced to a 32-10 lead at the end of the opening period, producing the most first-quarter points in school history. NU's 59 points at halftime were the highest first-half total in a season opener in school history.

The game marked the seventh time in the last 135 contests that the Big Red hit the century mark, dating back to a 108-50 season-opening win over Maine on Nov. 9, 2021. The Huskers have scored 100 points at least one time in each of the past five seasons, including three times in the first five games of 2021-22.

- The attendees will feature 11 of Nebraska's 1,000-point scorers, including Nebraska Athletic Hall of Famers and conference players of the year Karen Jennings and Maurtice Ivy, former WNBA Draft picks Nicole Kubik and Kiera Hardy, four-time All-Big Ten choice Alexis Markowski, all-conference picks Amy Stephens, Nafeesah Brown-Morrow, Cory (Montgomery) Barrett, Dominique Kelley-Johnson, Kate Galligan and Nebraska's first 1,000-point scorer Jan Crouch.

SERIES HISTORY WITH SAMFORD

- Today's game marks the second meeting in history between Nebraska and Samford in women's basketball. The Huskers worked their way to a 71-46 win over the Bulldogs at Pinnacle Bank Arena on Dec. 10, 2022.
- Callin Hake is the only active Husker who played in the first meeting with Samford, knocking down a three-pointer while adding two rebounds in 12 minutes off the bench as a true freshman.
- Graduate Allison Weidner, who is redshirting this season, posted a double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds to go along with five steals as a starter during her sophomore season in the game. Jaz Shelley added 15 points and six assists, while Alexis Markowski led the Big Red with 16 points, 15 rebounds and three blocked shots against the Bulldogs.
- Current Bulldog Alyssa Tarpley was a starter in the first meeting, managing three rebounds, two steals and an assist in 27 minutes. Emily (Bowman) Snoddy scored five points and grabbed three rebounds along with a steal in 11 minutes off the bench.

THREE THINGS TO WATCH

- **1** Callin Hake played the 100th game of her Nebraska career in Monday's win over Northwestern State. She finished with 13 points on a perfect 4-for-4 shooting from the field. The senior guard added three assists and three steals.
- **2** Nebraska has opened six consecutive seasons with a 2-0 record, dating back to a season-opening loss to Drake on Nov. 7, 2018. The Huskers have won their second home game in eight consecutive seasons, dating back to a Preseason WNIT loss to Missouri on Nov. 14, 2016.
- **3** Nebraska has hit 10 or more three-pointers 50 times in the last 142 games, including 10 times in 2024-25. The Huskers hit a school-record 20-of-34 threes in a win over South Dakota at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls (Nov. 16, 2024). Nebraska also tied a Pinnacle Bank Arena record last year by hitting 16-of-32 threes in a win over Wisconsin (Jan. 20, 2025), before hitting 15-of-29 threes in a win over Oregon (Feb. 19, 2025). Nebraska set a school record with 292 made threes in 2023-24 and have produced the four highest season totals in school history the past four years.

FACTS & FIGURES

Dahaunda

- Samford coach Matt Wise's mother, Mary, was the head coach of the Florida volleyball team from 1991 to 2024. She led the Gators to 19 SEC regular-season titles, 12 conference tournament titles and eight NCAA Final Four appearances in her career. She guided the Gators to the national championship match in 2003 and 2017. Nebraska won the 2017 national title 3-1 over Florida in Kansas City, after the Gators defeated the Huskers in the second match of the season.
- The Huskers have hit at least one three-pointer in 533 straight regular-season games dating back to a loss at UTEP on Dec. 20, 2009. Nebraska has hit at least two three-pointers in 412 consecutive games.
- Nebraska improved to 49-3 all-time in home season openers with its 103-46 win over Northwestern State Monday. The Huskers are 44-7 all-time in their second home game of the season.
