Teams Attending (Tentative):

- Cloud County CC, Creighton, Iowa Western CC, Midland, Missouri – Kansas City, **Nebraska**, Nebraska - Kearney Northern Iowa, South Dakota State, Wayne State, William Penn

Collegiate Entry Procedures:

- Institutions of any collegiate division are welcome to attend.
- Institutions wishing to compete will need to contact Meet Director, Cody Brousek at cbrousek@huskers.com to receive approval and the appropriate access link for registration.
- Entries will be submitted via **Athletic.Net**.
 - A staff representative will still need to locate the meet on DirectAthletics and declare all eligible athletes.
- Entries will *OPEN* on Monday, March 9th and *CLOSE* on Monday, March 30th at 5:00pm (CDT).
- Entry marks will be accepted from the 2025 Indoor/Outdoor Season or 2026 Indoor season. Marks not found within TFRRS from the 2025 or 2026 seasons, will be entered as “No Time”, “No Height”, or “No Distance”.
- Entry notes will be considered by meet management for those who have not yet achieved a valid mark.
- A list of accepted entries will be posted on the “Home Meet Info” tab, located on the Husker’s Track & Field website upon closure of the entry window.

Unattached Entry Procedures:

- A limited number of CURRENT or POST collegiate unattached entries may be accepted to enhance fields at the meet. NO high school entries or younger will be accepted.
- Athletes wishing to compete will need to contact Meet Director, Cody Brousek at cbrousek@huskers.com with name, desired event(s), and proof of performance no later than the entry deadline.
- Upon acceptance, additional instructions will be provided for official entry.
- NO entry fee will be charged for unattached athletes.

Entry Fee:

- \$50 per individual entry/relay; not to exceed \$750 per gender.
- All entries will be paid via Athletic.Net and MUST be paid prior to the closure of entries on Monday, March 30th at 5:00pm (CDT).
- Payment of entry fee is NOT a guarantee to compete. This is only an entry fee, not a competition fee.

Entry Restrictions:

- Meet management reserves the right to select which entries will be accepted and in which sections entrants will be placed in order to provide the highest level of competition possible.

Practice & Warm-ups:

- **Thursday, April 2nd**
 - The facility will be made available Thursday between 4:30pm – 8:00pm. All teams wishing to use the facility **MUST** make arrangements with Cody Brousek, no later than Monday, March 30th.

Team Tents:

- Team tents will be set up in the parking lot directly south of the outdoor track.
- Teams may bring with them their own tent; but all tents onsite will need to be safely secured using weights
- Teams wishing to order a tent are asked to contact Meet Director, Cody Brousek at cbrousek@huskers.com for additional information.

Sports Medicine:

- Host medical will be located on the first floor of the south building.
- Visiting Trainers & Massage Therapists are asked to set up treatment tables within their team tent.

Shower Facilities:

- Women's Visiting Locker Room will be in Locker Room #1, located inside of the Bob Devaney Sports Center.
- Men's Visiting Locker Room will be in Locker Room #2, located inside of the Bob Devaney Sports Center
- No towels will be provided, please plan accordingly.

Restrooms:

- Restroom available to all attendees will be located in the south building of the facility. Portable restrooms will also be available along the backstretch.
- Portable restrooms for student-athletes and staff will be located near the team camp area.

Food & Drink:

- Team Food and Drinks should be delivered and kept in respective team tents. Credentialed athletes and staff will be allowed to bring outside food through the credentialed entrance.
- Teams having food delivered should have their drivers follow the same traffic pattern as team buses/vans; but inform the traffic attendant that they are making a team delivery.
- Spectators will not be allowed to bring in outside food.
