NEBRASKA VS. MICHIGAN

- Through 38 all-time meetings, Nebraska holds a 21-17 advantage over Michigan in the all-time series.
- The Huskers and Wolverines met in a three-game series in Lincoln last season, where the Big Red took two of three against Michigan.

BEST START IN THE BOLT ERA

- With a 16-5 record through 21 games, Nebraska has matched its best start under head coach Will Bolt.
- The Big Red also began the 2024 campaign with a 16-5 mark, where the Huskers earned to No. 2 seed in the Stillwater Regional.

BIG RED ON AN 11-GAME WIN STREAK

- Nebraska enters the weekend on an 11-game win streak, which is the 11th time the Huskers have strung together 10-plus consecutive wins since 2000.
- The 11-game win streak is tied for the third-longest active win streak in the country, trailing No. 15 Kentucky and No. 1 UCLA with win streaks of 13 and 12 games, respectively.
- In the 11 games, the Husker offense is hitting .317 at the plate and scoring 7.5 runs per game, while the NU pitching staff has compiled a 3.00 ERA and 119 strikeouts.

A LOOK AT THE WEEKEND ROTATION

- Ty Horn takes the mound on Friday's series opener and is 0-0 on the season with a 3.16 ERA in 25.2 innings this season with 24 strikeouts in five starts.
- Redshirt sophomore Carson Jasa gets the nod on Saturday and is 3-1 with a 5.01 ERA and 37 punchouts in 23.1 innings.
- Gavin Blachowicz is scheduled to start the series finale and is 2-1 on the season with a 2.96 ERA and 33 strikeouts in 24.1

innings across five starts.

NOTABLES ON THE 2026 CAMPAIGN

- With wins against No. 7 Auburn and No. 16 Florida State this season, the Big Red are 8-5 against ranked opponents in the last two seasons.
- Nebraska is one of eight programs, to rank in the top 25 nationally in batting average (24th, .312) and fielding percentage (18th, .983).
- The Husker offense ranks 12th nationally with 52 doubles and is 12th in the country with 2.48 doubles per game, a pace that would produce the fifth-most doubles in program history over the 55-game regular-season slate in 2026.
- Cooper Katskee is off to a strong start for the NU pitching staff, ranking sixth nationally in WHIP (0.66), 16th in strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.67), 23rd in hits allowed/9 inn. (4.81) and 34th with a 1.48 ERA.
- The NU pitching staff has recorded 14 strikeouts in four of the first 21 games this season, after totaling just six such performances combined in 2024 and 2025.
- Dylan Carey ranks among the top 15 of DI's active career leaders in four categories, including second in at-bats (751), third in doubles (55), fifth in games played (196) and 11th in hits (215).
- Dylan Carey was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch list, while Ty Horn and Gavin Blachowicz landed on the Pitcher of the Year Award Watch List.
- The Big Red completed its nine-game homestand with a perfect 9-0 mark, recording their best home start since opening the home slate in 2015 with an 11-0 record.

SEVEN WALK-OFF WINS SINCE APRIL 2025

- The Huskers have recorded three walk-off victories through the first 21 games this season.
- Going back to the final three weeks of the regular season in 2025, the Big Red have totaled seven victories in walk-off fashion.

MAC OF ALL TRADES

- Junior Mac Moyer has been a mainstay in the leadoff spot and a key contributor for the Husker offense this season, ranking among the team leaders in a variety of categories.
- The center fielder has seen action in every game this season, reaching base safely in the last 20 contests
- Moyer leads the Huskers with a .421 batting average, .527 on-base percentage, eight doubles, 17 walks drawn and four stolen bases, while ranking second in hits (32) and runs scored (22).

OTHER BATS IN THE HUSKER LINEUP

- Case Sanderson has scored a team-best 24 runs and is second on the team with 12 walks while batting .375 with eight doubles, a home run and 18 runs driven in.
- Jett Buck is batting .375 at the plate with six doubles, three homers, 17 RBI, 15 runs scored and team-high four stolen bases on the season.
- Joshua Overbeek is hitting .260 with six doubles, a homer, 11 RBI and 17 runs scored while tallying a .408 on-base percentage.
- Cole Kitchens has doubled five times and driven in 16 runs as NU's designated hitter, while Jeter Worthley is batting .304 with five doubles and 16 run scored.
- Drew Grego is hitting .314 with a triple, a homer, six RBI and six runs scored after homering for the first time on Wednesday at Wichita State.

NOTABLE ARMS IN THE PEN

- Caleb Clark has made a team-high eight relief appearances and holds a 3.86 ERA in seven innings, while Ryan Harrahill has compiled a 0.87 ERA with one run allowed in 10.1 innings across seven relief outings.
- Kevin Mannell is 1-0 on the year with a save in eight appearances and has totaled a 3.97 ERA and 12 strikeouts in 11.1 innings.
- J'Shawn Unger holds a 3-1 record and two saves in seven relief outings while posting a 4.50 ERA and 12 strikeouts with an opposing batting average of .186 in 12 innings.
- Chase Olson is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA across five relief appearances.
- Tucker Timmerman and Colin Nowaczyk have seen action in six relief outings, while southpaws Grant Cleavinger and Braxton Stewart have toed the rubber five and three times, respectively.

LUCKY NUMBER SIX IN THE BOLT ERA

- Nebraska is 142-29 under head coach Will Bolt when scoring at least six runs.
- The Husker offense has scored six-plus runs in 13 of the 16 victories this season after reaching the six-run mark 32 times last season, compiling a 25-7 record.
- Nebraska scored six-plus runs in 34 contests (28-6) in 2024 after tallying at least six runs 33 times (26-7) in 2023, 23 times (19-4) in 2022, 28 times (26-2) in 2021 and seven times (5-2) in 2020.

CAREY NEARING ALL-TIME DOUBLES RECORD

- With 55 career doubles in four seasons at Nebraska, Dylan Carey needs two doubles to become the program's all-time leader.
- Carey is tied for second all-time after doubling eight times through Nebraska's first 21 games this season.
- The Castle Rock, Colo., native is tied with Daniel Bruce (2002-05) and Matt Hopper (2000-03) and is one shy of tying Will Bolt's (1999-02) program record of 56 career doubles.

CAREY JOINS 200-CAREER HIT CLUB, CLIMBS ALL-TIME LIST

- Dylan Carey became the 28th member of Nebraska's 200-hit club with five hits in a road series at No. 7 Auburn earlier this season.
- Carey has averaged 62 hits per season over the last two seasons, which would put him just outside NU's all-time top 10 if he were to reach that average again in 2026.
- Before Carey, the Huskers had five players join the 200-hit club since 2015, including second-round draft picks Max Anderson (2021-23) and Ryan Boldt (2014-16).

BIG INNINGS PROPEL NU OFFENSE IN THE BOLT ERA

- During Will Bolt's tenure at Nebraska, the Huskers have scored three-plus runs in an inning in 176 games and hold a 140-35-1 record in those contests.
- The Huskers are 65-15 in the last three seasons when the NU offense has generated the big inning (3+ runs) in 2024, 2025 and 2026.
- In 2025, Division I teams who scored three-plus runs in an inning won 70.1% of the time.

ROB CHILDRESS PITCHING FACTORY

- Proven to be one of the nation's top pitching coaches at the collegiate level, Rob Childress has produced 25 All-Americans and 41 top-10 round draft picks in his 26 seasons directing the pitching at Nebraska and Texas A&M.
- Under his tutelage, 84 pitchers have been drafted or signed as free agents during his time with the Huskers and Aggies.
- Childress' pitching staffs have finished in the top-15 in the country in ERA eight times since 2000, including top-three finishes on three occasions. Five of his pitching staffs have finished in the top-25 nationally in strikeouts per nine innings since 2010, including four times in the top 10.
- In his 10 seasons at the helm of the NU pitching staff, the Huskers have produced seven of the top 10 single-season strikeout totals in school history, including a school-record 538 strikeouts in 2005. The NU pitchers fell 11 punchouts shy of tying the school record in 2024, compiling the second-most strikeouts in program history with 527 strikeouts.
- Childress' pitching staffs have completed 11 seasons with a walks-per-innings below three, including a season-low 2.51 walks/9 inn. at Nebraska in 2000 and Texas A&M in 2011.

THREE HUSKERS IN D1BASEBALL POSITION RANKINGS

- Nebraska had three players listed in D1Baseball's Preseason Player Rankings released throughout the month of February.
- Ty Horn and Cooper Katskee were ranked No. 76 and 84, respectively, in the list of the top 200 starting pitchers. Horn went 4-4 and struck out 76 in 85.2 innings as NU's No. 2 arm in the rotation, while Katskee went 11-2 with a 3.08 ERA and 70 punchouts in 84.2 innings while earning third-team All-American recognition.
- Dylan Carey checked in at No. 25 in the top 50 shortstops after hitting .288 at the plate with 20 doubles, eight home runs and 41 RBI in 62 games in 2025.

MINING THE JUNIOR COLLEGE RANKS

- Of the 41 Huskers on this year's squad, 11 Huskers spent time playing at least one season at the junior college level at some point prior to arriving in Lincoln.
- Two players hail from Johnson County CC and Cisco College, while Grossmont College, New Mexico Military Institute, Crowder College, San Jacinto JC, Cloud County CC, Three Rivers College and Iowa Western CC all had one Husker come through their respective programs.

BIG RED'S HISTORIC RUN IN 2025 BIG TENTOURNAMENT

• Nebraska went 2-0 in pool play and added two more wins in the semifinal and championship rounds to become the lowest seed to ever win the Big Ten Tournament last season.

TWO HUSKERS TAKEN IN 2025 MLB DRAFT

• The Huskers have had at least two players picked in the MLB Draft in nine of the last 11 drafts (excluding shortened 2020 Draft) after Mason McConnaughey and Luke Broderick heard

their names called in the 2025 MLB Draft.

• McConnaughey was taken in the fourth round by the Texas Rangers after having his junior campaign cut short after a season-ending injury in his third start of 2025. The Preseason All-American was the first Husker named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List since 2016 after earning second-team All-Big Ten accolades with a 9-3 record and 3.45 ERA in 17 appearances, including 11 starts in 2024.

• Broderick heard his name called with the 14th-round selection by the Colorado Rockies to become the eighth Husker pitcher to be drafted under head coach Will Bolt. The Second-Team All-Big Ten selection went 4-2 with a 3.25 ERA in 27 relief appearances and totaled 13 saves, which ranks tied for third-most in a season and sixth all-time in program history.

#PROBIGNED: HUSKERS IN SPRING TRAINING

• With MLB spring training scheduled to start in February, seven former Huskers are set to report to various spring training camps across Florida and Arizona this month.

• Jake Meyers and Brice Matthews earned invites from the Astros, while Aaron Bummer (Braves), Matt Waldron (Padres), Cade Povich (Orioles), Max Anderson (Tigers) and Josh Caron (Mariners) are also Huskers to keep an eye on this spring.

NU AMONG NATION'S BEST IN ATTENDANCE

• Nebraska has led the Big Ten in attendance every season since joining the Big Ten in 2012 and ranks 10th nationally in average attendance in the last 14 seasons with 4,258 fans per game.

• The Big Red have ranked in the Top 20 in average attendance in each season since 2012, climbing as high as sixth in 2017 and 2021.

• The Huskers have finished in the top 15 in average attendance in every season since 2015, joining LSU, Ole Miss, Arkansas, South Carolina, Mississippi State, Texas and Florida as the only eight programs to accomplish the feat.

One of the catalysts in Nebraska baseball's rise to national prominence in his playing days, Will Bolt returned to his alma mater as former athletic director Bill Moos named Bolt the 24th head coach of the Husker baseball program on June 14, 2019.

Bolt has 17 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience, having served in assistant coaching roles at Texas A&M and Nebraska. Bolt also spent four years as the head coach at Texarkana College.

Since taking over the Huskers, Bolt has led the Big Red to three conference titles and three NCAA Regional appearances in the last five seasons.

Nebraska made back-to-back regional appearances for the first time since 2016-17 in 2025 after Bolt led the Huskers to back-to-back Big Ten Tournament titles and six wins over ranked opponents, including No. 4 Oregon, No. 5 Oregon State (twice), No. 13 UCLA, No. 16 Vanderbilt and No. 22 Kansas last season.

In 2024, Bolt led the Huskers to their first Big Ten Tournament title in program history. With an overall record of 40-22, the Big Red reached the 40-win mark for the first time since 2014 and the 19th time in program history.

Along with the Big Ten Tournament run, Brett Sears was a unanimous Second-Team All-American and was named the Big Ten's Pitcher of the Year before getting drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the seventh round of the MLB Draft. Josh Caron was selected in the fourth round by the Seattle Mariners, becoming the highest overall selection of a Husker catcher since 1985.

In 2023, the Huskers had four players picked in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft for the first time since 2005. Fueled by Second-Team All-American Max Anderson and first-round draft pick Brice Matthews, the Nebraska offense belted a school-record 97 home runs. Anderson became the first Husker since 2001 to hit above .400 at the plate with a .414 batting average while hitting the fifth-most homers in program history with 21 last season. Matthews became the first player in program history and second player all-time in the Big Ten to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season.

The 2021 Big Ten Coach of the Year, Bolt guided Nebraska to its second Big Ten regular-season championship in 2021. The Huskers compiled a 34-14 record, including a 31-12 record in Big Ten play, with NU capturing the league crown by 3.5 games. Nebraska also advanced to its first regional final since 2007 while posting a 3-2 record in the NCAA Fayetteville Regional.

In addition to Bolt's coaching accolade, NU counted the Big Ten Player of the Year in Spencer Schwellenbach, the Big Ten Freshman of the Year in Max Anderson and four first-team All-Big Ten honorees -- its most since joining the league. Schwellenbach was also tabbed the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year and a first-team All-American, and Anderson picked up Freshman All-America recognition.

Three NU hurlers were selected in the 2021 MLB Draft, with Schwellenbach in the second round (59th overall) by the Atlanta Braves, Cade Povich going in the third round (98th overall) by the Minnesota Twins and Cam Wynne picked in the 20th round by the Philadelphia Phillies.

Nebraska's 2020 season -- Bolt's first at the helm -- was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Bolt spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Texas A&M in 2015-19, where the Aggies went 219-98-1 with five consecutive NCAA Regional appearances, three regional titles, an SEC Tournament title in 2016 and an appearance in the 2017 College World Series.

Bolt's primary functions on the Aggie staff included coordinating the offensive game, mentoring the infielders and serving as third base coach. The Aggies finished in the top-25 nationally in batting average twice under his tutelage and finished in the top five of the SEC in hitting or runs scored in four of his five seasons with the Aggies. He mentored 12 hitters who were selected in the MLB Draft during his tenure in College Station, including six players selected in the top-10 rounds, and seven players who earned first or second-team All-SEC accolades.

Bolt worked three seasons as associate head coach on Darin Erstad's staff (2012-14) and tutored four players to first-team All-Big Ten honors, including three two-time selections. The Husker offense ranked among the Big Ten leaders in the three-year stint, finishing eighth and 19th nationally in the 2012 and 2014 seasons, respectively. Under Bolt's watch in 2013, the Big Red concluded the year ranked second in the nation with a .981 fielding percentage.

Before joining Erstad's staff, Bolt served four years as head coach at Texarkana College (2008-11). He posted a 140-82 (.631) record and helped over 20 players sign with DI schools, while guiding the Bulldogs to back-to-back Region XIV titles during a stretch of four consecutive 30-plus win seasons.

Bolt began his coaching career with volunteer assistant roles at Texas A&M (2006-07) and Nebraska (2005). Working with infielders and hitters at both stops, he helped the Huskers sweep the Big 12 regular-season and tournament titles and aided the Aggies to a super regional and their first-ever Big 12 Tournament title with a 49-18 overall record.

A four-year starter and team captain on Nebraska's 2001 and 2002 College World Series teams, Bolt played an instrumental role in helping Nebraska to four NCAA Regionals, three Super Regionals and back-to-back CWS appearances as a member of Dave Van Horn's first recruiting class.

Bolt finished his career holding six school records, including games played (251), games started (242), at-bats (922), hits (281), doubles (56) and assists (639). Bolt remains in the program's top five in several categories, including doubles (first, 56), games played (second, 251), assists (second, 639), hits (third, 281) and runs scored (fifth, 197).

In addition to his accomplishments on the field, Bolt graduated from Nebraska in 2003 with a degree in communication studies before earning his master's degree in 2006.

Will and his wife, Lauren, were married in summer of 2005 and have two sons, Jaxon and Austin, and one daughter, Bella.

NEBRASKA BASEBALL SCORIGAMI

A scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before. Generally associated with the NFL, the term was coined by SB Nation sportswriter Jon Bois in 2016. Through the 2025 season, there have been over 1,095 unique scores ("scorigamis") in NFL history.

NEBRASKA BASEBALL SCORIGAMI TRENDS

- Through 4,190 games in Nebraska baseball history, there have been 402 unique score combinations.
- The most common score is 3-2 (148 occurrences), followed by 4-3 (136 occurrences).
- Five of the six most common scores are one-run games, with the exception of 5-3 (103 times).
- With 79 occurrences, a 3-2 win is the most common result for Nebraska baseball, followed by defeats of 3-2 and 4-3 with 69 occurrences each.
- Since 2000, there have been 20 scorigami scores, including the most recent occurrence of Florida's 17-11 win over Nebraska in the Stillwater Regional in 2024.
- Five runs scored (423 occurrences) is the most common for the Huskers, while three runs scored (508 occurrences) is the most common for opponents.
- **27,310** runs scored, **21,576** runs allowed in **4,190** games in **120** seasons for an all-time record of **2,414-1758-18**.
