## Uniform Policy

## **Introductory Statement**

This policy is to outline the school uniform, which is worn in Castletroy College.

## **Rationale**

To ensure parents, pupils and staff are aware of the correct school uniform.

The highest standard of personal appearance is expected at all times as it represents the standards set by our school for our students. The school endeavours to maintain the highest standards in matters of dress code and personal appearance for all students in the school.

Accordingly, parents must ensure that pupils comply with the standards as set out in this policy.

All students are obliged to wear the full school uniform during school hours, matches, outings, state examinations or when representing the school in any way unless otherwise stated.

On the rare occasion that a student may not be in a position to present to school in full school uniform the student should bring a written note to school explaining the reason for not having the correct uniform.

## **Requirements**

### **School Uniform**

The full school uniform, all of which is non gender specific, must be worn each day except on the day that a student has a double PE class timetabled as outlined below or permission is expressly given by the school not to wear uniform.

- The crested school jacket is a compulsory part of the school uniform.
- School Jumper with Castletroy College Crest.
- Traditional style school shirt, blue in colour (no logos visible) worn with the school tie (the tie to be seen at all times).
- Uniform skirt length should be at ankle or  $\frac{3}{4}$  length.
- Trousers – Dark Grey to shoe length.
- Brown/Black/Navy leather shoes to be worn – no runners, converse, boots, ugg boots, canvass shoes etc.
- In the interest of health and safety – jewellery must be kept to a minimum. Stud earrings no more than 4mm in diameter can be worn. (No spacers, bars or hoops allowed).
- No facial or body piercings are permitted.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times.
- No extreme hair colours are permitted - hair is to be of a natural colour.

## **PE Uniform**

For PE classes' students must wear

- The school crested PE t-shirt top.
- The school crested half zip / quarter zip top.
- The school crested tracksuit bottoms or crested leggings.
- Appropriate runners.

Students are permitted to wear their PE uniform to school on the day they are timetabled for a double PE class.

If a student does not have the school PE uniform then they must wear their school uniform to school and change into their PE gear prior to their PE class.

Senior Cycle students who are undertaking Leaving Certificate PE are permitted to wear their PE uniform if instructed to do so by their teacher.

## **General Appearance**

- For practical classes long hair should be tied back. Finger nails should not be of an excessive length (Art, Home Economics, PE, Engineering, Wood Technology, Science, etc).
- Logos, designs, etc that are inappropriate, offensive or represent illegal activity are not permitted.
- Chewing gum is prohibited.
- Students should keep their uniform clean and tidy.
- Gloves, hats and scarves to be worn outside only.

## **Uniform Consistency**

- Adherence to the school uniform policy is monitored daily by Class Teachers, Class Tutors, Year Heads and / or Senior Leadership Team as part of our commitment to maintaining and promoting a high standard of dress code.

## **Failure to Comply with this Policy**

- Failure to comply with the uniform policy may result in a sanction being issued.
